Any youth wearing their team's jersey will be admitted free. Several UI women's teams and former Hawkeye women's basketball letterwinners will be signing autographs.

Saturday is also Linn County Day.

SCOUTING PURDUE

The 13th-ranked Purdue Boilermakers are 18-3 overall and a perfect 8-0 in Big Ten play. Purdue has won 11 straight contests.

In their last game, the Boilermakers defeated Northwestern in Evanston, 80-70. Courtney Moses led all scorers with 29 points (14-of-14 FTs) and KK Houser had 21 points. Purdue forced 22 Northwestern turnovers and was 28-of-30 from the free throw line.

Brittany Rayburn leads Purdue with 14.3 points per game, followed by Moses at 10.4 points per contest. Sam Ostarello is the team's leading rebounder at eight boards per game.

As a team, Purdue is shooting .400 (474-1185) from the field, including .311 (90-289) from 3-point distance.

PURDUE VS. IOWA NOTES

- Sunday is the 60th meeting between lowa and Purdue, with the Boilermakers holding a 35-25 advantage in the all-time series. Purdue has won 16 of the last 19 contests. The Hawkeyes are 15-10 in games played in lowa City against Purdue.
- Purdue and Iowa share two common nonconference opponents in Kansas State and Texas A&M. The Hawkeyes were defeated at Kansas State (81-78 in OT) and lost to Texas A&M in the Bahamas (74-58). Purdue knocked off Kansas State in Cancun (61-48) and Texas A&M in Mackey Arena (60-51).

LAST MEETING

Purdue held on for a 57-55 win over lowa in West Lafayette (Jan. 15).

The Hawkeyes trailed 30-17 with 5:21 left in the first half, but an 11-2 run to close the half made it a four point game at 32-28 heading into the second period.

lowa opened the second half on a 9-0 run to take a 37-32 lead with 16:16 remaining, but a 16-2 surge by Purdue gave the Boilermakers a 48-39 lead with just over 11 minutes left.

The Hawkeyes clawed back and eventually took a one point lead after Kelly Krei made a pair of free throws with 37 seconds on the clock. Alex Guyton then made 1-of-2 free throws with 18 seconds left to tie the game, and Brittany Rayburn grabbed an offensive rebound and was fouled. She hit both free throws to take a two point lead, and lowa's final shot attempt was blocked.

Morgan Johnson led Iowa with 16 points, followed by 15 from Jaime Printy. Krei added 10 and Samantha Logic chipped in eight rebounds and six assists.

OPPONENTS IN THE RANKINGS

Six lowa opponents are ranked in the AP or ESPN/USA Today polls: Ohio State (9/9), Purdue (13/17), Texas A&M (14/13), Penn State (18/19) and Nebraska (19/21).

In addition, Kansas State, Michigan and St. John's are receiving votes.

LATE RUN NOT ENOUGH AT NEBRASKA

Once again, lowa fought hard at the end of the contest but came up short, falling at 19th-ranked Nebraska, 60-53.

lowa trailed by 13 at halftime, but an 8-0 lowa run cut the deficit to just two points with 7:07 remaining. After trading baskets, lowa cut the margin to just one point at 52-51 with 3:11 left, but the Huskers responded with six straight points to hold on for the win.

Jaime Printy netted 17 points, 15 of which came in the second half. Wahlin added 11 (nine in the second half) and Samantha Logic had 10. Kelly Krei grabbed 10 boards, while Morgan Johnson finished with eight points and nine rebounds.

PRINTY AND WAHLIN HAVE 1.300. PRINTY TOP 10 IN SCORING

Junior Jaime Printy became just the 13th player in school history to score 1,300 career points in lowa's game vs. Nebraska (Jan. 8), and senior Kamille Wahlin joined the 1,300 point club in Iowa's game at Penn State (Jan. 22).

Printy needs just six more points to become the 10th player in lowa history to hit the 1,400 career point mark.

Printy also cracked the top 10 on lowa's career scoring list against Wisconsin (Jan. 19). She entered the game needing five points to pass Wendy Ausdemore for 10th place, and she netted 25.

