- lowa opened its 2015-16 season with wins over Gardner-Webb (76-59) & Coppin State (103-68).
- Redshirt freshman Brady Ellingson will be making a homecoming on Thursday. The shooting guard hails from Sussex, Wisconsin, a suburb of Milwaukee.
- Iowa was 7-3 in true road games a year ago. Thursday's game is the Hawkeyes' earliest true road game since playing at Notre Dame in the preseason NIT on Nov. 17, 1990.
- Mike Gesell has 21 assists after two games. The senior point guard registered a career-high 12 assists in 19 minutes against Coppin State and had nine helpers against Gardner-Webb.
- Fran McCaffery is one victory from notching career win No. 350, and two wins from collecting victory No. 100 at Iowa.
- lowa's next four games will be away from lowa City. The Hawkeyes' next home game will come Dec. 2 against Florida State in the Big Ten/ACC Challenge.
- Jarrod Uthoff was selected as one of 10 players on the Preseason All-Big Ten team. Uthoff has made 14 straight free throws dating back to last year. He is 7-of-7 from the foul line this year.
- Iowa is 40-6 when scoring 80 points or more, the last six seasons. The Hawkeyes are 56-2 when holding opponents to fewer than 61 points, the last six years.

Thursday's contest is part of the inaugural Gavitt Games, which pits eight games between teams from the Big Ten and Big EAST.

ON THE AIR

Radio: lowa games are broadcast on the Hawkeye Radio Network. Gary Dolphin handles the play-by-play, along with color commentator Bob Hansen. The network includes more than 40 stations that blanket the state of lowa and include portions of Illinois, Nebraska, Minnesota, Missouri and Wisconsin. The Hawkeye Radio Network coverage includes a 60-minute pregame show.

TV: Thursday night's game will be televised nationally on FS1 (FOXSportsGO). Brian Anderson and Stephen Bardo will call the action.

SCOUTING MARQUETTE

- Marquette split its opening two games, falling to Belmont (83-80) in the opener and beating IUPUI (75-71) in overtime.
- Four Golden Eagles netted double figures in Monday's overtime triumph over IUPUI: Henry Ellenson (18), Luke Fischer (17), Duane Wilson (16), and Sandy Cohen III (11). Marquette made 24-of-29 (.828) of its free throw attempts against the Jaguars.
- Marquette has four players average in double figures in scoring after two games: Henry Ellenson (19.5), Luke Fischer (14.5), Duane Wilson (14.5), and Sandy Cohen III (11.0). The Golden Eagles own a +5.5 advantage over their opponents on the glass this season.
- Five Marquette players average 28 minutes or more of game action, including three players averaging more than 33 minutes.
- Steve Wojciechowski is in his second season as head coach at Marquette. He had previously served as an assistant coach at Duke since 1999 and was promoted to associate head coach in the summer of 2008.

ALL-TIME SERIES RECORD

Thursday will be the 18th meeting between lowa and Marquette and the first since an 87-77 Iowa win in Iowa City in 1982. The Hawkeyes own an 8-4 advantage in games against the Golden Eagles in Milwaukee. lowa won the last contest played in Milwaukee, 86-65 in overtime, in 1981.

lowa is 38-32 against current members of the Big EAST Conference.




Head Coach Fran McCaffery

Fran McCaffery, who is signed through the 2020 season, is in his sixth season as the head basketball coach at the University of Iowa and his 20th year overall as a college head coach. McCaffery has reached the 20-win plateau seven of the last nine seasons, including the last three years.

McCaffery spent five seasons (2005-10) as the head coach at Siena, six years at UNC-Greensboro (1999-2005) and three seasons at Lehigh (1985-88) before joining the Hawkeyes.

McCaffery has three decades of Division I coaching experience. He completed his 33rd



McCaffery, 56, holds a career mark of 349-252 (.581) and guided his teams to 10 postseason appearances (seven NCAA and three NIT). He is 98-75 (.566) at Iowa.

Since taking over the Iowa program in 2010, the Hawkeyes have earned four postseason tournament berths (2 NCAA, 2 NIT). McCaffery coached lowa to 25 victories in 2013, equaling the second-most win total in program history. McCaffery has guided two Hawkeyes to All-Big Ten first team laurels, one earned second team accolades, while five were voted on the third team.

McCaffery has posted upper division finishes in each of the past three seasons at Iowa and 15-of-19 seasons as a head coach. He has posted 20 wins or more seven of the last nine seasons, including the last three at Iowa (2013, 2014, and 2015).

