### **Quick Hits**

- Following an 0-2 start in Big Ten play, lowa has won four-of-five. The stretch started with a 78-71 win over Minnesota on Jan. 8.
- Minnesota's Rachel Banham leads the league in scoring (22.8 points/game), while the Gophers' Amanda Zahui leads the conference in rebounding (10.7/game).
- Iowa leads the Big Ten in overall victories (16).
- Junior guard Samantha Logic is the only player in the Big Ten to average 13 or more points (13.9), six or more rebounds (6.4), and six or more assists (7.0).
- Freshman Ally Disterhoft posted a double-double in her first career start at 0hio State on Jan. 19 (24 points, 10 rebounds, 12-of-12 from the line), and netted 15 points in her second career start against Indiana on Jan. 25.
- lowa is averaging 81.3 points and 18.3 assists per contest, leading the Big Ten in both categories. In addition, the Hawkeyes are 17th nationally in scoring offense and 15th in assists per game.
- lowa has had three or more players score in double figures in each of the last 19 contests, including four in the win over Indiana (Taylor 20, Dixon 16, Disterhoft 15, Doolittle 11).
- Five Hawkeyes are averaging double figures (Logic, Dixon, Doolittle, Disterhoft, Taylor).
- lowa is the only team in the Big Ten with three players averaging 13.9 or more points per game (Doolittle 14.3, Dixon 14.1, Logic 13.9).
- Lisa Bluder needs three wins to surpass Hall of Famer C. Vivian Stringer (269 wins) as lowa's all-time winningest coach. Bluder is one of 13 active Division I coaches with 600 or more wins.

### **THE SETTING:**

The University of Iowa women's basketball team (16-5, 5-3) continues Big Ten action Wednesday night, playing at Minnesota (13-8, 2-5). Tip-off is set for 7 p.m. (CT) at Williams Arena in Minneapolis.

#### AUDIO COVERAGE:

Brent Balbinot and Shelley Till will call the action for the Hawkeye Radio Network. Hawkeye fans can listen to the contest on the Hawkeye Radio Network (AM-800 KXIC in Iowa City, AM-1360 KMJM in Cedar Rapids, AM-1040 WHO in Des Moines) or on the Hawkeye All-Access page of <a href="https://hawkeyesports.com">hawkeyesports.com</a>. Balbinot is in his 10th season as Iowa's play-by-play voice, while Till is in her ninth providing analysis.

### **IOWA HISTORY:**

lowa has played 1,153 games since beginning basketball in 1974. lowa's overall record is 708-445 (.613). That includes a 352-181 (.660) mark in regular season Big Ten contests and a 345-99 (.776) mark in Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

### **IN THE RANKINGS:**

lowa is receiving votes in The Associated Press Top 25 poll this week. The Hawkeyes have been ranked as high as No. 21/24 this season.

Three lowa opponents are ranked in the latest Associated Press/USA Today polls: Penn State (12/13), lowa State (23/17), and Purdue (19/20). In addition, Nebraska, Michigan State, USC, Syracuse, and Michigan are receiving votes.

### **CLIMBING TO THE TOP:**

Lisa Bluder needs three wins to surpass Hall of Famer C. Vivian Stringer (269) as lowa's all-time winningest coach. Bluder -- one of 13 active Division I coaches with 600 or more wins -- is 267-162 all-time as the Hawkeye head coach.

### **NCAA STREAK LEADS THE BIG TEN:**

lowa is the only Big Ten team, and one of only 13 teams in the country, to have appeared in the last six NCAA Tournaments.