IOWA RANKS HIGH IN FREE THROW PERCENTAGE

lowa's .82.4 (327-of-397) free throw percentage is the best in NCAA Division I women's basketball.

Five Hawkeyes are shooting over 82 percent from the line, with two more shooting at least 75 percent. lowa's starting five has only missed a combined 48 free throws and is shooting 84.5 from the charity stripe (262-of-310).

Individually, Jaime Printy leads the Big Ten with a 90.1 percentage and is ranked seventh nationally in the latest NCAA statistics.

The Hawkeyes haven't missed more than seven free throws in any game this year and have attempted at least 10 in every contest, including eight games with 20 or more attempts.

WAHLIN IMPROVING IN BIG TEN PLAY

lowa senior Kamille Wahlin's numbers have improved greatly since entering Big Ten play.

Wahlin is averaging 14.3 points per game in eight conference games, compared to 9.5 points during lowa's 13 nonconference contests. She has also earned 24 trips to the free throw line in Big Ten play, converting 23 attempts. In the 13 nonconference games, Wahlin was 16-of-20 from the stripe.

Wahlin has already made 17 3-pointers in Big Ten play after making 19 in the nonconference portion of the schedule.

Head Coach Lisa Bluder

Lisa Bluder (pronounced BLUE-dir) is in her 12th season as head coach at the University of Iowa and her 28th season as a college head coach. She is a three-time Big Ten and two-time WBCA Regional Coach of the Year.

Bluder, 48, has a career record of 578-284 (.671), including a 222-142 (.610) record at lowa, a 187-106 (.638) record in 10 seasons (1990-2000) at Drake and a six-year mark (1984-90) of 169-36 (.824) at St. Ambrose.



Bluder is Iowa's second all-time winningest coach and trails only C. Vivian Stringer. She has guided the Hawkeyes to 10 post-season tournaments (8 NCAA, 2 WNIT) and eight upper-division finishes in the Big Ten Conference, including winning a share of the league championship in 2008 and tying for second place in 2009.

In her first season with the Hawkeyes, Bluder transformed a struggling program into a 21-game winner. Iowa finished second in the Big Ten, won the conference tournament and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament. Bluder became Iowa's third coach to be named Big Ten Coach of the Year. She was also honored as the College Coach of the Year by the *Women's Basketball News Service* and was named the WBCA District 6 Coach of the Year. Iowa's 2001-02 squad finished fourth in the Big Ten and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament for the second consecutive year. In 2003, Bluder guided the Hawkeyes to their first-ever WNIT appearance. Iowa, which had nine underclassmen on its roster, advanced to the quarterfinals before falling to Creighton. In 2004-05, Iowa finished 23-10, starting the year 13-0 and was the last Division I undefeated team standing. In 2005-06, Bluder mentored a team plagued by injuries to a fifth-place Big Ten finish and an NCAA Tournament berth.

In her 10 years at Drake, Bluder brought great success and tradition to the Bulldog program and established herself as one of the top coaches in the country. She led Drake to five 20-plus win seasons in her last six years, including five post-season appearances. She guided the Bulldogs to eight Missouri Valley Conference Tournament appearances, reaching the semifinals six times and winning the tournament four times. Bluder was also named the Conference Coach of the Year three times at Drake.

Bluder began her coaching career at St. Ambrose, where she coached six successful seasons, building the Bees into a NAIA powerhouse. During her tenure at St. Ambrose, Bluder guided the Bees to four straight national tournaments, including two consecutive Final Four appearances. The 1990 St. Ambrose team was ranked No. 1 and Bluder was named the NAIA Converse Coach of the Year.

A graduate of Linn-Mar High School in Marion, Iowa, Bluder was a three-year starter at Northern Iowa. She graduated from UNI in 1983 with a bachelor's degree in marketing.

WAHLIN REACHES MILESTONE

Senior Kamille Wahlin became just the third player in school history to make 200 career 3-pointers in Iowa's game at Penn State (Jan. 22).

