IOWA HISTORY

lowa has played 1,052 games since beginning basketball in 1974. lowa's overall record is 643-410 (.611). That includes a 320-161 (.666) mark in regular season Big Ten contests and a 304-88 (.776) mark in Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

WIN NO. 300 AT HOME

The UI women's basketball program picked up victory No. 300 inside Carver-Hawkeye Arena with a 90-79 win over Central Michigan Nov. 21. The Hawkeyes have compiled a 304-88 (.776) record inside their home venue since it opened in 1983.

SCOUTING INDIANA

The Indiana Hoosiers are 8-89 overall and 2-3 in Big Ten play.

In their last game, Indiana was defeated at home by Illinois, 74-67. Hope Elam led Indiana with 19 points and seven rebounds. Jori Davis added 16 points, five rebounds and seven assists, while Alisha Goodwin chipped in 14 points.

Davis leads the team with 18.4 points and 6.5 rebounds per game, followed by Elam at 11.1 points per game. Whitney Lindsay is averaging 10.1 points per contest.

As a team, Indiana is shooting .381 (377-990) from the field, including .306 (113-369) from three-point distance.

INDIANA VS. IOWA NOTES

- Sunday is the 57th meeting between lowa and Indiana, with the Hawkeyes leading the series, 41-15. Iowa has won four of the last six meetings. The Hawkeyes have dominated the series at home and hold a 23-3 record against the Hoosiers in lowa City. lowa has won the last 13 home matchups against Indiana and 23 of the last 24. lowa's last loss at home to Indiana was Feb. 20, 1994.
- lowa sophomore Theairra Taylor and Indiana junior Georgie Jones are both from St. Paul, MN, and were high school teammates at St. Paul Central High School.
- Indiana Assistant Coach Nathan Altenhofen and Iowa Head Coach Lisa Bluder both spent time as head coach at St. Ambrose in Davenport, IA. Bluder began her coaching career at St. Ambrose, compiling a six-year record of 169-36 from 1984-1990. She led St. Ambrose to four straight national tournaments, including two consecutive Final Four appearances. The 1990 St. Ambrose team was ranked No. 1 and Bluder was named the NAIA Converse Coach of the Year. Altenhofen spent the previous three seasons at St. Ambrose and finished with a 73-25 mark. He led St. Ambrose to a Sweet 16 apperance in his first season.

LAST MEETING

lowa knocked off Indiana Feb. 25 in Iowa City, 76-64, to gain a season sweep over the Hoosiers.

lowa shrugged off a cold start from the field in the first 6:25 of the game, going just 2-12. The Hawkeyes heated up towards the end of the half, taking a six-point lead to the locker room and finishing the first period shooting .438 (14-32).

The Hawkeyes led by as many as 16 in the second half, but a tough Indiana team cut the lead to just three with 6:48 left. Clutch free throw shooting down the stretch sealed the win, as Iowa converted on all 10 attempts from the charity stripe in the final 6:08.

Morgan Johnson led the way with 18 points, while Jaime Printy netted 17. Kelly Krei added 14 points and 13 rebounds, while Kamille Wahlin chipped in 10 points.

PRINTY'S RECORD SETTING DAY VS. THE HOOSIERS

With 17 points against Indiana Feb. 25 last season, Jaime Printy became lowa's all-time freshman scoring leader. Printy passed Lisa Becker, who scored 416 points during the 1983-84 season. Printy finished her freshman campaign with 501 points.

KREI HAS CAREER NIGHT VS. INDIANA

Kelly Krei collected her first career double-double against Indiana Feb. 25, scoring 14 points and grabbing 13 rebounds.

IOWA IN THE RANKINGS

The Hawkeyes are ranked No. 16 in the AP poll and No. 20 in the ESPN/USA Today poll.

Four lowa opponents are also ranked in the AP and the ESPN/ USA Today polls: Michigan State (9/10), North Carolina (11/11), Iowa State (17/16) and Ohio State (24/24).

