Wednesday Night Quick Hits

- Wednesday's game against Campbell will be the third and final Dale Howard Classic preliminary game.
- Wednesday will be the first ever meeting between the two schools.
- Tickets can be purchased at the door for \$12 for adults and \$5 for UI students and youths.
- Wednesday is also "UI Faculty/Staff Appreciation Night". UI faculty and staff receive free admission (with university ID), while any guests they bring will receive \$5 admission.
- Iowa is 5-0 when scoring 80 points or more under McCaffery the last two seasons. Furthermore, the Hawkeyes are 10-0 when holding opponents to fewer than 60 points.
- Coach McCaffery coached against Campbell and coach Robbie Laing twice in 2003, both while he was head coach at UNC Greensboro. The Spartans beat the Fighting Camels, 78-66 (Nov. 25, 2003) and 79-61 (Dec. 9, 2003).
- Iowa ranks first in the Big Ten in assists (19.5), second in scoring (84.5), third in steals (10.3) and free throw percentage (.725), and fourth in assist/turnover ratio (1.6).
- Freshman Josh Oglesby averaged 15 points off the bench the last two outings.
- Iowa averaged only 8.5 turnovers its last two games.

HAWKEYES FALL TO CREIGHTON IN DES MOINES

Creighton used scoring runs of 10-0 and 14-0 in the first and second halves, respectively, to post an 82-59 victory over Iowa at Wells Fargo Arena in Des Moines Sunday afternoon.

The Bluejays outrebounded the Hawkeyes by 15 (43-28) and shot 55 percent from the field (32-of-58), including 47 percent (9-of-19) from 3-point range. Iowa shot only 36 percent (21-of-59) from the field and 53 percent (10-of-19) from the foul line.

Iowa had two players reach double figures in Josh Oglesby and Matt Gatens. Gatens scored 11 of his 13 points in the first half, while Oglesby scored 13 of his team-high 14 points in the second stanza.

CREIGHTON TIP-INS

- A crowd of 12,746 watched Sunday's Dale Howard Classic at Wells Fargo Arena.
- Iowa had 10 steals, to Creighton's four. The Hawkeyes outscored the Bluejays, 15-7, in points off turnovers. Matt Gatens collected season and game-high three steals. Melsahn Basabe, Zach McCabe and Aaron White each had two thefts.
- Redshirt freshman Darius Stokes scored his first points in a Hawkeye uniform on a put-back with 39 seconds left in the game.

TAKING CARE OF THE BASKETBALL

Iowa has done a good job possessing the basketball early in the season. Iowa has had only 17 turnovers the last two games combined. The Hawkeyes are averaging 12.3 turnovers per game through four games, while they are forcing 17.8 turnovers.

BALANCED SCORING

Iowa has six players averaging 8.3 points or more. Matt Gatens is first on the team (15.5), followed by Eric May (13.0), Melsahn Basabe (9.8), Aaron White (9.3), Josh Oglesby (8.5) and Zach McCabe (8.3).

Head Coach Fran McCaffery

Fran McCaffery is in his second season as the head basketball coach at the University of Iowa and his 16th year overall as a college head coach. McCaffery spent five seasons (2005-10) as the head coach at Siena, six years at UNC-Greensboro (1999-2005) and three seasons at Lehigh (1985-88) before joining the Hawkeyes.



McCaffery has nearly three decades of Division I coaching experience. He completed his 29th season as a collegiate coach in 2011, which includes 15 years as a head coach and 14 as an assistant.

McCaffery, 50, holds a career mark of 265-198 (.572) and guided his teams to six postseason appearances (five NCAA, one NIT). He is 14-21 (.400) at Iowa.

McCaffery's five years at Siena were the best in its 70-year history. He led the Saints on an incredible run that ended with three straight Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference championships and NCAA Tournament appearances. In so doing, Siena became the only program in the country to win its regular season and postseason title the last three years.

McCaffery's Saints owned a 112-51 (.687) record in his five years with the program. He guided the Saints to four consecutive 20-win seasons, something that has never been accomplished before at the Siena.

The 2009 MAAC Coach of the Year and 2010 District I Coach of the Year is the third winningest coach, by percentage, in league history (68-22, .756). He is the only coach to guide a MAAC program to two NCAA Tournament wins. McCaffery led his 2008 and 2009 teams to first round NCAA Tournament victories over Vanderbilt and Ohio State, respectively.

