# Game #4 Quick Hits

- Saturday is the second of two Cancun Challenge preliminary games.
- Iowa has started the year 3-0 for the second straight season.
- lowa has won eight of its last nine home games, dating back to Feb. 1.
- lowa won its first three games by an average of 24.3 points.
- Roy Devyn Marble scored 15 of his season-high 22 points in the first half Thursday against Howard. It marked the third time in his career the junior reached the 20-point plateau.
- Aaron White leads the team in rebounding (7.3), steals (1.7) and free throws made (20) and attempted (26), and is second in scoring (15.3).
- Saturday will be Iowa's final home game until Dec. 1 against Texas A&M-Corpus Christi.
- This marks the second time in three years under Fran McCaffery that the Hawkeye head coach has started two freshmen in the season opener (Basabe and McCabe in 2010).
- lowa is 10-2 when scoring 80 points or more, the last three seasons. The Hawkeyes are 16-0 when holding opponents to fewer than 60 points, the last two years.
- lowa's average starting lineup height is 6-foot-6. The Hawkeye starting lineup consists of two freshmen, one sophomore, and two juniors.

lowa will play its fourth game in nine days when it hosts Gardner-Webb on Saturday. Tipoff is slated for 7:07 p.m. (CT) on Mediacom Court at Carver-Hawkeye Arena. Saturday's game is a Cancun Challenge preliminary game.

Tickets are \$14 for adults, and \$5 for youths and UI students. Trading cards will be available for the first 1,000 fans.

#### ON THE AIR

Radio: lowa games are broadcast on the Hawkeye Radio Network. Gary Dolphin handles the play-by-play, along with color commentator Bob Hansen. The network includes more than 40 stations that blanket the state of lowa and include portions of Illinois, Nebraska, Minnesota, Missouri and Wisconsin. The Hawkeye Radio Network coverage includes a 60-minute pregame show.

Television: Saturday's game will be televised in the state of lowa on Mediacom's MC22 channel. Rob Brooks and Mac McCausland will call the action. Fans can also access the game online on hawkeyesports.com via the BTN Digital Network. Hawkeye All-Access subscribers can watch live video streams of UI events on the BTN Digital Network at no extra charge. Fans can also access the game via video.BTN.com.

#### SEASON TICKETS AND MINI PACKAGES ON SALE

Hawkeye fans can purchase a season ticket for \$320. UI Faculty and staff can purchase tickets for \$270, while the price is only \$80 for UI students.

There are also two mini-season ticket packages. There is a six-game weekday package (\$120) and a six-game weekend package (\$125).

Single-game tickets to home non-conference games are also on sale. Fans can purchase tickets at the UI Ticket Office, calling 1-800-IAHAWKS or online at hawkeyesports.com.

#### **HAWKEYES POST 30-POINT WIN OVER HOWARD**

- Iowa beat Howard, 66-36, Thursday night on Mediacom Court at Carver-Hawkeye Arena. The 36 points are the fewest an lowa opponent has scored since a 61-36 win over Bryant on Dec. 5, 2008.
- The Hawkeyes doubled-up the Bison in paint points (32-16). lowa also outscored Howard, 12-0, in fast break points.
- Iowa outrebounded the Bison by 13 (43-30) and outscored the visitors by 13 at the foul line (18-5), bolstered by Aaron White's 10-of-11 performance at the charity stripe.
- Senior captain Eric May scored a season-high eight points off the bench.

# **Head Coach Fran McCaffery**

Fran McCaffery is in his third season as the head basketball coach at the University of lowa and his 17th year overall as a college head coach. McCaffery spent five seasons (2005-10) as the head coach at Siena, six years at UNC-Greensboro (1999-2005) and three seasons at Lehigh (1985-88) before joining the Hawkeyes.



McCaffery has three decades of Division I coaching experience. He completed his

30th season as a collegiate coach in 2012, which includes 16 years as a head coach and 14 as an assistant.

McCaffery, 53, holds a career mark of 283-214 (.569) and guided his teams to seven postseason appearances (five NCAA, two NIT). He is 32-37 (.464) at lowa.

McCaffery's five years at Siena were the best in its 70-year history. He led the Saints on an incredible run that ended with three straight Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference championships and NCAA Tournament appearances. In so doing, Siena became the only program in the country to win its regular season and postseason title the last three years.

McCaffery's Saints owned a 112-51 (.687) record in his five years with the program. He guided the Saints to four consecutive 20-win seasons, something that has never been accomplished before at the Siena.

The 2009 MAAC Coach of the Year and 2010 District | Coach of the Year is the third winningest coach, by percentage, in league history (68-22, .756). He is the only coach to guide a MAAC program to two NCAA Tournament wins. McCaffery led his 2008 and 2009 teams to first round NCAA Tournament victories over Vanderbilt and Ohio State, respectively.

