Game #2 Quick Hits

- Tickets can be purchased at the UI Ticket Office. Tickets are \$15 for adults and \$5 for youths and UI students. Sunday is a women-men's basketball doubleheader with the women hosting No. 14 Dayton at 1:05 p.m. Fans with a men's ticket are welcome to attend the women's game with their men's ticket.
- Sunday will be the second meeting between Iowa and Nebraska-Omaha. The Hawkeyes beat the Mavericks, 71-58, on Nov. 30, 1981, in the only previous meeting. Iowa is 35-3 (.921) against current members of The Summit League.
- On Friday, Jarrod Uthoff (14 points, seven rebounds, four blocks) became only the second Big Ten player since the 1996-97 season to register 14-plus points, seven-plus rebounds and four-plus blocks in his first career game (Ohio State's Greg Oden, 2006-07).
- Iowa is 18-2 when scoring 80 points or more, the last three seasons. The Hawkeyes are 32-1 when holding opponents to fewer than 61 points, the last four seasons.
- Roy Devyn Marble needs four points to surpass Bob Hansen and Kevin Kunnert for 26th place on Iowa's career scoring chart.
- Iowa's first five games to start the 2013-14 season will be at home.

THE SETTING

Iowa will play its second game in three days when it entertains Nebraska-Omaha on Sunday. Tipoff is slated for 3:32 p.m. (CT) on Mediacom Court at Carver-Hawkeye Arena (15,400). Sunday's game will be played as part of a basketball doubleheader; the Iowa women are scheduled to host No. 14 Dayton at 1:05 p.m.

Fans are encouraged to purchase tickets to Sunday's basketball games in advance. Tickets to the women's game cost \$10 for adults, \$6 for youth, while UI students are admitted free. Tickets to the men's game cost \$15 for adults and \$5 for boys and girls high school aged and younger, and UI students. Tickets can be purchased online at hawk-eyesports.com, over the phone at 1-800 IA-HAWKS, and at the UI Athletics Ticket Office in Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

ON THE AIR

Radio: Iowa games are broadcast on the Hawkeye Radio Network. Gary Dolphin handles the play-by-play, along with color commentator Bob Hansen. The network includes more than 40 stations that blanket the state of Iowa and include portions of Illinois, Nebraska, Minnesota, Missouri and Wisconsin. The Hawkeye Radio Network coverage includes a 60-minute pregame show.

Television/Webstream: There is no television coverage for Sunday afternoon's contest. However, fans can watch the game online via ESPN3.com. BJ Schaben and Kevin Lehman will call the action.

HOME COOKIN'

Iowa posted a school-record 18 home wins last season (18-2), the most since posting 17 home victories in 2006. Iowa's two losses came by less than four points to nationally-ranked teams (Michigan State and Indiana). Iowa was 11-0 against nonconference opponents a year ago at home.

The Hawkeyes have won 20-straight home games against unranked opponents, dating back to the Dayton game on March 13, 2012 -- the third-longest active streak in the Big Ten.

Head Coach Fran McCaffery

Fran McCaffery is entering his fourth season as the head basketball coach at the University of Iowa and his 18th year overall as a college head coach. McCaffery spent five seasons (2005-10) as the head coach at Siena, six years at UNC-Greensboro (1999-2005) and three seasons at Lehigh (1985-88) before joining the Hawkeyes.



McCaffery has three decades of Division I coaching experience. He completed his 31st season as a collegiate coach in 2013, which includes 17 years as a head coach and 14 as an assistant.

McCaffery, 54, holds a career mark of 306-227 (.574) and guided his teams to eight postseason appearances (five NCAA, three NIT). He is 55-50 (.524) at Iowa.

Since taking over the Iowa program in 2010, the Hawkeyes have increased their win total by 15 games. McCaffery coached Iowa to 25 victories in 2013, equaling the second-most win total in program history. McCaffery has guided the Black and Gold to back-to-back NIT appearances, including a runner-up finish in 2013.

