- Jarrod Uthoff has led lowa in scoring five of the last seven outings, including pouring in a career-best 32 points in the last game at No. 2/4 lowa State on Dec. 10. Uthoff was named Big Ten Co-Player of the Week on Monday.
- Iowa has won its last four games against Drake, dating back to 2009.
- lowa averaged 85.8 points its last five games, scoring more than 82 points four times.
- Iowa has had nine different players score in double digits at least once this season. Senior Jarrod Uthoff has reached double figures in every game. Uthoff has scored 24 points or more in the first half of each of the last two contests (Western Illinois and Iowa State).
- Senior Jarrod Uthoff ranks 11th nationally in 3-point accuracy (.510), 13th in blocks (2.8), and 38th in scoring (19.6). Senior Mike Gesell ranks ninth in assists (7.0).
- lowa has made 12 3-pointers in four games this season. The last time the Hawkeyes made 12+ 3-pointers in a game four times in a season was in 2009-10 (five times).
- Jarrod Uthoff was selected as one of 10 players on the Preseason All-Big Ten team.
- Iowa is 44-7 when scoring 80 points or more, the last six seasons. The Hawkeyes are 58-2 when holding opponents to fewer than 61 points, the last six years.



Head Coach Fran McCaffery

Fran McCaffery, who is signed through the 2020 season, is in his sixth season as the head basketball coach at the University of Iowa and his 20th year overall as a college head coach. McCaffery has reached the 20-win plateau seven of the last nine seasons, including the last three years.

McCaffery spent five seasons (2005-10) as the head coach at Siena, six years at UNC-Greensboro (1999-2005) and three seasons at Lehigh (1985-88) before joining the Hawkeyes.

McCaffery has three decades of Division I coaching experience. He completed his 33rd



McCaffery, 56, holds a career mark of 354-255 (.581) and guided his teams to 10 postseason appearances (seven NCAA and three NIT). He is 103-78 (.569) at Iowa, winning game No. 100 vs. Wichita State on Nov. 29.

Since taking over the lowa program in 2010, the Hawkeyes have earned four postseason tournament berths (2 NCAA, 2 NIT). McCaffery coached lowa to 25 victories in 2013, equaling the second-most win total in program history. McCaffery has guided two Hawkeyes to All-Big Ten first team laurels, one earned second team accolades, while five were voted on the third team.

McCaffery has posted upper division finishes in each of the past three seasons at Iowa and 15-of-19 seasons as a head coach. He has posted 20 wins or more seven of the last nine seasons, including the last three at Iowa (2013, 2014, and 2015).

McCaffery and the Hawkeyes have made Carver-Hawkeye Arena one of the most feared arenas to play nationally. Fans have embraced McCaffery and his team's style of play with attendance increasing by more than 50 percent since 2010. The Hawkeyes boast a 45-10 home record the last three seasons, which includes a school-record 18 wins in 2014.

McCaffery's five years at Siena were the best in its 70-year history. He led the Saints on an incredible run that ended with three straight Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference championships and NCAA Tournament appearances. In so doing, Siena became the only program in the country to win its regular season and postseason title 2008-10.

McCaffery's Saints owned a 112-51 (.687) record in his five years with the program. He guided the Saints to four consecutive 20-win seasons.

The 2009 MAAC Coach of the Year and 2010 District I Coach of the Year is the third winningest coach, by percentage, in league history (68-22, .756). He is the only coach to guide a MAAC program to two NCAA Tournament wins. McCaffery led his 2008 and 2009 teams to first round NCAA Tournament victories over Vanderbilt and Ohio State, respectively.

In his final two seasons at Siena, he coached the Saints to back-to-back 27-win campaigns and boasted a combined 39-3 (.929) record against MAAC opponents, which included MAAC Tournament contests.

McCaffery began his coaching career as an assistant at Penn (1982-83) and Lehigh (1983-85). After three seasons as head coach at Lehigh, he spent 11 seasons as an assistant at Notre Dame (1988-99).