In his final two seasons at Siena, he coached the Saints to back-to-back 27-win campaigns and boasted a combined 39-3 (.929) record against MAAC opponents, which included MAAC Tournament contests.

McCaffery began his coaching career as an assistant at Penn (1982-83) and Lehigh (1983-85). Then at age 26, he became the nation's youngest Division I head coach when hired by Lehigh in 1985. After three seasons as head coach at Lehigh, he spent 11 seasons as an assistant at Notre Dame (1988-99).

McCaffery played basketball at Wake Forest his freshman year (1977-78) and then concluded his collegiate playing career at Penn his final three seasons (1979-82).

He earned his B.S. degree in Economics from The Wharton School (Penn) in 1982. McCaffery also earned a Master of Education from Lehigh in 1985.

SCOUTING CAMPBELL

- Robbie Laing is in his ninth season as Campbell's head coach, owning an 88-150 mark (.370).
- Campbell is located in Buies Creek, N.C. Campbell rejoined the Big South Conference this season after competing in the Atlantic Sun Conference from 1994-2011. Tonight will be Iowa's fourth game against a current member of the Big South. The Hawkeyes are 3-0 against Big South competition, beating Charleston Southern, Liberty and UNC Asheville.
- Campbell started the season 4-0, collecting home wins over Houston Baptist (82-68), East Carolina (76-74) and North Carolina A&T (94-66), and getting a road victory at Chicago State (75-69) Monday night.
- The Camels have three players who average 16 points or more: Darren White (20.0), Eric Griffin (18.8) and Trey Freeman (16.8). White poured in a game-high 25 points on 8-of-12 shooting from the field, and 4-6 from 3-point range, at Chicago State Monday.
- Trey Freeman recorded the second-highest scoring game by a Camel freshman in his collegiate debut on Nov. 11 with a 22-point effort against Houston Baptist.
- Campbell has four players with 12 assists or more: Rico Ferguson (18), Trey Freeman (17), Amir Celestin (14) and Darren White (12).
- The Camels are averaging 81.8 points per game, shooting 54 percent from the field and own a +6.5 rebounding margin.
- Wednesday's game is the second of a three-game Dale Howard Classic road trip for Campbell. The Camels played at Chicago State Monday, play the Hawkeyes Wednesday and conclude the road trip at Creighton on Friday.

HOT SHOT

Freshman Josh Oglesby has led Iowa in scoring the last two games, netting a career-high 16 points against Northern Illinois and 14 versus Creighton.

Oglesby becomes the first Hawkeye reserve to lead the team in scoring, in back-to-back games, since Ricky Davis paced Iowa with 25 and 18 on the road at Wisconsin (Feb. 3) and Michigan State (Feb. 7), respectively, in 1998. Like Oglesby, Davis accomplished the feat as a freshman.

After shooting 1-of-9 (.111) from the field the first two games, the Cedar Rapids native shot 11-of-17 (.647) the last two outings.

IMPROVEMENT UNDER McCaffery IN SECOND YEAR OF PROGRAM

Fran McCaffery-coached teams have posted improved win totals from their first year to second with McCaffery as a head coach. At Lehigh, his team improved by two wins (13 in 1986 to 15 in 1987). His UNC Greensboro team had four more victories from 2000 (15) and 2001 (19). At Siena his team improved by five victories, registering 15 in 2006 to 20 in 2007.

DIALING UP LONG DISTANCE

Iowa made a combined 31 triples its first three games. The 31 treys are the most by a Hawkeye team to start the season. Iowa made 30 triples to start the 1994-95 campaign, making seven against Morgan State, 14 versus Drake and nine against Pepperdine.

FIRE BALLERS

Senior Matt Gatens and junior Eric May have been on fire shooting the ball to start the season. The duo are shooting at a 54 percent clip (42-of-78) from the field and 44 percent (17-of-39) from behind the 3-point arc.

May is averaging 13 points, 4.8 rebounds and 3.0 assists. Gatens is averaging a team-best 15.5 points and is shooting a team-best 55.3 percent (21-of-38) from the field.

