Balbinot is in his seventh season as Iowa's play-by-play voice, while Till is in her sixth providing analysis.

### IOWA HISTORY

## WIN NO. 300 AT HOME

The UI women's basketball program picked up victory No. 300 inside Carver-Hawkeye Arena with a 90-79 win over Central Michigan Nov. 21. The Hawkeyes have compiled a 306-88 (.777) record inside their home venue since it opened in 1983.

## SCOUTING PURDUE

The Purdue Boilermakers are 15-7 overall and 5-4 in Big Ten play.

In their last game, the Boilermakers defeated Indiana, 71-57 at Mackey Arena. Four plays scored double figures, led by Courtney Moses' 23 points. Drey Mingo added 16 points and seven rebounds, while Brittany Rayburn added 17 points, four assists and six steals. Alex Guyton chipped in 11 points. Purdue's defense limited Indiana to just. 364 from the field.

Rayburn leads the team with 13.6 points per game, followed by Moses at 12.9 points per game. Mingo is the team's top rebounder at 5.2 boards per contest, along with 10.3 points.

As a team, the Boilermakers are shooting .423 (500-1,183) from the field, including .323 (96-297) from three-point distance.

## IOWA VS. PURDUE NOTES

- Thursday is the 58th meeting between Iowa and Purdue, with the Boilermakers holding a 33-25 advantage in the all-time series. Purdue has won 14 of the last 17 contests, but the Hawkeyes won the last meeting (70-50 in Iowa City last season). Iowa is 9-18 in games played in West Lafayette and have lost the last 10 meetings on the road. Iowa's last win in West Lafayette was Feb. 6, 1998 (73-67).
- Iowa and Purdue both played South Dakota State during the non-conference portion of the schedule. Purdue defeated the Jackrabbits, 73-40 at Mackey Arena. Iowa defeated South Dakota State, 65-54, in Brookings, SD.

## LAST MEETING

Iowa defeated Purdue, 70-50, inside Carver-Hawkeye Arena Jan. 31, 2010.

The Hawkeyes avenged an earlier 21-point loss at Purdue by jumping out to a 19-1 lead. Iowa never trailed in the game, and held a 13-point halftime lead. The Hawkeyes fought off a Boilermaker surge in the second half to win its third-straight Big Ten contest.

Five Hawkeyes scored double figures, including Morgan Johnson and Kachine Alexander, who each scored 16 points. Both players ended with double-doubles, with Johnson grabbing 11 boards and Alexander finishing with 10. Jaime Printy added 12 points, while Kamille Wahlin and Gabby Machado each had 11.

Purdue's Brittany Rayburn scored 15 points, while Jode Howell finished with 11 points.

## ***2010-11 Team Captains***

Iowa captains are senior Kelsey Cermak and junior Kamille Wahlin.

### **DOUBLE-DOUBLE TIMES TWO**

In Iowa's win against Purdue (Jan. 31, 2010), both Morgan Johnson and Kachine Alexander recorded double-doubles.

The last time Iowa had two players record double-doubles in the same game was Feb. 19, 2005, in Iowa's 78-59 win at Michigan. Johanna Solverson finished with 18 points and 10 assists, while Jamie Cavey had 19 points and 14 rebounds.

The last time Iowa had two players record double-doubles with points and rebounds was Dec. 10, 2004, in Iowa's 91-82 win at Creighton. Krista VandeVenter had 19 points and 14 rebounds, while Jamie Cavey had 20 points and 10 rebounds.

### **IOWA IN THE RANKINGS**

The Hawkeyes are ranked No. 20 in the AP poll and No. 22 in the ESPN/USA Today poll.

Three Iowa opponents are also ranked in the AP poll: Michigan State (11th/T-15th), North Carolina (15th/12th) and Iowa State (22nd/20th).

Penn State, Ohio State and Kansas State are receiving votes.

Iowa is also ranked 12th in the latest RPI released by the NCAA, which is the highest mark for a Big Ten school. The Hawkeyes also rank 11th in the nation in attendance, bringing in an average of 6,224 fans to Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

### **HAWKEYES PICK UP ROAD WIN AT ILLINOIS**

Iowa knocked off Illinois in Champaign (Jan. 30), 80-69.

Iowa led for most of the first half, but a 14-2 run by Illinois gave the Fighting Illini the lead with 4:25 left in the first half. Iowa took a one-point lead into halftime and held on through the second half to earn the win.

Five players scored double figures for Iowa, led by Kachine Alexander's 19 points. Morgan Johnson added 17 points and 13 rebounds, while Jaime Printy scored 15 points and had five assists. Kamille Wahlin chipped in 13 points and Kelly Krei had 11.

