

Quick Hits

- lowa (10-1) is off to its best start in three seasons, when it started the 2010-11 campaign with a 12-1 record.
- lowa is tied for the most wins of any team in the nation. The Hawkeyes -- 2-1 against ranked opponents this season -- have won six-straight games overall.
- lowa is averaging 84.1 points and 20.7 assists per contest, leading the Big Ten in both categories.
- Iowa has scored 294 total points over its last three games, including 95 or more in each.
- lowa tallied 28 assists on 31 made field goals in win over Idaho State. The Hawkeyes have tallied 28 or more assists in their last three games (30, 28, 28), and 28 or more four times this season. The school record for assists in a game is 31.
- lowa --1-1 in away games this season -- has had three or more players score in double figures in each of the last nine contests, including four last time out in win over Idaho State (Dixon 24, Doolittle 17, Taylor 16, Disterhoft 14).
- Five Hawkeyes are averaging double figures.
- Samantha Logic is tied for third in career assists (427) with Kamille Wahlin. Logic needs five assists to take over second place (Michelle Edwards - 431).
- Junior guard Melissa Dixon has made 20 3-pointers over the last three games -- the most in a three-game stretch in school history; she has tied the school record for 3-pointers in a game twice in the last three contests (seven).
- lowa is the only Big Ten team, and one of only 13 teams in the country, to have appeared in the last six NCAA Tournaments.
- Lisa Bluder needs nine wins to surpass Hall of Famer C. Vivian Stringer (269 wins) as Iowa's all-time winningest coach. Bluder is one of 13 active Division I coaches with 600 or more wins.

THE SETTING:

The 21st-ranked University of Iowa women's basketball team (10-1) travels to No. 17/11 Iowa State on Thursday for the annual lowa Corn Cy-Hawk Series matchup. Tip-off is set for 7 p.m. (CT) at Hilton Coliseum in Ames, Iowa.

IOWA OFF TO HOT START:

The Hawkeyes enter the contest on a six-game winning streak (the second-longest in the Big Ten), with an overall mark of 10-1. Iowa -- tied for the most wins of any team in the country -- is off to its best start in three seasons, when it started the 2010-11 campaign with a 12-1 record. The Hawkeyes have started 10-1 or better three times (including this season) under 14th-year UI head coach Lisa Bluder. Iowa started 13-0 in 2004-05, and 12-1 in 2010-11.

AUDIO COVERAGE:

Brent Balbinot and Shelley Till will call the action for the Hawkeye Radio Network. Hawkeye fans can listen to the contest on the Hawkeye All-Access page of hawkeyesports.com. Balbinot is in his 10th season as Iowa's play-by-play voice, while Till is in her ninth providing analysis.

FOLLOW THE ACTION:

Hawkeye fans can watch live on Cyclones.tv on Mediacom (check local listings) and online (check link on Hawkeyesports.com schedule page). Fans can also follow the action via live stats (Gametracker). IOWA HISTORY:

lowa has played 1,143 games since beginning basketball in 1974. lowa's overall record is 702-441 (.613). That includes a 348-178 (.662) mark in regular season Big Ten contests and a 341-97 (.776) mark in Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

IOWA CORN CY-HAWK SERIES:

lowa currently leads the annual lowa Corn Cy-Hawk Series, 7-6. Six points are up for grabs this week: women's hoops (Thursday), and men's hoops and women's swimming (Friday). The Cyclones have recorded wins in volleyball, and men's and women's cross country. The Hawkeyes posted victories in soccer, wrestling and football. Each victory is worth two points, except football (three points).