Michigan is receiving votes.

BUZZER BEATER SINKS HAWKEYES AT MICHIGAN STATE

Michigan State's Kalisha Keane hit a three-pointer with 0.5 seconds remaining to give the ninth-ranked Spartans a 63-60 win over lowa Jan. 13 in East Lansing.

lowa trailed by eight at 60-52 with 2:01 left in the game before scoring eight-straight points, capped by a three-pointer by Kamille Wahlin, to tie the game at 60 with 10 seconds remaining. Michigan State ended lowa's comeback with the buzzer-beating three-pointer.

Jaime Printy led Iowa with 23 points on 7-11 shooting from the field, including a perfect 4-4 from beyond the arc, and also had seven rebounds. Printy had 18 of Iowa's 28 first half points. Kamille Wahlin added 17 points, three rebounds and three assists.

POURING IN THE POINTS

Jaime Printy recorded her second-consecutive 20-point performance, and her fifth of the season, against Michigan State (Jan. 13).

Printy netted 20 or more points against Bradley (21), Kansas State (20), Northern Iowa (27), Ohio State (25) and Michigan State (23). She has scored 15 or more points in 11 of Iowa's 18 games.

The Marion, IA, native has led lowa in scoring in nine contests this season, including five of the last six outings.

Head Coach Lisa Bluder

Lisa Bluder (pronounced BLUE-dir) is in her 11th season as head coach at the University of Iowa and her 27th season as a college head coach. She is a three-time Big Ten and two-time WBCA Regional Coach of the Year.

Bluder, 47, has a career record of 559-269 (.675), including a 203-127 (.615) record at lowa, a 187-106 (.638) record in 10 seasons (1990-2000) at Drake and a six-year mark (1984-90) of 169-36 (.824) at St. Ambrose.



Bluder is Iowa's second all-time winningest coach and trails only C. Vivian Stringer. She has guided the Hawkeyes to nine post-season tournaments (7 NCAA, 2 WNIT) and seven upper-division finishes in the Big Ten Conference, including winning a share of the league championship in 2008 and tying for second place in 2009.

In her first season with the Hawkeyes, Bluder transformed a struggling program into a 21-game winner. Iowa finished second in the Big Ten, won the conference tournament and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament. Bluder became Iowa's third coach to be named Big Ten Coach of the Year. She was also honored as the College Coach of the Year by the *Women's Basketball News Service* and was named the WBCA District 6 Coach of the Year. Iowa's 2001-02 squad finished fourth in the Big Ten and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament for the second consecutive year. In 2003, Bluder guided the Hawkeyes to their first-ever WNIT appearance. Iowa, which had nine underclassmen on its roster, advanced to the quarterfinals before falling to Creighton. In 2004-05, Iowa finished 23-10, starting the year 13-0 and was the last Division I undefeated team standing. In 2005-06, Bluder mentored a team plagued by injuries to a fifth-place Big Ten finish and an NCAA Tournament berth.

In her 10 years at Drake, Bluder brought great success and tradition to the Bulldog program and established herself as one of the top coaches in the country. She led Drake to five 20-plus win seasons in her last six years, including five post-season appearances. She guided the Bulldogs to eight Missouri Valley Conference Tournament appearances, reaching the semifinals six times and winning the tournament four times. Bluder was also named the Conference Coach of the Year three times at Drake.

Bluder began her coaching career at St. Ambrose, where she coached six successful seasons, building the Bees into a NAIA powerhouse. During her tenure at St. Ambrose, Bluder guided the Bees to four straight national tournaments, including two consecutive Final Four appearances. The 1990 St. Ambrose team was ranked No. 1 and Bluder was named the NAIA Converse Coach of the Year.

A graduate of Linn-Mar High School in Marion, IA, Bluder was a three-year starter at Northern Iowa. She graduated from UNI in 1983 with a bachelor's degree in marketing.