### **SHOOTING LIGHTS OUT**

Iowa's shooting percentage of .521 (25-48) and three-point percentage of .667 (8-12) against Illinois (Jan. 30) were both season-highs. The Hawkeyes were a perfect 5-5 from three-point range in the second half against the Fighting Illini.

### **FINDING THEIR SHOT**

As a team, Iowa put up some impressive shooting numbers last week.

The Hawkeyes shot a combined .510 (49-96) from the field in games vs. Michigan State and Illinois. Iowa finished .560 (14-25) from beyond the three-point arc.

Morgan Johnson shot .750 (9-12) in those two games, and Kachine Alexander finished with a .609 (14-23) shooting percentage.

### **WAHLIN CLOSE TO 1,000**

Kamille Wahlin needs just 23 more points to become the 28th player in Iowa history to record 1,000 career points. She currently has 977 career points.

## ***Head Coach Lisa Bluder***

Lisa Bluder (pronounced BLUE-dir) is in her 11th season as head coach at the University of Iowa and her 27th season as a college head coach. She is a three-time Big Ten and two-time WBCA Regional Coach of the Year.

Bluder, 47, has a career record of 562-270 (.675), including a 206-128 (.617) record at Iowa, a 187-106 (.638) record in 10 seasons (1990-2000) at Drake and a six-year mark (1984-90) of 169-36 (.824) at St. Ambrose.

Bluder is Iowa's second all-time winningest coach and trails only C. Vivian Stringer. She has guided the Hawkeyes to nine post-season tournaments (7 NCAA, 2 WNIT) and seven upper-division finishes in the Big Ten Conference, including winning a share of the league championship in 2008 and tying for second place in 2009.

In her first season with the Hawkeyes, Bluder transformed a struggling program into a 21-game winner. Iowa finished second in the Big Ten, won the conference tournament and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament. Bluder became Iowa's third coach to be named Big Ten Coach of the Year. She was also honored as the College Coach of the Year by the *Women's Basketball News Service* and was named the WBCA District 6 Coach of the Year. Iowa's 2001-02 squad finished fourth in the Big Ten and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament for the second consecutive year. In 2003, Bluder guided the Hawkeyes to their first-ever WNIT appearance. Iowa, which had nine underclassmen on its roster, advanced to the quarterfinals before falling to Creighton. In 2004-05, Iowa finished 23-10, starting the year 13-0 and was the last Division I undefeated team standing. In 2005-06, Bluder mentored a team plagued by injuries to a fifth-place Big Ten finish and an NCAA Tournament berth.

In her 10 years at Drake, Bluder brought great success and tradition to the Bulldog program and established herself as one of the top coaches in the country. She led Drake to five 20-plus win seasons in her last six years, including five post-season appearances. She guided the Bulldogs to eight Missouri Valley Conference Tournament appearances, reaching the semifinals six times and winning the tournament four times. Bluder was also named the Conference Coach of the Year three times at Drake.

Bluder began her coaching career at St. Ambrose, where she coached six successful seasons, building the Bees into a NAIA powerhouse. During her tenure at St. Ambrose, Bluder guided the Bees to four straight national tournaments, including two consecutive Final Four appearances. The 1990 St. Ambrose team was ranked No. 1 and Bluder was named the NAIA Converse Coach of the Year.

A graduate of Linn-Mar High School in Marion, IA, Bluder was a three-year starter at Northern Iowa. She graduated from UNI in 1983 with a bachelor's degree in marketing.

### **MORE MILESTONES FOR ALEXANDER**

- If Kachine Alexander records two more assists, she would be the first player in Iowa history and just the fifth in Big Ten history, to have 1,000 career points, 800 career rebounds and 300 career assists. The other Big Ten players to hit the milestone were Wisconsin guard Jolene Anderson, Minnesota center Janel McCarville, and Illinois forwards Lacey Simpson and Tajua Catchings.
- With 11 rebounds at Ohio State (Jan. 24), Alexander became just the sixth player in school history, and the first-ever guard, to collect 800 career rebounds.
- Alexander is the sixth player in school history to have 1,000 career points and 800 career rebounds.

### **PRINTY AGAINST RANKED OPPONENTS**

Iowa has played in six games against opponents ranked in the top 25 this year, and Jaime Printy's numbers in those games have been impressive.

Printy is averaging 15.5 points, 4.7 rebounds and 4.2 assists in Iowa's games against ranked opponents (North Carolina, Iowa State, Ohio State twice and Michigan State twice). Printy is shooting .448 (30-67) from the field, including .458 (11-24) from three-point distance and .917 (22-24) from the free throw line against ranked foes.

### **PRINTY HAS A BIG WEEK**

Jaime Printy averaged 20.5 points and 7.5 rebounds in Iowa's two games at Michigan State (Jan. 13) and at home vs. Indiana (Jan. 16).

Printy shot a combined .571 (12-21) from the field, including .700 (7-10) from three-point distance, while only missing one free throw (10-11, .909).

