- Saturday will be the first ever meeting between Iowa and Longwood.
- Saturday is "Josh Oglesby Bobblehead Day". The first 1,500 fans will receive a bobblehead of the Hawkeye senior from Cedar Rapids. Saturday will be Oglesby's 100th game played.
- lowa has won 28 straight nonconference home games, a streak that dates back to November 2011 (Clemson). The active streak ranks ninth in the country.
- Saturday will be Iowa's third home game in six days.
- Four Hawkeyes scored in double figures in Iowa's, 70-49, win over Northern Illinois: Aaron White (14), Anthony Clemmons (14), Adam Woodbury (12), and Gabriel Olaseni (10).
- Gabriel Olaseni, who hails from London, England, learned of his father's passing Wednesday morning. He played later that evening, posting 10 points, blocking four shots and grabbing five rebounds in 20 minutes of action against the Huskies.
- Anthony Clemmons, who scored in double figures once last season, has reached double digits three times already this season, including equaling a career-high 14 points on Wednesday.
- lowa is 36-6 when scoring 80 points or more, the last five seasons. The Hawkeyes are 43-1 when holding opponents to fewer than 61 points, the last five years.

HAWKEYES BEAT NORTHERN ILLINOIS

- Iowa handed Northern Illinois its first loss of the season, 70-49, Wednesday night in Iowa City.
- lowa blocked 12 shots, one shy of the school record of 13 set against Illinois in 2013. Jarrod Uthoff denied a career-best five shots, while Gabriel Olaseni rejected four shots for the second time this season (Hampton).
- The Hawkeyes forced 17 turnovers and converted those miscues into 22 points.
- Iowa outscored Northern Illinois, 11-0, in fast break points.
- Aaron White tallied 10 of his 14 points in the first half. The senior has scored in double figures in every game this season.
- Adam Woodbury netted 12 points and grabbed six rebounds. The Hawkeye junior has reached double figures four of the last five games; Woodbury scored in double figures four times in 33 games a season ago.
- lowa shot 79 percent from the free throw line, sinking 15 of its 19 attempts. Anthony Clemmons was 6-of-7 from the charity stripe, which are career highs in makes and attempts for the Hawkeye junior.
- lowa's bench produced 28 points, 19 of which came from Josh Oglesby (nine) and Olaseni (10).

Head Coach Fran McCaffery

Fran McCaffery, who is signed through the 2020 season, is in his fifth season as the head basketball coach at the University of Iowa and his 19th year overall as a college head coach. McCaffery spent five seasons (2005-10) as the head coach at Siena, six years at UNC-Greensboro (1999-2005) and three seasons at Lehigh (1985-88) before joining the Hawkeyes.

McCaffery has three decades of Division I coaching experience. He completed his 32nd season as a collegiate coach in 2014, which includes 18 years as a head coach and 14 as an



assistant. McCaffery became one of 12 coaches to lead four different Division I teams to the NCAA Tournament in 2014.

McCaffery, 54, holds a career mark of 329-245 (.573) and guided his teams to nine postseason appearances (six NCAA, three NIT). He is 78-65 (.545) at lowa.

Since taking over the lowa program in 2010, the Hawkeyes have increased their win total by 15 games. McCaffery coached lowa to 25 victories in 2013, equaling the second-most win total in program history. McCaffery has guided the Black and Gold to back-to-back NIT appearances, including a runner-up finish in 2013.

McCaffery has posted upper division finishes in each of the past two seasons at Iowa and 14-of-18 seasons as a head coach. He has posted 20 wins or more six of the last eight seasons, including the last two at Iowa (2013 and 2014).

McCaffery and the Hawkeyes have made Carver-Hawkeye Arena one of the most feared arenas to play nationally. Fans have embraced Mc-Caffery and his team's style of play with attendance increasing by 57 percent since 2010. The Hawkeyes won a school-record 18 home games a year ago.

McCaffery's five years at Siena were the best in its 70-year history. He led the Saints on an incredible run that ended with three straight Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference championships and NCAA Tournament appearances. In so doing, Siena became the only program in the country to win its regular season and postseason title 2008-10.

