### **Iowa Corn Cy-Hawk Series Game Quick Hits**

- Hawkeye fans are encouraged to "Be Bold, Wear Gold" on Friday.
- Iowa has won 11 of its last 12 home games, dating back to Feb. 1.
- The Hawkeyes will not leave the state of Iowa until Jan. 6 when they travel to Ann Arbor, Mich., to face nationally-ranked Michigan.
- · Iowa's first nine games have been decided by eight points or more. Four of the Hawkeyes' seven victories have come by a margin of 20 points or more.
- Roy Devyn Marble has scored in double figures in all nine games.
- Aaron White leads the team in rebounding (6.4), and free throws made (51) and attempted (65), and ranks second in scoring (13.7).
- The Hawkeyes have attempted 20 or more free throws in seven of their nine games, including attempting 39 (made 31) against Wichita State.
- Iowa is 12-2 when scoring 80 points or more, the last three seasons. The Hawkeyes are 19-0 when holding opponents to fewer than 60 points, the last three years.
- · Iowa started three freshmen (Clemmons, Gesell and Woodbury) the last two games. The last time the Hawkeyes started three rookies in a game was on Dec. 2, 2008 at Boston College.

### <u>IOWA CORN CY-HAWK SERIES</u>

Iowa State currently leads the annual Iowa Corn Cy-Hawk Series, 9-4. Six points are up for grabs this week: women's hoops (Thursday), and men's hoops and women's swimming (Friday). The Cyclones have recorded

wins in football (3 points), men's and women's cross country (4 points) and volleyball. The Hawkeyes posted victories in soccer (2 points) and wrestling (2 points).

### HAWKEYES POST SECOND STRAIGHT VICTORY

- lowa closed the first half on a 21-7 run and never looked back en route to an 87-63 triumph over South Dakota on Tuesday night in Iowa City.
- Four players posted double figures: Aaron White (21), Roy Devyn Marble (14), Mike Gesell (12), and Adam Woodbury (10).
- Iowa outrebounded the Coyotes by 19 (50-31). The 50 rebounds are the fourth most by a Hawkeye team under Fran McCaffery.
- Iowa drained 17-of-19 from the free throw line, shooting at an 89.5 percent clip. The 89.5 percent shooting ranks as the second best by a Hawkeye team under McCaffery.
- Anthony Clemmons dished out eight assists and had zero turnovers in his second start.
- Gabriel Olaseni posted career bests in scoring (8) and rebounds (9) in only 11 minutes.
- Iowa scored 54 of its 87 points in the paint and had 24 second chance points.

# **Head Coach Fran McCaffery**

Fran McCaffery is in his third season as the head basketball coach at the University of Iowa and his 17th year overall as a college head coach. McCaffery spent five seasons (2005-10) as the head coach at Siena, six years at UNC-Greensboro (1999-2005) and three seasons at Lehigh (1985-88) before joining the Hawkeyes.



McCaffery has three decades of Division I coaching experience. He completed his

30th season as a collegiate coach in 2012, which includes 16 years as a head coach and 14 as an assistant.

McCaffery, 53, holds a career mark of 287-216 (.570) and guided his teams to seven postseason appearances (five NCAA, two NIT). He is 36-39 (.480) at Iowa.

McCaffery's five years at Siena were the best in its 70-year history. He led the Saints on an incredible run that ended with three straight Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference championships and NCAA Tournament appearances. In so doing, Siena became the only program in the country to win its regular season and postseason title the last three years.

McCaffery's Saints owned a 112-51 (.687) record in his five years with the program. He guided the Saints to four consecutive 20-win seasons, something that has never been accomplished before at the Siena.

The 2009 MAAC Coach of the Year and 2010 District I Coach of the Year is the third winningest coach, by percentage, in league history (68-22, .756). He is the only coach to guide a MAAC program to two NCAA Tournament wins. McCaffery led his 2008 and 2009 teams to first round NCAA Tournament victories over Vanderbilt and Ohio State, respectively.

In his final two seasons at Siena, he coached the Saints to back-to-back 27-win campaigns and boasted a combined 39-3 (.929) record against MAAC opponents, which included MAAC Tournament contests.

