SCOUTING OHIO STATE

The No. 9 Ohio State Buckeyes are a perfect 14-0 overall and 1-0 in conference play. The Buckeyes are 11-0 at Value City Arena this season.

In its last game, Ohio State defeated Wisconsin, 77-61, to open Big Ten play. Four Buckeyes scored double figures, led by Tayler Hill's 21 points. Samantha Prahalis had 12 points and 11 assists while playing all 40 minutes. Ashley Adams had 14 points and Kalpana Beach led the team with eight rebounds. Ohio State out-scored Wisconsin, 38-16 in the paint.

Hill leads Ohio State with 21.2 points per game and is shooting .503 (98-195) from the field, including .416 (37-89) from three-point range. Prahalis is next at 17.5 points. Beach is the team's leading rebounder, with 6.3 boards per contest.

As a team, Ohio State leads the Big Ten in scoring (78.9 points per game) and field goal percentage (404-844, .474).

IOWA VS. OHIO STATE NOTES

- Friday will be the 57th meeting between the two schools, with Ohio State holding a slim 30-26 advantage in the all-time series. Ohio State has won 15 of the last 17 meetings, dating back to the 2002-03 season. Iowa's two wins in that stretch came during the 2008-09 season (85-75, Feb. 12, 2009) and last season in Iowa City (89-76, Jan. 8, 2011). The Hawkeyes hold a 7-18 record in Columbus, including a 1-10 record at Value City Arena. Iowa's last win at Ohio State was Feb. 20, 1998 (74-71).
- The top two free throw shooters in the Big Ten will face off Monday night. Samantha Prahalis leads the conference with a .920 percentage. Jaime Printy is second at .908.
- Iowa Head Coach Lisa Bluder and Ohio State Head Coach Jim Foster are the longest-tenured Big Ten coaches. Bluder is in her 12th season at Iowa and has 220 wins as a Hawkeye. Foster is in his 10th year at Ohio State with 250 wins.

LAST MEETING

Ohio State defeated Iowa, 71-61, in the quarterfinals of last year's Big Ten Tournament.

The contest was tied at 27 at halftime but Ohio State built a 52-40 lead with 10 minutes left in the second half. The Hawkeyes responded with an 11-0 run in the next five minutes to pull the game to 52-51. Ohio State maintained a small advantage throughout the remainder of the game to hold on for the win.

Jaime Printy led Iowa with 19 points and five assists. Morgan Johnson had 10 points, nine rebounds and four blocks.

Ohio State was led by Birttany Johnson's 23 points. Jantel Lavender had 11 points and 14 rebounds, while Tayler Hill had 12 points and five assists.

HAWKEYES OPEN BIG TEN SEASON WITH VICTORY

lowa used a furious scoring run early in the first half en route to an 86-55 win over Northwestern (Dec. 30) to open the conference season with a win.

Kamille Wahlin drained a three-pointer at the 15:11 mark in the first half to spark a 22-5 run over the next 4:58. The Hawkeyes drained six-straight three-pointers during the run to take a 35-18 advantage. Iowa finished with 12 three-pointers and shot .444 from long distance.

Four players scored double figures, led by Jaime Printy with 20 points. Wahlin (16), Morgan Johnson (14) and Melissa Dixon (10) led lowa in scoring. Johnson was also one rebound shy of a double-double, while Printy (8) and Wahlin (7) led the team in assists.

PRINTY AND WAHLIN SHARING WELL

Kamille Wahlin and Jaime Printy have been unselfish in Iowa's last five games, while holding on to the ball. The two have combined for 54 of Iowa's 96 assists over the last five games.

Wahlin has recorded 28 assists over the five-game stretch and has only committed 10 turnovers. Printy has 26 assists to 13 turnovers.

Wahlin dished out five assists vs. Western Illinois (Dec. 9), six at Bradley (Dec. 17), three vs. Drake (Dec. 20) and seven vs. Mississippi Valley State (Dec. 22) and Northwestern (Dec. 30)

Printy recorded four assists vs. Western Illinois (Dec. 9), seven at Bradley (Dec. 17), three vs. Drake (Dec. 20) four vs. Mississippi Valley State (Dec. 22) and eight vs. Northwestern (Dec. 30).

IMPROVING FROM LONG DISTANCE

The Hawkeyes have improved their three-point shooting by 20 percentage points over the past two games.

lowa entered its final non-conference game vs. Missississippi Valley State shooting .322 (78-242) from beyond the arc. Entering Monday's game at Ohio State, the Hawkeyes are at .342 (104-304).

In their last two games, the Hawkeyes have shot a combined .419 (26-62) from three-point distance. lowa drained 14 three-pointers to set a new school record against Mississippi Valley State and followed with 12 treys against Northwestern.

CHARITY STRIPE SUCCESS

The Hawkeyes have cashed in from the free throw line so far this season.

lowa is 228-278 from the charity stripe and their .820 free throw percentage ranks first in the Big Ten and is ranked second-best in latest NCAA statistics.