McCaffery played basketball at Wake Forest his freshman year (1977-78) and then concluded his collegiate playing career at Penn his final three seasons (1979-82).

He earned his B.S. degree in Economics from The Wharton School (Penn) in 1982. McCaffery also earned a Master of Education from Lehigh

SCOUTING DRAKE

- Drake enters Saturday's game on a three-game losing streak, most recently falling by the score of 79-71 at Nevada on Dec. 12. In the loss to the Wolf Pack, 10 of the Bulldogs' 23 field goals were 3-pointers. Nevada forced 15 Bulldog turnovers and converted those miscues into 22 points. Jacob Enevold posted his fifth career double-double, pulling down a team-best 11 rebounds and scoring nine of his 13 points at the free throw line.
- Reed Timmer's 19 points per game average ranks 48th in the nation, while shooting at a high percentage from the field (.551, 65-of-118), 3-point territory (.545, 18-of-33), and the foul line (.824, 42-of-51).
- Kale Abrahamson averages 16.1 points per game, bolstered by a career-high 41-point effort against Western Kentucky on Nov. 23. Abrahamson played on the same AAU team as Iowa's Mike Gesell and Adam Woodbury and played against the Hawkeye duo his first two seasons of eligibility when has was on Northwestern.
- Drake averages eight 3-pointers per game, with three Bulldogs accounting for 84 percent of its makes: Graham Woodward (25), Kale Abrahamson (24), and Reed Timmer (18). The Bulldogs shoot at a 42 percent clip from long distance -- 15th best in the country.
- Drake and Iowa have played one common opponent: UMKC. The Bulldogs lost to the Kangaroos (79-73) in Des Moines, while the Hawkeyes won (95-75) in Iowa City.
- Giacoletti brought his Eastern Washington team to Iowa City for the 2003 Hawkeye Challenge. The Hawkeyes beat the Eagles, 70-54, in the first round.

LAST MEETING AGAINST DRAKE

lowa closed the first half on a 10-0 surge to pull away from Drake and ultimately win 83-66 at the 2013 Big Four Classic in Des Moines. Four Hawkeyes netted double figures: Melsahn Basabe (15), Jarrod Uthoff (14), Peter Jok (14), and Devyn Marble (14).

lowa dominated the glass, outrebounding the Bulldogs by 19 (47-28). Jarrod Uthoff led all rebounders with nine off the bench. The Hawkeyes outscored Drake, 29-5, in second chance opportunities after grabbing 17 offensive boards. Iowa limited the Bulldogs to only six offensive rebounds.

lowa attacked the basket and was rewarded with 30 free throw attempts (made 22).

UTHOFF NAMED BIG TEN CO-PLAYER OF THE WEEK

lowa's Jarrod Uthoff was named Big Ten Co-Player of the Week along with Maryland's Melo Trimble. The honor is the second of Uthoff's career, having first earned the recognition on Jan. 6, 2015.

Uthoff shot 61 percent from the field (22-of-36), including a blistering 69 percent from 3-point territory (9-of-13), and 86 percent from the free throw line (6-of-7) in two games last week, averaging nearly a double-double (29.5 points and nine rebounds). He also averaged 2.5 blocks.

The native of Cedar Rapids, Iowa, scored a career-high 27 points in a 90-56 win over Western Illinois, and then bested that performance with a personal-best 32 points in a one-point loss at No. 2 Iowa State.

The Hawkeye senior scored 24 of his 27 points in the first half against the Leathernecks and 30 of his 32 in the first 20 minutes against the Cyclones. Uthoff's 32 points are the most by a Hawkeye since Matt Gatens had 33 against Wisconsin on Feb. 23, 2012, and the most by a Big Ten player this season against a ranked opponent.

UTHOFF FILLS IT UP DURING FIRST HALF AT IOWA STATE

Senior Jarrod Uthoff scored 30 first-half points at second-ranked lowa State, while also grabbing six rebounds, blocking two shots and collecting a steal. Uthoff made 11-of-13 shot attempts, including 5-of-6 from 3-point territory, while also going 3-of-4 from the charity stripe the first 20 minutes of action.

