Quick Hits

- Iowa is ranked No. 16 in the *Associated Press* Top-25 poll and No. 17 in the *USA Today* Coaches poll.
- Iowa's NCAA RPI (Feb. 4) is No. 5. Iowa is 9-3 against teams in the top 55 of the RPI.
- Iowa is in second place in the Big Ten at 8-2, one game ahead of Nebraska, Rutgers, and Ohio State (7-3).
- The Hawkeyes are off to their best start in league play and overall since the 1995-96 season.
- Iowa senior Samantha Logic, the NCAA's active career assists leader (775), ranks sixth in assists in Big Ten history. Penn State's Jess Strom is fifth with 776 career assists.
- Senior Melissa Dixon (293 career 3-pointers) needs two 3-pointers to move into third in Big Ten history.
- Dixon (3.95) and Ohio State's Kelsey Mitchell (3.82) rank No. 1 and 2 nationally in 3-pointers per game.
- Mitchell (26 points per game), a freshman, and Ohio State junior Ameryst Alston (20.6) rank first and third in the Big Ten in scoring.
- The Hawkeyes won all three meetings against Ohio State last season.
- Iowa set the school record for scoring offense (78.2) last season, leading the league in scoring while notching the second-most points in a season in Big Ten history (2,814). The Hawkeyes rank ninth nationally this season (79.7).
- Ally Disterhoft has scored in double figures in 35 of her 38 career starts. Iowa is 30-8 when Disterhoft starts.
- Iowa is the only Big Ten team, and one of only 14 teams in the country, to appear in the last seven NCAA Tournaments. There are 349 Division I teams.
- Iowa is 44-13 overall since the start of last season.

The 16th-ranked University of Iowa women's basketball team (17-4, 8-2) hosts Ohio State (15-7, 7-3) on Thursday at Carver-Hawkeye Arena. Tipoff is set for 7 p.m. (CT).

TICKETS:

Single game women's basketball tickets are \$12 for adults. Youth -- high school-aged and younger -- are admitted free to all weekday games, including Friday night games. Youth tickets for weekend games cost \$8. Youth -- five years old and younger -- are admitted free to all games. UI students are admitted free with student ID. Tickets are available by visiting the ticket office at Carver-Hawkeye Arena, calling 1-800-IA-HAWKS, or online at **hawkeyesports.com**.

BEST START SINCE 1996:

- The Hawkeyes (8-2) are off to their best start in Big Ten play since starting 11-0 during the 1995-96 season.
- Iowa is off to its best start (17-4) through 21 games since the 1995-96 season when it opened 20-1. The Hawkeyes finished 27-4 overall and 15-1 in Big Ten action that year while advancing to the Sweet Sixteen.

SCOUTING OHIO STATE:

- Ohio State is 15-7 overall and 7-3 in Big Ten play, one game behind Iowa.
- The Buckeyes have won four-straight games.
- Ohio State is 3-3 in road games.
- Kelsey Mitchell (26.0 points per game) and Ameryst Alston (20.6) make up the top-scoring back court in the country. Mitchell leads the nation in scoring, while Alston is third in the Big Ten.
- Ohio State is coached by Kevin McGuff. He is in his second season.

SERIES HISTORY/NOTES:

- Iowa and Ohio State have met 61 times. Ohio State leads the all-time series, 31-30.
- The Hawkeyes have won the last four meetings in the series, including all three last season.
- Iowa has won the last four meetings in Iowa City.
- Iowa's Melissa Dixon leads the nation in 3-point field goals per game (3.95), while Ohio State's Kelsey Mitchell is second nationally at 3.82. Dixon has made 83 in 21 games, while Mitchell has made 84 in 22 games. No other player in the country

- Ohio State is second in the Big Ten and seventh nationally in scoring offense (81.0), while Iowa is third in the conference and ninth nationally (79.7).
- Iowa leads the Big Ten in 3-point field goal percentage (40.7%). The Hawkeyes (8.3/game) and Buckeyes (7.8) lead the league in 3-pointers.

