#### CAMPBELL BEATS IOWA 77-61

Campbell kept its undefeated record intact Wednesday night after a 77-61 victory over Iowa on Mediacom Court inside Carver-Hawkeye Arena. The loss was Iowa's second straight after falling to Creighton in Des Moines on Sunday.

The Fighting Camels used an 18-4 scoring surge late in the first half to build a 16-point advantage (38-22). However, the Hawkeyes scored the last nine points of the half cut the deficit to seven (38-31).

lowa got to within five points (54-49) midway through the second stanza but were unable to get any closer as Campbell pulled away down the stretch sinking 10-of-13 (.769) from the foul line the last four minutes.

Matt Gatens led Iowa in scoring, totaling 17 points, while Roy Devyn Marble posted a season-best 14 points and had a team-high four assists.

lowa shot 36 percent (24-of-66) from the field, while the Camels shot a blistering 62 percent (28-45). Eighteen of Campbell's 28 field goals came inside the paint. The Camels missed only seven field goals in the second half, shooting 65 percent (13-of-20).

#### **CAMPBELL TIP-INS**

- Senior Andrew Brommer returned to action Wednesday after reinjuring his knee in the North Carolina A&T game. The center played nine minutes collecting three rebounds and four points off the bench.
- Roy Devyn Marble's four assists equaled a career high.
- Zach McCabe came off the bench to grab a team and season-high seven rebounds.
- Iowa missed only two free throws, making 10 of 12 attempts (.833). Iowa has shot at an 80 percent clip or better from the foul line twice this year (Chicago State, .844 and Campbell, .833).
- Campbell missed only seven field goals in the second half, shooting 65 percent (13of-20).
- Campbell's Eric Griffin registered game highs in points (23), rebounds (13) and blocks (6). Griffin only missed one field goal, making 10 of his 11 shot attempts.

Matt Gatens played all 40 minutes in Iowa's loss to Campbell on Wednesday. It marked the 13th time the senior was on the court 40 minutes or more in a contest.

#### **Head Coach Fran McCaffery**

Fran McCaffery is in his second season as the head basketball coach at the University of lowa and his 16th year overall as a college head coach. McCaffery spent five seasons (2005-10) as the head coach at Siena, six years at UNC-Greensboro (1999-2005) and three seasons at Lehigh (1985-88) before joining the Hawkeyes.



McCaffery has nearly three decades of Division I coaching experience. He com-

pleted his 29th season as a collegiate coach in 2011, which includes 15 years as a head coach and 14 as an assistant.

McCaffery, 50, holds a career mark of 265-199 (.571) and guided his teams to six postseason appearances (five NCAA, one NIT). He is 14-22 (.389) at lowa.

McCaffery's five years at Siena were the best in its 70-year history. He led the Saints on an incredible run that ended with three straight Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference championships and NCAA Tournament appearances. In so doing, Siena became the only program in the country to win its regular season and postseason title the last three years.

McCaffery's Saints owned a 112-51 (.687) record in his five years with the program. He guided the Saints to four consecutive 20-win seasons, something that has never been accomplished before at the Siena.

The 2009 MAAC Coach of the Year and 2010 District | Coach of the Year is the third winningest coach, by percentage, in league history (68-22, .756). He is the only coach to guide a MAAC program to two NCAA Tournament wins. McCaffery led his 2008 and 2009 teams to first round NCAA Tournament victories over Vanderbilt and Ohio State, respectively.

In his final two seasons at Siena, he coached the Saints to back-to-back 27-win campaigns and boasted a combined 39-3 (.929) record against MAAC opponents, which included MAAC Tournament contests.

McCaffery began his coaching career as an assistant at Penn (1982-83) and Lehigh (1983-85). Then at age 26, he became the nation's youngest Division I head coach when hired by Lehigh in 1985. After three seasons as head coach at Lehigh, he spent 11 seasons as an assistant at Notre Dame (1988-99).

