Balbinot is in his sixth season as Iowa's play-by-play voice, while Till is in her fifth year providing analysis.

IOWA HISTORY

Iowa has played 1,027 games, since beginning basketball in 1974. Iowa's overall record is 624-403 (.608). That includes a 316-157 (.668) mark in regular season Big Ten contests and a 295-87 (.772) mark in Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

ALL-TIME SERIES

Tonight will be the 64th meeting between Iowa and Minnesota, with Iowa holding a 41-22 advantage. The Hawkeyes have won four of the previous six matchups against the Golden Gophers. Iowa won 20-straight games over Minnesota between 1983-94. The Hawkeyes are 22-8 in games played in Iowa City.

SCOUTING MINNESOTA

The Minnesota Golden Gophers are 12-13 overall and 5-9 in Big Ten play. In its last game, Minnesota gave conference-leader Ohio State a tough game, but eventually fell, 64-59. Minnesota led the game for 30 minutes, but an 8-0 Ohio State run in the second half proved to be the difference.

Kiara Buford is leading the team with 13.1 points per game. Ashley Ellis-Milan is next with 9.7 points per contest, while Jackie Voigt is averaging 9.0 points per game. Ellis-Milan is also Minnesota's leading rebounder at 5.2 boards per contest.

As a team, Minnesota is shooting .378 from the field, including .331 from three-point distance and .760 from the charity stripe.

IOWA VS. MINNESOTA NOTES

- Iowa freshman Theairra Taylor will see two high school teammates tonight. Minnesota's Kiara Buford and Ashley Ellis-Milan are from the same hometown (St. Paul, MN) and attended the same high school (St. Paul Central) as Taylor.

- The 2009-10 edition of the Iowa Women's Basketball team has four players from the state of Minnesota. They include junior Kachine Alexander (Minneapolis), sophomores Kamille Wahlin (Crookston) and Hannah Draxten (Fergus Falls) and freshman Theairra Taylor (St. Paul).

- Iowa and Minnesota share two common non-conference opponents. Both schools played Iowa State and Santa Clara. The Hawkeyes opened the season with a 67-51 win over Santa Clara, and were defeated 85-66 by Iowa State. Minnesota knocked off Santa Clara, 91-51, and lost to Iowa State, 77-60.

LAST MEETING

Iowa dropped its second overtime contest in three games, losing at Minnesota, 72-69 (Jan 3).

In a back and forth game, Iowa couldn't pull away in regulation, as the Golden Gophers forced overtime. With 2:41 remaining, Minnesota's Brittany McCoy hit a jumper to tie the game at 62, which would also be the last points of the second half. After the teams traded missed baskets, Iowa grabbed a defensive rebound with 11 seconds left. Kamille Wahlin had a jumper in the lane with two seconds remaining that rimmed out, forcing overtime.

Minnesota used a 7-2 run in overtime to put the game out of reach for the Hawkeyes.

Iowa was led by Jaime Printy, who scored 26 points, along with two rebounds, three assists and two steals. Kachine Alexander recorded a double-double with 15 points and 11 rebounds.

HAWKEYES SWEEP SEASON SERIES VS. ILLINOIS

Iowa defeated Illinois, 77-67, Sunday to sweep the season series against the Fighting Illini.

The Hawkeyes led by as many as 30 in the second half, but Illinois trimmed the deficit to just four points with 3:30 remaining. Clutch free throw shooting by Kachine Alexander down the stretch helped Iowa hold onto its lead and seal the win.

Iowa sprinted out to a 25-6 lead in the first half, and took a 47-20 lead into halftime. The 27-point lead at intermission was Iowa's largest of the season.

Three Hawkeyes scored double figures, including a game-high 24 points by Alexander. Jaime Printy added 17 points, four rebounds, two assists and a career-high three steals, while Kamille Wahlin had 17 points.

ALEXANDER NAMED TEN PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Junior Kachine Alexander was named Ten Player of the Week for the second time this season Feb. 15.

The Minneapolis, MN, native averaged 22.5 points and 11 rebounds in wins at Indiana and at home against Illinois. She shot .579 from the field and .875 from the free throw line. She scored 21 points and grabbed 16 rebounds at Indiana, and followed with 24 points, six rebounds and six assists against Illinois.

Alexander first received the award Nov. 16, after earning MVP honors at the KCRG-TV9 Hawkeye Challenge. She tied a Hawkeye Challenge tournament record by grabbing 18 rebounds (nine offensive, nine defensive), along with netting 19 points in Iowa's season-opening win over Santa Clara. Both her 19 points and 18 rebounds were game highs.