### **SCOUTING MINNESOTA:**

- Minnesota is 13-8 overall and 2-5 in Big Ten play following an 83-53 loss at Penn State on Sunday.
- The Gophers are 10-2 at home this season, with losses to UCLA and Michigan State.
- Minnesota is led in scoring by junior guard Rachel Banham (22.8 points/game) and redshirt freshman center Amanda B. Zahui (14.5). Banham leads the league in scoring, while Zahui is averaging a double-double, grabbing 10.7 rebounds per game. Zahui leads the conference in rebounding.
- Minnesota leads the Big Ten and ranks third nationally in 3-point field goal percentage (.422).
- Minnesota is coached by Pam Borton. Borton, in her 12th season at the helm, is the winningest head coach in program history.

lowa captains are senior Theairra Taylor and junior Samantha Logic.

### **IOWA-MINNESOTA SERIES NOTES:**

- Iowa leads the all-time series against Minnesota, 46-23.
- lowa has won five of the last six meetings, and nine of the last 12 in the series.
- The Hawkeyes and Gophers have split the last six meetings in Minneapolis.
- Wednesday's meeting marks the second between the two in the last three weeks.

### THE LAST MEETING:

Senior Theairra Taylor, a Minnesota native, guided the Hawkeyes past Minnesota on Jan. 8 in lowa City, 78-71, on "Theairra Taylor Bobblehead Night". Taylor finished the contest with a season-high 20 points, and matched her previous season-high point total of 16 before halftime. She scored her 12th point 11:36 into the contest, putting her on pace for more than a point a minute. At halftime she had made 6-of-8 field goals, 2-of-3 3-pointers, and 2-of-2 free throws. In the second half she scored four points, making her only field goal and both free throws. Taylor wasn't alone, as it took an entire effort by the Hawkeyes to overcome a 32-point performance by Minnesota's Rachel Banham. Bethany Doolittle scored 19 points, followed by Melissa Dixon with 13, Samantha Logic with 11, and Ally Disterhoft with nine.

### THE LAST MEETING IN MINNEAPOLIS:

Minnesota claimed the only meeting between the two teams last season, winning 72-60 in Minneapolis. Rachel Banham led all scorers with 34 points. The Hawkeyes were led by Jaime Printy (21 points) and Morgan Johnson, who posted a double-double (13 points, 10 rebounds).

### **FUN FACTS:**

- lowa has not trailed during its last three victories (Jan. 25 vs. Indiana, 84-75; Jan. 19 at Ohio State, 81-74; Jan. 12 at Wisconsin, 82-65).
- lowa, the Big Ten leader in assists/game (18.3) and assist/turnover ratio (1.3), is 15-1 when tallying as many or more assists than its opponents, and 12-2 when registering fewer turnovers.
- The Hawkeyes lead the Big Ten in scoring average (81.3 points/game), averaging nearly six more points than the second-highest average.
- lowa is 14-0 when leading at the half this season.
- The Hawkeyes are 14-0 when holding their opponents to less than 80 points this season.
- lowa is undefeated (7-0) when shooting over 40 percent from 3-point range, and undefeated (8-0) when grabbing more rebounds.

### **HAWKEYES AVENGE LOSS TO INDIANA:**

Following an 86-84 loss at Indiana in the Big Ten opener on Jan. 2, the Hawkeyes returned the favor in Iowa City on Jan. 25, defeating the Hoosiers 84-75. Iowa never trailed in the win.

Four Hawkeyes (Theairra Taylor 20, Melissa Dixon 16, Ally Disterhoft 15, Bethany Doolittle 11) scored in double figures as lowa shot 53.7 percent from the field. Doolittle tallied seven blocked shots, equaling her career-best (also accomplished against Drake on Dec. 7, 2013). Doolittle surpassed Toni Foster (145) for fourth on lowa's career list with 146 career blocks.

### A B1G WIN IN COLUMBUS IN LAST ROAD GAME:

The Hawkeyes (2-1 on the road in B1G games) are coming off an 81-74 win at Ohio State on Jan. 19 in their last road contest. Iowa never trailed on its way to its first win in Columbus since 1998. Five players (Disterhoft 24, Dixon 16, Doolittle 14, Taylor 11, Kastanek 10) scored in double figures. Iowa finished 17-of-19 (89.5%) from the foul line and 8-of-17 from 3-point-range (47.1%), while out-rebounding the Buckeyes (32-31). Four Hawkeyes (Disterhoft, Dixon, Taylor, Kastanek) tallied two 3-point field goals.