SINKING THE FREEBEEFS

Starters Matt Gatens (10-of-11), Melsahn Basabe (19-of-22) and Bryce Cartwright (7-of-8) are a combined 36-of-41 (.878) from the free throw line.

Gatens ranks fourth in Big Ten career free throw percentage.

Iowa is 11-of-12 (.917) from the foul line in shots attempted the final five minutes of games.

EXPERIENCED BACKCOURT

Iowa has the most experienced starting backcourt duo in the Big Ten. The Hawkeyes are the only league team with two starting senior guards, Bryce Cartwright and Matt Gatens.

BROMMER RE-INJURES KNEE

Senior Andrew Brommer sprained his knee on Oct. 13 and missed four weeks of pre-season practice and Iowa's season opener against Chicago State. The center returned to practice and played six minutes in Iowa's game against North Carolina A&T on Nov. 14 before reinjuring the knee. He did not dress in Iowa's last two games versus Northern Illinois and Creighton. His availability for Wednesday's contest against Campbell is questionable.

WHITE TABBED BIG TEN CO-FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

Iowa freshmen Aaron White was named Big Ten co-Freshman of the Week after his performance in Iowa's season opening victory over Chicago State (Nov. 11). White shared the weekly honor with Indiana's Cody Zeller.

White shined in his Hawkeye debut, leading all scorers and rebounders with 19 points and 10 rebounds in 18 minutes of action. The native of Strongsville, Ohio, shot 50 percent (6-of-12) from the field and sank all five free throw attempts.

The 19 points are the most by an Iowa freshman in a season opener, equaling Dick Ives' 19 scored against Nebraska in his debut on Dec. 10, 1943. Furthermore, White's performance marked the first time a Hawkeye posted a double-double, in a season opener, since Dean Oliver had 10 points and 12 assists in a victory over Chicago State in 1997. It was the first time a Hawkeye freshman had a double-double, points and rebounds, since Jess Settles had 13 points and 11 rebounds versus Drake in 1993.

DISHING THE ROCK

Iowa has done an excellent job distributing the basketball so far this season. The Hawkeyes are averaging a Big Ten-best 19.5 assists. Iowa had 22 assists against Chicago State, 20 versus North Carolina A&T and 26 against Northern Illinois. The 26 dimes against the Huskies are the most by a Big Ten team this season and the most by a Hawkeye team since being credited with 26 versus in a 101-59 win over Georgia State on Dec. 20, 2006.

HAWKEYE FAST BREAKS

- Seven of Iowa's first eight contests will be played at home, with the non-home game during the stretch being played on a neutral floor in Des Moines versus Creighton.
- Coach McCaffery has played at least 10 players in each of Iowa's first four games. Also, Iowa's bench averages 36.5 points its first four games.
- Iowa's 61.9 percent (13-of-21) 3-point percentage and 26 assists against Northern Illinois are the best of any Big Ten team this season.
- Iowa had five players score 12 points or more in its win over North Carolina A&T on Nov. 14. It marked only the fourth time the Hawkeyes had five players tally 12 points or more in a game (UW-Green Bay in 2003, Michigan in 2004, SIU-Edwardsville in 2010 and North Carolina A&T in 2011).
- Matt Gatens is only three points from equaling Chad Calabria (1968-70) for 24th place on Iowa's career scoring chart and seven points from tying John Johnson (1969-70) for 23rd.
- Iowa saw an increase in its attendance numbers in 2010-11. Compared to 2009-10, last year's Hawkeyes averaged 2,085 more fans than the previous season, an increase of 20%. Iowa averaged 9,550 fans two years ago, compared to 11,635 last year.

WELCOME NEW HAWKEYES

Iowa has six new faces on the team this season: Gabriel Olaseni, Josh Oglesby, Aaron White, Stephen McCarty, Kyle Denning and Christopher Rickert. Olaseni, Oglesby and White are on scholarship, while Denning, McCarty and Rickert are walk-ons.

COACHING EXPERIENCE

Fran McCaffery has assembled one of the most experienced coaching staffs in the country. Assistant coaches Kirk Speraw, Sherman Dillard and Andrew Francis have over six decades of combined coaching experience. Furthermore, the entire coaching staff combines for 47 years of head coaching experience.