Alexander followed on Sunday with a 21 point, 12 rebound (nine offensive, three defensive) performance in the championship game against Illinois State. Alexander was clutch down the stretch at the free-throw line, making 13-16 attempts from the charity stripe.

PRINTY EARNS FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK HONORS

Jaime Printy was named Big Ten Freshman of the Week for the fourth time this season, Feb. 15.

Printy averaged 22.5 points along with 4.5 rebounds in Iowa's wins at Indiana and over Illinois. She scored a career-high 28 points at Indiana, and netted 17 points vs. Illinois.

Printy led the Hawkeyes to back-to-back conference wins, as Iowa defeated Illinois in Champaign, and knocked off Northwestern in Iowa City. The Marion, IA, native averaged 22.5 points on the week, and shot a blistering .522 (12-23) from the field, including .400 (4-10) from three-point range and .850 (17-20) from the charity stripe. Printy led Iowa with 22 points at Illinois, including 8-8 from the free throw line, which set career highs in both makes and attempts. She also added four rebounds, four assists and two steals. Against Northwestern, Printy led the Hawkeyes with 23 points on 6-10 shooting, and played 38 minutes in the win.

Printy first earned the award Nov. 30, after a stellar performance against William & Mary, and an impressive two-game stretch at the Nugget Classic in Reno, NV. Her second accolade came Jan. 4, after the Hawkeyes defeated Wisconsin and dropped a tough overtime game at Minnesota. Her third honor came Jan. 25 after wins over Illinois and Northwestern.

HAWKEYES RACKING UP THE HONORS

Freshman Jaime Printy has now been named Big Ten Freshman of the Week a conference-leading four times this season. As a team, the Hawkeyes have collected seven weekly honors this season, second only to Ohio State's eight awards.

Head Coach Lisa Bluder

Lisa Bluder (pronounced BLUE-dir) is in her 10th season as head coach at the University of Iowa and her 26th season as a college head coach. She is a two-time Big Ten and WBCA Regional Coach of the Year, most recently earning honors a year ago in 2007-08.

Bluder, 47, has a career record of 539-262 (.673), including a 183-120 (.604) record at Iowa, a 187-106 (.638) record in 10 seasons (1990-2000) at Drake and a six-year mark (1984-90) of 169-36 (.824) at St. Ambrose. Bluder is Iowa's second all-time winningest coach and trails only C. Vivian Stringer. She has guided the Hawkeyes to six post-season tournaments (4 NCAA, 2 WNIT) and six upper-division finishes in the Big Ten Conference, including winning a share of the league championship in 2008 and tying for second place in 2009.

In her first season with the Hawkeyes, Bluder transformed a struggling program into a 21-game winner. Iowa finished second in the Big Ten, won the conference tournament and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament. Bluder became Iowa's third coach to be named Big Ten Coach of the Year. She was also honored as the College Coach of the Year by the *Women's Basketball News Service* and was named the WBCA District 6 Coach of the Year. Iowa's 2001-02 squad finished fourth in the Big Ten and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament for the second consecutive year. In 2003, Bluder guided the Hawkeyes to their first-ever WNIT appearance. Iowa, which had nine underclassmen on its roster, advanced to the quarterfinals before falling to Creighton. In 2004-05, Iowa finished 23-10, starting the year 13-0 and was the last Division I undefeated team standing. In 2005-06, Bluder mentored a team plagued by injuries to a fifth-place Big Ten finish and an NCAA Tournament berth.

In her 10 years at Drake, Bluder brought great success and tradition to the Bulldog program and established herself as one of the top coaches in the country. She led Drake to five 20-plus win seasons in her last six years, including five post-season appearances. She guided the Bulldogs to eight Missouri Valley Conference Tournament appearances, reaching the semifinals six times and winning the tournament four times. Bluder was also named the Conference Coach of the Year three times at Drake.

Bluder began her coaching career at St. Ambrose, where she coached six successful seasons, building the Bees into a NAIA powerhouse. During her tenure at St. Ambrose, Bluder guided the Bees to four straight national tournaments, including two consecutive Final Four appearances. The 1990 St. Ambrose team was ranked No. 1 and Bluder was named the NAIA Converse Coach of the Year.

A graduate of Linn-Mar High School in Marion, IA, Bluder was a three-year starter at Northern Iowa. She graduated from UNI in 1983 with a bachelor's degree in marketing.