Wahlin entered the game with 197 3-pointers and finished with five. She currently ranks third on Iowa's career 3-point list behind Lindsey Meder (261) and Wendy Ausdemore (221).

WAHLIN AND PRINTY ARE BEST ACTIVE 3-POINT SHOOTERS

lowa senior Kamille Wahlin and junior Jaime Printy rank first and second among active Big Ten players in career three-pointers made.

Wahlin's 203 career 3-pointers ranks first, while Printy's 194 rank second. Michigan's Carmen Reynolds is third with 182, Purdue's Brittany Rayburn is fourth with 180, Ohio State's Samantha Prahalis is fifth with 167 and Penn State's Maggie Lucas is sixth with 162.

HAWKEYE 3-POINT SHOOTERS IN ELITE COMPANY

lowa is the only Big Ten school, and just one of three in the nation, to boast three players inside the top 10 in career three-point shooting in school history.

Kamille Wahlin (third), Jaime Printy (fourth) and Kelly Krei (seventh) all rank inside the top 10 in career three-pointers made at Iowa. Only Oral Roberts and Miami (Fla.) have three players inside its respective top 10.

WAHLIN DELIVERS IN THE CLUTCH

lowa's game against Illinois (Jan. 5) marked the seventh time in Kamille Wahlin's four-year career that she hit a shot in the final 1:05 of a game or overtime to either tie the game or give the Hawkeyes a lead.

JOHNSON AMONG THE BEST AT HER POSITION

Junior Morgan Johnson's 80.5 (70-of-87) free throw percentage is the best percentage in the country for players listed as true centers.

According to the latest NCAA statistics, Johnson's 80.5 percentage leads Fairleigh Dickinson's Erika Livermore (77.9) for the best percentage for a center.

IOWA GUARDS LIKE TO SHARE

lowa is the only team to have three players ranked inside the top 15 in assists in the latest Big Ten statistics.

Jaime Printy (sixth - 4.3), Kamille Wahlin (ninth - 3.6) and Samantha Logic (T-10th - 3.5) are all ranked. Northwestern has two players ranked.

In the latest NCAA statistics, Iowa ranks 24th in assists per game (16.2).

JOHNSON FROM THE FIELD

Junior Morgan Johnson leads the Big Ten and is 26th in the nation with a 53.6 (112-of-209) field goal percentage.

Johnson has atttempted at least 10 shots in 10 of lowa's 21 games this season. In eight of those games, Johnson has shot 50 percent or better.

Johnson was 5-of-10 (.500) vs. Harvard, 9-of-13 (.692) at Northern Iowa, 6-of-11 (.545) at Kansas State, 5-10 (.500) at Iowa State, 13-20 (.650) at Bradley, 11-16 (.688) at Ohio State, 5-of-10 (.500) vs. Illinois and 9-of-14 (.643) vs. Nebraska.

The only games Johnson failed to shoot 50 percent or better with 10 or more shots was vs. Virginia Tech (8-of-21, .381) and at Purdue (7-of-16, .438).

REACHING DOUBLE FIGURES

lowa's game at Nebraska (Jan. 26) marked the 13th time this season that at least three players have scored 10 or more points.

The Hawkeyes had all five starters score double figures against Mississippi Valley State. Four players hit double figures against Northern Iowa, Kansas State, Western Illinois and Northwestern. Three players reached double digits against Harvard, Albany, Ohio State, Illinois, Nebraska, at Purdue, vs. Wisconsin and at Nebraska.

MOVING UP CAREER CHARTS

Four Hawkeyes are currently working their way up the career records lists at lowa.

- Kamille Wahlin ranks third in career 3-pointers made (203), sixth in career assists (384) and 13th in career scoring (1,321). She needs 19 more 3-pointers to move past Wendy Ausdemore into second place, four more assists to move past Franthea Price for fifth place and 15 more points to pass Lisa Becker for 12th place.
- Morgan Johnson ranks second in career blocks (202) and 17th in career rebounds (562). She needs 34 more blocks to move past Tangela Smith for first place and three more rebounds to move past Necole Tunsil for 16th place.
- Jaime Printy ranks fourth in career 3-pointers made (194), 10th in career scoring (1,394) and 12th in career assists (298). She needs 10 more 3-pointers to move past Wahlin for third place, 46 more points to move past Megan Skouby for ninth place and 25 more assists to move past Lisa Anderson for 11th place.
- Kelly Krei ranks seventh in career 3-pointers made (147) and needs 10 more to move past Leah Magner into sixth place.