McCaffery and the Hawkeyes have made Carver-Hawkeye Arena one of the most feared arenas to play nationally. Fans have embraced McCaffery and his team's style of play with attendance increasing by 30 percent since 2010. The Hawkeyes won a school-record 18 home games a year ago, which includes 19 straight against unranked opponents dating back to 2012 -- the third-longest active streak in the Big Ten.

McCaffery's five years at Siena were the best in its 70-year history. He led the Saints on an incredible run that ended with three straight Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference championships and NCAA Tournament appearances. In so doing, Siena became the only program in the country to win its regular season and postseason title 2008-10.

McCaffery's Saints owned a 112-51 (.687) record in his five years with the program. He guided the Saints to four consecutive 20-win seasons.

The 2009 MAAC Coach of the Year and 2010 District I Coach of the Year is the third winningest coach, by percentage, in league history (.68-22, .756). He is the only coach to guide a MAAC program to two NCAA Tournament wins. McCaffery led his 2008 and 2009 teams to first round NCAA Tournament victories over Vanderbilt and Ohio State, respectively.

In his final two seasons at Siena, he coached the Saints to back-to-back 27-win campaigns and boasted a combined 39-3 (.929) record against MAAC opponents, which included MAAC Tournament contests.

McCaffery began his coaching career as an assistant at Penn (1982-83) and Lehigh (1983-85). After three seasons as head coach at Lehigh, he spent 11 seasons as an assistant at Notre Dame (1988-99).

McCaffery played basketball at Wake Forest his freshman year (1977-78) and then concluded his collegiate playing career at Penn his final three seasons (1979-82).

He earned his B.S. degree in Economics from The Wharton School (Penn) in 1982. McCaffery also earned a Master of Education from Lehigh in 1985.

HAWKEYES OVERWHELM UNC WILMINGTON

- Twelve Hawkeyes scored en route to an 82-39 victory over UNC Wilmington in Iowa City to opener the season. The 43-point victory matched the 37th-largest margin of victory in program history.
- Friday night's attendance of 15,293 is Iowa's largest crowd for a home opener since 15,500 saw Iowa beat Maryland-Eastern Shore in the 2001 opener.
- Iowa pulled down 56 rebounds, which equaled the most by a Hawkeye team under Fran McCaffery (56 vs. Brown in 2011 and 56 vs. SC State in 2012).
- The Hawkeyes blocked 12 shots, one shy of the school record of 13 set last season against Illinois. Junior Gabriel Olaseni rejected five shots, all in the first half.
- Iowa's 36-point halftime advantage over vs UNC Wilmington is its largest under Fran McCaffery (33 vs. SIU-Edwardsville in 2010).
- Iowa held the Seahawks to 2-of-23 (.087) shooting from 3-point territory and 16-of-72 (.222) from the field overall. The Hawkeyes held the Seahawks' starting backcourt (Chris Dixon and Freddie Jackson) to 1-of-19 shooting from the field.
- Friday was the 500th all-time men's basketball game in Carver-Hawkeye Arena. The Hawkeyes improved the home record to 381-119 (.762) with Friday night's win.
- Iowa has won three consecutive season openers under Fran McCaffery.

NEWCOMERS PERFORM IN OPENER

Freshman Peter Jok and sophomore transfer Jarrod Uthoff combined for 25 points and 12 rebounds in their first collegiate game of their career. Uthoff also contributed seven rebounds and four blocks, while Jok snagged five boards.

Uthoff became only the second Big Ten player since the 1996-97 season to register 14-plus points, seven-plus rebounds and four-plus blocks in his first career game (Ohio State's Greg Oden, 2006-07).

OGLESBY BREAKS FOOT. OUT APPROXIMATELY 6 WEEKS

Junior Josh Oglesby broke a bone in his right foot during practice on Nov. 6. The shooting guard had surgery on Nov. 8 and is expected to miss approximately six weeks.

Oglesby (6-foot-5, 208 pounds) played in 37 contests, including two starts, a year ago. The native of Cedar Rapids, Iowa, scored 126 of his 165 points from 3-point territory in his sophomore campaign.