DISTERHOFT NAMED TO BIG TEN PLAYER OF THE WEEK HONOR ROLL:

- Ally Disterhoft was named to the Big Ten Player of the Week Honor Roll on Feb. 2 after averaging 21.3 points and eight rebounds during Iowa's three games against No. 15 Nebraska, Northwestern, and No. 5 Maryland.
- The sophomore notched a double-double in the overtime win over Nebraska (20 points, 13 rebounds), and scored 22 points at Northwestern and at Maryland.

RECORD-SETTING WIN:

- Iowa won at Northwestern on Jan. 29, 102-99.
- The two teams combined for 32 3-pointers, setting a new NCAA record for combined 3-pointers in a game. The previous record was 31.
- Iowa converted 19 3-pointers, setting a new program and Big Ten record for 3-pointers by a team in a single game. Previous record (17): Iowa vs. Idaho State (Dec. 7, 2013); Ohio State vs. Penn State (Feb. 7, 2010).
- Senior Melissa Dixon made nine 3-pointers, finishing 9-of-10.
- Iowa finished with 32 assists on 33 field goals, setting a new program record.

FUN FACTS:

- Iowa is 44-13 overall since the start of last season (27-9 last year; 17-4 this year).
- The Hawkeyes enter Thursday's game ranked No. 5 in the NCAA RPI.
- Iowa is 9-3 against teams in the top 55 of the RPI.
- Iowa is 16-1 this season when scoring 70 or more points, and 1-3 when failing to reach the 70-point plateau.
- The Hawkeyes are 12-0 when registering more steals than their opponent this year, and 12-1 when recording fewer turnovers.
- Iowa ranks 13th nationally in assists per game. The Hawkeyes are 12-1 when notching more assists than their opponent.
- The Hawkeyes are third nationally in 3-point field goal percentage (40.7%), ninth in scoring offense (79.7), ninth in field goal percentage (46.3%), 17th in assist to turnover ratio (1.24), and 14th in 3-pointers per game (8.3).

THE NATION'S LEADING 3-POINT SHOOTER:

- Iowa senior Melissa Dixon leads the nation in 3-point field goals, averaging 3.95 per game.
- Dixon is first in the Big Ten and fourth nationally in 3-point percentage (48%).
- Dixon made six 3-pointers (6-of-10) in the win at Rutgers on Jan. 4, surpassing Lindsey Meder (261) for the most in Iowa history.
- Dixon is tied for fourth in Big Ten history with 293 career 3-pointers.
- She scored 31 points in Iowa's win at Drake on Dec. 21, making 10 3-pointers (10-of-14), setting a new school record. The previous school record was seven, accomplished five times in program history, twice by Dixon; the NCAA and Big Ten record for 3-pointers in a single game is 12.
- Dixon finished 9-of-10 from 3-point range in Iowa's 102-99 win at Northwestern (Jan. 29).

1,000-POINT CLUB:

- Four members of this year's team have reached, or have the potential to reach 1,000 career points this season.
- Senior Samantha Logic (1,329 points) ranks 15th on Iowa's all-time scoring list. Lisa Becker is 14th (1,335).
- Senior Melissa Dixon (1,318 points) is 17th. Amy Herrig is 16th (1,319).
- Senior Bethany Doolittle became the 33rd member of Iowa's 1,000-point club in the Hawkeyes' win over Penn State on Dec. 28. She has 1,138 career points to rank 26th.
- Sophomore Ally Disterhoft has 804 career points. She tallied 474 in 36 games as a freshman last year (13.2 per game), and is averaging 15.7 points per game this season.

Head Coach Lisa Bluder

Lisa Bluder (pronounced BLUE-dir), the all-time winningest coach in program history, is in her 15th season as head coach at the University of Iowa and her 31st season as a college head coach.



Under her direction, the Hawkeyes have advanced to 13 postseason appearances (11 NCAA and two WNIT) in 14 seasons, including NCAA Tournament berths in each of the last seven seasons. Iowa is the only team in the Big Ten, and one of 14 in NCAA Division I women's basketball, to qualify for the NCAA Tournament in each of the last seven years. There are 343 Division I teams.

The longest-tenured Big Ten coach, Bluder has posted a 295-170 (.636) record at Iowa and her career record stands at 651-312 (.6747). Bluder surpassed Hall of Famer C. Vivian Stringer (269 wins) as the all-time winningest coach in program history on Feb. 10, 2014, as the Hawkeyes defeated Northwestern, 90-84.