McCaffery and the Hawkeyes have made Carver-Hawkeye Arena one of the most feared arenas to play nationally. Fans have embraced McCaffery and his team's style of play with attendance increasing by more than 50 percent since 2010. The Hawkeyes boast a 45-10 home record the last three seasons, which includes a school-record 18 wins in 2014.

McCaffery's five years at Siena were the best in its 70-year history. He led the Saints on an incredible run that ended with three straight Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference championships and NCAA Tournament appearances. In so doing, Siena became the only program in the country to win its regular season and postseason title 2008-10.

McCaffery's Saints owned a 112-51 (.687) record in his five years with the program. He guided the Saints to four consecutive 20-win seasons.

The 2009 MAAC Coach of the Year and 2010 District I Coach of the Year is the third winningest coach, by percentage, in league history (68-22, .756). He is the only coach to guide a MAAC program to two NCAA Tournament wins. McCaffery led his 2008 and 2009 teams to first round NCAA Tournament victories over Vanderbilt and Ohio State, respectively.

In his final two seasons at Siena, he coached the Saints to back-to-back 27-win campaigns and boasted a combined 39-3 (.929) record against MAAC opponents, which included MAAC Tournament contests.

McCaffery began his coaching career as an assistant at Penn (1982-83) and Lehigh (1983-85). After three seasons as head coach at Lehigh, he spent 11 seasons as an assistant at Notre Dame (1988-99).

McCaffery played basketball at Wake Forest his freshman year (1977-78) and then concluded his collegiate playing career at Penn his final three seasons (1979-82).

He earned his B.S. degree in Economics from The Wharton School (Penn) in 1982. McCaffery also earned a Master of Education from Lehigh

Fran McCaffery coached in his 600th career game as a head coach in lowa's regular season opener against Gardner-Webb Friday evening. He has compiled a record of 349-252 in 20 seasons as a head coach. Also, he has amassed 98 wins as an lowa head coach in six seasons; McCaffery is two wins from notching win No. 100 as a Hawkeye.

IOWA CRUISES TO WIN OVER COPPIN STATE

- lowa cruised to a 103-68 win over Coppin State Sunday in Iowa City.
- · The 103 points tie for the fourth most by a Fran McCaffery coached team at Iowa. The Hawkeyes made 12 treys, which are the second most by an lowa team under coach McCaffery.
- Redshirt freshman Brady Ellingson netted a game and personal-best 20 points. He was 7-of-8 from the field, including 1-2 from 3-point distance, and 5-of-6 from the foul line.
- Mike Gesell dished out a game and career-high 12 assists. The 12 assists tie for the fifth most by an lowa player in a single game in program history.
- Dom Uhl started his first career game, replacing an injured Peter Jok. Uhl answered the call, scoring a career-best 18 points and grabbing five rebounds.
- lowa assisted on 30 of 41 field goals (77.5 percent). The Hawkeyes shot 55.6 percent from the floor (40-of-72).
- Adam Woodbury grabbed five rebounds to reach the 500-rebounding plateau in his career. His 503 rebounds are fifth most among active Big Ten players.

HAWKEYES BEAT GARDNER-WEBB IN SEASON OPENER

- lowa won its fifth straight season opener, recording a 76-59 win over Gardner-Webb.
- lowa had the advantage on the glass, pulling down seven more rebounds (46-39). lowa freshman Ahmad Wagner corralled a team-high eight rebounds, six offensive, in only nine minutes of action.
- Senior Jarrod Uthoff poured in a game-high 21 points, while also collecting six rebounds, two blocks, and two steals.
- Senior Mike Gesell dished out nine assists, to go along with three steals, four rebounds, and two points.
- lowa earned 28 free throws, sinking 21 (.750). Jarrod Uthoff made all seven of his attempts, while Adam Woodbury made 5-of-7 of his attempts and Anthony Clemmons sank a career-high 6-of-8.
- lowa's newcomers, includes redshirts, combined to score 20 points. Nicholas Baer and Ahmad Wagner each scored six points. Brady Ellingson tallied four points, Dale Jones had three, while Andrew Fleming added one.

INCREASED WORK LOAD

The last couple seasons, Adam Woodbury split time at the center position with Gabriel Olaseni. With Olaseni having graduated, expect Woodbury's minutes to increase according to coach McCaffery. The 7-foot-1, 250-pounder averaged 21 minutes per game a year ago alongside Olaseni. In his career when playing 28 minutes or more, Woodbury averaged 11.3 points and six rebounds per game.