KASHIN' IN FROM THE CHARITY STRIPE

Kachine Alexander set two school records and a Big Ten record Sunday against Illinois. Alexander's 17 made free throws and 20 free throw attempts were both school records. In addition, the two marks are Carver-Hawkeye records for an Iowa player. Alexander's 17 made free throws are also the most by a single player in a Big Ten game. The 20 attempts are the third-most by a Big Ten player in conference history. Alexander has scored 107 of her total 286 points from the free throw line, and is averaging 7.6 trips to the charity stripe per game.

WAHLIN TIES SOPHOMORE TREY MARK

Kamille Wahlin tied Wendy Ausdemore's record for three-pointers made by a sophomore Sunday vs. Illinois. Wahlin finished with four made three-pointers, which gives her 62 on the year. Wahlin is currently tied with Ausdemore, and one more trey will give her the sophomore record.

PRINTY SETS FRESHMEN THREE-POINTERS RECORD

Jaime Printy became Iowa's all-time leader for three-pointers made by a freshman Feb. 4 at Ohio State. Printy's four treys against the Buckeyes gave her 50 for the season, which is one better than the previous record of 49, held by Lindsey Meder (1998-99).

CLIMBING THE RECORDS LADDER

Sophomore Kamille Wahlin and freshmen Jaime Printy and Morgan Johnson are putting their names in the Hawkeye records book this season.

- Printy already broke the freshmen record for three-pointers made in a single season at Iowa with 57.
- Printy's 388 points rank third among Hawkeye freshmen. She only needs 28 more points to become the all-time freshmen scoring leader at Iowa. She is currently in third place with 388 points, and trails Megan Skouby (414) and Lisa Becker (416). Printy needs to average seven points over the next four games to break the record.
- Printy's 77 assists ranks fifth in Iowa history for a freshman. She trails Necole Tunsil for fourth place (78) and Kristi Smith for third place (82).
- Wahlin's 62 made three-pointers are tied for first in Iowa history for a sophomore. She is tied with Wendy Ausdemore for first place.
- Johnson's 56 blocks are the second-most for an Iowa freshmen. Tangel Smith (73) is in first place. Smith's 73 blocks also rank first all-time in Iowa history.
- Johnson's 175 rebounds are third among freshmen. She trails Cindy Haugejorde (237) for third place.

ON A STREAK

Since Jan. 21, Iowa has won six of its last seven games, with its only loss coming at conference-leader Ohio State. Iowa has moved from last place in the Big Ten to alone in fifth place. The Hawkeyes are just one game out of third place, and 1.5 games out of second place in the standings. Iowa has also moved up 23 spots in the NCAA RPI (74 to 51) since Jan. 21.

DOUBLE TROUBLE

Kachine Alexander collected her 11th double-double of the season at Indiana Feb. 11. Alexander scored 21 points and grabbed 16 rebounds. She now has 20 career double-doubles.

Alexander registered her double-double just 15:24 in the game. She grabbed her 10th rebound of the contest at the 4:43 mark in the first half. Alexander entered halftime with 14 of Iowa's 32 points and 12 of its 28 rebounds.

Alexander had double-doubles in each of Iowa's first three games, before missing the next seven games with a stress fracture. She now has double-doubles in four-straight games.

Despite missing seven games, Alexander still ranks third in the Big Ten in double-doubles, behind Ohio State's Jantel Lavendar (15) and Illinois' Jenna Smith (14), who are both post players.

HAWKEYES LEADING IN STAT CATEGORIES

Several of Iowa's statistics leading the Big Ten, and stack up well across the country.

- As a team, the Hawkeyes lead the Big Ten in three-pointers made per game (7.64) and rank second in three-point percentage (.367). In Big Ten games only, Iowa leads the conference in three-pointers made per game (7.36) and is second in three-point percentage (.347). Nationally, Iowa ranks 15th in three-pointers made per game and 27th in three-point percentage.
- Iowa's team free throw percentage of .756 is third in the Big Ten, and 17th nationally.
- Individually, freshman Jaime Printy leads the Big Ten in free throw percentage (.887) and ranks second in three-pointers made per game (2.44). Printy ranks 11th nationally in free throw percentage.
- Printy is second in the Big Ten in three-pointers made per game (2.44), and first in league games only (2.57).
- Kamille Wahlin leads the Big Ten in three-pointers made per game (2.58).
- Kachine Alexander is third in the Big Ten in double-doubles, and ranks 21st nationally. She is also third in the conference in rebounding (10.2) and defensive rebounds (7.31), in league games only.
- In Big Ten games only, freshman Morgan Johnson ranks first with a .484 field goal percentage.

LEADING THE ROOKIES

Jaime Printy and Morgan Johnson are making their cases to be included on the Big Ten all-Freshmen team this season.

