Game #5 Quick Hits

- Monday will be the third meeting between Iowa and Pepperdine and the first since 1994. Iowa leads the all-time series, 2-0.
- Monday is "Dollar Dog Night" and "UI Faculty and Staff Appreciation Night" (free admission for UI faculty and staff with a valid ID, and \$5 for their guests).
- Aaron White was named to the 2K Classic All-Tournament team after averaging a double-double against No. 10 Texas and No. 23 Syracuse in New York (19 points and 10 rebounds).
- Jarrod Uthoff netted a career-high 20 points in Iowa's loss to No. 23 Syracuse on Friday.
- Adam Woodbury averaged 11 points and 6.5 rebounds in Iowa's two games in New York.
- Aaron White, Jarrod Uthoff, and Adam Woodbury accounted for 88 of Iowa's 120 points (73 percent) against Texas and Syracuse in New York.
- Iowa is scheduled to play three home games in six days this week.
- Iowa is 36-6 when scoring 80 points or more, the last five seasons. The Hawkeyes are 41-1 when holding opponents to fewer than 61 points, the last five years.
- Aaron White has 1,368 career points. He is five points from surpassing Ed Horton (1,372 points) for 15th place on Iowa's all-time scoring chart.

Iowa (2-2) returns home to host Pepperdine (3-0) Monday. Tipoff is scheduled for 7:02 p.m. (CT) on Mediacom Court at Carver-Hawkeye Arena (15,400).

ON THE AIR

Radio: Iowa games are broadcast on the Hawkeye Radio Network. Gary Dolphin handles the play-by-play, along with color commentator Bob Hansen. The network includes more than 40 stations that blanket the state of Iowa and include portions of Illinois, Nebraska, Minnesota, Missouri and Wisconsin. The Hawkeye Radio Network coverage includes a 60-minute pregame show.

Webstream: Monday's game will be streamed on ESPN3.com (WATCHESPN). Shawn Kenney and former Hawkeye Jess Settles will call the action. The game will not be televised.

HAWKEYES DROP TWO IN NEW YORK

- Iowa lost, 71-57, to No. 10 Texas and dropped a narrow, 66-63, decision to No. 23 Syracuse last week in New York City.
- Iowa led 30-24 at half against the Longhorns, but Texas outscored the Hawkeyes 47-27 in the second half.
- Senior Aaron White posted career highs in free throws made (14) and attempted (16) against Texas. The 14 free throws made equal the most by a Hawkeye in the Fran McCaffery era (Devyn Marble made 14 against Northern Iowa in 2012).
- Aaron White scored 23 points against the Longhorns, which marks the 11th time in his career that the Strongsville, Ohio, native topped 20 points.
- Aaron White followed up his 23-point performance against Texas with a double-double effort versus Syracuse. White posted 15 points and controlled 12 rebounds for his first double-double of the year and 13th of his career.
- Adam Woodbury tallied 10 points against Texas and had 12 versus Syracuse.
- Mike Gesell led the Hawkeyes in assists in each game, dishing out four versus Texas and a season-best seven against Syracuse.
- In addition to pouring in a career-high 20 points against Syracuse, Uthoff had six rebounds and three steals in each of the two games in New York.
- Iowa trailed Syracuse by 15 points with 12 minutes left, but rallied back to close within one point on three occasions in the final three minutes, but were unable to claim the lead.

NUMBER OF THE WEEK -- 26

- Iowa has won 26 straight nonconference home games, a streak that dates back to November 2011 (Clemson). The active streak ties Oregon for 11th in the country.

Head Coach Fran McCaffery

Fran McCaffery, who is signed through the 2020 season, is in his fifth season as the head basketball coach at the University of Iowa and his 19th year overall as a college head coach. McCaffery spent five seasons (2005-10) as the head coach at Siena, six years at UNC-Greensboro (1999-2005) and three seasons at Lehigh (1985-88) before joining the Hawkeyes.