HAWKEYE FAST BREAKS

- lowa returned seven letterwinners, including four starters.
- Iowa has won 34 of its last 35 nonconference home games, dating back to November 2011.
- Jarrod Uthoff was one of 10 players named to the Preseason All-Big Ten team as selected by a media voting panel.
- Iowa has competed in postseason play the last four years: NIT second round in 2012; NIT runner-up in 2013; NCAA first round in 2014; NCAA third round in 2015. The Hawkeyes tied for third place in the Big Ten last season -- its best finish in nine years.
- lowa won 21 regular season games last season, the most by a Hawkeye team since 2006 (22).
- lowa has won at least 20 games in three consecutive seasons -- its longest streak in 15 years.
- lowa averaged 11.1 turnovers in 2015, which is the best average for fewest turnovers in program history since turnovers became an official stat in 1980.
- Iowa's free throw percentage a year ago (74.4 percent) was the fourth best in program history for a single season.
- Iowa was the first team in the country to post road wins over two ranked opponents last year: No. 12 North Carolina (60-55) on Dec. 3 and No. 18 Ohio State (71-65) on Dec. 30.
- The Hawkeyes won seven true road games last season, including winning its final six regular-season Big Ten games for the first time since 1955. The seven total road wins were the most by a Hawkeye team since 1987.
- lowa's 12 conference wins last season are the most by a Hawkeye team since 1997. Also, its third place finish was its best in nine seasons.
- Junior guard Anthony Clemmons made 17 of his last 19 (.895) free throw attempts combined the last eight games.
- Adam Woodbury collected six assists to go along with his 11 points at Michigan last year. Woodbury became just the third Big Ten 7-footer to post 10+ points & 6+ assists in a game since 1996-97.
- Iowa's 83-52 dominant performance over Davidson in the NCAA Second Round was the program's first tournament win since 2001. It also marked the largest margin of victory in an NCAA Tournament 7/10 match-up.
- Iowa has had a first-team All-Big Ten honoree in each of the last two seasons: Devyn Marble in 2014 and Aaron White in 2015.

FLOCKING TO CHA

lowa sold out 16 home games the last two seasons. The Hawkeyes ranked 20th in national attendance in 2015, averaging 14,101 fans. It is the second straight season and 21st time that lowa has cracked the top 20 in the national attendance rankings.

Additionally, lowa played in front of 475,998 fans in its 34 games (home, away, and on neutral courts) throughout the season. That figure ranked 13th in the country.

As a conference, the 14 Big Ten schools averaged 12,781 fans to lead in the nation in average attendance for a 39th consecutive season. More than three million fans witnessed Big Ten games in person throughout the course of the 2014-15 season. For the second consecutive year, lowa was one of seven Big Ten schools to rank in the top 20 nationally.

WELCOME NEWCOMERS

Despite having four returning starters, plus another who has starting experience, lowa welcomes 10 newcomers to its 2015-16 roster. The 10 newcomers includes two players who received redshirts last season (Nicholas Baer and Brady Ellingson). Iowa's 10 newcomers ties for third most among Division I schools: Portland State and Tennessee State have 11, followed by Iowa, UTEP, and Nebraska with 10.

The Hawkeyes add five freshmen (Isaiah Moss, Andrew Fleming, Brandon Hutton, Ahmad Wagner, and Christian Williams), and three junior college transfers (Dale Jones, and Michael and Steven Soukup). The Soukups are identical twins.

DISTRIBUTOR AND PROTECTOR

Point guard Mike Gesell has done an outstanding job directing the Hawkeye offense his first three seasons. Gesell owns two of lowa's top four assist-to-turnover ratio's since the 1996-97 season. His 3.05 ratio in 2013-14 ranks first, while his 2.21 ratio in 2014-15 ranks fourth. Dean Oliver's 2.75 ratio in 2000-01 is second, followed by Ryan Luehrsmann's 2.21 in 1997-98 ranking third.

Gesell had nine assists and three turnovers (3.0) in Friday night's win over Gardner-Webb and 12 assists and two turnovers against Coppin State.

