### **AUDIO COVERAGE**

Brent Balbinot and Shelley Till will call Thursday's game for the Hawkeye Radio Network. Hawkeye fans can listen to the contest on AM-800 KXIC in lowa City, AM-600 WMT in Cedar Rapids, AM-1040 WHO in Des Moines or on the Hawkeye All-Access page of <a href="hawkeyesports.com">hawkeyesports.com</a>. Balbinot is in his seventh season as lowa's play-by-play voice, while Till is in her sixth providing analysis.

### **CARIBBEAN CHALLENGE NOTES**

- This week marks lowa's second trip to Cancun and the Caribbean Challenge. Iowa holds a 1-1 record at the Caribbean Challenge after defeating Mississippi State (60-54), but falling to 13th-ranked Arizona State (58-60) over Thanksgiving break in 2007.
- The Caribbean Challenge is normally held at the Moon Palace Resort in Cancun (where lowa played in 2007). Tournament officials were forced to move the Challenge to the Aventura Spa and Cove Palace due to the international United Nations Climate Summit being held at the Moon Palace.

### **IOWA HISTORY**

lowa has played 1,041 games, since beginning basketball in 1974. Iowa's overall record is 635-406 (.610). That includes a 318-158 (.668) mark in regular season Big Ten contests and a 300-87 (.775) mark in Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

### HAWKEYES PICK UP HOME WIN NO. 300

The UI women's basketball program recorded victory No. 300 inside Carver-Hawkeye Arena with a 90-79 win over Central Michigan Nov. 21. The Hawkeyes have compiled a 300-87 (.775) inside their home venue since it opened in 1983.

### **SCOUTING JAMES MADISON**

The James Madison Dukes are 2-1 on the season. James Madison dropped its season opener to Hampton (64-69) before picking up wins against St. Francis (64-49) and Central Florida (82-78 in overtime). All three games have been at home.

Dawn Evans leads the team with 25.7 points per game. She has 77 of the team's 210 points on the season. Evans has played 38 minutes per game and is 20-21 (.952) from the free throw line. Jalissa Taylor is the team's leading rebounder with 15 boards per game.

James Madison is shooting .353 (72-204) from the field, including .266 (17-64) from three-point.

### <u>JAMES MADISON VS. IOWA NOTES</u>

- Thursday will be the third meeting between the two schools, with lowa holding a 2-0 record. lowa won the first matchup Dec. 19, 1993, 72-44 in Harrisonburg, VA. The Hawkeyes won the return match in lowa City Nov. 26, 1994 (60-30).
- Two of the top guards in the country will face off Thursday at the Caribbean Challenge in James Madison's Dawn Evans and Iowa's Kachine Alexander. Both are on the Naismith Trophy, Wade Trophy and Wooden Award watch lists. Both guards are also candidates for the Lowe's Senior CLASS Award and were named the top five at their position by ESPN.com and FanHouse.com. Evans was named the preseason CAA Co-Player of the Year and Alexander was a preseason all-Big Ten selection.

### **IOWA IN THE RANKINGS**

The Hawkeyes are ranked No. 22 in the AP poll and No. 24 in the ESPN/USA Today poll.

Four Iowa opponents are also ranked in the AP and ESPN/USA Today polls: Ohio State (7/7), North Carolina (14/15), Iowa State (19/17) and Michigan State (25/22).

Kansas State, Penn State, Wisconsin, Northwestern, Purdue and James Madison are receiving votes.

### HAWKEYES WIN SHOOTOUT AGAINST CENTRAL MICHIGAN

lowa captured the 2010 KCRG-TV9 Hawkeye Challenge title with a 90-79 win over Central Michigan Sunday.

Four Hawkeyes hit double figures, led by Morgan Johnson with a team-high 21 points. Kachine Alexander added 20 points and 18 rebounds, while Jaime Printy chipped in 18 points, six rebounds and five assists. Kamille Wahlin had 13 points and five assists.

The Hawkeyes out-rebounded Central Michigan, 53-49, including 20 offensive boards.

### **BLUDER CLOSING IN ON MILESTONE**

lowa Head Coach Lisa Bluder is just six wins away from becoming only the second coach in school history to reach the 200-win milestone.

Bluder currently has 194 wins in her 11 years at lowa. C. Vivian Stringer is the only other Hawkeye head coach to reach the 200-win plateau at lowa, finishing her time in lowa City with 269 wins.

Ohio State Head Coach Jim Foster is the only other active Big Ten coach to have reached 200 wins at his/her current school.

### **DOUBLE TROUBLE**

Kachine Alexander has collected double-doubles in Iowa's last three games and earned MVP honors at the KCRG-TV9 Hawkeye Challenge.

Alexander's first double-double of the season came against Bradley Nov. 16, recording 14 points and 10 rebounds. Alexander was 8-10 from the free throw line and also had five assists and three steals.

Alexander started the KCRG-TV9 Hawkeye Challenge with 21 points and 12 rebounds in a win over Northeastern Nov. 20, adding six assists, two steals and a block.

