Quick Hits

- The Hawkeyes face their second ranked opponent in their first five games Wednesday when they play at No. 16 Colorado (winners of 26-straight nonconference regular season games). Iowa defeated No. 14 Dayton, 97-93, in overtime Nov. 10, for its eighth victory over a ranked opponent since the start of last season. The Hawkeyes tied the record for wins over ranked opponents in a single season last year (seven).
- lowa limited Arkansas-Pine Bluff to 38 points on Nov. 13, the fewest total for an opponent in 19 years. The Hawkeyes then limited Stony Brook to 40 points on Nov. 17.
- lowa is averaging 80.2 points and 20.8 assists per contest. lowa leads the Big Ten in assists. Five Hawkeyes are averaging double figures (points).
- In the win against No. 14 Dayton on Nov. 10, lowa registered 30 assists as a team, one shy of the school record.
- Samantha Logic is eighth in career assists (384). She needs four more assists to move past Franthea Price for seventh place.
- Melissa Dixon ranks 10th in career 3-pointers (119). She needs seven more 3-pointers to move past Johanna Solverson for ninth place.
- lowa is the only Big Ten team, and one of only 13 teams in the country, to have appeared in the last six NCAA
 Tournaments
- Lisa Bluder needs 15 wins to surpass Hall of Famer C. Vivian Stringer (269 wins) as lowa's all-time winningest
 coach. Bluder is one of 13 active Division I coaches with 600 or more wins.

THE SETTING:

The University of Iowa women's basketball team (4-0) hits the road for the first time this season, playing at No. 16 Colorado (2-0) on Wednesday night. Tip-off is set for 9:30 p.m. (CT) at the Coors Events Center at Boulder, Colo.

ALL-TIME SERIES:

Colorado leads the all-time series, 2-1. The Buffaloes won the last meeting, 92-83, during the 2001-02 season in Boulder. Iowa won the previous year in Iowa City, 92-66. Colorado claimed the first meeting at a neutral site during the 1992-93 season, 72-70.

AUDIO COVERAGE:

Brent Balbinot and Shelley Till will call the action for the Hawkeye Radio Network. Hawkeye fans can listen to the contest on AM-800 KXIC in Iowa City, AM-1360 KMJM in Cedar Rapids, AM-1040 WHO in Des Moines or on the Hawkeye All-Access page of hawkeyesports.com. Balbinot is in his 10th season as Iowa's play-by-play voice, while Till is in her ninth providing analysis.

TELEVISION:

Wednesday night's game will be televised live on the Pac-12 Mountain Network. Anne Marie Anderson and Ros Gold-Onwude will have the call.

FOLLOW THE ACTION:

Hawkeye fans can also follow the action via live stats. The link can be accessed on the women's basketball schedule page.

IOWA HISTORY:

lowa has played 1,136 games since beginning basketball in 1974. lowa's overall record is 696-440 (.612). That includes a 348-178 (.662) mark in regular season Big Ten contests and a 339-97 (.776) mark in Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

IOWA IN THE RANKINGS:

The Hawkeyes are the first team listed receiving votes in the AP Top 25 Poll and the USA Today Coaches Poll. Seven Iowa opponents are also ranked in the Associated Press/USA Today polls: Nebraska (11/10), Penn State (14/15), Colorado (16/20), Purdue, (18/22), Michigan State (21/19), Iowa State (22/16) and Dayton (RV/24). In addition, Ohio State is receiving votes.

SCOUTING COLORADO:

Colorado is 2-0, defeating Colorado State on the road, 63-59, and Alcorn State in its home opener, 83-33. The Buffaloes are allowing 46 points per game and averaging 73. Colorado has not allowed an opponent to reach 70 points in its last 34 contests.

The Buffaloes have won 26-straight nonconference regular season games. Colorado finished the last two seasons with 11-0 nonconference marks.

Colorado is coached by Linda Lappe. Lappe, in her fourth year at Colorado, has never faced lowa. She was a player at Colorado from 1998-2003, and served as an assistant coach at Drake from 2003 to 2006.

The Buffaloes finished 25-7 last season, with a 13-5 mark in the Pac-12 in their second year in the league. Colorado was picked to finish third in the Pac-12 this season.

BIG TEN RANKINGS:

lowa, one of two 4-0 teams in the Big Ten, leads the conference in assists (20.8/game) and assist/turnover ratio (1.4). The Hawkeyes are second in scoring margin (+23.5), field goal percentage defense (.293), and blocks (7.8/game). lowa ranks third in offensive rebounds (14.8), defensive rebounds (32.2), and 3-pointers per game (6.8).

lowa captains are senior Theairra Taylor and junior Samantha Logic.