### **DISTERHOFT SHINES IN FIRST CAREER START:**

Freshman Ally Disterhoft posted a double-double in her first career start at 0hio State on Jan. 19 (24 points, 10 rebounds, 12-of-12 from the line). She finished 6-for-6 from the charity stripe in the final 28 seconds. Her 12-for-12 mark from the line marks the third-best total (when shooting 100%) in the league this season, and the best performance from the line in conference only action. It also tied the program record for most free throws made (when making 100%) during a Big Ten game. Disterhoft averaged 18 points and 8.5 rebounds last week, both tying for the sixth-most in the Big Ten.

### **Head Coach Lisa Bluder**

Lisa Bluder (pronounced BLUE-dir) is in her 14th season as head coach at the University of Iowa and her 30th season as a college head coach. She is a three-time Big Ten and two-time WBCA Regional Coach of the Year.

Bluder has a career record of 623-304 (.674), including a 267-162 (.624) record at lowa, a 187-106 (.638) record in 10 seasons (1990-2000) at Drake and a six-year mark (1984-90) of 169-36 (.824) at St. Ambrose.



Bluder is lowa's second all-time winningest coach and trails only C. Vivian Stringer (269 wins). She has guided the Hawkeyes to 12 postseason tournaments (10 NCAA, 2 WNIT) and nine upper-division finishes in the Big Ten Conference, including winning a share of the league championship in 2008 and taking home the conference tournament title in 2001.

In her first season with the Hawkeyes, Bluder transformed a struggling program into a 21-game winner. Iowa finished second in the Big Ten, won the conference tournament and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament. Bluder became lowa's third coach to be named Big Ten Coach of the Year. She was also honored as the College Coach of the Year by the Women's Basketball News Service and was named the WBCA District 6 Coach of the Year. Iowa's 2001-02 squad finished fourth in the Big Ten and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament for the second consecutive year. In 2003, Bluder guided the Hawkeyes to their first-ever WNIT appearance. Iowa, which had nine underclassmen on its roster, advanced to the quarterfinals before falling to Creighton. In 2004-05, Iowa finished 23-10, starting the year 13-0 and was the last Division I undefeated team standing. In 2005-06, Bluder mentored a team plagued by injuries to a fifth-place Big Ten finish and an NCAA Tournament berth.

In her 10 years at Drake, Bluder brought great success and tradition to the Bulldog program and established herself as one of the top coaches in the country. She led Drake to five 20-plus win seasons in her last six years, including five post-season appearances. She guided the Bulldogs to eight Missouri Valley Conference Tournament appearances, reaching the semifinals six times and winning the tournament four times. Bluder was also named the Conference Coach of the Year three times at Drake.

Bluder began her coaching career at St. Ambrose, where she coached six successful seasons, building the Bees into a NAIA powerhouse. During her tenure at St. Ambrose, Bluder guided the Bees to four straight national tournaments, including two consecutive Final Four appearances. The 1990 St. Ambrose team was ranked No. 1 and Bluder was named the NAIA Converse Coach of the Year.

A graduate of Linn-Mar High School in Marion, Iowa, Bluder was a three-year starter at Northern Iowa. She graduated from UNI in 1983 with a bachelor's degree in marketing.

### **HAWKEYES IN BIG TEN PLAY:**

lowa head coach Lisa Bluder, the dean of Big Ten coaches, is a three-time Big Ten Coach of the Year (2001, 2008 and 2010). She has guided lowa to nine upper-division finishes in the Big Ten in 13 seasons. lowa won a share of the Big Ten regular season championship in 2008 and finished in a three-way tie for second in 2009. The Hawkeyes clinched a share of the title in 2008 with a win at Wisconsin in the regular season finale (March 2, 2008).