Iowa is receiving votes in both the Associated Press and USA Today Coaches preseason polls.

SCOUTING NEBRASKA-OMAHA

- Nebraska-Omaha comes to Iowa City with a 1-0 record after recording a come-from-behind 68-66 victory at Northern Illinois Friday night. The Mavericks shot 84 percent (27-of-32) from the foul line in the road victory.
- The Mavericks trailed the Huskies 39-28 at halftime, but outscored Northern Illinois 40-27 in the final 20 minutes. CJ Carter led Nebraska-Omaha scoring a game-high 18 points, while also collecting six rebounds and four assists.
- Nebraska-Omaha is a member of The Summit League. The Mavericks finished 11-20 last season and finished sixth in conference with a 6-10 record.
- Darrin Hansen enters his ninth season as head coach of the Mavericks. In his eight years at the helm he has compiled a record of 133-106, and guided the Mavericks to two NCAA Division II Tournament appearances and conference championships before UNO announced its reclassification to Division I.
- The Mavericks return four starters from a year ago including first-team preseason All-Summit selection Justin Simmons. The senior guard averaged 16.7 points, four rebounds, and two assists during 2012-13 campaign.

STAT LEADERS RETURN

Iowa returns its leading scorer, rebounder, shot blocker, distributor and thief from a year ago. Roy Devyn Marble returns for his senior season after leading the Hawkeyes in scoring (15.0) and assists (3.0). Aaron White had a sensational sophomore campaign, leading the team in rebounding (6.2) and ranking second in scoring (12.8). Melsahn Basabe returns for his final year after leading the team in rejections (1.2), while a healthy Mike Gesell returns for his sophomore season after pacing the Black and Gold with 1.2 steals a year ago.

White, who led the Hawkeyes in rebounding in each of his first two seasons, is looking to become the fifth player since 1960 to lead the Hawkeyes in rebounding three consecutive seasons. White would join Don Nelson (1960-62); Kevin Kunnert (1971-73); Bruce King (1975-77); and Greg Brunner (2004-06).

Likewise, Basabe led the team in blocked shots in each of his first three seasons with the Hawkeyes. The senior will be looking to become the third Hawkeye since 1980 to lead the squad in rejections four straight seasons. Greg Stokes led the team in blocks 1982-86, while Acie Earl led the team from 1990-93.

- Sophomore Mike Gesell celebrated his 20th birthday on Saturday.
- Iowa's average starting lineup height is 6-foot-6. The Hawkeye starting lineup consists of two sophomores, one junior, and two seniors.
- Sunday will be the first time Iowa will have played a game on Nov. 10.
- Iowa's attendance has increased each season since Fran McCaffery's arrival in Iowa City. The Hawkeyes averaged 11,635 in 16 games in 2011; 11,908 fans in 19 contests in 2012; and 13,625 in 20 games last season. Iowa's attendance boost from 2012 to 2013 ranked as the eighth-largest in the country.
- Fran McCaffery has guided Iowa to win improvements in each of his first three seasons, going from 11 wins, to 18, to 25 last year. McCaffery's highest win total as a head coach is when he coached Siena to back-to-back 27-win seasons in 2009 and 2010.
- Roy Devyn Marble and Aaron White have each increased their scoring output each season in an Iowa uniform. Marble averaged 5.7 points as a freshman, to 11.5 his sophomore campaign and 15.0 points last season as a junior. White averaged 11.1 points as a rookie and 12.8 points last year as a sophomore.
- Roy Devyn Marble averaged 20.6 points, 2.4 steals, 4.6 assists and four rebounds in five NIT games last season. He was one of only three Big Ten players to average 15+ points and 3+ assists (Trey Burke of Michigan and D.J. Newbill of Penn State) in 2013.
- Darius Stokes has earned a scholarship after being a walk-on the last three seasons. The Cedar Rapids, Iowa, native is a redshirt junior.
- Okey Ukah has been added to the roster as a walk-on. The Iowa City native is a junior.