IOWA STATE EDGES HAWKEYES ON LAST SECOND SHOT

- lowa led by as many as 20 points in the second half, but No. 2/4 lowa State charged back and upended the Hawkeyes 83-82 in Ames on Dec. 10.
- Three Hawkeyes scored in double digits, led by Jarrod Uthoff's 32 points. Peter Jok netted 18, while Adam Woodbury had 12. Jok scored 16 of his 18 points in the second half, bolstered by making four 3-pointers the first 5:05 of the half.
- Jarrod Uthoff recorded 30 of his 32 points in the first half. The senior also had a team-high nine rebounds and four blocks. Uthoff becomes the first player to score at least 32 points in an lowa-lowa State game since Acie Earl recorded 32 points and nine rebounds at Iowa State in 1991.
- The Hawkeyes shot 47.7 percent from the field, while Iowa State shot 48.6 percent. lowa was 9-of-10 (.900) from the free throw line, while the Cyclones were 6-of-11 (.545).
- The Hawkeyes made 11-of-27 3-point attempts, marking the sixth time this season they have made 10 or more in a single game.

THREE TIMES THE CHARM

lowa posted a 22-12 record last season, reaching the 20-win plateau for the third consecutive season. For the first time in 15 years, lowa won 20 or more games in three consecutive seasons. The last time lowa won at least 20 games four straight seasons was 1995-1999 -- Tom Davis' last five seasons as lowa's head coach.

UTHOFF NAMED TO ADVOCARE INVITE ALL-TOURNAMENT TEAM

lowa's Jarrod Uthoff was one of five players named to the 2015 Advocare Invitational All-Tournament Team. Uthoff joined Xavier's Trevon Bluiett and Jalen Reynolds, Scoochie Smith of Dayton, and Justin Robinson of Monmouth (MVP).

Uthoff averaged 20 points in three games (Dayton, Notre Dame, and Wichita State), reaching double figures in the first half in all three games. The Hawkeye senior also averaged 5.7 rebounds and 2.7 blocks, and shot at a 50 percent clip (23-of-46).

BAER PROVIDING SOLID MINUTES OFF BENCH

Redshirt freshman walk-on Nicholas Baer is averaging 13 minutes off the bench. Baer is not only producing offensively, but also defensively with his rebounding and taking charges.

Baer has made eight of his 19 attempts (.421) from 3-point range this season. He scored a personal-best 14 points in 15 minutes of action in lowa's victory over UMKC.

DIALING IT UP FROM LONG DISTANCE

lowa averaged 5.6 3-pointers made per game a year ago. Through nine games this season, the Hawkeyes are averaging 9.5 triples, which ranks fourth in the Big Ten and 32nd nationally.

lowa made 12 triples in four games this season (Coppin State, Marquette, Dayton, and UMKC). The last time the Hawkeyes made 12+3-pointers in a game four times in a season was in 2009-10 (five times).

Last year, lowa shot 33.3 percent from behind the arc, while the Hawkeyes are shooting at a 40 percent clip this season.

RETURNING STARTS

lowa returns 134 of a possible 170 starting positions from the previous year (78.8 percent), the second-highest total during the Fran McCaffery era.

INCREASED WORK LOAD

The last couple seasons, Adam Woodbury split time at the center position with Gabriel Olaseni. With Olaseni having graduated, expect Woodbury's minutes to increase according to coach McCaffery. The 7-foot-1, 250-pounder averaged 21 minutes per game a year ago alongside Olaseni. In his career when playing 28 minutes or more, Woodbury averages 11.7 points and 6.4 rebounds per game.

The senior has played over 28 minutes three this year (15 points and seven rebounds vs. Wichita State; 11 points and 10 rebounds vs. Florida State; 12 points and five rebounds at Iowa State).

WELCOME NEWCOMERS

Despite having four returning starters, plus another who has starting experience, lowa welcomes 10 newcomers to its 2015-16 roster. The 10 newcomers includes two players who received redshirts last season (Nicholas Baer and Brady Ellingson). Iowa's 10 newcomers ties for third most among Division I schools: Portland State and Tennessee State have 11, followed by Iowa, UTEP, and Nebraska with 10.