UTHOFF, GESELL, WOODBURY EARN ACADEMIC DISTINCTION

Mike Gesell and Jarrod Uthoff were named 2015 Capital One Academic All-District first team honorees for their combined performance athletically and in the classroom. Gesell was also tabbed third team Academic All-America, becoming the first Hawkeye to accomplish the national distinction since Adam Haluska (first team) in 2007.

Gesell, a native of South Sioux City, Nebraska, earned his degree in finance in three years. He led the team in assists (135) and ranked sixth in the Big Ten in assist-to-turnover ratio (2.2). Gesell averaged 7.4 points per game. Last fall, Gesell earned invitation to Beta Gamma Sigma, the National Scholastic Honor Society for business students at the University of Iowa who have garnered GPA's that place them in the top 10 percent of their class.

Uthoff, a native of Cedar Rapids, lowa, graduated last May with a degree in economics. Uthoff ranked second in team scoring (12.4), rebounding (6.4) and steals (38), and was first in blocked shots (56) and 3-point shooting (54-of-145, .372).

Additionally, Gesell, Uthoff, and Adam Woodbury were named 2015 Academic All-Big Ten.







THREE TIMES THE CHARM

lowa posted a 22-12 record last season, reaching the 20-win plateau for the third consecutive season. For the first time in 15 years, lowa won 20 or more games in three consecutive seasons. The last time lowa won at least 20 games four straight seasons was 1995-1999 -- Tom Davis' last five seasons as Iowa's head coach.

UTHOFF PRODUCING ON THE WING

Jarrod Uthoff, who was named third-team All-Big Ten last season, ranked second in team scoring (12.4 ppg), and steals (1.1), and first in 3-point shooting (54-of-145, .372). He was the only Division I player to have 50+ 3-pointers, 55+ blocks and 35+ steals. Additionally, Uthoff was one of only two Big Ten players to average 12+ points, 6+ rebounds, and 1.5+ blocks (Wisconsin's Frank Kaminsky).

Uthoff is one of 10 men's basketball players selected to the 2015 Preseason All-Big Ten team as selected by a media voting panel. Uthoff leads the team averaging 17 points in lowa's first two games. The Hawkeye senior netted a game-high 21 points in Friday's opener against Gardner-Webb.

His 56 blocks and 54 triples rank fourth and fifth best, respectively, by an lowa junior in program history.

Uthoff had two double-doubles in 2014-15 (North Florida and Michigan State). He had 10 points and a personal-best 12 boards against North Florida (Dec. 22), and 12 points and a team-best 10 rebounds versus Michigan State (Jan. 8).

FRESH START

Peter Jok made his first start of his career on Dec. 22, 2014, versus North Florida. The native of West Des Moines, Iowa, started 21 of the last 22 games last year. Jok is starting 2015 with a new number, changing from No. 3 last year to No. 14 this season.

Jok averaged seven points per game in 2015, which ranked fifth on the squad. He made at least one triple in 18 of the last 25 games, including multiple 3-pointers in seven of the last 13 contests. Jok's 36 triples in 2015 rank as the sixth most by a Hawkeye sophomore in program history. His 19 steals, 44 assists, 83 field goals and 36 treys last season were single season bests.

He scored 12 points in Iowa's win over Davidson, while grabbing five rebounds. Jok reached double figure scoring in two of three NCAA Tournament games played (Tennessee in 2014 and Davidson in 2015).

Jok scored eight points in Iowa's opener against Gardner-Webb before suffering an ankle injury. He did not play against Coppin State last Sunday.

EXPERIENCED BACKCOURT

Iowa has two senior point guards (Mike Gesell and Anthony Clemmons) and a junior shooting guard (Peter Jok) on this season's roster.

Clemmons, who has started 26 of 105 games, was named the team's Most Improved Player last spring after leading the team in 3-point accuracy (.373) and posting single-season bests in rebounding, steals, scoring average, and free throw percentage in

Gesell is a four-year starter, who has 812 points, 373 assists, and 119 steals. His 21 assists last weekend moved him past Kenny Arnold and Mon'ter Glasper and into seventh place on lowa's alltime assists chart. He is 24 assists from tying Roy Devyn Marble for sixth.

MUSCLE GAIN

Last season, freshman Dom Uhl was listed a 6-foot-8 and 195 pounds at the start of the season. After a year in the weight room, the sophomore forward checks in a 6-foot-9 and 215 pounds entering this season. Uhl earned the team's Newcomer Award last year.