BALANCED ATTACK

Five Hawkeyes are averaging double figures: Bethany Doolittle (14.0 ppg), Ally Disterhoft (13.8), Samantha Logic (13.0), Melissa Dixon (11.0), and Theairra Taylor (10.5). Iowa has had different leading scorers in every game this season (Disterhoft has been leading scorer twice, once equaled the top scoring output.

Six Hawkeyes scored in double figures in lowa's overtime win against No. 14 Dayton, and lowa has had three players score in double figures in each of the last two contests.

HAWKEYES LIMIT STONY BROOK:

lowa improved to 4-0 by limiting Stony Brook to 18.6-percent shooting from the field and 6.7-percent from 3-point range during a 78-40 victory on Mediacom Court inside Carver-Hawkeye Arena on Nov. 17. Four days after holding Arkansas-Pine Bluff to 38 points, the Hawkeyes held Stony Brook to 21 points in the first half and 19 in the second.

lowa shot 43.8-percent for the game (28-of-64) with five 3-pointers in 28 attempts. The Hawkeyes maintained huge advantages in bench points (33-11), paint points (38-18), and points off turnovers (22-8). Iowa outscored Stony Brook by 23 points in the second half (42-19).

Ten Hawkeyes saw action and 10 Hawkeyes found the scoring column. Iowa's leading scorer and rebounder came off the bench in freshman Ally Disterhoft. She scored 17 points on 6-of-8 shooting from the field (2-of-3 from 3-point), with nine rebounds, two steals and two blocks in 28 minutes.

FEWEST POINTS ALLOWED IN 19 YEARS:

The Hawkeyes sprinted to an 11-0 lead, outscored Arkansas-Pine Bluff 20-0 in fast break points, and cruised to a 76-38 win on Wednesday night inside Carver-Hawkeye Arena. It marked the fewest points allowed by Iowa since it defeated Michigan 53-36 on Dec. 30, 1994.

Three Hawkeyes scored in double figures with juniors Bethany Doolittle and Melissa Dixon sharing game high honors with 17. Freshman Ally Disterhoft played 23 minutes and scored 12 points with nine rebounds and four assists.

Three other Hawkeyes logged career highs in minutes played: sophomore Claire Till (25), and freshmen Alexa Kastanek (21) and Hailey Schneden (six). Eight of the 10 lowa players saw 20 or more minutes of action.

HAWKEYES TOP DAYTON IN OVERTIME:

The Hawkeyes defeated No. 14 Dayton on Nov. 10 in overtime, 97-93, to win the Hawkeye Challenge. Iowa equaled its high point total from a year ago, when it defeated Missouri State, 97-43, on Dec. 19 -- 97 points equals the seventh-highest total in a game in school history (106 is most).

lowa led by double digits in both halves, then overcame a five-point deficit with 32 seconds to play, before winning in overtime.

Samantha Logic (tournament MVP), Bethany Doolittle, and Kali Peschel were named to the all-tournament team, as six Hawkeyes scored in double figures.

Logic recorded her 13th career double-double (16 points, 14 assists).

Doolittle notched a career-best six blocks, moving into a tie for seventh all-time in program history with 86 career blocks. The center also netted a team high and career best 22 points.

Peschel recorded her first career double-double, posting career highs in points (12) and rebounds (14). She has grabbed double-digit rebounds in lowa's first two contests (11 vs. UC Riverside).

Freshman Ally Disterhoft netted 19 points off the bench. Melissa Dixon (13 points) and Theairra Taylor (10) also scored in double figures.

IOWA CONTINUES TREND AGAINST RANKED FOES:

The Hawkeyes have recorded at least one win against a top-25 team in all but two seasons under Bluder. In 10 of those seasons, lowa has knocked off at least one top-15 opponent. lowa defeated No. 11 Purdue and No. 12 West Virginia last year, when it tied a single-season record with seven victories over ranked foes.

CLIMBING TO THE TOP:

Lisa Bluder needs 15 wins to surpass Hall of Famer C. Vivian Stringer (269 wins) as lowa's all-time winningest coach. Bluder is 254-157 all-time as the Hawkeye head coach.

Head Coach Lisa Bluder

Lisa Bluder (pronounced BLUE-dir) is in her 14th season as head coach at the University of Iowa and her 30th season as a college head coach. She is a three-time Big Ten and two-time WBCA Regional Coach of the Year.

Bluder has a career record of 611-299 (.671), including a 255-157 (.619) record at lowa, a 187-106 (.638) record in 10 seasons (1990-2000) at Drake and a six-year mark (1984-90) of 169-36 (.824) at St. Ambrose.