Bluder, 1-of-10 active major college coaches with 600 or more wins, is a three-time Big Ten Coach of the Year (2001, 2008 and 2010) and two-time WBCA Regional Coach of the Year (2001 and 2008). She has guided Iowa to a winning record in 13 of her 14 years at Iowa, including 10 upper-division finishes in the challenging Big Ten Conference. Bluder, who ranks fourth among Big Ten coaches all-time in league victories (138), has led Iowa to eight 20-win seasons in her 14 years, including six of the last seven years.

Bluder has coached numerous players to different awards in her 14 years in Iowa City. She has mentored 19 players to 40 All-Big Ten honors, including 11 first team picks, 11 second, 11 third and seven honorable mention selections. She has also had two Big Ten Freshman of the Year award winners, two Big Ten Sixth Player of the Year recipients, six members of the Big Ten All-Freshman team and three players named to the Big Ten All-Defensive team, with Kachine Alexander earning the honor twice.

Five players during Bluder's tenure have earned a total of six Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) all-region team accolades and six players have earned a total of 11 honorable mention All-America honors.

With Bluder on the Iowa sidelines, student-athletes have been named Academic All-Big Ten 67 times, including a program-best eight honorees in 2011 and 2012. The 67 honorees equal the third-highest total in the Big Ten during the last 14 years.

In her 10 years at Drake, Bluder brought great success and tradition to the Bulldogs program and established herself as one of the top coaches in the country. She led Drake to five 20-plus win seasons in her last six years, including five post-season appearances. She guided the Bulldogs to eight Missouri Valley Conference Tournament appearances, reaching the semifinals six times and winning the tournament four times. Bluder was also named the Conference Coach of the Year three times at Drake.

Bluder began her coaching career at St. Ambrose, where she coached six successful seasons, building the Bees into a NAIA powerhouse. During her tenure at St. Ambrose, Bluder guided the Bees to four straight national tournaments, including two consecutive Final Four appearances. The 1990 St. Ambrose team was ranked No. 1 and Bluder was named the NAIA Converse Coach of the Year.

A graduate of Linn-Mar High School in Marion, Iowa, Bluder was a three-year starter at Northern Iowa. She graduated from UNI in 1983 with a bachelor's degree in marketing.

MOVING UP CAREER CHARTS:

- Samantha Logic (775 career assists) surpassed Cara Consuegra (1997-2001; 576) as Iowa's all-time assists leader during Iowa's win at Illinois on March 2, 2014, during the 2013-14 regular season finale. She ranks sixth in Big Ten history. Jess Strom of Penn State (776) is fifth, while Helen Darling of Penn State is fourth (791).
- Melissa Dixon is Iowa's career record holder for 3-pointers (293). She is tied for fourth in Big Ten history with Amber Moore of Illinois. Lindsay Bowen of Michigan State is third (294). Kelly Mazzante of Penn State is second (357), while Maggie Lucas of Penn State is the Big Ten record holder (365).
- Bethany Doolittle is third all-time in program history with 233 career blocks. Tangela Smith is second with 235. Morgan Johnson is first with 293.

IOWA RANKED FOR THE 13TH-STRAIGHT WEEK THIS SEASON:

- Iowa is No. 16 in this week's *Associated Press* Top-25 poll and No. 17 in the *USA Today* Coaches poll. Iowa has been ranked in each of the first 13 weeks this year: preseason (19/19), week 2 (18/18), week 3 (17/16), week 4 (22/19), week 5 (24/24), week 6 (23/24), week 7 (23/20), week 8 (20/20), week 9 (17/17), week 10 (22/21), week 11 (20/18), week 12 (20/17), and week 13 (16/17).
- It marks the longest Iowa has been ranked since being ranked for 13-straight weeks during the 2010-11 season, and 14 weeks in total that year. Prior to that, the longest stretch was 18-straight weeks during the 1995-96 season.
- In the AP Poll, Maryland is No. 5, followed by Iowa (No. 16), Nebraska (No. 19), and Rutgers (No. 21).
- The Hawkeyes finished the 2013-14 season ranked 19th in the AP Top-25 poll, and 26th (receiving votes) in the *USA Today* Coaches poll. Iowa was ranked for eight weeks last season in the AP poll, and received votes in nine additional weeks.