Uhl had a solid start to the 2015-16 season posting career highs in blocks (2), assists (3), and rebounds (6) in lowa's opener against Gardner-Webb. He started his first career game Sunday against Coppin State and poured in a career-high 18 points on 7-of-10 shooting from the field, including 3-of-5 from 3-point range, and 1-of-2 at the free throw line.

IOWA VS. RANKED TEAMS

The Hawkeyes was 4-6 against opponents ranked in either the Associated Press or USA Today Coaches last season.

GESELL NOMINATED FOR GOOD WORKS TEAM

Senior Mike Gesell is a nominee for the 2016 Allstate NABC Good Works Team.

This prestigious community service award recognizes a distinguished group of student-athletes who have demonstrated a commitment to enriching the lives of others and contributing to the greater good in their communities.

College sports information directors and basketball coaches across the country nominated players who exhibit exceptional leadership skills and an unwavering commitment to volunteerism.

IN MEMORY...

lowa's all-time leading scorer, Roy Marble, passed away on Sept. 11, 2015, at the age of 48. Marble led the Hawkeyes to four straight NCAA Tournament appearances, including advancing to the Elite Eight in 1987 and Sweet 16 in 1988, and led the team in scoring three consecutive seasons.

In memory of Marble, RM23 is stitched on the upper right corner of lowa's jerseys this season.

Iowa Signs 4 Prep Standouts

Jordan Bohannon, Tyler Cook, Ryan Kriener, and Cordell Pemsl have all signed a National Letter of Intent to attend the University of lowa in 2016.

Bohannon is a 6-foot-1, 170-pound guard from Linn-Mar High School in Marion, Iowa. Bohannon led his high school team in team in scoring (17.7), assists (4.5), rebounds (4.5), and tied for steals while being named first team All-Metro and All-Conference, second team All-State, Metro Player of the Year. He was a four-year letterman on the basketball team and competed three years on varsity golf team. Bohannon averaged 16 points and six rebounds on the 2015 AAU National, State, and Elite 28 Premier League Champion Martin Brother's squad. He was AAU teammates with Kriener and Pemsl.

Cook is a three-year varsity starter and team captain the last two seasons for Chaminade College Prep in St. Louis. The 6-foot-9, 240-pound All-State honoree as a junior averaged 13 points and six rebounds. Cook was a Nike Global Challenge and Nike Skills Academy participant. He is ranked as the No. 51 player in the 2016 class according to ESPN.

Kriener (pronounced KREEN-ir) is a 6-foot-10, 240 pounds forward from Spirit Lake High School in Spirit Lake, Iowa. He was a 2015 all-conference and second-team all-state honoree. Kriener was a two-time all-region selection for the state tournament. He averaged 19.8 points, while shooting at a 71 percent (204-of-286) clip from the field, and 8.5 rebounds as a junior. Kriener averaged 18 points and 15 rebounds on the 2015 AAU National, State, and Elite 28 Premier League Champion Martin Brother's squad. He was AAU teammates with Bohannon and Pemsl.

Pemsl, a native of Dubuque, Iowa, averaged 15.2 points and 8.75 rebounds his first three seasons at Wahlert High School. He was a two-time first-team all-state and all-conference selection. Pemsl, a three-time team captain, led Wahlert to two straight state championships. He veraged 17.3 points per game as a junior before missing the final seven games due to injury. He was AAU teammates with Bohannon and Kriener. Pemsl also competed on the Wahlert golf and baseball teams for four and three years, respectively.

Cincinnati and lowa each received votes in the first 2015-16 USA Today Sports Men's Basketball Coaches Poll. The Hawkeyes posted a 22-12 record last season, while the Bearcats were 23-11.

UAB owned a 20-16 mark in 2014-15 en route to winning the Conference-USA Tournament championship while knocking off then-No. 9 ranked Iowa State in the second round of the NCAA Tournament. Wyoming captured the Mountain West Conference Tournament championship while posting a 25-10 mark in 2014-15.

All four teams competed in the 2015 NCAA Men's Basketball Tournament with Cincinnati, Iowa, and UAB advancing to the third round.

ON THE HORIZON

lowa will travel to Orlando, Nov. 26-29, for the Advocare Invitational; the tournament features eight teams. The games will take place at the HP Field House at the ESPN Wide World of Sports Complex near Orlando. Five of the eight teams competed in the NCAA Tournament this past spring: Dayton, Iowa, Notre Dame, Wichita State, and Xavier.

lowa will open tournament play against Dayton Thanksgiving evening at 8 p.m. (CT).