Printy leads all Big Ten freshmen in scoring (15.5) and free throw percentage (.887), while Johnson is first in rebounding (7.0) and blocked shots (2.24).

ONE, TWO FROM THREE

Kamille Wahlin and Jaime Printy are proving to be a potent one-two punch from behind the three-point arc.

The duo ranks first and second in the Big Ten in three pointers made per game. Wahlin leads the league with 2.58, while Printy is second with 2.44.

TAKING ADVANTAGE OF FREE THROWS

Iowa, under Head Coach Lisa Bluder, is proving to be one of the best free throw shooting teams in the country.

The Hawkeyes have ranked in the top 20 in the nation four of the past five seasons. Iowa finished the 2005-06 season ranked 10th (.760), 2006-07 ranked fifth (.788) and also ranked fifth (.792) last season.

The 2009-10 campaign is no different. Iowa currently ranks 17th in free throw percentage across the NCAA (.756). The Hawkeyes are led by freshman Jaime Printy, who is a blistering .887 from the charity stripe. Sophomore Kamille Wahlin is also shooting an impressive .893 from the line.

HITTING 70 POINTS

If the Hawkeyes score 70 or more points, chances are they will walk away with a win.

Twelve of Iowa's 14 wins have come when the team scores 70 or more points. The Hawkeyes are 10-1 when scoring between 70-79 points, and 2-1 when reaching 80 points.

UNDERCLASSMEN CONTRIBUTING

Iowa's freshmen and sophomore class are putting up big numbers for the Hawkeyes this season.

Hawkeye underclassmen are responsible for 81 percent of the teams' points, 81 percent of the minutes played and 66 percent of rebounds.

PRINTY LEADS CHARGE AT INDIANA

Freshman Jaime Printy sparked Iowa in the second half, scoring 20 of her 28 points in the final 20 minutes. Printy scored 14-straight points for the Hawkeyes between the 10:41 and 4:05 mark in the second half.

With Iowa leading by just one point with 20 seconds left, Printy nailed a runner in the paint as the shot clock expired to put the Hawkeyes up three points.

HITTING THE BOARDS

Iowa dominated the glass Thursday at Indiana, out-rebounding the Hoosiers by 24 (53-29).

Thursday was the first time since March 20, 2003 that Iowa held a rebounding margin of that size. Iowa out-rebounded St. Louis in the first round of the WNIT by 30 (57-27).

Iowa's 53 rebounds Thursday night were also the most team rebounds since Dec. 30, 2003, when the Hawkeyes grabbed 55 against Missouri.

KASH GETS NO. 500

Kachine Alexander became the 19th player in Iowa history to reach the 500-career rebound plateau at Iowa Feb. 7 against Michigan State.

Alexander enters Thursday's game vs. Minnesota with 526 rebounds.



IT'S BEEN A WHILE

In Iowa's win against Purdue Jan. 31, both Morgan Johnson (16 points, 11 rebounds) and Kachine Alexander (16 points, 10 rebounds) recorded double-doubles.

The last time Iowa had two players record double-doubles, in the same game, was Feb. 19, 2005 in Iowa's 78-59 win at Michigan. Johanna Solverson finished with 18 points and 10 assists, while Jamie Cavey ended with 19 points and 14 rebounds.

The last time Iowa had two players record double-doubles with points and rebounds was Dec. 10, 2004 in Iowa's 91-82 win at Creighton. Krista VandeVenter had 19 points and 14 rebounds, while Jamie Cavey had 20 points and 10 rebounds.

OH, SO CLOSE

Seven of Iowa's 11 losses have been by six points or less, with three of those being by three points. Iowa has also lost two overtime games by a combined seven points.

- The Hawkeyes had a three-point attempt at the buzzer against West Virginia fall short, that would have sent the game to overtime.
- Against Boston College (Dec. 2), Iowa missed a three-pointer with seven seconds left that would have tied the game.
- Against Michigan (Dec. 6), Iowa missed the front-end of a one-and-one from the free throw line with both 27 and 11 seconds left, each time trailing by only one point.
- Iowa's two overtime losses came at Penn State (Dec. 28, four point loss) and at Minnesota (Jan. 3, three point loss). In each of those games, the Hawkeyes had the potential game winning shot in regulation bounce off the iron as time expired.
- Iowa led by nine points with 9:48 remaining against Penn State (Jan. 14), but an 11-0 Lady Lion run gave them a 51-49 advantage with 7:13 left. Penn State took the lead for good with 5:36 left, as Iowa could only come within four points with 44 seconds left.
- The Hawkeyes had a 72-71 lead with 4:58 at then-No. 8 ranked Ohio State, but couldn't hold on to the win, losing by four points.
- In addition, Iowa led No. 19 Kansas by three points (54-51) with 6:41 remaining in the game, but the Jayhawks closed the contest with a 15-1 run.