In his final two seasons at Siena, he coached the Saints to back-to-back 27-win campaigns and boasted a combined 39-3 (.929) record against MAAC opponents, which included MAAC Tournament contests.

McCaffery began his coaching career as an assistant at Penn (1982-83) and Lehigh (1983-85). Then at age 26, he became the nation's youngest Division I head coach when hired by Lehigh in 1985. After three seasons as head coach at Lehigh, he spent 11 seasons as an assistant at Notre Dame (1988-99).

McCaffery played basketball at Wake Forest his freshman year (1977-78) and then concluded his collegiate playing career at Penn his final three seasons (1979-82).

He earned his B.S. degree in Economics from The Wharton School (Penn) in 1982. McCaffery also earned a Master of Education from Lehigh in 1985.

#### HAWKEYE FASTBREAKS

- Fran McCaffery has coached in 497 career games (283-214, .569).
- The Hawkeyes have played 10 players or more in each of the first three games.
- Aaron White is attacking the rim averaging a team-best 8.7 free-throw attempts per game. He is averaging 6.7 free-throw makes per outing.
- Iowa has made (49) more free throws than its opponents have attempted (41), which is a staple of Fran McCaffery-coached teams.
- Freshman point guard Mike Gesell leads the team in assists (4.7) and shares the team lead in 3-pointers made (1.7).
- · Freshmen guards Mike Gesell and Anthony Clemmons have accounted for eight of Iowa's 18 triples.
- Freshman center Adam Woodbury has missed only four field goal attempts (7-of-11, .636). He is also averaging 4.7 boards per contest.
- Iowa blocked 10 shots vs. UT-Pan American on Friday, the most by an Iowa team since Nov. 14, 2005 (Md.-Eastern Shore).

#### **NUMBER OF THE WEEK -- 3**

Three of Iowa's starters are from the Sioux City area. Junior Zach McCabe and freshman Adam Woodbury hail from Sioux City, Iowa, while freshman Mike Gesell is a native of South Sioux City, Neb. Gesell celebrated his 19th birthday on Nov. 9, the season opener.

#### **ALL-TIME SERIES**

Saturday will be the first meeting between lowa and Gardner-Webb. The Hawkeyes are 3-1 all-time against current teams in the Big South, beating Charleston Southern, Liberty and UNC Asheville, but falling to Campbell last year.

#### **SCOUTING GARDNER-WEBB**

- Gardner-Webb lost 66-62 at home to Lipscomb on Wednesday, then flew to Chicago on Thursday morning and won at DePaul (71-59) the same night.
- Saturday will be Gardner-Webb's third game in four days.
- Gardner-Webb outrebounded the Blue Demons by 13 (44-31). Kevin Hartley paced the Runnin' Bulldogs with a double-double (16 points and 12 rebounds). Max Landis poured in a game-high 20 points to go along with three steals and four assists.
- The Runnin' Bulldogs will be without two of its starters, center Mike Byron and guard Tashan Newsome. Byron is expected to miss between 3-4 weeks after suffering an injury in the first half against Covenant (Ga.) College last Saturday. Newsome suffered a back injury, and the all-conference guard is not expected to return to the court in the immedi-
- Guard Max Landis leads the team in scoring (14.5), while wing player Donta Harper ranks second in scoring (11.0). Kevin Hartley ranks first on the squad in rebounding (7.5).

#### **MARKED IMPROVEMENT IN YEAR TWO**

Fran McCaffery guided Iowa to 18 wins (18-17) in his second season as head coach of the Hawkeyes, with four of the 18 victories coming against top 20 opponents. McCaffery was one of only four Big Ten coaches to record four or more wins over ranked opponents, and the only coach to do so with an unranked team.

McCaffery's seven-win improvement in his second season, ties Pops Harrison (1943-44) for the fourth best improvement following his second year as Iowa head coach. Steve Alford (2000-01) and Lute Olsen (1975-76) rank first (+9), while George Raveling (1984-85) is third (+8). Furthermore, the seven-win improvement ranked third-best in the Big Ten in 2012 behind Indiana (+12) and Michigan State (+10).

lowa improved by four wins in conference play from 2011 (four) to 2012 (eight), its best improvement since 1994-95. Tom Davis' 1994 team won five, while his 1995 squad collected nine victories.

#### **IOWA HISTORY**

Iowa has played 2,662 games since beginning basketball in 1902. Iowa's overall record is 1,598-1,064 (.600). That includes a 959-353 (.731) record in home games, a 549-721 (.432) record in contests away from Iowa City, a 711-728 (.494) mark in Big Ten games and a 365-117 (.757) record in Carver-Hawkeye Arena.