McCaffery's Saints owned a 112-51 (.687) record in his five years with the program. He guided the Saints to four consecutive 20-win seasons.

The 2009 MAAC Coach of the Year and 2010 District I Coach of the Year is the third winningest coach, by percentage, in league history (68-22, .756). He is the only coach to guide a MAAC program to two NCAA Tournament wins. McCaffery led his 2008 and 2009 teams to first round NCAA Tournament victories over Vanderbilt and Ohio State, respectively.

In his final two seasons at Siena, he coached the Saints to back-toback 27-win campaigns and boasted a combined 39-3 (.929) record against MAAC opponents, which included MAAC Tournament contests.

McCaffery began his coaching career as an assistant at Penn (1982-83) and Lehigh (1983-85). After three seasons as head coach at Lehigh, he spent 11 seasons as an assistant at Notre Dame (1988-99).

McCaffery played basketball at Wake Forest his freshman year (1977-78) and then concluded his collegiate playing career at Penn his final three seasons (1979-82).

He earned his B.S. degree in Economics from The Wharton School (Penn) in 1982. McCaffery also earned a Master of Education from Lehigh in 1985.

SCOUTING LONGWOOD

After opening the season with a 79-53 win over Averett on Nov. 14, Longwood has played its last five contests away from Farmville, Virginia. The Lancers have lost their last three contests (Youngstown State, Eastern Michigan and George Washington).

Longwood dropped its last contest, 91-66, at George Washington on Wednesday. George Washington converted 27-of-39 free throws after the Lancers were whistled for 28 fouls. Lotanna Nwogbo posted career highs of 25 points, 13 rebounds and 10-of-11 shooting from the field in defeat.

Ryan Badowski is Longwood's main 3-point threat, shooting at a 36 percent clip (19-of-53). Nwogbo averages a team-best 16.3 points, 24-of-28 free throws, and 8.7 rebounds. Shaquille Johnson averages 10.3 points and a team-best 4.3 assists per game.

Longwood has seven newcomers this season, which includes Quincy Taylor and Nwogbo who sat out last season due to NCAA transfer rules.

Jayson Gee is in his second season as Longwood head coach. A 25-year coaching veteran, Gee's resume includes successful rebuilding projects at University of Charleston and Cleveland State. He has taken programs to six NCAA Tournaments, including four consecutive trips as the head coach at Charleston from 1999-2002 and again as the associate head coach at Cleveland State in 2009.

ATTACKING THE RIM

lowa's 27.2 free-throw attempts average last season, ranked 15th nationally. The Hawkeyes ranked ninth in the country in made free throws (20.0). Through six games this season, lowa is averaging 24.3 free throw attempts and 17.8 makes. lowa has made more free throws (107) than its opponents have attempted (104).

Aaron White is on pace to shatter the school's free-throw makes record. White currently ranks fifth with 442 career makes. White (605) is also climbing lowa's free-throw attempts chart, ranking sixth.

In recognition of Mike Gesell's outstanding academic record in the Tippie College of Business at The University of Iowa, the junior has been invited to become a member of Beta Gamma Sigma, the National Scholastic Honor Society for business students. This honor is reserved for students who have earned GPAs that place them in the top 10 percent of their class. The UI chapter, established in 1920, is one of the 10 oldest in the nation.

UTHOFF PRODUCING ON THE WING

Jarrod Uthoff ranks second in team scoring (11.7 ppg) and first in steals (1.7) through six games. The redshirt junior averaged 14 points, six rebounds, and three steals in lowa's two games in New York. He has drained two 3-pointers or more in 4-of-6 games. Uthoff drained a personal-best four triples in lowa's victory over Hampton (Nov. 14). He has reached double figures in four of lowa's first six contests.

The native of Cedar Rapids, Iowa, tallied 15 points, grabbed eight rebounds and had three assists in lowa's win over Pepperdine. Despite scoring only two points in the Hawkeyes' triumph over Northern Illinois on Wednesday, he grabbed six rebounds, dished four assists and rejected a career-high five shots.