HAWKEYES AT CARVER-HAWKEYE ARENA:

The Hawkeyes are 361-101 (.781) all-time inside Carver-Hawkeye Arena, and 11-6 in NCAA Tournament games. Iowa went 14-4 at home last season, and is 101-24 in its last 124 games inside Carver-Hawkeye Arena. The Hawkeyes are 12-0 at home this season, with four regular season home dates remaining. Iowa has won 15-straight regular season home games dating back to last year.

Iowa's 14 home wins a year ago equaled the second-highest single-season total in program history. The 14 wins were the most in Iowa City since the Hawkeyes finished 14-0 in the 1995-96 season. Iowa also won 14 home games in 1988-89 (14-0), 1987-88 (14-0), 1986-87 (14-1), 1985-86 (14-1). The program record for home wins is 15, as the Hawkeyes finished 15-0 in 1992-93. Iowa advanced to the NCAA Final Four that season.

LOGIC NAMED TO DAWN STALEY AWARD WATCH LIST:

Senior Samantha Logic is one of 16 student-athletes to be named to the Midseason Watch List for the Dawn Staley Award. The Dawn Staley Award is given to the most outstanding collegiate guard in the country; a player who exemplifies the skills that Dawn possessed during her career (ball handling, scoring, her ability to distribute the basketball, and her will to win).

LOGIC NAMED TO WOODEN AWARD MIDSEASON TOP 20:

Senior Samantha Logic has been named to the John R. Wooden Award Women's Midseason Top 20 list, comprised of the front-runners for college basketball's most prestigious individual honor. The list is chosen by a poll of national women's college basketball media members. Logic is the only player from the Big Ten on the midseason list.

LOGIC NAMED SENIOR CLASS AWARD CANDIDATE:

Senior point guard Samantha Logic is one of 30 NCAA Division I women's basketball players to be named a candidate for the 2015 Senior CLASS Award®. To be eligible for the award, a student-athlete must be classified as an NCAA Division I senior and have notable achievements in four areas of excellence: community, classroom, character and competition. Logic is one of two candidates from the Big Ten, joining Nicole Elmlad of Michigan.

An acronym for Celebrating Loyalty and Achievement for Staying in School®, the Senior CLASS Award focuses on the total student-athlete and encourages students to use their platform in athletics to make a positive impact as leaders in their communities.

The two-time Academic All-Big Ten honoree, Big Ten Distinguished Scholar, and Dean's List member is active in the eastern Iowa community, volunteering with numerous charities, organizations, and local elementary schools.

HAWKEYES IN BIG TEN PLAY:

Iowa head coach Lisa Bluder is a three-time Big Ten Coach of the Year (2001, 2008 and 2010). She has guided Iowa to 10 upper-division finishes in the Big Ten in 14 seasons. Iowa won a share of the Big Ten regular season championship in 2008 and finished in a three-way tie for second in 2009. The Hawkeyes clinched a share of the title in 2008 with a win at Wisconsin in the regular season finale (March 2, 2008).

Since the 2008 season, Iowa has finished first once, second twice, third twice, fourth once, and seventh once.

IOWA PICKED 3RD: LOGIC NAMED ALL-BIG TEN:

Iowa was picked to finish third behind Maryland and Michigan State in the 2014-15 Coaches Big Ten preseason rankings, while senior Samantha Logic was named preseason All-Big Ten by league media and coaches.

Logic earned honorable mention All-America honors from the *Associated Press* and the WBCA as a junior last year. The Racine, Wisconsin, native was a unanimous first team All-Big Ten selection by the coaches, and a first team selection by the media to become the 18th Iowa player to garner first team All-Big Ten honors -- the most of any Big Ten program.



MOST BIG VICTORIES:

Head coach Lisa Bluder has 146 career Big Ten victories (146-93), surpassing former Ohio State head coach Jim Foster (136) for the fourth-most in league history. Rene Portland of Penn State has the most in conference history (176). Former Hawkeye head coach and current Rutgers coach C. Vivian Stringer is tied for first with 176 wins, and Karen Langeland of Michigan State has the third most (156).