#### **DEFYING LOGIC:**

- Samantha Logic is the only player in the Big Ten to average 13 or more points (13.9), six or more rebounds (6.4), and six or more assists (7.0).
- She ranks 18th in scoring, 14th in rebounding, second in assists, and third in steals (2.2) and assist/turnover ratio (1.8).
- Logic is second in career assists (501) at Iowa. Cara Consuegra (1997-2001) is Iowa's all-time assists leader (576).
- Logic is one of 26 players in Big Ten history to total 500 or more career assists.
- She has posted 148 assists this season, the highest total for a junior in progam history. Cara Consuegra posted the second-most
  as a junior (138 in 1999-00).
- Logic is 15th in the NCAA in career assists among active players, and sixth in assists/game (5.83).
- Logic is nearly averaging a triple-double over the last nine contests (13.9 points, 7.8 rebounds, and 7.8 assists).
- She has registered a triple-double and three double-doubles during the stretch.
- Last season, Logic led the Big Ten and ranked 15th in the NCAA with 6.4 assists per game. She has led the Big Ten in the category
  for most of this season, and is eighth nationally.
- Logic's 11 career games with double digit assists are the most in program history. Cara Consuegra is second with nine games of 10 or more assists. The next closest Hawkeyes on the list are Kachine Alexander, Jolette Law and Michelle Edwards, with two career games.
- Logic -- who has 18 career double-doubles -- became lowa's single-season assist record holder a year ago, breaking the mark in lowa's win at Northwestern (March 3). Logic entered the game tied with Cara Consuegra (2000-01) at 191 assists. Logic collected seven assists at Northwestern and finished the season with 217.
- Logic recorded her 13th career double-double (16 points, 14 assists) on Nov. 10, leading the Hawkeyes to a 97-93 overtime victory against No. 14 Dayton. Logic hit the game-tying 3-pointer with nine seconds remaining in regulation to send the game into overtime. The 14 assists equaled a personal best and lowa school record, and are the most in Carver-Hawkeye Arena history. The previous high was 12 (three times).

#### **BALANCED ATTACK:**

Five Hawkeyes are averaging double figures: Bethany Doolittle (14.3), Melissa Dixon (14.1), Samantha Logic (13.9), Ally Disterhoft (12.7), and Theairra Taylor (101.0).

lowa has had three or more players score in double figures in each of the last 19 contests, including four in the win over Indiana (Taylor 20, Dixon 16, Disterhoft 15, Doolittle 11).

lowa is the only team in the Big Ten with three players averaging 13.9 or more points per game (Doolittle - 14.3, Dixon - 14.1, Logic - 13.9).

### **MOVING UP CAREER CHARTS:**

- Samantha Logic is second in career assists (501). Cara Consuegra (1997-2001) is lowa's all-time assists leader (576).
- Melissa Dixon is sixth in career 3-pointers (170). Dixon surpassed Kelli Krei (162) during lowa's win over Minnesota on Jan. 8. Kristi Smith is fifth with 185.
- Bethany Doolittle is fourth all-time with 146 career blocks. She surpassed Toni Foster, who is now fifth with 145, during lowa's
  win over Indiana on Jan. 25.

### **LEADING THE BIG TEN IN ASSISTS:**

- The Hawkeyes lead the Big Ten in assists, averaging 18.3 per contest. lowa also leads the league in assist/turnover ratio (1.3).
- lowa tallied 28 assists on 31 made field goals on Dec. 7 in its win over Idaho State. The Hawkeyes have tallied 28 or more assists four times this season. The school record for assists in a game is 31.
- lowa broke the school record for single-season assists last year in the win over Miami (March 24). The previous record of 514 was
  set in 2011-12. lowa finished with 531 assists. lowa finished second in the Big Ten and 26th in the NCAA with 15.7 assists per
  game. lowa recorded at least 17 assists in 15 games, including five games with 20 or more.