McCaffery has three decades of Division I coaching experience. He completed his 32nd season as a collegiate coach in 2014, which includes 18 years as a head coach and 14 as an assistant. McCaffery became one of 12 coaches to lead four different Division I teams to the NCAA Tournament in 2014.

McCaffery, 54, holds a career mark of 327-245 (.572) and guided his teams to nine postseason appearances (six NCAA, three NIT). He is 76-65 (.539) at Iowa.

Since taking over the Iowa program in 2010, the Hawkeyes have increased their win total by 15 games. McCaffery coached Iowa to 25 victories in 2013, equaling the second-most win total in program history. McCaffery has guided the Black and Gold to back-to-back NIT appearances, including a runner-up finish in 2013.

McCaffery has posted upper division finishes in each of the past two seasons at Iowa and 14-of-18 seasons as a head coach. He has posted 20 wins or more six of the last eight seasons, including the last two at Iowa (2013 and 2014).

McCaffery and the Hawkeyes have made Carver-Hawkeye Arena one of the most feared arenas to play nationally. Fans have embraced McCaffery and his team's style of play with attendance increasing by 57 percent since 2010. The Hawkeyes won a school-record 18 home games a year ago.

McCaffery's five years at Siena were the best in its 70-year history. He led the Saints on an incredible run that ended with three straight Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference championships and NCAA Tournament appearances. In so doing, Siena became the only program in the country to win its regular season and postseason title 2008-10.

McCaffery's Saints owned a 112-51 (.687) record in his five years with the program. He guided the Saints to four consecutive 20-win seasons.

The 2009 MAAC Coach of the Year and 2010 District I Coach of the Year is the third winningest coach, by percentage, in league history (68-22, .756). He is the only coach to guide a MAAC program to two NCAA Tournament wins. McCaffery led his 2008 and 2009 teams to first round NCAA Tournament victories over Vanderbilt and Ohio State, respectively.

In his final two seasons at Siena, he coached the Saints to back-to-back 27-win campaigns and boasted a combined 39-3 (.929) record against MAAC opponents, which included MAAC Tournament contests.

McCaffery began his coaching career as an assistant at Penn (1982-83) and Lehigh (1983-85). After three seasons as head coach at Lehigh, he spent 11 seasons as an assistant at Notre Dame (1988-99).

McCaffery played basketball at Wake Forest his freshman year (1977-78) and then concluded his collegiate playing career at Penn his final three seasons (1979-82).

He earned his B.S. degree in Economics from The Wharton School (Penn) in 1982. McCaffery also earned a Master of Education from Lehigh in 1985.

SCOUTING PEPPERDINE

Pepperdine enters Monday's game against Iowa with a 3-0 mark, notching wins over Fresno State (89-74), Cal Lutheran (76-61) and San Jose State (63-44). Returning All-West Coast Conference performer Stacy Davis averages a team-best 17.7 points, making 12 of his 13 free throw attempts (92 percent) this season. Jett Raines averages 15 points, bolstered by 19-of-31 (61 percent) shooting from the field, and pulling down a team-best 8.7 rebounds, while Jeremy Major averages 12.7 points. Pepperdine owns a +9.7 rebounding margin and average 9.3 steals per contest.

Pepperdine freshman Nate Gehring is an Iowa native. Gehring hails from Waukee and went to Waukee High School.

Pepperdine is coached by Marty Wilson, who is in his fourth year as head coach and his 18th season in Malibu. He began his career at Pepperdine as a student-athlete (1985-89) and continued as an assistant coach (1991-96, which included a brief stint as interim head coach), and then returning as the associate head coach for three seasons (2009-11). He was then elevated to head coach following Tom Asbury's retirement after the 2010-11 season.

Pepperdine's women's team played in Iowa City over the weekend, finishing third in the four-team Hawkeye Challenge.