Director of Basketball Operations Jerry Strom is in his 31st season as a member of the Iowa basketball staff. Also, former Hawkeye standout and professional basketball player Ryan Bowen is the video coordinator. Bowen was on four NBA rosters (Denver, Houston, New Orleans and Oklahoma City).

HAWKEYES ARE TOUGH AT HOME

Iowa has won 75 of its 105 games (.714) in Carver-Hawkeye Arena (15,500) over the last eight seasons, including win streaks of 21 straight overall and 12 straight Big Ten Conference wins. Iowa has won 10 of its last 20 home games against ranked opponents. Iowa was a perfect 17-0 at home in 2006, 14-2 in 2007, 10-8 in 2008, 13-4 in 2009, 9-9 in 2010 and 8-8 this season.

IOWA IN CARVER-HAWKEYE ARENA

Iowa has compiled a 351-111 (.760) record in Carver-Hawkeye Arena since the facility opened in January, 1983. Iowa is 162-89 (.645) in Big Ten games and 189-22 (.896) in non-Big Ten contests.

IOWA HISTORY

Iowa has played 2,629 games since beginning basketball in 1902. Iowa's overall record is 1,580-1,049 (.601). That includes a 945-347 (.731) record in home games, a 545-712 (.434) record in contests away from Iowa City, a 703-718 (.495) mark in Big Ten games and a 351-111 (.760) record in Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

Iowa's 2012 Recruiting Class

Anthony Clemmons, Mike Gesell, Patrick Ingram, Kyle Meyer and Adam Woodbury have signed national letter of intents to attend the University of Iowa.

"I'm very excited about this class," said McCaffery. "We started working immediately upon arrival, in particular, on this group. I want to give particular recognition to how hard each and every one of my assistant coaches has worked. I believe we've addressed specific needs and attracted not only quality, but student-athletes who will fit with what we already have here to ultimately make us a better team."

Iowa's five-member 2012 recruiting class is ranked 19th by ESPN.com and Scout.com.

Paul Biancardi, who is ESPN's national recruiting director, had nothing but praise to say about Iowa's recruiting class and coach McCaffery.

"I'm very impressed, but not surprised, with the class coach McCaffery signed," said Biancardi. "This is a national statement class. Coach McCaffery and his staff have sold the vision and the plan for Iowa basketball in a big time way. It should get the fans of Iowa very excited not only right now but in the future. To be successful in this business you have to be able to recruit, and Fran's a proven recruiter. This is a class, that as it grows and develops together, will be the foundation for Iowa basketball. It will propel the Hawkeyes to the next step, which is the upper half of the Big Ten and NCAA Tournament."

ADAM WOODBURY (7-1, 230)

Woodbury is an All-State center from Sioux City, Iowa. The 7-foot-1, 230-pound was named the Most Valuable Player at the 2011 NBA Players Association Top 100 Camp. Woodbury is the No. 41 ranked player in the Class of 2012 by ESPN.com, No. 42 by Rivals.com and No. 47 by Scout.com. He enters his senior season ranked fourth in career scoring and first in rebounding at East High School. He led the Black Raiders to a combined 59-16 record the last three seasons, including back-to-back conference championships and three consecutive state tournament appearances. Woodbury is a two-time first team All-State, All-Missouri River Conference, All-Northwest Iowa and All-City honoree. As a junior, Woodbury averaged a double-double (18.5 points and 12 rebounds). He averaged 17.4 points and grabbed a school single-season record 315 rebounds (12.1 avg.) his sophomore campaign. Woodbury also participated in the Nike LeBron James Skills Academy and Amare Stoudemire Skills Academy in 2011. He played AAU for Martin Brothers and All-Iowa Attack from seventh through 11th grade. Fellow recruit Mike Gesell was an AAU teammate of Woodbury. Woodbury becomes Iowa's first seven-footer since Seth Gorney (2005-08) and is the tallest Hawkeye since Antonio Ramos (1999), who stood 7-foot-2.