PRINTY AGAINST RANKED OPPONENTS

lowa has played four teams ranked in the top 25 this year, and Jaime Printy's numbers in those games have been impressive.

Printy is averaging 17.5 points, 4.3 rebounds and five assists in lowa's games against ranked opponents (North Carolina, Iowa State, Ohio State and Michigan State). Printy is shooting .469 (23-49) from the field, including .500 (9-18) from three-point distance against ranked foes.

KASH GETS A GRAND

With a layup at the 11:54 mark in the first half against Minnesota (Jan. 5), senior Kachine Alexander became the 27th player in school history to record 1,000 career points.

Alexander is also the eighth player in school history to collect 1,000 career points and 700 career rebounds, and just the third in school history to record 1,000 career points, 700 career rebounds and 200 career assists.

If Alexander records 18 more assists, she would join Franthea Price as the only player in lowa history to have 1,000 career points, 700 career rebounds and 300 career assists.

SEEING DOUBLE

Kachine Alexander recorded her fourth double-double of the season against Ohio State (Jan. 8), finishing with 16 points and 13 rebounds.

Alexander now has 28 career double-doubles, which is seven shy of Lisa Long's school record for double-doubles (35, set from 1983-87).

Last season, Alexander finished with 15 double-doubles, which was one shy of tying Amy Herrig's record for single-season double-doubles.

Alexander tallied nine double-doubles as a sophomore.

HANSEN STEPS UP IN THE CLUTCH

Junior college transfer Kalli Hansen had her best game in a Hawkeye uniform against Minnesota (Jan. 5).

Hansen scored seven points and grabbed eight rebounds in 19 minutes of action. Her three-pointer with 3:10 remaining tied the game at 53, and her two free throws at the 2:54 mark gave lowa the lead for good. Hansen missed two free throws with 13 seconds remaining that would have put lowa up five, but she recorded a steal and sank her next two free throws to ice the game.

JOHNSON AT .500 OR BETTER

If Morgan Johnson takes eight or more shots in a game, chances are she will make at least half of them.

Johnson has attempted eight or more shots in 13 of lowa's 18 games this year. In those 13 games, Johnson has shot .500 or better nine times.

Johnson has attempted 10 or more shots six times, shooting. 500 or better in all but one game. Johnson was 8-13 (.615) against Northeastern, 10-16 (.625) against Central Michigan, 8-11 (.727) vs. Iowa State, 9-12 (.750) vs. South Dakota State and 5-10 (.500) vs. Michigan and Ohio State.

She was 4-12 (.333) at Minnesota.

JOHNSON FILLING UP THE STAT SHEET

Morgan Johnson scored double figures over a tough four game-stretch, including double-doubles in two of those four contests.

Johnson tallied a double-double with 16 points and 13 rebounds at No. 14 North Carolina Dec. 2. She followed with 13 points and six rebounds against Kansas State and recorded another double-double with 16 points and 10 rebounds against No. 15 lowa State. Johnson had a career-high 26 points at South Dakota State, including the first 11 points of the contest.

Over the four-game stretch, Johnson averaged 17 points, nine rebounds, shot .707 (29-41) from the field and blocked 13 shots.

DOUBLE TROUBLE

Morgan Johnson recorded her fifth double-double of the season and the eighth double-double of her career against Minnesota (Jan. 5). Johnson finished the game with 12 points and 10 rebounds.

BALANCED SCORING ATTACK

lowa is one of only four teams in the Big Ten to have four players ranked among the top 30 scorers in the conference.

lowa, Ohio State, Northwestern and Penn State and each have four players ranked. Wisconsin has three, while the remaining six schools have either one of two players ranked.

The Hawkeyes have had at least three players reach double figures in scoring in 16 of the 18 games this year. Five players scored 10 or more points against Bradley. Four players hit double digits against Northeastern, Central Michigan, Kansas State, Minnesota and Ohio State.