2014 IOWA BASKETBALL TEAM HIGHLIGHTS

- Iowa won 20 games or more in consecutive seasons for the first time since 2004-05/2005-06.
- Iowa returned to the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2006. The Hawkeyes, who played in their 23rd tournament, fell 78-65 in overtime to Tennessee in the first round.
- Fran McCaffery is one of 12 coaches to guide four different teams to the NCAA Tournament.
- Iowa finished sixth in the Big Ten standings for the second consecutive season. McCaffery has posted upper division finishes in each of the past two seasons at Iowa and 14-of-18 seasons as a head coach. He has posted 20 wins or more six of the last eight seasons, including the last two at Iowa (2013 and 2014).
- Iowa scored 2,689 points, which are the fifth most in program history.
- Iowa attempted 660 free throws -- the third most in program history.

2014 INDIVIDUAL HIGHLIGHTS

- Devyn Marble (first) and Aaron White (third) were all-conference honorees. Marble is Iowa's first all-conference first-team honoree since Adam Haluska in 2007.
- Aaron White was the only player in the country to shoot better than 55 percent from the field and 80 percent from the free throw line in 2013-14. White, who amassed 1,301 points, became just the fourth Hawkeye to accumulate 1,300+ points as a junior, joining Roy Marble (1,441), Ronnie Lester (1,423) and Jess Settles (1,303).
- Junior Gabriel Olaseni was one of only four players in the country (minimum 160 rebounds) with more offensive rebounds (82) than defensive (81).
- Peter Jok shot at a 34.8 percent clip from 3-point range, which is eighth best for an Iowa freshman.

ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE

In recognition of Mike Gesell's outstanding academic record in the Tippie College of Business at The University of Iowa, the junior has been invited to become a member of Beta Gamma Sigma, the National Scholastic Honor Society for business students. This honor is reserved for students who have earned GPAs that place them in the top 10 percent of their class. The UI chapter, established in 1920, is one of the 10 oldest in the nation.

ROSTER CHANGES FOR 2014-15

Roy Devyn Marble, Melsahn Basabe, and Zach McCabe exhausted their eligibility after last season, while forwards Kyle Meyer and Darius Stokes transferred.

Iowa welcomes five newcomers: Brady Ellingson, Trey Dickerson, Dom Uhl, and walk-ons Nicholas Baer and Charlie Rose.

After spending the last three seasons as a walk-on, guard Kyle Denning has been rewarded with a scholarship for his senior season by head coach Fran McCaffery.

UTHOFF PRODUCING ON THE WING

Jarrod Uthoff ranks second in team scoring (13.3 ppg) and first in steals (1.8) through four games. The redshirt junior averaged 14 points, six rebounds, and three steals in Iowa's two games in New York. He has drained two 3-pointers or more in all four games. Uthoff is shooting at a 50 percent clip (19-of-38) from the field, including 55 percent (11-of-20) from 3-point territory. He drained a personal-best four triples in Iowa's victory over Hampton (Nov. 14). Uthoff has reached double figures in three of Iowa's first four contests.

STRONG START FOR WOODBURY

Center Adam Woodbury averaged 5.7 points and 3.9 rebounds last year as a sophomore. So far through four games as a junior, Woodbury is averaging 9.8 points and 7.0 rebounds. He is shooting 63 percent (17-of-27) from the field this year.

GESELL JOINS ELITE GROUP

Through two seasons, Mike Gesell became just the third Hawkeye to ever amass 550+ points, 200+ assists, 150+ rebounds and 75+ steals. Gesell has 553 points, 217 assists, 155 rebounds and 83 steals. Gesell joins Jeff Horner (632 points, 204 assists, 292 rebounds and 78 steals) and Dean Oliver (631 points, 267 assists, 184 rebounds and 93 steals).