She wrapped up the tournament MVP award with 20 points and 18 rebounds against Central Michigan in the championship.

Alexander now ranks second in career double-doubles at lowa with 27. The school record is 35, held by Lisa Long.

### TWO HAWKEYE CHALLENGE RECORDS SET

Kachine Alexander's 18 rebounds against Central Michigan tied a Hawkeye Challenge record for single game rebounds. The original record of 18 rebounds was set by North Carolina State's Trena Trice in the 1985 Challenge. Alexander tied the record last year with 18 boards in the season opener against Santa Clara.

lowa's 31 three-point attempts against Central Michigan also broke the team single-game record for three-pointers attempted. The previous record was 29, held by the Hawkeyes against Kent State in the 2001 championship.

### **JOHNSON SCORING VEINTE PUNTOS**

Morgan Johnson has scored 20 or more points in her past two games. Johnson scored a career-high 22 points against Northeastern and followed with 21 against Central Michigan.

Johnson was yet to hit the 20-point mark in her career before her outburst against Northeastern.

Johnson was named to the KCRG-TV9 Hawkeye Challenge all-tournament team.

### KREI CLEANING SOME GLASS

Kelly Krei is giving lowa yet another rebounding presence in the paint.

Krei has 35 rebound through the first five games of the season. It took Krei eight games last year to reach 35 boards.

Krei also grabbed double-digit rebounds in the season opener Nov. 12 against Southern, finishing with 10. Krei did not grab 10 or more rebounds until Feb. 25 last season at Indiana.

### STEALING AWAY AGAINST BRADLEY

lowa collected 17 steals against Bradley Nov. 16, which was the highest steal total for a Hawkeye team since the 2005-06 season. lowa recorded 17 steals against UW-Milwaukee in the season opener on Nov. 20, 2005.

# Head Coach Lisa Bluder

Lisa Bluder (pronounced BLUE-dir) is in her 11th season as head coach at the University of Iowa and her 27th season as a college head coach. She is a three-time Big Ten and two-time WBCA Regional Coach of the Year.

Bluder, 47, has a career record of 550-265 (.675), including a 194-123 (.612) record at lowa, a 187-106 (.638) record in 10 seasons (1990-2000) at Drake and a six-year mark (1984-90) of 169-36 (.824) at St. Ambrose.



Bluder is Iowa's second all-time winningest coach and trails only C. Vivian Stringer. She has guided the Hawkeyes to nine post-season tournaments (7 NCAA, 2 WNIT) and seven upper-division finishes in the Big Ten Conference, including winning a share of the league championship in 2008 and tying for second place in 2009.

In her first season with the Hawkeyes, Bluder transformed a struggling program into a 21-game winner. Iowa finished second in the Big Ten, won the conference tournament and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament. Bluder became Iowa's third coach to be named Big Ten Coach of the Year. She was also honored as the College Coach of the Year by the *Women's Basketball News Service* and was named the WBCA District 6 Coach of the Year. Iowa's 2001-02 squad finished fourth in the Big Ten and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament for the second consecutive year. In 2003, Bluder guided the Hawkeyes to their first-ever WNIT appearance. Iowa, which had nine underclassmen on its roster, advanced to the quarterfinals before falling to Creighton. In 2004-05, Iowa finished 23-10, starting the year 13-0 and was the last Division I undefeated team standing. In 2005-06, Bluder mentored a team plagued by injuries to a fifth-place Big Ten finish and an NCAA Tournament berth.

In her 10 years at Drake, Bluder brought great success and tradition to the Bulldog program and established herself as one of the top coaches in the country. She led Drake to five 20-plus win seasons in her last six years, including five post-season appearances. She guided the Bulldogs to eight Missouri Valley Conference Tournament appearances, reaching the semifinals six times and winning the tournament four times. Bluder was also named the Conference Coach of the Year three times at Drake.

Bluder began her coaching career at St. Ambrose, where she coached six successful seasons, building the Bees into a NAIA powerhouse. During her tenure at St. Ambrose, Bluder guided the Bees to four straight national tournaments, including two consecutive Final Four appearances. The 1990 St. Ambrose team was ranked No. 1 and Bluder was named the NAIA Converse Coach of the Year.

A graduate of Linn-Mar High School in Marion, IA, Bluder was a three-year starter at Northern Iowa. She graduated from UNI in 1983 with a bachelor's degree in marketing.

### TAKING CARE OF THE BALL

lowa committed only nine turnovers against Bradley Nov. 16. The last time lowa had fewer than nine turnovers was the 2008-09 season when the Hawkeyes committed eight at Northwestern March 1, 2009.

### RACKING UP THE POINTS

lowa's 91 points against Bradley Nov. 16 were the most for a regular season, non-overtime game since Feb. 25, 2007, when the Hawkeyes defeated Wisconsin, 103-93. lowa scored 97 points in a triple-overtime win against Penn State Feb. 1, 2009.