Individually, Jaime Printy is second in the Big Ten with a .908 percentage and is ranked 27th-nationally in the latest NCAA statistics.

The Hawkeyes haven't missed more than six free throws in any game this year and have attempted at least 10 in every contest, including seven games with 20 or more attempts.

Head Coach Lisa Bluder

Lisa Bluder (pronounced BLUE-dir) is in her 12th season as head coach at the University of Iowa and her 28th season as a college head coach. She is a three-time Big Ten and two-time WBCA Regional Coach of the Year.

Bluder, 48, has a career record of 576-279 (.674), including a 220-137 (.616) record at lowa, a 187-106 (.638) record in 10 seasons (1990-2000) at Drake and a six-year mark (1984-90) of 169-36 (.824) at St. Ambrose.



Bluder is Iowa's second all-time winningest coach and trails only C. Vivian Stringer. She has guided the Hawkeyes to 10 post-season tournaments (8 NCAA, 2 WNIT) and eight upper-division finishes in the Big Ten Conference, including winning a share of the league championship in 2008 and tying for second place in 2009.

In her first season with the Hawkeyes, Bluder transformed a struggling program into a 21-game winner. Iowa finished second in the Big Ten, won the conference tournament and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament. Bluder became Iowa's third coach to be named Big Ten Coach of the Year. She was also honored as the College Coach of the Year by the *Women's Basketball News Service* and was named the WBCA District 6 Coach of the Year. Iowa's 2001-02 squad finished fourth in the Big Ten and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament for the second consecutive year. In 2003, Bluder guided the Hawkeyes to their first-ever WNIT appearance. Iowa, which had nine underclassmen on its roster, advanced to the quarterfinals before falling to Creighton. In 2004-05, Iowa finished 23-10, starting the year 13-0 and was the last Division I undefeated team standing. In 2005-06, Bluder mentored a team plagued by injuries to a fifth-place Big Ten finish and an NCAA Tournament berth.

In her 10 years at Drake, Bluder brought great success and tradition to the Bulldog program and established herself as one of the top coaches in the country. She led Drake to five 20-plus win seasons in her last six years, including five post-season appearances. She guided the Bulldogs to eight Missouri Valley Conference Tournament appearances, reaching the semifinals six times and winning the tournament four times. Bluder was also named the Conference Coach of the Year three times at Drake.

Bluder began her coaching career at St. Ambrose, where she coached six successful seasons, building the Bees into a NAIA powerhouse. During her tenure at St. Ambrose, Bluder guided the Bees to four straight national tournaments, including two consecutive Final Four appearances. The 1990 St. Ambrose team was ranked No. 1 and Bluder was named the NAIA Converse Coach of the Year.

A graduate of Linn-Mar High School in Marion, IA, Bluder was a three-year starter at Northern Iowa. She graduated from UNI in 1983 with a bachelor's degree in marketing.

JOHNSON AMONG THE BEST AT HER POSITION

Junior Morgan Johnson's .806 (54-67) free throw percentage is the second-best percentage in the country for players listed as true centers.

Only Ruta Zurauskyte from Santa Clara has a better free throw percentage among players listed as centers in the most recent NCAA statistics.

STATS DON'T LIE

In eight of lowa's nine victories this season, the Hawkeyes have recorded a higher field goal percentage than their opponents.

In all five of lowa's losses, the Hawkeyes have had a lower shooting percentage than their opponents.

The only opponent to record a higher field goal percentage and still lose was Mississippi Valley State (Dec. 22).

JOHNSON FROM THE FIELD

Junior Morgan Johnson has atttempted at least 10 shots in six of lowa's 14 games this season. In five of those games, Johnson has shot .500 or better.

Johnson was 5-10 (.500) vs. Harvard, 9-13 (.692) at Northern Iowa, 6-11 (.545) at Kansas State, 5-10 (.500) at Iowa State and 13-20 (.650) at Bradley.

The only game Johnson failed to shoot .500 with 10 or more shots was vs. Virginia Tech (8-21, .381).

REACHING DOUBLE FIGURES

lowa's game vs. Northwestern (Dec. 30) marked the seventh time this season that at least three players have scored 10 or more points. In those games, lowa is 6-1 (only loss was at Kansas State).

The Hawkeyes had all five starters score double figures against Mississippi Valley State. Four players hit double figures against Northern Iowa, Kansas State, Western Illinois and Northwestern. Three players reached double digits against Harvard and Albany.

CONSISTENT STARTS

Two Hawkeyes have recorded consistent starts in certain statistical categories through 11 games this season.

- Junior Jaime Printy has scored at least 15 points in all but four games, including six 20 point performances.
- Freshman Samantha Logic has grabbed at least five rebounds and dished out at least four assists in eight of lowa's 14 games.

MOVING UP CAREER CHARTS

Four Hawkeyes are currently working their way up the career records lists at Iowa.