McCaffery played basketball at Wake Forest his freshman year (1977-78) and then concluded his collegiate playing career at Penn his final three seasons (1979-82).

He earned his B.S. degree in Economics from The Wharton School (Penn) in 1982. McCaffery also earned a Master of Education from Lehigh in 1985.

#### **SCOUTING IPFW**

- Tony Jasick is in his first season as college head coach, owning a 3-0 mark. Jasick, 33, is the fifth-youngest head coach in NCAA Division I.
- IPFW is located in Fort Wayne, Ind. IPFW is a member of the Summit League. The Hawkeyes are 27-3 against Summit League competition: South Dakota (10-0), Western Illinois (8-0), South Dakota State (7-2), Oakland (1-0), Oral Roberts (1-0) and North Dakota State (0-1).
- IPFW opened with an 83-72 win over Nebraska-Omaha before dropping its second game at 13th-ranked Xavier (86-63). The Mastodons beat Judson Monday (85-59) before traveling to lowa City for Saturday's game.
- IPFW will have had four days to prepare for Iowa, with its last game coming Monday against Judson.
- Guard Frank Gaines, who is a preseason All-Summit League honoree, has had a solid start to the season. He's averaging a conference-best 22.3 points per game, bolstered by 23-of-26 (.885) shooting from the foul line. Gaines has made 23 of the team's 49 free throws. His performances garnered the junior College Sports Madness.com Summit League Player of the Week accolades.
- Trey McCorkle is averaging 14.3 points and 9.3 rebounds for the Mastodons. Mc-Corkle posted a double-double (17 points and 10 rebounds) in IPFW's win over Judson.
- The Mastodons have made only 16 triples, shooting 27 percent (16-of-60).

#### BALANCED SCORING

Iowa has six players averaging 7.8 points or more. Matt Gatens is first on the team (15.8), followed by Eric May (11.2), Melsahn Basabe (8.2), Josh Oglesby (8.0), Aaron White (7.8) and Zach McCabe (7.8).

#### STEALING THE ROCK

lowa is averaging 10.3 steals this season, collecting 10 steals or more in four of the five games. Last season, the Hawkeyes averaged 6.7 thefts.

#### <u>HOT SHO</u>T

Freshman Josh Oglesby led Iowa in scoring against Northern Illinois and Creighton, netting a career-high 16 points against the Huskies and 14 versus the Bluejays.

Oglesby becomes the first Hawkeye reserve to lead the team in scoring, in back-toback games, since Ricky Davis paced lowa with 25 and 18 on the road at Wisconsin (Feb. 3) and Michigan State (Feb. 7), respectively, in 1998. Like Oglesby, Davis accomplished the feat as a freshman.

After shooting 1-of-9 (.111) from the field the first two games, the Cedar Rapids native shot 13-of-20 (.650) the last two outings.

#### IMPROVEMENT UNDER McCAFFERY IN SECOND YEAR OF PROGRAM

Fran McCaffery-coached teams have posted improved win totals from their first year to second with McCaffery as a head coach. At Lehigh, his team improved by two wins (13 in 1986 to 15 in 1987). His UNC Greensboro team had four more victories from 2000 (15) and 2001 (19). At Siena his team improved by five victories, registering 15 in 2006 to 20 in 2007.

Starters Matt Gatens (16-of-17), Melsahn Basabe (19-of-22) and Bryce Cartwright (7-of-8) are a combined 42-of-47 (.894) from the free throw line. As a team, the Hawkeyes rank fourth in the Big Ten, making 74 percent of their attempts (76-of-103).

Gatens ranks third in Big Ten career free throw percentage.

lowa is 13-of-14 (.929) from the foul line in shots attempted the final five minutes of games.