HAWKEYES HITTING THE BOARDS

lowa's rebounding numbers through its first 18 games are impressive. The Hawkeyes lead the Big Ten in total rebounding (42.5 per game) and rank second in rebounding margin (+5.8), offensive rebounds (14.2 per game) and defensive rebounds (28.3 per game).

Kachine Alexander and Morgan Johnson rank third and four are tied for third in the league in offensive rebounding (3.4 per game). Alexander's 18 rebounds against Central Michigan, Nov. 21, are the second most for any Big Ten player this season.

REBOUNDING NUMBERS IMPROVED FROM A YEAR AGO

lowa's rebounding has improved greatly from a year ago.

Through 18 games last year, lowa had a -0.3 rebound margin. The Hawkeyes were being outrebounded, 693-687, including a 225-218 deficit on the offensive glass.

This year through 18 games, lowa holds a +5.8 rebounding margin and is outrebounding opponents 765-660. That includes a 256-219 advantage on the offensive glass.

MOVING UP CAREER CHARTS

Four Hawkeyes are currently working their way up the career records lists at lowa.

- Kachine Alexander ranks second in career double-doubles (28), eighth in career rebounding (782), 11th in career assists (282) and 26th in career scoring (1,038). With a 75-71 win at Drake Dec. 20, lowa Head Coach Lisa Bluder became only the second coach in school history to reach the 200-win milestone.

Bluder currently has 201 wins in her 11 years at lowa. C. Vivian Stringer is the only other Hawkeye head coach to reach the 200-win plateau at lowa, finishing her time in lowa City with 269 wins.

Ohio State Head Coach Jim Foster is the only other active Big Ten coach to have reached 200 wins at his/her current school.

ALEXANDER NAMED CO-BIG TEN PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Kachine Alexander was named co-Big Ten Player of the Week, Nov. 22, for her efforts against Bradley, Northeastern and Central Michigan. Alexander shared the weekly honor with Northwestern's Amy Jaeschke.

Alexander collected double-doubles in each of Iowa's three games and earned MVP honors at the KCRG-TV9 Hawkeye Challenge.

Alexander's first double-double of the season came against Bradley, recording 14 points and 10 rebounds. Alexander was 8-10 from the free throw line and also had five assists and three steals.

Alexander started the KCRG-TV9 Hawkeye Challenge with 21 points and 12 rebounds in a win over Northeastern, adding six assists, two steals and a block.

She wrapped up the tournament MVP award with 20 points and 18 rebounds against Central Michigan in the championship.

Alexander has now been named Big Ten Player of the Week five times in her career. She was a two-time award winner as both a sophomore and junior.

ALEXANDER MAKES FIRST CUT FOR WOODEN AWARD - ON WATCH LISTS FOR OTHERS

Senior Kachine Alexander was one of 20 players to be named to the Wooden Award Top 20 Midseason List Jan 11. She is also on watch lists for the Wade Trophy and the Naismith Trophy. The "Wade Watch" List is made up of the top 25 preseason women's basketball players and the Naismith Trophy watch list is made up of 50 players.

The Wade Trophy, Wooden Award and Naismith Trophy are considered the three most prestigious awards in NCAA women's college basketball.

Alexander is also one of 30 Division I women's basketball players nationally to be selected as a candidate for the Lowe's Senior CLASS Award. To be eligible, the candidates must show excellence in four categories: community, classroom, character and competition.

SUCCESS UNDER BLUDER

Last year marked the seventh time in 10 seasons under Head Coach Lisa Bluder that lowa has been selected for the NCAA Tournament, including each of the last three seasons. The Hawkeyes have participated in postseason play in all but one season under Bluder (two WNIT appearances).

In addition, lowa finished with a winning record for the ninth time in 10 seasons under Bluder. Iowa's third place finish in the Big Ten is also the seventh time under Bluder the Hawkeyes recorded an upper-division finish in the conference.

lowa also tallied its fifth 20-win season under Bluder, including each of the last three seasons.