IOWA-IOWA STATE SERIES NOTES:

- lowa leads the all-time series, 23-20.
- The home team has won 11 of the last 12 meetings, including the last six matchups. The Hawkeyes won last season in Iowa City, 50-42. Three Hawkeyes scored in double figures, including Theairra Taylor (11) and Melissa Dixon (11).
- The Hawkeyes and Cyclones last met as ranked teams on Dec. 9, 2010. No. 19 Iowa defeated No. 16 Iowa State, 62-40, in lowa City.
- Two experienced coaches will face off Thursday night. Lisa Bluder is the dean of Big Ten coaches, and is in her 14th season at Iowa. Bill Fennelly is the dean of Big 12 coaches, and is in his 19th year at Iowa State.
- The Cyclones have six native lowans on their roster: Lexi Albrecht (Carroll), Elly Arganbright (Panora), Madison Baier (Tama), Jadda Buckley (Mason City), Hallie Christofferson (Hamlin), and Ashley Hagedorn (Irwin).
- The Hawkeyes have three native lowans: Ally Disterhoft (lowa City), Hailey Schneden (Davenport), and Claire Till (Dubuque).

lowa captains are senior Theairra Taylor and junior Samantha Logic.

SCOUTING IOWA STATE:

The No. 17/11 Iowa State Cyclones are 8-0 after wins over North Dakota, South Dakota, Cincinnati, Drake, Eastern Washington, Auburn, Northern Iowa and Cal-State Fullerton.

lowa State defeated Cal-State Fullerton on Sunday in its last game, 79-52. The Cyclones outscored the Titans in the paint, 30-12, and shot 51 percent from the field, limiting Fullerton to a 29.5 percentage from the field.

Hallie Christofferson led the Cyclones in scoring with 33 points. She is averaging 25 per game this season. Seanna Johnson (12.1) and Nikki Moody (11.1) are also averaging in double figures. Iowa State averages 82.1 points per game, while limiting opponents to 55 per outing.

HAWKEYES MOVE UP IN AP TOP 25 POLL/ENTER USA TODAY POLL:

lowa is ranked 21st in The Associated Press Top 25 poll this week, and sits 24th in the USA Today Coaches Poll.

Six lowa opponents are also ranked in the Associated Press/USA Today polls: Penn State (12/12), Colorado (11/15), Iowa State (17/11), Purdue (18/23), Nebraska (19/16), and Syracuse (25/RV), In addition, Dayton and Michigan State are receiving votes.

IOWA SETS NEW SINGLE-GAME 3-POINT RECORD:

The Hawkeyes won their sixth game in a row, thanks to a school-record 17 made 3-point field goals, 95-47, on Dec. 7 against Idaho State inside Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

lowa shot 56.4-percent from the field for the game and held the Bengals to 21.5-percent (11.8-percent in the second half). While the Hawkeyes made 75-percent of their two-point field goals (14-of-21), the real story was their success from long range.

Junior Melissa Dixon converted six 3-pointers, giving her 20 in the last three games. She had a school-record seven against UNC-Wilmington and Syracuse. Senior Theairra Taylor made four 3-pointers against Idaho State, freshman Ally Disterhoft had three, sophomore Kathryn Reynolds added two, and junior Samantha Logic and freshman Alexa Kastanek made one apiece.

The previous record was 14, last accomplished on Dec. 22, 2011, against Mississippi Valley State.

NOTES -- IOWA DOWNS IDAHO STATE FOR 6TH-STRAIGHT WIN:

- lowa has scored 294 total points over its last three games, including 95 or more in each (102 vs. UNC-Wilmington, 97 vs. No. 22 Syracuse)
- Iowa has scored 95 points or more, four times this season.
- Iowa has had three or more players score in double figures in each of the last nine contests, including four in the win against Idaho State (Dixon 24, Doolittle 17, Taylor 16, Disterhoft 14).
- lowa -- the Big Ten leader in assists -- tallied 28 assists on 31 made field goals. The Hawkeyes
 have tallied 28 or more assists in their last three games (30, 28, 28), and 28 or more four times
 this season. The school record for assists in a game is 31.