ATTACKING THE RIM

Iowa's 27.2 free-throw attempts average last season, ranked 15th nationally. The Hawkeyes ranked ninth in the country in made free throws (20.0). Through four games this season, Iowa is averaging 25.2 free throw attempts and 18.8 makes. Iowa has made more free throws (75) than its opponents have attempted (66).

Aaron White is on pace to shatter the school's free-throw makes record. White currently ranks fifth with 434 career makes. White (596) is also climbing Iowa's free-throw attempts chart, ranking sixth. He attempted 20 foul shots in New York last week.

REBOUNDING BOOST

Last year, Iowa owned a +7.0 rebounding margin, which ranked 11th in the country. The Hawkeyes are off to a good start on the glass in 2014-15, averaging seven more boards than their opponents through four games.

Iowa ranked 12th in the nation in defensive rebounding (26.9) and 22nd in offensive rebounding (13.5) a year ago.

ON POINT

Point guard Mike Gesell scored in double figures in seven of the last 11 games in 2014, which included a stretch of five straight games -- the longest stretch of his career.

In 33 games, Gesell ranked first in the Big Ten and 12th nationally in assist-to-turnover ratio (3.0). The sophomore has 563 career points, just past halfway to the 1,000-point club.

Gesell leads the team in assists (4.2) through four games this year.

BENCH MOB

Iowa's reserves played a large role in Iowa's 20 victories last year. Overall, Iowa's bench averaged 30.6 points, 18.8 rebounds and 2.7 blocks. The Hawkeye reserves' rebounding average was tops in the country, while their scoring and blocks rank third best.

Iowa's bench is averaging 23 points after four games in 2014-15. The Hawkeye reserves tallied 37 points against Hampton and 36 versus North Dakota State.

WHITE HOT

Aaron White ranks first among active Big Ten players in rebounding (688) and is fourth in scoring (1,368).

White ranks first on the team in rebounding (8.8) and scoring (16.8), and second in assists (3.5) through four games in 2014-15. White is seeking to become the first Hawkeye to lead the team in scoring and rebounding since Greg Brunner in 2006 (14.1 points and 9.2 rebounds per game).

White was the only Big Ten player to average 13+ points and 7+ rebounds during league play in 2014. White became the first Hawkeye ever to register 1,300+ points, 650+ rebounds, 100+ steals and 100+ assists by his junior season.

White was the only player in the country to shoot better than 55 percent from the field and 80 percent from the foul line in 2014. He shot 58 percent from the field and 81 percent from the charity stripe.

White became the fifth player, since 1960, to lead the Hawkeyes in rebounding three consecutive seasons. White joins Don Nelson (1960-62); Kevin Kunnert (1971-73); Bruce King (1975-77); and Greg Brunner (2004-06). He is seeking to become the first Hawkeye to ever lead the Hawkeyes in rebounding all four seasons.

White became the 41st Hawkeye to surpass 1,000 career points with his 19th point scored with one second remaining at the free throw line versus Notre Dame (Dec. 3). He reached the 1,000-point milestone in his 82nd career game. He currently ranks 16th in Iowa scoring.

IOWA HISTORY

Iowa has played 2,645 games since beginning basketball in 1902. Iowa's overall record is 1,552-1,093 (.587). That includes a 989-349 (.739) record in home games, a 557-741 (.429) record in contests away from Iowa City, a 729-746 (.494) mark in Big Ten games and a 395-123 (.762) record in Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

BLOCK PARTY

Junior Gabriel Olaseni blocked at least three shots five times last season. His 43 blocks ranked 10th in the Big Ten (1.3 average). Sophomore Jarrod Uthoff denied 34 shots (1.1 average), a total that ranked 11th in the league. Olaseni denied a game-high four shots in Iowa's season-opening triumph over Hampton and another two versus North Dakota State on Nov. 17. Uthoff ranks second in blocks (1.5), rejecting at least one shot in all four games.

As a team, Iowa ranked second in the Big Ten, and 40th nationally, in rejections (5.0) in 2013-14.