#### **HAWKEYE FAST BREAKS**

- Seven of lowa's first eight contests will be played at home, with the non-home game during the stretch being played on a neutral floor in Des Moines versus Creighton.
- Coach McCaffery has played at least 10 players in each of lowa's first five games. Also, lowa's bench averages 35.6 points its first five outings.
- lowa's 61.9 percent (13-of-21) 3-point percentage and 26 assists against Northern Illinois are the best of any Big Ten team this season.
- lowa had five players score 12 points or more in its win over North Carolina A&T on Nov. 14. It marked only the fourth time the Hawkeyes had five players tally 12 points or more in a game (UW-Green Bay in 2003, Michigan in 2004, SIU-Edwardsville in 2010 and North Carolina A&T in 2011).
- Matt Gatens' 17 points Wednesday night propelled him past Chad Calabria (1968-70), John Johnson (1969-70), Sam Williams (1967-68) and Val Barnes (1991-93) into 21st place on Iowa's all-time scoring chart. The senior is only six points from tying Bill Logan (1954-56) and Dave Gunther (1957-59) and seven from matching Kevin Boyle (1979-82). Gatens has 1,182 points entering Saturday's contest versus IPFW.
- lowa saw an increase in its attendance numbers in 2010-11. Compared to 2009-10, last year's Hawkeyes averaged 2,085 more fans than the previous season, an increase of 20%. Iowa averaged 9,550 fans two years ago, compared to 11,635 last year.

#### WHITE TABBED BIG TEN CO-FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

lowa freshmen Aaron White was named Big Ten co-Freshman of the Week after his performance in Iowa's season opening victory over Chicago State (Nov. 11). White shared the weekly honor with Indiana's Cody Zeller.

White shined in his Hawkeye debut, leading all scorers and rebounders with 19 points and 10 rebounds in 18 minutes of action. The native of Strongsville, Ohio, shot 50 percent (6-of-12) from the field and sank all five free throw attempts.

The 19 points are the most by an lowa freshman in a season opener, equaling Dick Ives' 19 scored against Nebraska in his debut on Dec. 10, 1943. Furthermore, White's performance marked the first time a Hawkeye posted a double-double, in a season opener, since Dean Oliver had 10 points and 12 assists in a victory over Chicago State in 1997. It was the first time a Hawkeye freshman had a double-double, points and rebounds, since Jess Settles had 13 points and 11 rebounds versus Drake in 1993.

#### **WELCOME NEW HAWKEYES**

lowa has six new faces on the team this season: Gabriel Olaseni, Josh Oglesby, Aaron White, Stephen McCarty, Kyle Denning and Christopher Rickert. Olaseni, Oglesby and White are on scholarship, while Denning, McCarty and Rickert are walk-ons.

#### **HAWKEYES ARE TOUGH AT HOME**

lowa has won 75 of its 106 games (.708) in Carver-Hawkeye Arena (15,500) over the last eight seasons, including win streaks of 21 straight overall and 12 straight Big Ten Conference wins. Iowa has won 10 of its last 20 home games against ranked opponents. lowa was a perfect 17-0 at home in 2006, 14-2 in 2007, 10-8 in 2008, 13-4 in 2009, 9-9 in 2010 and 8-8 this season.

#### **IOWA IN CARVER-HAWKEYE ARENA**

lowa has compiled a 351-112 (.758) record in Carver-Hawkeye Arena since the facility opened in January, 1983. Iowa is 162-89 (.645) in Big Ten games and 189-23 (.892) in non-Big Ten contests.

#### **IOWA HISTORY**

lowa has played 2,630 games since beginning basketball in 1902. Iowa's overall record is 1,580-1,050 (.601). That includes a 945-348 (.731) record in home games, a 545-712 (.434) record in contests away from lowa City, a 703-718 (.495) mark in Big Ten games and a 351-112 (.758) record in Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

#### **lowa's 2012 Recruiting Class**

Anthony Clemmons, Mike Gesell, Patrick Ingram, Kyle Meyer and Adam Woodbury have signed national letter of intents to attend the University of Iowa.