MIKE GESELL (6-1, 180)

Gesell is a three-time first team All-State, All-Conference and All-Metro honoree for South Sioux City High School. Gesell is the No. 73 ranked player in the Class of 2012 by ESPN.com, No. 89 by Scout.com and No. 96 by Rivals.com. As a junior, he averaged 25.2 points, 8.2 assists, 5.5 rebounds and 2.9 steals while being honored as the Nebraska Gatorade Basketball Player of the Year. As a sophomore, Gesell averaged 19.9 points, 6.4 assists, 7.7 rebounds and 3.3 steals. He made 82 percent (158-193) of his free throw attempts as a junior and 79 percent (125-158) as a sophomore. The 6-foot-1, 180-pound guard was a Basketball Super State and All-State Class B Team Captain recipient his sophomore and junior seasons. He holds single season school records for scoring (655), assists (212) and steals (79), career scoring (1,446) and single-game steals (8) and assists (13). Gesell, who is a Wendy's High School Heisman state finalist and will be the team's captain this year, also excels in the classroom, ranking in the top five percent of his class while earning Gold Honor Roll distinction all four years. He also is a three-time Academic All-Conference and NSAA Academic All-State honoree. Fellow recruit Adam Woodbury was a teammate of Gesell on Martin Brothers and the All-Iowa Attack AAU squads.

ANTHONY CLEMMONS (6-1, 185)

Clemmons is a native of Lansing, Mich., and has started the last two years for Sexton High School. The 6-foot-1, 185-pound point guard helped his team to back-to-back conference championships and a Class B state title a year ago. Sexton finished as state runner-up his sophomore season. Clemmons is a two-time All-Conference honoree and was an All-State and All-Area selection in 2011. Clemmons averaged 12.3 points, 4.6 rebounds, 4.1 assists and 3.2 steals his junior year. He will serve as a team co-captain his senior campaign. Clemmons played AAU basketball the last two years with the Michigan Mustangs. He also played football his freshman through junior years at Sexton, earning all-conference honors in 2010, playing fullback, linebacker and safety.

PATRICK INGRAM (6-2, 190)

Ingram is a 6-foot-2, 190-pound guard from Indianapolis. He is a two-year starter and helped North Central High School win back-to-back conference championships and the Class 4A state championship in 2010. His high school team boasted a combined 70-8 record his first three seasons. Ingram averaged 10.4 points, 5.0 rebounds and 2.0 assists his junior campaign. He shot 55.5 percent from the field and 33-percent from beyond the arc. A captain on this year's team, Ingram also played on the AAU circuit for the Eric Gordon All-Stars. His team won the Walt Disney World tournament, Eric Gordon Shootout and the IndyBall Tournament. Ingram was tabbed MVP of the Walt Disney World tournament.

KYLE MEYER (6-10, 220)

Meyer is a 6-foot-10, 220-pound forward from Alpharetta, Ga. Meyer averaged 15 points, 11 rebounds, 3.5 blocks and 2.6 assists for Northview High School as a junior. He earned All-Region and co-MVP accolades as a junior, and was also recognized on the 2010 Pickens All-Tournament team. Meyer, who attends the same high school as Minnesota senior Ralph Sampson III, is a three-year starter. He averaged 10 points, 9.5 rebounds and 2.2 blocks, and earned the team's Coaches Award his sophomore campaign. Meyer garnered all-tournament laurels at the Chattahoochee Tournament as a freshman. Meyer also played AAU basketball for the Atlanta Celtics.

Carver-Hawkeye Arena and Dale and Marilyn Howard Family Pavilion



In September 2011, the University of Iowa completed a \$47 million revitalization of Carver-Hawkeye Arena. That project includes the construction of a practice facility for men's and women's basketball and volleyball, a 10,000-square-foot strength training and cardiovascular center, and an expansion to the Dan Gable Wrestling Complex, in addition to new locker room and support facilities for men's and women's basketball, wrestling and volleyball programs, and office space for the majority of Iowa administrative and coaching staffs.

Carver-Hawkeye Arena's four-story, 75,000-square foot addition has been named the Dale and Marilyn Howard Family Pavilion, named after the Howard's gave a multi-million dollar contribution to the athletic department.

"The Howard's have done so much for our program and the UI Athletics Department," said Iowa head coach Fran McCaffery. "Their generosity has helped pave the way for this beautiful state-of-the-art facility that our program desperately needed. Everything from the offices, locker room, practice gym to the weight room, is first class. We are extremely thankful for the Howard's contribution and are so proud to name the new addition after Dale and Marilyn Howard."