The Hawkeyes add five freshmen (Isaiah Moss, Andrew Fleming, Brandon Hutton, Ahmad Wagner, and Christian Williams), and three junior college transfers (Dale Jones, and Michael and Steven Soukup). The Soukups are identical twins.

FLOCKING TO CHA

lowa sold out 16 home games the last two seasons. The Hawkeyes ranked 20th in national attendance in 2015, averaging 14,101 fans. It is the second straight season and 21st time that lowa has cracked the top 20 in the national attendance rankings.

Additionally, lowa played in front of 475,998 fans in its 34 games (home, away, and on neutral courts) throughout the season. That figure ranked 13th in the country.

As a conference, the 14 Big Ten schools averaged 12,781 fans to lead in the nation in average attendance for a 39th consecutive season. More than three million fans witnessed Big Ten games in person throughout the course of the 2014-15 season. For the second consecutive year, lowa was one of seven Big Ten schools to rank in the top 20 nationally.

HAWKEYE FAST BREAKS

- lowa returns seven letterwinners, including four starters.
- lowa has won eight of its last 12 true road games, including posting a 7-3 mark last season.
- lowa's win over Florida State on Dec. 2, clinched the Big Ten/ ACC Challenge for the Big Ten. The Hawkeyes have clinched the Challenge for the Big Ten each of the last two years.
- lowa has won 37 of its last 38 nonconference home games, dating back to November 2011.
- lowa has competed in postseason play the last four years: NIT second round in 2012; NIT runner-up in 2013; NCAA first round in 2014; NCAA third round in 2015. The Hawkeyes tied for third place in the Big Ten last season -- its best finish in nine years.
- lowa won 21 regular season games last season, the most by a Hawkeye team since 2006 (22).
- lowa has won at least 20 games in three consecutive seasons -- its longest streak in 15 years.
- lowa averaged 11.1 turnovers in 2015, which is the best average for fewest turnovers in program history since turnovers became an official stat in 1980.



- The Hawkeyes won seven true road games last season, including winning its final six regular-season Big Ten games for the first time since 1955. The seven total road wins were the most by a Hawkeye team since 1987.
- lowa's 12 conference wins last season are the most by a Hawkeye team since 1997. Also, its third place finish was its best in nine seasons.
- Iowa's 83-52 effort over Davidson in the NCAA Second Round was the program's first tournament win since 2001. It also marked the largest margin of victory in an NCAA Tournament 7/10 match-up.
- Iowa has had a first-team All-Big Ten honoree in each of the last two seasons: Devyn Marble in 2014 and Aaron White in 2015.

DISTRIBUTOR AND PROTECTOR

Point guard Mike Gesell has done an outstanding job directing the Hawkeye offense his entire Hawkeye career. Gesell owns two of lowa's top four assist-to-turnover ratio's since the 1996-97 season. His 3.05 ratio in 2013-14 ranks first, while his 2.21 ratio in 2014-15 ranks fourth. Dean Oliver's 2.75 ratio in 2000-01 is second, followed by Ryan Luehrsmann's 2.21 in 1997-98 ranking third.

The native of South Sioux City, Nebraska, ranks 15th in the country in assists (7.0). He collected a career-best 12 assists in lowa's win over Coppin State. He has been credited with nine or more assists five times this season.

UTHOFF. GESELL. WOODBURY EARN ACADEMIC DISTINCTION

Mike Gesell and Jarrod Uthoff were named 2015 Capital One Academic All-District first team honorees for their combined performance athletically and in the classroom. Gesell was also tabbed third team Academic All-America, becoming the first Hawkeye to accomplish the national distinction since Adam Haluska (first team) in 2007.

Gesell, a native of South Sioux City, Nebraska, earned his degree in finance in three years. Last fall, Gesell earned invitation to Beta Gamma Sigma, the National Scholastic Honor Society for business students at the University of Iowa who have garnered GPA's that place them in the top 10 percent of their class.