DIXON SIDELINED WITH KNEE INJURY

Freshman Melissa Dixon suffered a torn meniscus in Iowa's game at Ohio State (Jan. 2). Dixon had surgery Jan. 9 and will miss 3-4 weeks of action.

JOHNSON RECORDS SOLID PLAY VS. TOUGH OPPONENTS

Junior Morgan Johnson averaged 19 points, 9.8 rebounds and 2.8 blocks in Iowa's four games at No. 9 Ohio State, vs. Illinois vs. No. 19 Nebraska and at No. 17 Purdue.

Johnson shot 57.1 percent (32-of-56) from the field and 75 percent (12-of-16) from the charity stripe over the four-game stretch.

lowa's starting center also recorded back-to-back double-doubles for the first time in her career. She scored 14 points (5-of-10 FGs) and grabbed a career-high 16 rebounds against Illinois. Johnson followed with 21 points (9-of-14 FGs) and 12 rebounds against Nebraska. Johnson had a double-double at half against the Huskers (10 points and 11 rebounds).

JOHNSON NAMED BIG TEN PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Junior Morgan Johnson was named Big Ten Player of the Week after a career night at Bradley (Dec. 17).

Johnson notched career highs in points (37), field goals made (13), free throws made (11) and free throws attempted (12). Her 37 points were also a Renaissance Coliseum record and are the second-most scored by any player in the Big Ten, so far, this season.

Johnson's 37 points were the most for an lowa center since Megan Skouby netted 33 at Kansas in 2008. Skouby finished the game 10-of-17 from the field and 13-of-14 from the free throw line.

The award was Johnson's first Big Ten Player of the Week honor. She was named Big Ten Freshman of the Week once during her first season at Iowa.

HAWKEYES SET FREE THROW RECORDS

lowa tied the school and Carver-Hawkeye Arena record for free throw percentage against Wisconsin (Jan. 19).

The Hawkeyes were a perfect 16-of-16 from the charity stripe against the Badgers, marking the fourth time in school history, and just the second time in Carver-Hawkeye Arena, an lowa team has converted every free throw attempt when shooting at least 10 free throws. lowa was also a perfect 10-of-10 against UNLV earlier this season.

There have been five times this season a Big Ten team has converted every free throw when shooting at least 10 from the charity stripe, with lowa having two of those performances.

lowa also finished 27-of-30 (.900) from the free throw line at Bradley (Dec. 17), which is believed to be a school record for free throw percentage (minimum 30 attempts).

HOT-SHOOTING HAWKEYES

The Hawkeyes set or tied four 3-point shooting records in their win over Mississippi Valley State (Dec. 22).

- lowa set a school record for 3-pointers made in a single game with 14. The previous record was 13 (at Gonzaga, NCAA Tournament first round, 3/19/11).
- Iowa tied the Carver-Hawkeye Arena record for 3-pointers made in a single game (14 by Northern Iowa, 12/19/06), and set the Iowa record for 3-pointers made in Carver-Hawkeye Arena (12 vs. Illinois, 2/14/10).
- The Hawkeyes set a new school record for 3-pointers attempted inside Carver-Hawkeye with 35. The previous record was 34 (vs. Penn State, 2/1/09).

PRINTY NAMED TO WATCH LISTS

Junior Jaime Printy has been named to the "Wade Watch," Wooden Award and Naismith Trophy Watch Lists. The "Wade Watch" List is made up of the top 25 preseason women's basketball players, the Wooden Award includes 30 student-athletes and the Naismith Trophy list has 51 players.

The three awards are considered the most prestigious awards in NCAA women's college basketball.