McCaffery began his coaching career as an assistant at Penn (1982-83) and Lehigh (1983-85). Then at age 26, he became the nation's youngest Division I head coach when hired by Lehigh in 1985. After three seasons as head coach at Lehigh, he spent 11 seasons as an assistant at Notre Dame (1988-99).

McCaffery played basketball at Wake Forest his freshman year (1977-78) and then concluded his collegiate playing career at Penn his final three seasons (1979-82).

He earned his B.S. degree in Economics from The Wharton School (Penn) in 1982. McCaffery also earned a Master of Education from Lehigh in 1985.

### HAWKEYE FASTBREAKS

- The Hawkeyes have played 10 players or more in each of the first nine games.
- Aaron White is attacking the rim, averaging a team-best 7.2 free-throw attempts per game. He is averaging 5.7 free-throw makes per outing. His 51 makes and 65 attempts are superior in the Big Ten, both ranking first by a wide margin.
- Iowa has made (168) more free throws than its opponents have attempted (159), which is a staple of Fran McCaffery-coached teams.
- Roy Devyn Marble scored 15 of his season-high 22 points in the first half against Howard. It marked the third time in his career the junior reached the 20-point plateau.
- Aaron White has scored a season-high 21 points in two of lowa's last three outings. White had 21 points on 8-of-15 shooting and 5-of-6 from the foul line at Virginia Tech. He had 21 points on 7-of-11 shooting (1-of-1 from distance) and 6-of-6 from the charity stripe versus South Dakota on Tuesday. The sophomore has reached the 20-point plateau four times in his career.
- The Hawkeyes have four players who have made 10 or more triples: Oglesby (13), Marble (10), Gesell (10), and McCabe (10).
- Roy Devyn Marble (31) and Mike Gesell (30) lead the squad in assists.
- Gabriel Olaseni has averaged seven points and five rebounds in Iowa's last two games.
- Iowa has had an attendance figure of 10,500 fans or greater at all six home contests.
- Iowa blocked 10 shots vs. UT-Pan American in its season opener, the most by an Iowa team since Nov. 14, 2005 (Md.-Eastern Shore).

### HAWKEYE DEFENSE IMPROVING

Last year, Iowa allowed opponents 72.5 points per contest. Through nine games in 2012, Iowa is yielding 61.7 points. Iowa held Howard to 36 points on Nov. 15, which were the fewest points a Hawkeye team allowed since a 61-36 win over Bryant on Dec. 5, 2008.

### ALL-TIME SERIES

lowa holds a 42-23 advantage in the series that began with a 30-27 Hawkeye win in 1910. lowa State has won the last three meetings: 81-71 in Ames (2009); 75-72 in lowa City (2010), and 86-76 in Ames (2011). The two teams have split the last 16 meetings. The home team has won seven of the last eight games (Iowa State won in Iowa City in 2010).

The teams split games during the 2003-04 campaign. That marked the first time since 1921 that the teams met twice in the same season and it was the first time the teams met in postseason action.

Just eight of the last 23 games have had a final margin of eight points or less.

Iowa had three players score in double figures to lead the visitors: Roy Devyn Marble, Melsahn Basabe and Matt Gatens. Marble posted then-personal bests in scoring and assists, leading all scorers with 21 points and dishing out a team-best five assists. Basabe tallied 18 points to go along with a game-high nine rebounds. Gatens scored nine of his 11 points in the second half.

lowa State shot 55 percent (28-of-51) from the field, including 59 percent (19-of-32) from the floor the first 20 minutes.

lowa sank 88 percent of its free-throw attempts (22-of-25), including 16-of-17 (.941) in the second stanza.

- Iowa State will be playing its second true road game of the season on Friday. The Cyclones lost at UNLV (82-70) on Nov. 24.
- The Cyclones scored 83 points in each of their last two victories (BYU and Florida Gulf Coast).
- The Cyclones have three players who average double figures in scoring: Will Clyburn (16.1), Tyrus McGee (14.3) and Melvin Ejim (11.0).
- Iowa State ranks sixth in the country in 3-point percentage defense (.248) and rebounding margin (+11.6), 12th in 3-pointers made (9.5), 13th in scoring margin (17.8) and 14th in scoring offense (82.5).