Bluder is lowa's second all-time winningest coach and trails only C. Vivian Stringer (269 wins). She has guided the Hawkeyes to 12 postseason tournaments (10 NCAA, 2 WNIT) and nine upper-division finishes in the Big Ten Conference, including winning a share of the league championship in 2008 and taking home the conference tournament title in 2001.

In her first season with the Hawkeyes, Bluder transformed a struggling program into a 21-game winner. Iowa finished second in the Big Ten, won the conference tournament and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament. Bluder became Iowa's third coach to be named Big Ten Coach of the Year. She was also honored as the College Coach of the Year by the Women's Basketball News Service and was named the WBCA District 6 Coach of the Year. Iowa's 2001-02 squad finished fourth in the Big Ten and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament for the second consecutive year. In 2003, Bluder guided the Hawkeyes to their first-ever WNIT appearance. Iowa, which had nine underclassmen on its roster, advanced to the quarterfinals before falling to Creighton. In 2004-05, Iowa finished 23-10, starting the year 13-0 and was the last Division I undefeated team standing. In 2005-06, Bluder mentored a team plagued by injuries to a fifth-place Big Ten finish and an NCAA Tournament berth.

In her 10 years at Drake, Bluder brought great success and tradition to the Bulldog program and established herself as one of the top coaches in the country. She led Drake to five 20-plus win seasons in her last six years, including five post-season appearances. She guided the Bulldogs to eight Missouri Valley Conference Tournament appearances, reaching the semifinals six times and winning the tournament four times. Bluder was also named the Conference Coach of the Year three times at Drake.

Bluder began her coaching career at St. Ambrose, where she coached six successful seasons, building the Bees into a NAIA powerhouse. During her tenure at St. Ambrose, Bluder guided the Bees to four straight national tournaments, including two consecutive Final Four appearances. The 1990 St. Ambrose team was ranked No. 1 and Bluder was named the NAIA Converse Coach of the Year.

A graduate of Linn-Mar High School in Marion, lowa, Bluder was a three-year starter at Northern Iowa. She graduated from UNI in 1983 with a bachelor's degree in marketing.

LOGIC NAMED B1G PLAYER OF THE WEEK:

Junior guard Samantha Logic was named Big Ten Player of Week on Nov. 12 for her efforts in lowa's wins against UC Riverside and No. 14 Dayton last week.

Logic (5-foot-9) was named tournament MVP of the Hawkeye Challenge after averaging 22 points, 9.5 assists, 6.0 rebounds, and 3.0 steals, leading lowa to the team title. She went 4-of-5 from 3-point range and made 10-of-12 free throws.

In the season-opening victory against UC Riverside on Nov. 8, Logic netted a career-best and game-high 28 points. She added seven rebounds, five assists and three steals.

The Racine, Wis., native recorded her 13th career double-double (16 points, 14 assists) on Nov. 10, leading the Hawkeyes to a 97-93 overtime victory against the Flyers. Logic hit the game-tying 3-pointer with nine seconds remaining in regulation to send the game into overtime. The 14 assists equaled a personal best and lowa school record, and are the most in Carver-Hawkeye Arena history. The previous high was 12 (three times).

Logic, 1-of-2 conference juniors named preseason All-Big Ten, has seven career games with double-digit assists, the second most in lowa history. Cara Consuegra had nine games in her career with 10 or more assists. Logic moved into eighth place on lowa's all-time assists list, passing Steph Schueler (367). Logic has 372 career assists.

The award marked Logic's third career Player of the Week honor. Jaime Printy was the last Hawkeye to garner the weekly honor (Jan. 29, 2013).

LOGIC NAMED PRESEASON ALL-BIG TEN:

Junior Samantha Logic was named Preseason All-Big Ten by league media, the conference office announced Thursday. Logic, a junior from Racine, Wis., started all 34 games last season and was a third team All-Big Ten selection. The 5-foot-9 guard set school records for single-season assists (217) and single-game assists (14 vs. Texas, Dec. 28). Logic tallied five double-doubles, and led the Big Ten and ranked 15th in the NCAA in assists per game (6.4).

NCAA STREAK LEADS THE BIG TEN:

lowa is the only Big Ten team, and one of only 13 teams in the country, to have appeared in the last six NCAA Tournaments.

SUCCESS UNDER BLUDER:

Last season marked the 10th time in 13 seasons under head coach Lisa Bluder -- one of 13 active Division I coaches with 600 or more wins -- that lowa has been selected for the NCAA Tournament, including each of the last six seasons. The Hawkeyes have participated in postseason play in all but one season under Bluder (two WNIT appearances).

It also marked the seventh time in Bluder's 13 seasons that the Hawkeyes reached 20 wins. lowa has collected 20 or more wins in five of the last six years. In addition, lowa finished with a winning record for the 12th time in 13 seasons under Bluder.