- Kamille Wahlin ranks third in career three-pointers made (190), seventh in career assists (362) and 19th in career scoring (1,223). She needs 32 more three-pointers to move past Wendy Ausdemore into second place, six more assists to move past Steph Schueler for sixth place and eight more points to past Lisa Long for 18th place.
- Morgan Johnson ranks second in career blocks (185) and 21st in career rebounds (500). She needs 51 more blocks to move past Tangela Smith for first place and seven more rebound to move past Jamie Cavey for 20th place.
- Jaime Printy ranks fifth in career three-pointers made (180), 15th in career scoring (1,264) and 16th in career assists (266). She needs six more three-pointers to move past Kristi Smith for fourth place, one more point to move past Jamie Cavey for 14th place and 14 more assists to move past Necole Tunsiil and Laurie Aaron for 14th place.
- Kelly Krei ranks seventh in career three-pointers made (140) and needs 17 more to move past Leah Magner into sixth place.

JOHNSON NAMED BIG TEN PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Junior Morgan Johnson was named Big Ten Player of the Week after a career night at Brad-

Johnson notched new career highs in points (37), field goals made (13), free throws made (11) and free throws attempted (12). Her 37 points were also a Renaissance Coliseum record and are the most scored by any player in the Big Ten, so far, this season.

Johnson's 37 points were the most for an lowa center since Megan Skouby netted 33 at Kansas in 2008. Skouby finished the game 10-17 from the field and 13-14 from the free throw line.

The award was Johnson's first Big Ten Player of the Week honor. She was named Big Ten Freshman of the Week once during her first season at Iowa.

HOT-SHOOTING HAWKEYES

The Hawkeyes set or tied four three-point shooting records in their win over Mississippi Valley State (Dec. 22).

- lowa set a school record for three-pointers made in a single game with 14. The previous record was 13 (at Gonzaga, NCAA Tournament first round, 3/19/11).
- lowa tied the Carver-Hawkeye Arena record for three-pointers made in a single game (14 by Northern Iowa, 12/19/06), and set the Iowa record for three-pointers made in Carver-Hawkeye Arena (12 vs. Illinois, 2/14/10).
- The Hawkeyes set a new school record for three-pointers attempted inside Carver-Hawkeye with 35. The previous record was 34 (vs. Penn State, 2/1/09).

NOT MISSING FROM THE CHARITY STRIPE

lowa finished 27-30 (.900) from the free throw line at Bradley (Dec. 17), which is believed to be a school record for free throw percentage (minimum 30 attempts).

Morgan Johnson was 11-12 from the line, while Melissa Dixon was 5-6. Kelly Krei was 2-3 and Kamille Wahlin, Kalli Hansen, Theairra Taylor and Virginia Johnson were all 2-2. Samantha Logic was also 1-1.

WINNING BIG

lowa's 53-point winning margin over Western Illinois (Dec. 9) was the fourth-largest in school history. It was also the largest margin of victory for a Hawkeye team since an 89-34 win (55 points) over Boise State in 1996.

EVEN MORE BENCH POINTS

The Hawkeyes scored 37 points off the bench against Western Illinois (Dec. 9), which were the most for an Iowa team since scoring 49 against Northern Illinois in 2007.

Earlier this season, Iowa netted 26 bench points, which were tied for the most since 2008.

lowa's 98 points vs. Western Illinois (Dec. 9) are the most for an lowa team since scoring 99 points, also against Western Illinois, in 2000.

The Hawkeyes have now scored 90 or more points in 49 games.

Iowa had just one player (Morgan Johnson) score double figures in a win over Virginia Tech (Nov. 30).

The last time an lowa team won a game with just one player in double figures was Dec. 2, 2007 vs. Detroit when Kristi Smith netted 10 points.

Since the game vs. Detroit in 2007, lowa teams have only had one player score 10 or more points just seven times. The Hawkeyes lost all seven of those contests.

PRINTY STREAK SNAPPED

Junior Jaime Printy had converted 30-straight free throws, dating back to Iowa's game vs. UNLV (Nov. 13), before a miss from the charity stripe against Texas A&M (Nov. 26).

Printy went 8-8 against UNLV (Nov. 13), 9-9 against Albany (Nov. 16), 4-4 vs. Northern Iowa (Nov. 19) and 8-8 vs. St. John's (Nov. 25). She made her first attempt against Texas A&M, before missing the first of two free throws in the second half.

Printy's latest streak is the second time she has made at least 30-straight free throws. She made 32-straight free throws last year, one shy of lowa's record for consecutive free throws (33 by Lindsey Meder).

PRINTY NAMED TO WATCH LISTS

Junior Jaime Printy has been named to the "Wade Watch," Wooden Award and Naismith Trophy Watch Lists. The "Wade Watch" List is made up of the top 25 preseason women's basketball players, the Wooden Award includes 30 student-athletes and the Naismith Trophy list has 51 players.

The three awards are considered the most prestigious awards in NCAA women's college basketball.