"I'm very excited about this class," said McCaffery. "We started working immediately upon arrival, in particular, on this group. I want to give particular recognition to how hard each and every one of my assistant coaches has worked. I believe we've addressed specific needs and attracted not only quality, but student-athletes who will fit with what we already have here to ultimately make us a better team."

lowa's five-member 2012 recruiting class is ranked 19th by ESPN.com and Scout.com.

Paul Biancardi, who is ESPN's national recruiting director, had nothing but praise to say about lowa's recruiting class and coach McCaffery.

"I'm very impressed, but not surprised, with the class coach McCaffery signed," said Biancardi. "This is a national statement class. Coach McCaffery and his staff have sold the vision and the plan for lowa basketball in a big time way. It should get the fans of lowa very excited not only right now but in the future. To be successful in this business you have to be able to recruit, and Fran's a proven recruiter. This is a class, that as it grows and develops together, will be the foundation for Iowa basketball. It will propel the Hawkeyes to the next step, which is the upper half of the Big Ten and NCAA Tournament."

#### **ADAM WOODBURY (7-1, 230)**

Woodbury is an All-State center from Sioux City, Iowa. The 7-foot-1, 230-pound was named the Most Valuable Player at the 2011 NBA Players Association Top 100 Camp. Woodbury is the No. 41 ranked player in the Class of 2012 by ESPN.com, No. 42 by Rivals.com and No. 47 by Scout.com. He enters his senior season ranked fourth in career scoring and first in rebounding at East High School. He led the Black Raiders to a combined 59-16 record the last three seasons, including back-to-back conference championships and three consecutive state tournament appearances. Woodbury is a two-time first team All-State, All-Missouri River Conference, All-Northwest Iowa and All-City honoree. As a junior, Woodbury averaged a double-double (18.5 points and 12 rebounds). He averaged 17.4 points and grabbed a school single-season record 315 rebounds (12.1 avg.) his sophomore campaign. Woodbury also participated in the Nike LeBron James Skills Academy and Amare Stoudemire Skills Academy in 2011. He played AAU for Martin Brothers and Alllowa Attack from seventh through 11th grade. Fellow recruit Mike Gesell was an AAU teammate of Woodbury. Woodbury becomes lowa's first sevenfooter since Seth Gorney (2005-08) and is the tallest Hawkeye since Antonio Ramos (1999), who stood 7-foot-2.

#### MIKE GESELL (6-1, 180)

Gesell is a three-time first team All-State, All- Conference and All-Metro honoree for South Sioux City High School. Gesell is the No. 73 ranked player in the Class of 2012 by ESPN.com, No. 89 by Scout.com and No. 96 by Rivals.com. As a junior, he averaged 25.2 points, 8.2 assists, 5.5 rebounds and 2.9 steals while being honored as the Nebraska Gatorade Basketball Player of the Year. As a sophomore, Gesell averaged 19.9 points, 6.4 assists, 7.7 rebounds and 3.3 steals. He made 82 percent (158-193) of his free throw attempts as a junior and 79 percent (125-158) as a sophomore. The 6-foot-1, 180-pound guard was a Basketball Super State and All-State Class B Team Captain recipient his sophomore and junior seasons. He holds single season school records for scoring (655), assists (212) and steals (79), career scoring (1,446) and single-game steals (8) and assists (13). Gessell, who is a Wendy's High School Heisman state finalist and will be the team's captain this year, also excels in the classroom, ranking in the top five percent of his class while earning Gold Honor Roll distinction all four years. He also is a three-time Academic All-Conference and NSAA Academic All-State honoree. Fellow recruit Adam Woodbury was a teammate of Gesell on Martin Brothers and the All-lowa Attack AAU squads.