### **ALEXANDER AND WAHLIN MAKE ALL-TOURNAMENT TEAM**

Kachine Alexander was named MVP of the Islander Tip-Off Tournament and Kamille Wahlin was picked for the all-tournament team.

Alexander scored 30 points and grabbed 17 rebounds in the two games. Wahlin added 23 points, seven rebounds and seven assists.

### **ALEXANDER ON WATCH LISTS**

Senior Kachine Alexander has been named to the watch lists for the Wade Trophy, the Wooden Award and the Naismith Trophy. The "Wade Watch" List is made up of the top 25 preseason women's basketball players, the Wooden Award includes 30 student-athletes and the Naismith Trophy watch list is made up of 50 players.

The Wade Trophy, Wooden Award and Naismith Trophy are considered the three most prestigious awards in NCAA women's college basketball.

Alexander is also one of 30 Division I women's basketball players nationally to be selected as a candidate for the Lowe's Senior CLASS Award. To be eligible, the candidates must show excellence in four categories: community, classroom, character and competition.

### KASH IN THE BANK

- As a 5-9 guard, junior Kachine Alexander ranked second in the Big Ten and 23rd nationally with 10.4 rebounds per game last season.
- Alexander claimed the Big Ten rebounding title, averaging 11.1 boards per game in league games.
- Alexander was the top rebounding guard in the country under 5-10, and was one of only two guards in the entire country to average a double-double (16 points, 10.4 rebounds per game). She was also one of only three Big Ten players to average a double-double, with the other two being post players.
- Alexander had 15 double-doubles this season and has 24 in her career, which ties Amy Herrig for fourth most in school history.
- Alexander scored double figures in 22 of 27 games played, including eight 20-plus point performances. She had 10 or more rebounds in 17 of those games, with an impressive 10 games with 12 or more boards.
- Alexander averaged more rebounds than nine of the 10 players selected to the Division I State Farm Coaches' all-America Team. She averaged the same amount of rebounds (10.4) as Nebraska's Kelsey Griffin.
- Alexander had more double-doubles than seven all-Americans, despite playing between 12 and 14 fewer games than most of the honorees.

### **EVERYBODY BACK**

lowa returns all but one player who logged significant minutes from last year's team that finished in a tie for third place in the Big Ten, earned a berth in the Big Ten Tournament championship game and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament after knocking off Rutgers in the first round (Gabby Machado - transfer).

### SUCCESS UNDER BLUDER

Last year marked the seventh time in 10 seasons under Head Coach Lisa Bluder that lowa has been selected for the NCAA Tournament, including each of the last three seasons. The Hawkeyes have participated in postseason play in all but one season under Bluder (two WNIT appearances).

In addition, lowa finished with a winning record for the ninth time in 10 seasons under Bluder. lowa's third place finish in the Big Ten is also the seventh time under Bluder the Hawkeyes recorded an upper-division finish in the conference.

lowa also tallied its fifth 20-win season under Bluder, including each of the last three seasons.

### **AWARD WINNERS RETURNING**

Several Hawkeyes earned numerous awards during the 2009-10 season.

- Head Coach Lisa Bluder was named Big Ten Coach of the Year for the third time in 10 seasons at lowa.
- Kachine Alexander was named honorable mention All-America by the Associated Press and the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA). Alexander was also selected All-Region by the WBCA. She also earned All-America honors by the National Strength and Conditioning Assocation (NSCA). Alexander was named first team all-Big Ten by the coaches, second team all-Big Ten by the media and was one of five players named to the Big Ten all-Defensive Team. She was also selected to the Big Ten Tournament all-tournament team, named the MVP of the KCRG-TV9 Hawkeye Challenge and was a two-time Big Ten Player of the Week.
- Jaime Printy was named Big Ten Freshman of the Year and was a unanimous pick for the Big Ten all-Freshmen team. Printy also earned second team all-conference honors from the media and third team all-league honors by the coaches. Printy was named Big Ten Freshman of the Week four times. She was named second team Freshman all-American by Full Court Press.
- Kamille Wahlin was a third team all-Big Ten selection by both the coaches and media. She was also named to the Big Ten Tournament, KCRG-TV9 Hawkeye Challenge and Nugget Classic all-tournament teams.
- Kelly Krei was named to the Big Ten Tournament all-tournament team.
- Morgan Johnson earned a Big Ten Freshman of the Week award.

### **LEADING THE LEAGUE**

Several Hawkeyes led the Big Ten in different statistical categories (both overall and league games only) last season.

### **INJURY UPDATE**

Iowa sophomores Theairra Taylor and Trisha Nesbitt are both sidelined with injuries.

Taylor suffered her third ACL tear in the last 20 months during preseason practice and will miss the entire season.

Nesbitt partially ruptured the plantar fascia in her right foot and will be out indefinitely. A timetable for Nesbitt's return has not been established.

### **TOUGH SCHEDULE IN 10-11**

Iowa's schedule features 15 opponents who participated in postseason play last year (nine NCAA teams, five WNIT teams and one WBI team). The Hawkeyes will take on six 2010 NCAA Tournament teams before conference play.