DIXON CATCHING FIRE:

- Junior guard Melissa Dixon finished with six 3-point field goals in Iowa's last game against Idaho State – one shy of her personal record and the school record (seven – accomplished five times, twice by Dixon).
- Dixon made seven 3-pointers in each of lowa's previous two contests, giving her 20 made 3-pointers over the last three games – the most in a three-game stretch in school history.
- After converting seven 3-pointers total during the first six games of the season (7-of-46), Dixon has made 28 over the last five games (28-of-54).
- Dixon finished with a game-high 24 points, after posting 27 in lowa's win against No. 22 Syracuse and a career-best 32 in lowa's win against UNC-Wilmington. She has scored 83 points total over the last three games (27.6/game).
- She has scored 17 points or more during the last five contests (18, 17, 32, 27, 24), for an average of 23.6 points per game.
- Prior to the Cancun Challenge, Dixon was averaging 9.7 points per game. She is now Iowa's leading scorer, averaging 16.0 points per outing.
- Dixon has 148 career 3-pointers, and needs nine to surpass Leah Magner for seventh (156) on lowa's all-time list.

CLIMBING TO THE TOP:

Lisa Bluder needs nine wins to surpass Hall of Famer C. Vivian Stringer (269) as lowa's alltime winningest coach. Bluder -- one of 13 active Division I coaches with 600 or more wins -- is 261-158 all-time as the Hawkeye head coach.

Head Coach Lisa Bluder

Lisa Bluder (pronounced BLUE-dir) is in her 14th season as head coach at the University of Iowa and her 30th season as a college head coach. She is a three-time Big Ten and two-time WBCA Regional Coach of the Year.

Bluder has a career record of 617-300 (.671), including a 261-158 (.619) record at lowa, a 187-106 (.638) record in 10 seasons (1990-2000) at Drake and a six-year mark (1984-90) of 169-36 (.824) at St. Ambrose.



Bluder is lowa's second all-time winningest coach and

trails only C. Vivian Stringer (269 wins). She has guided the Hawkeyes to 12 postseason tournaments (10 NCAA, 2 WNIT) and nine upper-division finishes in the Big Ten Conference, including winning a share of the league championship in 2008 and taking home the conference tournament title in 2001.

In her first season with the Hawkeyes, Bluder transformed a struggling program into a 21-game winner. Iowa finished second in the Big Ten, won the conference tournament and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament. Bluder became Iowa's third coach to be named Big Ten Coach of the Year. She was also honored as the College Coach of the Year by the Women's Basketball News Service and was named the WBCA District 6 Coach of the Year. Iowa's 2001-02 squad finished fourth in the Big Ten and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament for the second consecutive year. In 2003, Bluder guided the Hawkeyes to their first-ever WNIT appearance. Iowa, which had nine underclassmen on its roster, advanced to the quarterfinals before falling to Creighton. In 2004-05, Iowa finished 23-10, starting the year 13-0 and was the last Division I undefeated team standing. In 2005-06, Bluder mentored a team plagued by injuries to a fifth-place Big Ten finish and an NCAA Tournament berth.

In her 10 years at Drake, Bluder brought great success and tradition to the Bulldog program and established herself as one of the top coaches in the country. She led Drake to five 20-plus win seasons in her last six years, including five post-season appearances. She guided the Bulldogs to eight Missouri Valley Conference Tournament appearances, reaching the semifinals six times and winning the tournament four times. Bluder was also named the Conference Coach of the Year three times at Drake.

Bluder began her coaching career at St. Ambrose, where she coached six successful seasons, building the Bees into a NAIA powerhouse. During her tenure at St. Ambrose, Bluder guided the Bees to four straight national tournaments, including two consecutive Final Four appearances. The 1990 St. Ambrose team was ranked No. 1 and Bluder was named the NAIA Converse Coach of the Year.

A graduate of Linn-Mar High School in Marion, Iowa, Bluder was a three-year starter at Northern Iowa. She graduated from UNI in 1983 with a bachelor's degree in marketing.

BALANCED ATTACK:

Five Hawkeyes are averaging double figures: Melissa Dixon (16.0), Bethany Doolittle (14.4), Samantha Logic (13.5), Ally Disterhoft (11.5), and Theairra Taylor (10.0).

Six Hawkeyes scored in double figures in Iowa's overtime win against No. 14 Dayton, and Iowa has had three or more players score in double figures in each of the last nine contests.