### **NONCONFERENCE RECAP:**

lowa's 12 wins prior to the start of conference play equaled the most in a season under head coach Lisa Bluder. lowa finished 12-1 in its preconference slate during the 2010-11 campaign. The Hawkeyes were 11-3 prior to the start of league play last season and 11-0 in 2004-05.

### **IOWA SETS NEW SINGLE-GAME 3-POINT RECORD:**

The Hawkeyes won their sixth game in a row, thanks to a school record 17 made 3-point field goals, 95-47, on Dec. 7 against Idaho State inside Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

lowa shot 56.4-percent from the field for the game and held the Bengals to 21.5-percent (11.8-percent in the second half). While the Hawkeyes made 75-percent of their two-point field goals (14-of-21), the real story was their success from long range.

Junior Melissa Dixon converted six 3-pointers, giving her 20 in the last three games. She had a school-record seven against UNC-Wilmington and Syracuse. Senior Theairra Taylor made four 3-pointers against Idaho State, freshman Ally Disterhoft had three, sophomore Kathryn Reynolds added two, and junior Samantha Logic and freshman Alexa Kastanek made one apiece.

The previous record was 14, last accomplished on Dec. 22, 2011, against Mississippi Valley State.

### **DIXON EQUALS SCHOOL 3-POINT RECORD:**

Junior guard Melissa Dixon finished with seven 3-point field goals in wins over Syracuse and UNC-Wilmington, tying a personal and school record; the feat has been accomplished five times in program history (twice by Dixon).

### **BLUDER GETS WIN NO. 600:**

Head coach Lisa Bluder became the 42nd coach in NCAA women's basketball history (all divisions), and only the 25th Division I head coach (minimum 10 years at a DI school) to collect 600 wins, Jan. 20 vs. Purdue. Bluder is one of 13 active Division I coaches with 600 or more wins.

### **BLUDER SIGNS CONTRACT EXTENSION:**

Head coach Lisa Bluder has agreed to a one-year contract extension that secures her as head coach of the women's basketball program at the University of Iowa through the 2019 basketball season, UI Director of Athletics Gary Barta announced Dec. 26, 2013.

### **HAWKEYES CONTINUE TREND AGAINST RANKED FOES:**

- lowa is 2-3 this season against ranked opponents:
  - W vs. No. 14 Dayton (97-93 in overtime) Nov. 10
  - L at No. 16 Colorado (90-87) Nov. 20
  - W vs. No. 22 Syracuse (97-91) Dec. 5
  - L at No. 11 Iowa State (83-70) Dec. 12
  - L vs. No. 15 Penn State (87-71) Jan. 5
- The Hawkeyes have defeated nine top-25 opponents since the start of last season (9-7 record).
- lowa is averaging 84.4 points per game during its five contests against ranked teams this season.
- The Hawkeyes have recorded at least one win against a top-25 team in all but two seasons under Bluder. In nine of those seasons, lowa has knocked off at least one top-15 opponent.
- This year marked the seventh time in school history that lowa played at least three ranked teams prior to conference action. lowa faced five ranked opponents in 1990 (2-3 record) and three in 2012 (3-0), 1999 (0-3), 1995 (2-1), 1993 (3-0), and 1989 (1-2)
- Last season marked just the second time in school history that lowa defeated three ranked teams prior to Big Ten play (No. 12 West Virginia, No. 22 Iowa State, No. 20 Texas). The only other time lowa defeated three ranked opponents was in 1993 (No. 4 Louisiana Tech, No. 20 Missouri State, No. 9 Southern California).
- lowa tied the school record for number of wins over ranked teams in a season last year with seven. The Hawkeyes have accomplished the feat three other times (1995-96, 1993-94, 1992-93). Iowa faced 11 ranked teams last season, which tied for the most games against ranked opponents in a season. The only other time lowa played 11 ranked teams in a season was in 1992-93 (7-4 record).