IOWA SELECTED TO HOST NCAA 1ST AND 2ND ROUNDS:

The University of Iowa and Carver-Hawkeye Arena have been selected by the NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Committee to serve as one of 16 hosts for the first and second rounds of the 2014 NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Championship. Iowa is 1-of-8 schools chosen to host first/second round games for the second-straight year.

The 2014 NCAA Championship will mark the 13th time the University of lowa has served as a host. Iowa hosted its first NCAA action in 1986 when it was one of four regional final sites. Carver-Hawkeye Arena also hosted from 1986-90, 1992-94, 1996-98 and in 2009 and 2013. Carver-Hawkeye Arena has hosted the regional finals four times and first and/or second round games 11 times.

lowa hosted first and second round games in 2009. Despite having late afternoon and evening games on a Sunday in March of 2009, lowa's site recorded the fourth-highest first round attendance (5,615).

In 2013, the first round of the lowa City Regional drew 6,836 fans, which was the third-best attended site among the 16 host sites. In addition, lowa City had the sixth-best figure for second round games (4,942) and the fifth-highest total attendance (11,778).

BLUDER GETS WIN NO. 600:

Head coach Lisa Bluder became the 42nd coach in NCAA women's basketball history (all divisions) and only the 25th Division I head coach (minimum 10 years at a DI school) to collect 600 wins Jan. 20 vs. Purdue.

Bluder is one of 13 active Division I coaches with 600 or more wins.

RETURNING ALL-BIG TEN HONOREES:

Two Hawkeyes that earned Big Ten honors last year return in 2013-14:

- Sophomore Melissa Dixon was named Big Ten Sixth Player of the Year. She is the second Hawkeye in school history to earn the award (Megan Skouby, 2008).
- Sophomore Samantha Logic was a third team All-Big Ten selection by the media and an honorable mention pick by the coaches. She was a unanimous selection to the Big Ten All-Freshman Team in 2012.

ANOTHER TOP ATTENDANCE YEAR:

lowa ranked 19th in the country in attendance in 2013, averaging 4,567 fans per contest, marking the third-straight season that lowa has ranked inside the top 20 in attendance.

GOLDWIRE JOINS HAWKEYE STAFF:

Lacey Goldwire joined the UI coaching staff in August, after spending the 2012-13 season as an assistant coach at Morehead State. Prior to joining the Eagles' staff, Goldwire served on the Oklahoma State staff for four seasons -- two as a student assistant and two as a graduate assistant

Following Oklahoma State's tragic loss of its head and assistant coach during a plane crash in November of 2011, Goldwire was elevated to interim assistant coach where she took on added recruiting duties. During her time with the program, the Cowgirls won 80 games and advanced to the postseason all four years, winning the 2012 WNIT championship.

Goldwire, an Oklahoma City native, played collegiately at East Central (Okla.) University where she ranks fifth in career scoring with 1,340 points. Goldwire, an all-state and all-city player at Del City (Okla.)  previous record of 514 was set in 2011-12. lowa finished with 531 assists. lowa finished second in
 the Big Ten and 26th in the NCAA with 15.7 assists per game. lowa recorded at least 17 assists in 15
 games, including five games with 20 or more.

LOGIC BREAKS ASSIST RECORD:

- Samantha Logic recorded her 13th career double-double (16 points, 14 assists) on Nov. 10, leading the Hawkeyes to a 97-93 overtime victory against No. 14 Dayton. Logic hit the game-tying 3-pointer with nine seconds remaining in regulation to send the game into overtime. The 14 assists equaled a personal best and lowa school record, and are the most in Carver-Hawkeye Arena history. The previous high was 12 (three times)
- Logic became lowa's single-season assist record holder a year ago, breaking the mark in lowa's win at Northwestern (March 3). Logic entered the game tied with Cara Consuegra (2000-01) at 191 assists. Logic collected seven assists at Northwestern and finished with 217.
- Last season, Logic led the Big Ten and ranked 15th in the NCAA with 6.4 assists per game.
- Logic recorded seven or more assists in 15 games, including four games with 10 or more. She
 had at least five assists in 24 games.
- Logic's seven games with double digit assists are the second most in lowa history. Cara Consuegra
 had nine games in her career with 10 or more assists. The next closest Hawkeyes on the list
 are Kachine Alexander, Jolette Law and Michelle Edwards, with two career games.

<u>UP NEXT:</u>

The Hawkeyes' next five games will be away from lowa City. Following the game at Colorado, lowa heads to Cedar Falls to face UNI on Sunday (2 p.m. CT). The Hawkeyes then take on USC, Boston College and UNC-Wilmington in the Cancun Challenge, Nov. 28-30.
