Multi-Sport Opportunities



Student-athletes who have the talent, and the desire, to excel in two sports at the NCAA Division I level have the opportunity to do so at the University of Iowa. The list of former Iowa track and field student-athletes who have excelled in a second sport includes such standouts as **Tim Dwight**, **Bashir Yamini**, **Jeremy Allen**, **Quinn Early**, **Chris Gambol**, **Gary Kostrubala**, **Tim Dodge**, **Nick Bell**, **Robert Smith** and **Eric Rothwell**.

Two current team members are listed on both the track and football rosters. Wide receivers **Paul Chaney, Jr.** and **Trey Stross** are set to compete on the gridiron this fall and the track next spring. Chaney, Jr., is a four-time NCAA regional qualifier who anchored the winning men's 400-meter relay (40.71) and the Iowa's men's 800-meter relay to a school-record (1:24.85) at the 2009 Drake Relays. The St. Louis, MO, native also ran the second leg on Iowa's sprint medley relay that placed second in 3:20.05, which ranks third in school history. He led the team in the 60 and 200 meters indoors the last three seasons, and led the Hawkeyes in the 100 and 200 meters last outdoor season, as well as ran on the team-leading 400-meter, 800-meter and sprint medley relays. Stross scored points for Iowa in the high jump at both the Big Ten indoor and outdoor meets in 2008.

Dwight leads the list of former two-sport standouts, earning all-America honors in both football and track before moving on to a career in the NFL. A senior all-American in 1997, Dwight returned to compete for Iowa's track team after his rookie season with the Atlanta Falcons. He earned all-America honors as a member of the 1,600-meter relay team. Dwight was named Athlete of the Meet at the 1999 Big Ten Outdoor Championships when he won the 100 meters and ran the second legs of Iowa's winning 400 and 1,600-meter relays.


Yamini is Iowa's most recent NCAA champion, winning the long jump in 1998. He still shares the Big Ten Outdoor Championships long jump record of 26-8 1/4 with the legendary Jesse Owens of Ohio State. A nine-time Big Ten champion and six-time all-American from 1996-99, Yamini used his 1999 stint at wide receiver as a stepping stone to a career in the NFL.

Allen is the only thrower in conference history to win Big Ten Freshman of the Year honors during the indoor and outdoor seasons of his rookie year. He was a four-time Big Ten champion and five-time all-American for the Hawkeyes from 1998-2001. Allen was a two-year starter at fullback who signed an NFL contract with the Minnesota Vikings following the 2002 NFL Draft.


Dodge, a senior on the 2001 Hawkeye football squad, earned all-America honors while competing in sprint events for Iowa's track team. Dodge played both wide receiver and defensive back in football and led the team in punt and kickoff returns in 1999. He signed an NFL contract with the Tennessee Titans following the 2002 NFL Draft and remains active in arena football.

Bell, the recipient of the *Chicago Tribune's* Silver Football as the 1990 Big Ten Player of the Year, ran indoor track during the off season leading into his senior year with the Iowa football team. He saw running track as an opportunity to work on his speed and explosiveness.


Early, a four-year football letterman who played wide receiver for the NFL's San Diego Chargers, New Orleans Saints and Buffalo Bills, won Big Ten long jump titles at the indoor and outdoor meets in 1986. His collegiate best (25-7 1/4) still ranks fifth in Iowa outdoor history.




Ashton Cross Country Course

The Bill and Jim Ashton Cross Country Course is located west of Finkbine Golf Course and adjacent to the University's West Campus project, which includes the Athletic Hall of Fame and soccer fields. It is able to accommodate races of 5,000, 6,000, 8,000 and 10,000 meters.

The course boasts a rolling terrain with an outstanding rhythm for running. The Hawkeye cross country squads have the advantage of a large grass area for training and racing. Some features include a 2,000-meter perimeter and a layout that will enable spectators to view the entire race, from start to finish, from one vantage point. The first event held on the course was the Iowa Invitational on August 29, 2003. The course was dedicated on October 31, 2004, in conjunction with Iowa hosting the Big Ten Championships. The Hawkeyes also hosted the NCAA Midwest Regional on November 12, 2005.

The leadership gift for the course was made by former Hawkeyes Bill and Jim Ashton. Bill, of Davenport, IA, graduated from the University's College of Engineering in 1962, and earned his master's degree in 1963. Jim, a 1964 University of Iowa College of Engineering graduate, currently resides in Dallas, TX. The Ashton brothers lettered in cross country under former Hawkeye men's coach, the late Francis X. Cretzmeyer, and made the lead gift for the course in his honor.

UI Recreation Building

Iowa's indoor practice and competition facility is the multi-million dollar University of Iowa Recreation Building. Located within walking distance of the University's west-side dormitories, Kinnick Stadium and Carver-Hawkeye Arena, the Recreation Building houses a six-lane mondo-Turf circuit that was resurfaced in 2002.

Locker rooms, weight training and athletic training space for the Iowa track and field, and cross country teams is also located in the Recreation Building.

The Hawkeyes hosted the Big Ten Indoor Men's Championships in 1989, 1997 and 2006, and the Big Ten Indoor Women's Championships in 1991 and 2004 at the facility.

Francis X. Cretzmeyer Track

The University of Iowa track and field team practices and competes at the Francis X. Cretzmeyer Track during the outdoor season. Located within walking distance of Carver-Hawkeye Arena and Pearl Field, the track was completed in 1986. The facility was named after the late Francis X. Cretzmeyer, who coached the men's cross country and track teams from 1948-78 and led the Hawkeyes to five Big Ten team titles.

In June 2008, floodwaters and debris damaged the entire track complex, which will be completely reconstructed and refinished for competition in 2010. Cretzmeyer Track features an IAAF certified, BSS 1000 track and field surface designed by Benyon Sports Surfaces. The state of the art full-pour polyurethane surface provides the resiliency and return of energy necessary for NCAA athletes to compete at the highest level and train intensively without injury.

Iowa hosted the 1987 and 2000 Big Ten Championships at Cretzmeyer Track, as well as the annual Iowa Musco Twilight Invitational. The Hawkeyes are scheduled to host the 2011 Big Ten Outdoor Championships.