Uthoff, a native of Cedar Rapids, Iowa, graduated last May with a degree in economics.

Additionally, Gesell, Uthoff, and Adam Woodbury were named 2015 Academic All-Big Ten.

IOWA HISTORY

Iowa has played 2,684 games since beginning basketball in 1902. Iowa's overall record is 1,579-1,105 (.588). That includes a 1,008-353 (.740) record in home games, a 567-749 (.431) record in contests away from Iowa City, a 741-751 (.497) mark in Big Ten games and a 412-127 (.764) record in Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

Iowa Signs 4 Prep Standouts

Jordan Bohannon, Tyler Cook, Ryan Kriener, and Cordell Pemsl have all signed a National Letter of Intent to attend the University of lowa in 2016.

Bohannon is a 6-foot-1, 170-pound guard from Linn-Mar High School in Marion, Iowa. Bohannon led his high school team in team in scoring (17.7), assists (4.5), rebounds (4.5), and tied for steals while being named first team All-Metro and All-Conference, second team All-State, Metro Player of the Year. He was a four-year letterman on the basketball team and competed three years on varsity golf team. Bohannon averaged 16 points and six rebounds on the 2015 AAU National, State, and Elite 28 Premier League Champion Martin Brother's squad. He was AAU teammates with Kriener and Pemsl.

Cook is a three-year varsity starter and team captain the last two seasons for Chaminade College Prep in St. Louis. The 6-foot-9, 240-pound All-State honoree as a junior averaged 13 points and six rebounds. Cook was a Nike Global Challenge and Nike Skills Academy participant. He is ranked as the No. 51 player in the 2016 class according to ESPN.

Kriener (pronounced KREEN-ir) is a 6-foot-10, 240 pounds forward from Spirit Lake High School in Spirit Lake, Iowa. He was a 2015 all-conference and second-team all-state honoree. Kriener was a two-time all-region selection for the state tournament. He averaged 19.8 points, while shooting at a 71 percent (204-of-286) clip from the field, and 8.5 rebounds as a junior. Kriener averaged 18 points and 15 rebounds on the 2015 AAU National, State, and Elite 28 Premier League Champion Martin Brother's squad. He was AAU teammates with Bohannon and Pemsl.

Pemsl, a native of Dubuque, Iowa, averaged 15.2 points and 8.75 rebounds his first three seasons at Wahlert High School. He was a two-time first-team all-state and all-conference selection. Pemsl, a three-time team captain, led Wahlert to two straight state championships. He veraged 17.3 points per game as a junior before missing the final seven games due to injury. He was AAU teammates with Bohannon and Kriener. Pemsl also competed on the Wahlert golf and baseball teams for four and three years, respectively.

UTHOFF PRODUCING ON THE WING

Jarrod Uthoff, who was named third-team All-Big Ten last season, ranked second in team scoring (12.4 ppg), and steals (1.1), and first in 3-point shooting (54-of-145, .372). He was the only Division I player to have 50+ 3-pointers, 55+ blocks and 35+ steals.

This season, Uthoff is one of 10 men's basketball players selected to the 2015 Preseason All-Big Ten team, selected by a media voting panel, and was named to the 2015 Advocare Invitational after averaging 20 points in three games.

The senior has scored in double figures in all 10 games, including reaching double figures in the first half in six of those contests. Uthoff has scored 20 or more five times this year, including a personal-best 32, including 30 in the first half, at fourth-ranked Iowa State.

Uthoff ranks first on the team in scoring (18.2), blocks (2.6) and 3-pointers (20), and is second in rebounding (6.4). His 2.6 blocks per game ranks 22nd best in the nation.





EXPERIENCED BACKCOURT

Iowa has two senior point guards (Mike Gesell and Anthony Clemmons) and a junior shooting guard (Peter Jok) on this year's roster.