MOVING UP CAREER CHARTS:

- Samantha Logic is tied for third in career assists (427) with Kamille Wahlin. Logic needs five assists to take over second place (Michelle Edwards - 431).
- Melissa Dixon has 148 career 3-pointers, and needs nine to surpass Leah Magner for seventh (156) on Iowa's all-time list.
- Bethany Doolittle is sixth all-time with 107 career blocks. She needs eight blocks to surpass Jennie Lillis (114) for fifth place.

B1G HONOR ROLL:

- Two Hawkeyes -- Samantha Logic and Melissa Dixon -- have been named to the Big Ten Player of the Week Honor Roll in the last three weeks. Iowa has had a player named to the Honor Roll for three-straight weeks.
- Logic was named to the Honor Roll on Nov. 25 after averaging 21.5 points, 7.5 rebounds, 4.0 assists and 2.0 steals as lowa split a pair of road contests at No. 16 Colorado and UNI.
- Dixon was honored Dec. 2 after being named MVP of the Cancun Challenge Mayan Division, where she averaged 22.3 points per game, including a career-high 32 against UNC-Wilmington.
- Dixon was honored again on Dec. 9, after helping lowa to wins over No. 22 Syracuse and Idaho State last week, averaging 25.5 points per game, while converting 13-of-21 three-point attempts.
- Logic was named Big Ten Player of Week on Nov. 12 for her efforts in Iowa's wins against UC Riverside and No. 14 Dayton.

HAWKEYES CONTINUE TREND AGAINST RANKED FOES:

- lowa is 2-1 this season against ranked opponents (the two top-25 wins are the most of any Big Ten team):
 - W vs. No. 14 Dayton (97-93 in overtime) Nov. 10
 - L at No. 16 Colorado (90-87) Nov. 20
- W vs. No. 22 Syracuse (97-91) Dec. 5
- The Hawkeyes have defeated nine top-25 opponents since the start of last season (9-5 record).
- lowa is averaging 93.7 points per game during its three contests against ranked teams this season.
- The Hawkeyes have recorded at least one win against a top-25 team in all but two seasons under Bluder. In nine of those seasons, lowa has knocked off at least one top-15 opponent.
- This year marks the seventh time in school history that lowa has played at least three ranked teams prior to conference action. lowa faced five ranked opponents in 1990 (2-3 record) and three in 2012 (last year) (3-0), 1999 (0-3), 1995 (2-1), 1993 (3-0), and 1989 (1-2).
- Last season marked just the second time in school history that lowa defeated three ranked teams prior to Big Ten play (No. 12 West Virginia, No. 22 Iowa State, No. 20 Texas). The only other time Iowa defeated three ranked opponents was in 1993 (No. 4 Louisiana Tech, No. 20 Missouri State, No. 9 Southern California).
- lowa tied the school record for number of wins over ranked teams in a season last year with seven. The Hawkeyes have accomplished the feat three other times (1995-96, 1993-94, 1992-93). Iowa faced 11 ranked teams last season, which tied for the most games against ranked opponents in a season. The only other time lowa played 11 ranked teams in a season was in 1992-93 (7-4 record).

IOWA ROLLS IN CANCUN:

Following a three-point loss at No. 16 Colorado on Nov. 20, the Hawkeyes won at Northern Iowa, 67-60, on Nov. 20. Iowa then traveled to the Cancun Challenge and finished with a 3-0 mark, defeating all three opponents -- Southern California (78-65), Boston College (78-68), and UNC-Wilmington (102-65) -- by double digits to win the Mayan Division.

During the Cancun Challenge finale, junior guard Melissa Dixon tied the school record for 3-pointers in a single game (seven). Dixon matched the record held by Lindsey Meder, Kamille Wahlin, and Jaime Printy. Dixon finished with a career-high 32 points and was named MVP of the Mayan Division; junior Samantha Logic was also named to the All-Tournament team.

lowa's 102 points against UNC-Wilmington marked the fourth-most in a single game in program history (106 is the record twice). Ten Hawkeyes played, and all 10 scored.