HAWKEYES HIT FREE THROW MARKS

Iowa shot 20-21 (.952) from the charity stripe at Minnesota Jan. 3, which is a school record for free throw percentage (minimum 20 attempts).

Jaime Printy led the way, going 8-8, while Kachine Alexander and Trisha Nesbitt each went 4-4.

Earlier this season, Iowa tied the school record for single-game free throw percentage, converting all 16 attempts against Columbia (1.000).

Freshman Morgan Johnson led the way, going 6-6. Sophomore Kamille Wahlin and freshman Theairra Taylor each went 4-4, while freshman Gabby Machado finished 2-2.

JOHNSON TIES SCHOOL RECORD...AGAIN

Freshman Morgan Johnson has tied the school record for blocked shots in a game (7) twice this season.

Johnson first blocked seven shots at Northern Iowa Nov. 22. She repeated the accomplishment Jan. 14 against Penn State. Johnson's seven blocks are also a career high.

Johnson holds the record with Jerica Watson (vs. Kent State, 12/8/01) and Tangela Smith (at Michigan State, 1/15/95).

Hawkeyes Ink Talented Recruit

Jade Rogers has signed a National Letter of Intent to attend the University of Iowa next fall.

"We are eager to have Jade Rogers join our team," Bluder said. "Jade is a tremendous kid that loves the game, and has grown up as a Hawkeye fan. Jade will be a versatile player that can play a number of positions. She can post up or she can shoot the long ball. She is also a good rebounder. Jade has had a great career at Cedar Rapids Kennedy, and is looking forward to continuing her career as a Hawkeye."

Rogers, a 5-11 forward, is from nearby Hiawatha, IA, and attends Cedar Rapids Kennedy High School. She led the state in scoring (22.3) and rebounding (13.4) as a sophomore, and was named the Missouri Valley Conference Player of the Year. She also earned first team all-state, all-district, all-metro and all-conference honors.

Rogers suffered an ACL injury during the summer of the 2008, but returned to the court and helped lead Kennedy to the semifinal round of the state tournament. Rogers played in 17 games as a junior and averaged 17.9 points and 10.6 rebounds. She was named first team all-state, all-district, all-metro and all-conference, along with being named to the state tournament all-tournament team.

As a freshman, Rogers earned second team all-state honors, along with first team all-district, all-metro and all-conference recognition.

Rogers currently has 1,089 points (18.5 per game average), which is fourth on the all-time scoring list at Kennedy. She also holds school records for single-game rebounds (20), single-season rebounds per game (12.6) and is on pace to become Kennedy's career rebounding leader. Rogers is also a three-time team captain.

Rogers has also lettered in volleyball. She helped lead the Kennedy volleyball team to a state tournament appearance this year.

WAHLIN SHOOTS HER WAY INTO RECORD BOOKS

Sophomore Kamille Wahlin went 7-15 from three-point range against Penn State Dec. 28, which set one school record, and tied another.

Wahlin's 15 three-point attempts set a school record for long distance shots attempted in a single game. Her seven made treys also tied Lindsey Meder's school record, set against Wisconsin Dec. 31, 2000.

THREE HAWKEYES OUT FOR SEASON

Senior JoAnn Hamlin, sophomore Hannah Draxten and freshman Theairra Taylor will all miss the season with injuries.

Hamlin has missed the entire season after having a blood clot removed in her right leg. Taylor suffered a torn ACL in Iowa's win over South Dakota State. Draxten has played four games this season, despite suffering from a herniated disc. It was announced after Iowa's loss at Penn State that Draxten will be forced to miss the rest of the season due to the back injury.

JOHNSON EARNS FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK HONORS

Morgan Johnson was named Big Ten Freshman of the Week (Feb. 1) for her efforts in Iowa's win against Purdue.

Johnson led Iowa against the Boilermakers with her third career double-double. The Platte City, MO, native netted 16 points and 11 rebounds, and finished 7-8 from the field. She made her first seven shots of the game before missing her final attempt at the 2:10 mark in the second half. Johnson added two blocks in 24 minutes of action.

ON THE HORIZON

The Hawkeyes travel to Evanston, IL, Sunday to face Northwestern. Tip-off is slated for 1 p.m. at Welsh-Ryan Arena.