Matt Gatens is in his final season with the Hawkeyes and is ecstatic for the new additions and amenities to Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

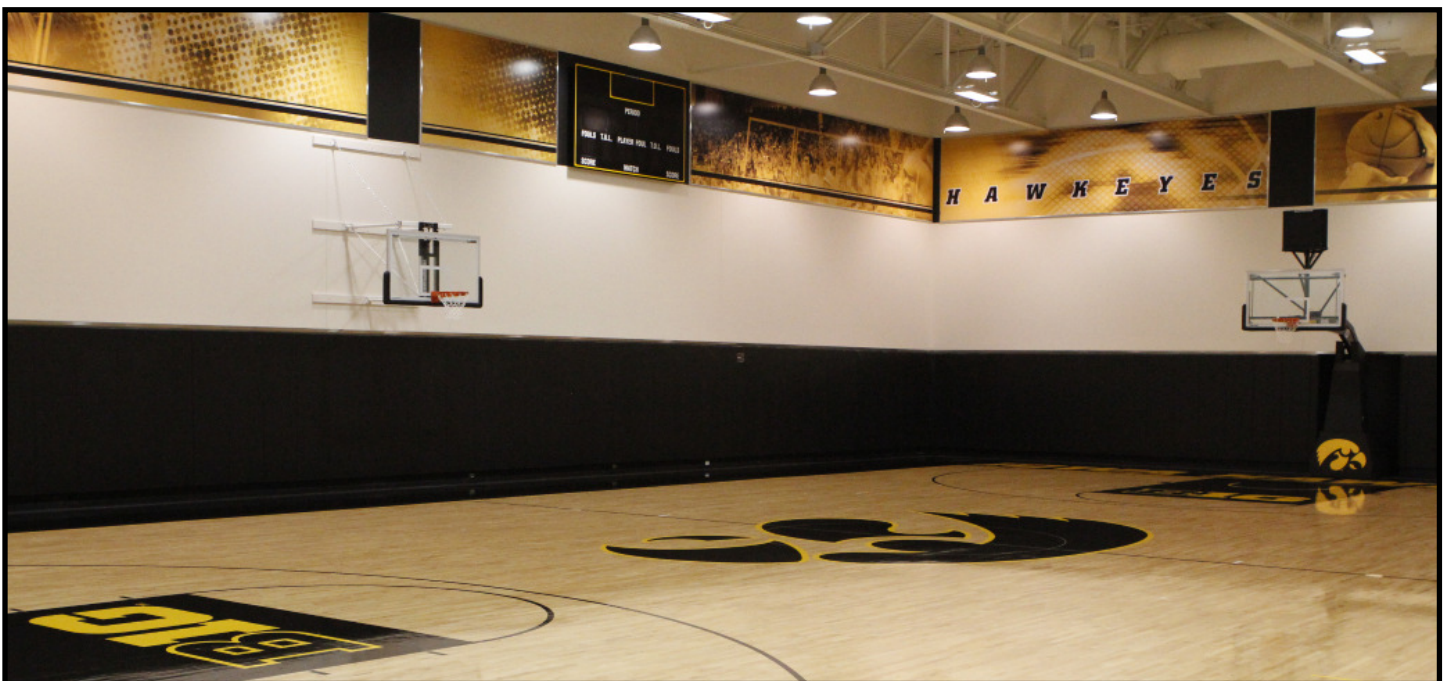




“The new facilities are first class,” said Gatens. “After two years of construction, it’s good to finally be able to use the facility in our training efforts. It’s nice to be able to have a practice gym where we can come over and get extra shots up at our leisure. It’s great to be a Hawkeye!”

The addition of the practice facility eliminates the need to have student-athletes in the sports of men’s basketball, women’s basketball and volleyball practice and train at unusual or irregular times of day or at times which are typically reserved for classes. The flexibility created by the practice space also positively impacts the potential for use of the arena for other University and community-related events such as concerts.

The revitalization of the arena also extends into spaces used by the general public on game days and nights, including renovation of select concessions and restroom facilities, and the creation of hospitality and meeting spaces combined with club facilities for fans of the Hawkeyes who choose to participate in a variety of premium seating options similar to that which are available in the Paul W. Brechler Press Box at Kinnick Stadium.