STRONG START FOR WOODBURY

Center Adam Woodbury averaged 5.7 points and 3.9 rebounds last year as a sophomore. So far through six games as a junior, Woodbury is averaging 9.7 points and 6.5 rebounds. He is shooting 58 percent (25-of-43) from the field this year. Woodbury has already matched the number of double-digit scoring games from a year ago (four).

GESELL JOINS ELITE GROUP

Through two seasons, Mike Gesell became just the third Hawkeye to ever amass 550+ points, 200+ assists, 150+ rebounds and 75+ steals. Gesell has 553 points, 217 assists, 155 rebounds and 83 steals. Gesell joins Jeff Horner (632 points, 204 assists, 292 rebounds and 78 steals) and Dean Oliver (631 points, 267 assists, 184 rebounds and 93 steals).

ON POINT

Point guard Mike Gesell scored in double figures in seven of the last 11 games in 2014, which included a stretch of five straight games -- the longest stretch of his career.

In 33 games, Gesell ranked first in the Big Ten and 12th nationally in assist-to-turnover ratio (3.0).

Gesell leads the team and ranks 12th in the Big Ten in assists (4.2) through six games this year.

IN THE BIG TEN...

lowa ranks second in the conference in steals (9.2), and third in free throw percentage (.733), field goal percentage defense (.353), and blocked shots (5.8).

Individually, Aaron White (16.3 ppg and 8.0 rpg) is one of three Big Ten players to average 16+ points and 8+ rebounds (Fran Kaminsky of Wisconsin and Nebraska's Shavon Shields).

IOWA HISTORY

lowa has played 2,647 games since beginning basketball in 1902. lowa's overall record is 1,554-1,093 (.587). That includes a 993-349 (.740) record in home games, a 557-741 (.429) record in contests away from lowa City, a 729-746 (.494) mark in Big Ten games and a 397-123 (.763) record in Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

WHITE HOT

Aaron White ranks first among active Big Ten players in rebounding (701) and is fourth in scoring (1,399).

White ranks first on the team in rebounding (8.0) and scoring (16.3), and second in assists (2.7) through six games in 2014-15. White is seeking to become the first Hawkeye to lead the team in scoring and rebounding since Greg Brunner in 2006 (14.1 points and 9.2 rebounds per game).

White was the only Big Ten player to average 13+ points and 7+ rebounds during league play in 2014. White became the first Hawkeye ever to register 1,300+ points, 650+ rebounds, 100+ steals and 100+ assists by his junior season.

White was the only player in the country to shoot better than 55 percent from the field and 80 percent from the foul line in 2014. He shot 58 percent from the field and 81 percent from the charity stripe. White is already on pace to accomplish the feat a second consecutive season, shooting 57 percent from the field and 86 percent from the foul line after six games.

White became the fifth player, since 1960, to lead the Hawkeyes in rebounding three consecutive seasons. White joins Don Nelson (1960-62); Kevin Kunnert (1971-73); Bruce King (1975-77); and Greg Brunner (2004-06). He is seeking to become the first Hawkeye to ever lead the Hawkeyes in rebounding all four seasons.

White became the 41st Hawkeye to surpass 1,000 career points with his 19th point scored with one second remaining at the free throw line versus Notre Dame (Dec. 3). He reached the 1,000-point milestone in his 82nd career game. White currently ranks 15th in lowa scoring.

BLOCK PARTY

Junior Gabriel Olaseni blocked at least three shots five times last season. His 43 blocks ranked 10th in the Big Ten (1.3 average). Sophomore Jarrod Uthoff denied 34 shots (1.1 average), a total that ranked 11th in the league. Olaseni denied a game-high four shots in lowa wins over Hampton (Nov. 14) and Northern Illinois (Nov. 26). He leads the Hawkeyes and ranks third in the league averaging 2.5 rejections per game. Uthoff ranks second in blocks (1.8), rejecting at least one shot in 5-of-6 games. He denied a career-high five shots in lowa's win over Northern Illinois on Wednesday.

As a team, lowa ranked second in the Big Ten, and 40th nationally, in rejections (5.0) in 2013-14.