DIXON SETS 3-POINT RECORD IN WIN AT DRAKE:

Senior Melissa Dixon made 10 3-pointers (10-of-14) in Iowa's 100-98 win at Drake on Dec. 21, setting a new school record. The previous school record was seven, accomplished five times in program history, twice by Dixon. The NCAA and Big Ten record for 3-pointers in a single game is 12. She finished with 31 points. Dixon was named to the Big Ten Player of the Week Honor Roll.

ANOTHER TRIPLE-DOUBLE:

Senior Samantha Logic notched her fifth career triple-double on Nov. 22, tallying 12 points, 11 rebounds, and 10 assists to lead Iowa over Dayton in the Hawkeye Challenge title game. She is tied for the fifth-most triple-doubles in NCAA history, and has the most of any player as a member of the Big Ten. Suzie McConnell of Penn State (1985-88) and Louella Tomlinson of St. Mary's (CA) (2008-11) hold the career record with seven. Stanford's Nicole Powell (2001-04) and Alyssa Thomas of Maryland (2011-14) both posted six in their careers. Logic, Joskeen Garner (Northwestern State, 1993-96), Shalee Lehning (Kansas State, 2006-09), and Brittney Griner (Baylor, 2010-13), all have five career triple-doubles.

PESCHEL NAMED TO ALLSTATE GOOD WORKS TEAM:

Junior Kali Peschel has been nominated for the 2015 Allstate WBCA Good Works Team®. This prestigious community service award recognizes a distinguished group of student-athletes who have demonstrated a commitment to enriching the lives of others and contributing to the greater good in their communities.

Peschel, a junior from Sauk Centre, Minnesota, has played in every game for the Hawkeyes the last two seasons, making 22 starts. She was a 2014 Academic All-Big Ten honoree.

TOUGH SCHEDULE:

Iowa has played the 11th toughest schedule in the country this season. Iowa's schedule this season features 29 regular season games (18 conference, 11 nonconference). Of those 29 contests, 20 will come against teams that played in a postseason tournament last season. Seventeen-of-24 teams the Hawkeyes play this season reached a postseason tournament a year ago.

With the addition of Maryland and Rutgers to the Big Ten, the 14 league teams will compete in an 18-game conference schedule, playing five teams both home and away and eight teams once. Each team will play four of its single-play opponents at home and four on the road. Iowa plays Minnesota, Nebraska, Northwestern, Ohio State, and Wisconsin twice, while playing the other eight league teams once.

HAWKEYES SET SCHOOL RECORD IN OPENER:

The Hawkeyes defeated USC Upstate in the season-opener on Nov. 14, 107-56, setting a new school record for points in a game. The previous record was 106 against North Carolina in 1990 and Northern Iowa in 1978. Iowa has scored 100 or more points in a game three times this season (100 at Drake, 102 at Northwestern).

NCAA STREAK BEST IN BIG TEN:

Iowa is the only Big Ten team, and one of only 14 teams in the country, to appear in the last seven NCAA Tournaments. There are 349 Division I teams.

Iowa is 1-of-21 teams to advance to the Second Round of the NCAA Tournament in each of the last two seasons. The Hawkeyes, a No. 6 seed in the 2014 NCAA Tournament, defeated 11th-seeded Marist in the First Round, 87-65, marking the fourth-largest margin of victory in an NCAA Tournament game in program history.

LOGIC NAMED PRESEASON ALL-AMERICAN:

Samantha Logic, a 2014 honorable mention All-American, has been named to ESPN's Pre-season All-America Second Team. Logic was joined on the second team by Rachel Banham of Minnesota, Moriah Jefferson of UConn, Isabelle Harrison of Tennessee and Aleighsa Welch of South Carolina. The first team included Jewell Loyd of Notre Dame, Tiffany Mitchell of South Carolina, Kaleena Mosqueda-Lewis of UConn, Nina Davis of Baylor and Breanna Stewart of UConn.

2015 Recruiting Class

Tania Davis (Grand Blanc, Michigan), Megan Gustafson (Port Wing, Wisconsin), Tagyn Larson (Sioux Falls, South Dakota) and Hannah Stewart (Minot, North Dakota) have signed National Letters of Intent to attend the University of Iowa next fall. Iowa's class is ranked 18th nationally by ESPN HoopGurlz.