Basabe is averaging 8.1 points and 4.8 rebounds. He also has rejected a team-best 13 shots, blocking four shots in two games (Central Michigan and Western Kentucky).

May is averaging 4.9 points and 3.9 rebounds. His scoring numbers have been aided by his ability to attack the basket and get to the free throw line in the early stages of the season. May is 18-of-23 (.783) from the charity stripe through nine games. Last season, May was 15-of-24 (.610) from the foul line in 33 contests.

Thirteen of Oglesby's 15 field goals have come from beyond the arc. The sophomore averages 5.6 points in the early stages of the season.

### WHITE. WOODBURY RECEIVE PRESEASON RECOGNITION

Sophomore Aaron White has been named preseason third team All-Big Ten by the website College Sports Madness, while Adam Woodbury was named by CBSSports.com as a top 30 freshman to make an impact.

White, who was named to the 2012 Kyle Macy Freshman All-America team, averaged 11.1 points and a team-best 5.7 rebounds a year ago.

Woodbury, is a three-time All-State honoree, and was tabbed MVP of the NBA Top 100 Camp in 2011. The 7-foot-1 center topped 1,000 career points and rebounds in his prep career for Sioux City East High School.

# **Peter Jok Signs With Hawkeyes**

University of Iowa Men's Basketball Coach Fran McCaffery announced today that Peter Jok has signed a National Letter of Intent to attend the University of Iowa.

"We are thrilled that Peter Jok is going to become part of the Hawkeye family," said McCaffery. "He has a complete skillset that will be a great asset to our team. He's an excellent athlete who can play four different positions, and is a terrific 3-point shooter. Peter is exactly what we are looking for in this class."

Jok is a 6-foot-6, 200-pound guard born in Sudan, who played his first two years as a prep at Des Moines Roosevelt, and his last two at West Des Moines Valley. Last season at Valley, Jok earned second team all-conference honors after averaging 10.2 points. He hit 86 percent of his free throws, grabbed 4.3 rebounds and made 37 percent of his 3-point attempts. Jok's high school coach at Valley is Jeff Horner, Iowa's all-time assist leader.

As a sophomore at Roosevelt, Jok averaged 18.5 points and seven rebounds and was a second team all-state and first team all-conference honoree. He was also one of 30 high school freshmen invited to the Nike Top 100 Camp in St. Louis in 2010, and participated in the 2012 NBA Players Association Top 100 Camp.

Jok played AAU basketball on the All-Iowa Attack.

Jok will join Jarrod Uthoff, who transferred to Iowa from the University of Wisconsin this year, on the 2013-14 active Iowa roster.

### **BLOCK PARTY**

Last season, Iowa amassed 199 blocks in 35 games (3.4 per game). So far this season, the Hawkeyes have been credited with 49 rejections (5.4 per contest), which rank second in the conference and 22nd nationally.

Melsahn Basabe leads the team with 13 blocked shots, freshman center Adam Woodbury has 10, while sophomore Gabriel Olaseni has eight.

Iowa started three freshmen in its last two outings: Anthony Clemmons, Mike Gesell and Adam Woodbury. The last time the Hawkeyes started three rookies (Aaron Fuller, Matt Gatens and Anthony Tucker) was on Dec. 2, 2008 at Boston College.

### **IOWA POSTS LARGEST COMEBACK IN SCHOOL HISTORY**

Iowa trailed Gardner-Webb by 23 points (38-15) with 13 seconds left in the first half on Nov. 17 in Iowa City. Sophomore Josh Oglesby drained three free throws after being fouled on a 3-point attempt with one second remaining in the half to cut the deficit to 20 (38-18) at halftime. The Hawkeyes rallied in the second half and ultimately won by nine points (65-56), which is a 32-point swing. The comeback is believed to be the largest in school his-

The last team in the country to overcome a 20+ halftime deficit was Harvard, which trailed Brown by 22 points (53-31) and won 85-78 on Feb. 12, 2011.

The last Big Ten team to overcome a 20+ halftime deficit was Illinois, which trailed at Clemson by 20 points (47-27) and won 76-74 on Dec. 2, 2009.