BLUDER GETS WIN NO. 600:

Head coach Lisa Bluder became the 42nd coach in NCAA women's basketball history (all divisions) and only the 25th Division I head coach (minimum 10 years at a DI school) to collect 600 wins Jan. 20 vs. Purdue. Bluder is one of 13 active Division I coaches with 600 or more wins.

HAWKEYES LIKE TO SHARE:

- The Hawkeyes lead the Big Ten in assists, averaging 20.7 per contest. Iowa also leads the league in assist/turnover ratio (1.4).
- Samantha Logic leads the league in assists, averaging 6.7 a game.
- As a team, lowa registered 30 assists, one shy of the school record, in the win against No. 14 Dayton on Nov. 10. lowa matched that number in its win against UNC-Wilmington in the Cancun Challenge (Nov. 30).
- lowa broke the school record for single-season assists last year in the win over Miami (March 24). The previous record of 514 was set in 2011-12. Iowa finished with 531 assists. Iowa finished second in the Big Ten and 26th in the NCAA with 15.7 assists per game. Iowa recorded at least 17 assists in 15 games, including five games with 20 or more.

- Samantha Logic recorded her 13th career double-double (16 points, 14 assists) on Nov. 10, leading the Hawkeyes to a 97-93
 overtime victory against No. 14 Dayton. Logic hit the game-tying 3-pointer with nine seconds remaining in regulation to send
 the game into overtime. The 14 assists equaled a personal best and Iowa school record, and are the most in Carver-Hawkeye
 Arena history. The previous high was 12 (three times).
- Logic --- who now has 14 career double-doubles --- became lowa's single-season assist record holder a year ago, breaking the
 mark in lowa's win at Northwestern (March 3). Logic entered the game tied with Cara Consuegra (2000-01) at 191 assists.
 Logic collected seven assists at Northwestern and finished with 217.
- Last season, Logic led the Big Ten and ranked 15th in the NCAA with 6.4 assists per game.
- Logic recorded seven or more assists in 15 games, including four games with 10 or more. She had at least five assists in 24 games.
- Logic's eight games with double digit assists are the second most in lowa history. Cara Consuegra had nine games in her career with 10 or more assists. The next closest Hawkeyes on the list are Kachine Alexander, Jolette Law and Michelle Edwards, with two career games.

NCAA STREAK LEADS THE BIG TEN:

lowa is the only Big Ten team, and one of only 13 teams in the country, to have appeared in the last six NCAA Tournaments.

REYNOLDS NOMINATED FOR ALLSTATE WBCA GOOD WORKS TEAM:

Kathryn Reynolds has been nominated for the Women's Basketball Coaches Association Allstate Good Works Team. The announcement was made Dec. 3 by the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA), the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC), and Allstate Insurance Company.

Reynolds is one-of-five Big Ten players nominated.

NCAA 1ST AND 2ND ROUND TICKETS ON SALE:

Tickets for the 2014 NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Championship First and Second Rounds, hosted by the University of lowa, are now on sale for UI women's basketball season ticket holders and the general public.

lowa's First and Second Round Games will be played Sunday, March 23 (4:30 and 7 p.m.) and Tuesday, March 25 (8:30 p.m.). The UI was one of 16 sites chosen to host First and Second Round Games, and 1-of-8 chosen to host in back-to-back years.

LOGIC NAMED PRESEASON ALL-BIG TEN:

Junior Samantha Logic was named Preseason All-Big Ten by league media, the conference office announced Thursday. Logic, a junior from Racine, Wis., started all 34 games last season and was a third team All-Big Ten selection. The 5-foot-9 guard set school records for single-season assists (217) and single-game assists (14 vs. Texas, Dec. 28). Logic tallied five double-doubles, and led the Big Ten and ranked 15th in the NCAA in assists per game (6.4).

HAWKEYE DEFENSE:

lowa limited Arkansas-Pine Bluff to 38 points on Nov. 13, the fewest total for an opponent in 19 years. The Hawkeyes then limited Stony Brook to 40 points on Nov. 17.