Davis, a 5-foot-4 guard from Goodrich High School in Grand Blanc, Michigan, is an ESPN HoopGurlz Top 100 recruit, ranking as the 37th-best prospect nationally and the 12th-best point guard. She is ranked as the top prospect in the 2015 class in the state of Michigan by Lady Baller Insider.

The two-time team captain has led Goodrich to three-straight conference titles, a district championship, and two state titles. Davis earned honorable mention all-conference honors as a freshman, leading Goodrich to a 28-0 record and a state title, playing in 28 contests while making six starts. She averaged 8.1 points, 2.1 rebounds, 2.3 assists, and 1.7 steals. As a sophomore, Davis started all 28 games while averaging 17.6 points, 2.7 rebounds, 4.0 assists, 3.2 steals, leading Goodrich to a 25-3 record and a second-consecutive state title. She earned first team all-conference, Basketball Coaches Association Class B All-State, Associated Press Class B Special Mention All-State, Detroit Free Press First Team All-State Class B, and Detroit News First Team All-State Class B honors.

Last year as a junior, Davis led Goodrich to a district title and a 22-3 record, averaging 19.1 points, 3.0 rebounds, 4.1 assists, and 3.2 steals, while starting all 25 games. She earned MLive (Flint) Player of the Year, Associated Press Class B Player of the Year, Basketball Coaches Association Best of the Best (top 11 players in state), Detroit Free Press First Team All-State Class B, Detroit News First Team All-State, and first team all-conference honors. Davis notched five 25-point games, including a 41-point performance. A National Honor Society member, she has been a member of the honor roll every semester since her freshman year.

Gustafson, a 6-foot-3 forward from South Shore High School in Port Wing, Wisconsin, is an ESPN HoopGurlz Top 100 recruit (No. 92). The two-time team captain is a three-time first team all-conference honoree and a two-time first team all-state selection. As a freshman, she averaged 19.9 points, 13.7 rebounds, and 5.3 blocks. Gustafson led South Shore to a conference, regional, and sectional championship as a sophomore, averaging 30.9 points, 12.6 rebounds, and 5.6 blocks in 28 starts as team finished 27-1. Last year as a junior, she started all 27 games, leading team to a 26-1 record and conference and regional titles. Gustafson averaged 29.8 points, 18.9 rebounds, and 5.9 blocks.

Gustafson is also a four-time all-conference selection in volleyball, and competes in the shot put, discus, triple jump, 300-meter hurdles, and 100-meter hurdles in track. She finished seventh in the shot put and 11th in the discus in last year's state track meet. Gustafson, a National Honor Society member, has been an honor roll student throughout high school. She has served as class president all four years of high school, and served as a student council member as a junior.

Larson, a 6-foot-2 forward from Roosevelt High School in Sioux Falls, South Dakota, is a three-time all-state and all-city honoree. She is a two-time all-tournament and all-conference selection, and has been named to the Argus Leader First Five. Larson averaged 12 points and eight rebounds and registered 90 blocks as a sophomore, leading Roosevelt to a conference title. As a junior she averaged 16 points and eight rebounds, tallying 69 blocks. She shot 51 percent from the field and 80 percent from the foul line. Larson holds the school record for career blocks and blocks in a game, and needs 71 rebounds to become the school's career leader.

Larson is a standout outside hitter for the Roosevelt volleyball team, earning all-state, all-conference, and all-city honors. Named a Hometown Hero for her high school, she is also involved in Spanish Club, Cancer Awareness Club, and Fellowship of Christian Athletes.

Stewart, a 6-foot-2 forward from Bishop Ryan High School in Minot, North Dakota, is an ESPN HoopGurlz Top 100 recruit (No. 95). She has played varsity basketball since she was in eighth grade, when she averaged 7.8 points, 6.4 rebounds, 1.7 assists, 1.9 steals, and 1.7 blocks, as team finished third in Region 6. As a freshman, Stewart averaged 18.7 points, 10.2 rebounds, 1.8 assists, 3.6 steals, and 2.2 blocks, leading team to a 26-2 record, a conference title, and a fifth-place finish at the state tournament. She was named all-state, all-region, all-district, and to the state all-tournament team.