Printy started the week with 23 points, seven rebounds, two assists and three steals in Iowa's buzzer-beater loss at Michigan State, scoring 18 of Iowa's 28 first half points.

She followed with a game-high 18 points on 5-10 shooting, including 3-6 from beyond the arc, and eight rebounds in Iowa's 20-point victory over Indiana.

### **NINE IN A ROW FROM DOWNTOWN**

Jaime Printy buried nine-straight three-pointers, starting with Iowa's game at Minnesota (Jan. 5). Printy made her last three-point attempt at Minnesota, was a perfect 2-2 against Ohio State (Jan. 8), a perfect 4-4 at Michigan State (Jan. 13) and made her first two attempts vs. Indiana (Jan. 16) before missing a long-distance shot.

### **SEEING DOUBLE**

Kachine Alexander recorded her sixth double-double of the season against Michigan State (Jan. 27), finishing with 23 points and 11 rebounds.

Alexander now has 30 career double-doubles, which is five shy of Lisa Long's school record for double-doubles (35, set from 1983-87).

Last season, Alexander finished with 15 double-doubles, which was one shy of tying Amy Herrig's record for single-season double-doubles.

Alexander tallied nine double-doubles as a sophomore.

### **KASH GETS A GRAND**

With a layup at the 11:54 mark in the first half against Minnesota (Jan. 5), senior Kachine Alexander became the 27th player in school history to record 1,000 career points.

Alexander currently ranks 24th in career scoring at Iowa with 1,103 points.

### **DOUBLE TROUBLE**

Morgan Johnson recorded her sixth double-double of the season and the ninth double-double of her career against Illinois (Jan. 30). Johnson finished the game with 17 points and 13 rebounds.

### **JOHNSON AT .500 OR BETTER**

When Morgan Johnson takes eight or more shots in a game, chances are she will make at least half of them.

Johnson has attempted eight or more shots in 16 of Iowa's 22 games this year. In those 15 games, Johnson has shot .500 or better 11 times, including a 7-9 (.778) shooting performance at Illinois (Jan. 30).

Johnson has attempted 10 or more shots eight times, shooting .500 or better in all but two games. Johnson was 8-13 (.615) against Northeastern, 10-16 (.625) against Central Michigan, 8-11 (.727) vs. Iowa State, 9-12 (.750) vs. South Dakota State, 5-10 (.500) vs. Michigan and vs. Ohio State and 7-12 (.583) at Ohio State.

She was 2-12 (.167) vs. James Madison and 4-12 (.333) at Minnesota.

### **JOHNSON FILLING UP THE STAT SHEET**

Morgan Johnson scored double figures over a tough four game-stretch, including double-doubles in two of those four contests.

Johnson tallied a double-double with 16 points and 13 rebounds at No. 14 North Carolina Dec. 2. She followed with 13 points and six rebounds against Kansas State and recorded another double-double with 16 points and 10 rebounds against No. 15 Iowa State. Johnson had a career-high 26 points at South Dakota State, including the first 11 points of the contest.

Over the four-game stretch, Johnson averaged 17 points, nine rebounds, shot .707 (29-41) from the field and blocked 13 shots.

### **BALANCED SCORING ATTACK**

Iowa is one of only three teams in the Big Ten to have four players ranked among the top 30 scorers in the conference.

Iowa, Ohio State, and Northwestern have four players ranked. Penn State, Wisconsin and Purdue have three ranked, while the remaining five schools have either one or two players ranked.

The Hawkeyes have had at least three players reach double figures in scoring in 19 of the 22 games this year. Five players scored 10 or more points against Bradley and at Illinois. Four players hit double digits against Northeastern, Central Michigan, Kansas State, Minnesota and in both games vs. Ohio State.

### **HAWKEYES HITTING THE BOARDS**

Iowa's rebounding numbers are impressive. The Hawkeyes lead the Big Ten in total rebounding (41.9 per game) and rank second in defensive rebounding (28.1 per game) and third in both offensive rebounding (13.8 per game) and rebounding margin (+5.1).

Kachine Alexander and Morgan Johnson are both tied for third in the league in offensive rebounding (3.3 per game). Alexander is also tied for third in offensive rebounding (9.2 per game). Alexander's 18 rebounds against Central Michigan, Nov. 21, are the third most for any Big Ten player this season.

### REBOUNDING NUMBERS IMPROVED FROM A YEAR AGO

Iowa's rebounding has improved greatly from a year ago.

Through 22 games last year, Iowa had a +0.7 rebound margin. The Hawkeyes held just a slim, 840-825 advantage on the boards, and had a 266-269 deficit on the offensive glass.

This year through 22 games, Iowa holds a +5.1 rebounding margin and is outrebounding opponents 922-809. That includes a 303-279 advantage on the offensive glass.