Clemmons, who has started 35 of 114 games, was named the team's Most Improved Player last spring after leading the team in 3-point accuracy (.373) and posting single-season bests in rebounding, steals, scoring, and free throw percentage in 2014-15. Clemmons is averaging 8.4 points and 4.4 assists this season.

Gesell is a four-year starter, who has 881 points, 422 assists, and 131 steals. He is 59 assists from tying Ronnie Lester (480) for fifth.

FRESH START

Peter Jok made his first start of his career on Dec. 22, 2014, versus North Florida. The native of West Des Moines, Iowa, started 21 of the last 22 games last year.

Jok started 2015 with a new number, changing from No. 3 last year to No. 14 this season.

Jok averaged seven points per game in 2014-15, which ranked fifth on the squad. His 36 triples in 2015 rank as the sixth most by a sophomore in lowa history. His 19 steals, 44 assists, 83 field goals and 36 treys last season were single season bests.

This season, Jok ranks second on the team in scoring (13.4 ppg) and is first in free throw accuracy (.857, 18-of-21). He has scored 20 or more points twice (20 at Marquette on Nov. 19 and a careerbest 24 vs. FSU on Dec. 2). In addition to netting 24 points against the Seminoles, Jok had a career-best four steals. The Hawkeye junior has scored in double figures six of the last eight outings.

MUSCLE GAIN

Last season, freshman Dom Uhl was listed a 6-foot-8 and 195 pounds. After a year in the weight room, the sophomore forward checks in a 6-foot-9 and 215 pounds entering this season. Uhl earned the team's Newcomer Award last year.

Uhl is averaging 16 minutes, 7.5 points, and 3.9 rebounds per game this year. He posted his first career double-double against UMKC with 14 points and a personal-high 10 boards. He followed up that performance with 15 points, four rebounds, and a careerhigh three blocks versus Western Illinois.

IOWA VS. RANKED TEAMS

The Hawkeyes were 4-6 against opponents ranked in either the Associated Press or USA Today Coaches polls last season.

lowa is 1-2 against ranked opponents this season. The Hawkeyes split their first two games versus ranked opponents at the Advocare Invitational in Orlando (Nov. 26-27). lowa fell to No. 17 Notre Dame (68-62), but overwhelmed No. 20 Wichita State (84-61). The Hawkeyes were edged at No. 2 lowa State, 83-82, on Dec. 10.

GESELL NOMINATED FOR GOOD WORKS TEAM

Senior Mike Gesell is a nominee for the 2016 Allstate NABC Good Works Team.

This prestigious community service award recognizes a distinguished group of student-athletes who have demonstrated a commitment to enriching the lives of others and contributing to the greater good in their communities.

College sports information directors and basketball coaches across the country nominated players who exhibit exceptional leadership skills and an unwavering commitment to volunteerism.

IN MEMORY ...

lowa's all-time leading scorer, Roy Marble, passed away on Sept. 11, 2015, at the age of 48. Marble led the Hawkeyes to four straight NCAA Tournament appearances, including advancing to the Elite Eight in 1987 and Sweet 16 in 1988, and led the team in scoring three consecutive seasons.

In memory of Marble, RM23 is stitched on the upper right corner of lowa's jerseys this season.

McCAFFERY'S HONORED WITH FIGHTING SPIRIT AWARD

The American Cancer Society honored Fran and Margaret McCaffery with the Fighting Spirit Award, Sept. 30, in Troy, New York, at the 10th Anniversary Coaches vs. Cancer Basket Ball. The McCaffery's were honored for bringing attention and their tremendous amount of fundraising for cancer research.

McCaffery was also honored with the Coaches vs. Cancer Champion Award during Final Four Weekend in Indianapolis last April.

The honor is awarded annually to a college coach who has been engaged vigorously in the Coaches vs. Cancer program's fundraising, education and promotional initiatives and has demonstrated leadership in the fight to save more lives from cancer.

The McCaffery's helped raise \$176,000 at October's cancer research fundraiser, which will benefit the Adolescent and Young Adult Program Fund in Johnson County. The McCaffery family committed \$22,000 this year and an additional \$10,000 per year for the duration of his contract at lowa.