#### **ANTHONY CLEMMONS (6-1, 185)**

Clemmons is a native of Lansing, Mich., and has started the last two years for Sexton High School. The 6-foot-1, 185-pound point guard helped his team to back-to-back conference championships and a Class B state title a year ago. Sexton finished as state runner-up his sophomore season. Clemmons is a two-time All-Conference honoree and was an All-State and All-Area selection in 2011. Clemmons averaged 12.3 points, 4.6 rebounds, 4.1 assists and 3.2 steals his junior year. He will serve as a team co-captain his senior campaign. Clemmons played AAU basketball the last two years with the Michigan Mustangs. He also played football his freshman through junior years at Sexton, earning all-conference honors in 2010, playing fullback, linebacker and safety.

#### PATRICK INGRAM (6-2, 190)

Ingram is a 6-foot-2, 190-pound guard from Indianapolis. He is a two-year starter and helped North Central High School win back-to-back conference championships and the Class 4A state championship in 2010. His high school team boasted a combined 70-8 record his first three seasons. Ingram averaged 10.4 points, 5.0 rebounds and 2.0 assists his junior campaign. He shot 55.5 percent from the field and 33-percent from beyond the arc. A captain on this year's team, Ingram also played on the AAU circuit for the Eric Gordon All-Stars. His team won the Walt Disney World tournament, Eric Gordon Shootout and the IndyBall Tournament. Ingram was tabbed MVP of the Walt Disney World tournament.

#### **KYLE MEYER (6-10, 220)**

Meyer is a 6-foot-10, 220-pound forward from Alpharetta, Ga. Meyer averaged 15 points, 11 rebounds, 3.5 blocks and 2.6 assists for Northview High School as a junior. He earned All-Region and co-MVP accolades as a junior, and was also recognized on the 2010 Pickens All-Tournament team. Meyer, who attends the same high school as Minnesota senior Ralph Sampson III, is a three-year starter. He averaged 10 points, 9.5 rebounds and 2.2 blocks, and earned the team's Coaches Award his sophomore campaign. Meyer garnered all-tournament laurels at the Chattahoochee Tournament as a freshman. Meyer also played AAU basketball for the Atlanta Celtics.



In September 2011, the University of Iowa completed a \$47 million revitalization of Carver-Hawkeye Arena. That project includes the construction of a practice facility for men's and women's basketball and volleyball, a 10,000-square-foot strength training and cardiovascular center, and an expansion to the Dan Gable Wrestling Complex, in addition to new locker room and support facilities for men's and women's basketball, wrestling and volleyball programs, and office space for the majority of Iowa administrative and coaching staffs.

Carver-Hawkeye Arena's four-story, 75,000-square foot addition has been named the Dale and Marilyn Howard Family Pavilion, named after the Howard's gave a multi-million dollar contribution to the athletic department.

"The Howard's have done so much for our program and the UI Athletics Department," said Iowa head coach Fran McCaffery. "Their generosity has helped pave the way for this beautiful state-of-the-art facility that our program desperately needed. Everything from the offices, locker room, practice gym to the weight room, is first class. We are extremely thankful for the Howard's contribution and are so proud to name the new addition after Dale and Marilyn Howard."

Matt Gatens is in his final season with the Hawkeyes and is ecstatic for the new additions and amenities to Carver-Hawkeve Arena.










"The new facilities are first class," said Gatens. "After two years of construction, it's good to finally be able to use the facility in our training efforts. It's nice to be able to have a practice gym where we can come over and get extra shots up at our leisure. It's great to be a Hawkeye!"

The addition of the practice facility eliminates the need to have student-athletes in the sports of men's basketball, women's basketball and volleyball practice and train at unusual or irregular times of day or at times which are typically reserved for classes. The flexibility created by the practice space also positively impacts the potential for use of the arena for other University and community-related events such as concerts.

The revitalization of the arena also extends into spaces used by the general public on game days and nights, including renovation of select concessions and restroom facilities, and the creation of hospitality and meeting spaces combined with club facilities for fans of the Hawkeyes who choose to participate in a variety of premium seating options similar to that which are available in the Paul W. Brechler Press Box at Kinnick Stadium.