Stewart has led Bishop Ryan to a state record 57-game winning streak entering her senior year, winning conference and state championships in each of the last two years. As a sophomore, she averaged 21.9 points, 10.5 rebounds, 2.1 assists, 4.7 steals, and 3.2 blocks, while posting 23.0 points, 11.3 rebounds, 2.4 assists, 4.3 steals, and 2.9 blocks per contest as a junior. A two-time team captain, she has garnered all-state, all-region, all-district, state all-tournament team, and state tournament MVP honors in each of the last two years. Stewart was a Gatorade Player of the Year nominee in 2014, an all-area athlete in 2013 and 2014, and athlete of the year for the state of North Dakota in 2014. She holds school records for career points (1,955), rebounds (1,047), blocks (274), and steals (397), and rebounds in a single game (16).

Stewart is also a standout volleyball player, earning all-district and all-region honors. She plays pitcher and shortstop in softball, and owns the school records for home runs, career hits, and pitching wins. Stewart tossed a no-hitter in the 2013 state tournament. She has guided Bishop Ryan to three-straight conference titles and three-consecutive state runner-up finishes, while being named all-state and state all-tournament four times and a nominee for the Gatorade Player of the Year twice.

A 4.0 student, Stewart serves as National Honor Society president, and is a member of the speech team, Rotary Club, and S.A.D.D. She is also a Special Olympics volunteer and plays violin in the orchestra.

LOGIC NAMED TO WOODEN AWARD / WADE WATCH / NAISMITH LISTS:

Samantha Logic, named Preseason All-Big Ten and preseason All-America by ESPN, was named to the John R. Wooden Award Women's Preseason Top 30 list, comprised of the early front-runners for college basketball's most prestigious honor. The list is chosen by a preseason poll of national women's college basketball media members.

She has also been named a 2014-15 "Wade Watch" list candidate for the prestigious award (The Wade Trophy), the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) announced.

In addition, Logic has been named to the Naismith Trophy Women's Top 50 Watch List, the Atlanta Tipoff Club announced.

ANOTHER TOP ATTENDANCE YEAR:

Iowa currently ranks 18th in average attendance (4,652). Iowa ranked 22nd in the country in attendance last season, averaging 4,395 fans per contest. Last year marks the fourth-straight season that Iowa has ranked inside the top 25 in attendance. The Hawkeyes were 19th in attendance in each of the previous two years, and were 13th in 2010.

DIXON REACHES 1,000. NAMED TO BIG HONOR ROLL:

Iowa senior Melissa Dixon was named to the Big Ten Player of the Week Honor Roll on Nov. 17 after recording her 1,000th-career point and averaging 18.5 points per game in a pair of wins over USC Upstate (107-65) and Robert Morris (85-67). She is Iowa's 32nd career 1,000-point scorer.

THE STATE SWEEP:

- The Hawkeyes finished 3-0 this season against in-state rivals, and are 20-4 against Drake, Iowa State and UNI since the start of the 2007-08 season.
- Iowa defeated UNI on Nov. 25 in Iowa City, 73-45.
- The Hawkeyes downed Iowa State on Dec. 11, 76-67, at Carver-Hawkeye Arena.
- Iowa won at Drake, 100-98, on Dec. 21.

IOWA HISTORY:

Iowa has played 1,189 games since beginning basketball in 1974. Iowa's overall record is 736-453 (.618). That includes a 367-185 (.667) mark in regular season Big Ten contests and a 361-101 (.781) mark in Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

WATCH THE HAWKEYES:

Twenty-six of Iowa's 29 regular season contests can be seen on BTN, BTN Plus, ESPN2, ESPN3, or MC22 (Mediacom Connections). Seventeen games will appear on BTN or digitally on BTN Plus, and two additional regular season contests will be televised by ESPN2. All 18 of Iowa's league games can be seen on one of the BTN or ESPN platforms, and the Hawkeyes' home nonconference victory against Iowa State on Dec. 11 was televised by BTN. Iowa is 17-0 when playing on BTN since the start of last season.

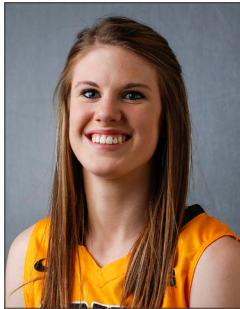