### MOVING UP CAREER CHARTS

Four Hawkeyes are currently working their way up the career records lists at Iowa.

- Kachine Alexander ranks second in career double-doubles (30), sixth in career rebounding (818), 10th in career assists (298) and 23rd in career scoring (1,103). She needs 10 more rebounds to move past Jennie Lillis for fifth place on the rebounding list and 25 assists to move past Lisa Anderson for ninth on the assists list. She needs six more double-doubles to take over first place (Lisa Long, 35).
- Morgan Johnson ranks fourth in career blocks (133) and needs 13 more to move past Toni Foster into third place.
- Kamille Wahlin ranks fifth in career three-pointers made (149) and 27th in career scoring (977). She needs eight more three-pointers to move past Leah Magner into fourth place.
- Jaime Printy ranks seventh in career three-pointers made (131) and needs eight more to move past Kristi Faulkner for sixth place.

### BLUDER REACHES MILESTONE

With a 75-71 win at Drake Dec. 20, Iowa Head Coach Lisa Bluder became only the second coach in school history to reach the 200-win milestone.

Bluder currently has 204 wins in her 11 years at Iowa. C. Vivian Stringer is the only other Hawkeye head coach to reach the 200-win plateau at Iowa, finishing her time in Iowa City with 269 wins.

Ohio State Head Coach Jim Foster is the only other active Big Ten coach to have reached 200 wins at his/her current school.

### ALEXANDER NAMED CO-BIG TEN PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Kachine Alexander was named co-Big Ten Player of the Week, Nov. 22, for her efforts against Bradley, Northeastern and Central Michigan. Alexander shared the weekly honor with Northwestern's Amy Jaeschke.

Alexander collected double-doubles in each of Iowa's three games and earned MVP honors at the KCRG-TV9 Hawkeye Challenge.

Alexander's first double-double of the season came against Bradley, recording 14 points and 10 rebounds. Alexander was 8-10 from the free throw line and also had five assists and three steals.

Alexander started the KCRG-TV9 Hawkeye Challenge with 21 points and 12 rebounds in a win over Northeastern, adding six assists, two steals and a block.

She wrapped up the tournament MVP award with 20 points and 18 rebounds against Central Michigan in the championship.

Alexander has now been named Big Ten Player of the Week five times in her career. She was a two-time award winner as both a sophomore and junior.

### **ALEXANDER MAKES FIRST CUT FOR WOODEN AWARD - ON WATCH LISTS FOR OTHERS**

Senior Kachine Alexander was one of 20 players to be named to the Wooden Award Top 20 Midseason List Jan 11. She is also on watch lists for the Wade Trophy and the Naismith Trophy. The "Wade Watch" List is made up of the top 25 preseason women's basketball players and the Naismith Trophy watch list is made up of 50 players.

The Wade Trophy, Wooden Award and Naismith Trophy are considered the three most prestigious awards in NCAA women's college basketball.

### **SUCCESS UNDER BLUDER**

Last year marked the seventh time in 10 seasons under Head Coach Lisa Bluder that Iowa has been selected for the NCAA Tournament, including each of the last three seasons. The Hawkeyes have participated in postseason play in all but one season under Bluder (two WNIT appearances).

In addition, Iowa finished with a winning record for the ninth time in 10 seasons under Bluder. Iowa's third place finish in the Big Ten is also the seventh time under Bluder the Hawkeyes recorded an upper-division finish in the conference.

Iowa also tallied its fifth 20-win season under Bluder, including each of the last three seasons.

### **AWARD WINNERS RETURNING**

Several Hawkeyes earned numerous awards during the 2009-10 season.

- Head Coach Lisa Bluder was named Big Ten Coach of the Year for the third time in 10 seasons at Iowa.
- Kachine Alexander was named honorable mention All-America by the Associated Press and the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA). Alexander was also selected All-Region by the WBCA. She also earned All-America honors by the National Strength and Conditioning Association (NSCA). Alexander was named first team all-Big Ten by the coaches, second team all-Big Ten by the media and was one of five players named to the Big Ten all-Defensive Team. She was also selected to the Big Ten Tournament all-tournament team, named the MVP of the KCRG-TV9 Hawkeye Challenge and was a two-time Big Ten Player of the Week.
- Jaime Printy was named Big Ten Freshman of the Year and was a unanimous pick for the Big Ten all-Freshmen team. Printy also earned second team all-conference honors from the media and third team all-league honors by the coaches. Printy was named Big Ten Freshman of the Week four times. She was named second team Freshman all-American by Full Court Press.

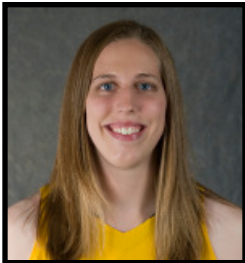
