Balbinot is in his seventh season as Iowa's play-by-play voice, while Till is in her sixth providing analysis.

IOWA HISTORY

lowa has played 1,048 games, since beginning basketball in 1974. Iowa's overall record is 641-408 (.612). That includes a 318-159 (.667) mark in regular season Big Ten contests and a 303-87 (.777) mark in Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

WIN NO. 300 AT HOME

The UI women's basketball program picked up victory No. 300 inside Carver-Hawkeye Arena with a 90-79 win over Central Michigan Nov. 21. The Hawkeyes have compiled a 303-87 (.777) record inside their home venue since it opened in 1983.

SCOUTING MICHIGAN

The Michigan Wolverines are 8-5 overall and 1-0 in Big Ten play.

In their last game, the Wolverines upset No. 12 Ohio State, 64-51, in Ann Arbor. Michigan limited Ohio State to a .274 (17-62) field goal percentage, including .133 (2-15) from three-point distance. Veronica Hicks and Carmen Reynolds each had 17 points in the win, while Hicks added a team-best eight rebounds.

Hicks leads the team with 10.8 points per game. Reynolds is next at 10.7 points per contest. Jenny Ryan is the team's leading rebounder at 5.2 boards per game.

As a team, Michigan is shooting .447 (313-700) from the field, including .330 (97-294) from three-point distance.

MICHIGAN VS. IOWA NOTES

- Iowa leads the all-time series, 41-13. The Hawkeyes have won 12 of the previous 15 contests, with Michigan winning both games last season. Iowa won 21-straight contests from 1985-96. The Hawkeyes are 21-5 against Michigan in Iowa City.
- lowa Assistant Coach Shannon Gage served as an assistant coach at Michigan from 2005-07
- Both Iowa and Michigan played Iowa State during non-conference action. Iowa State defeated Michigan, 60-47, as a part of the Big Ten/Big 12 Challenge. The Hawkeyes knocked off the Cyclones, 62-40.

LAST MEETING

lowa dropped a 63-46 decision at Michigan Jan. 7 last season.

Three Hawkeyes scored in double figures, including Jaime Printy (12), Kamille Wahlin (10) and Kachine Alexander (10). Alexander also collected 12 rebounds for a double-double.

The Hawkeyes could never grab a lead in the game, and trailed by 18 points at halftime. Iowa came out firing in the second half, using a 14-5 run to cut the deficit to nine, but that was as close as the Hawkeyes could get.

IOWA IN THE RANKINGS

The Hawkeyes are ranked No. 14 in the AP and No. 13 in the ESPN/USA Today top 25. Four lowa opponents are also ranked in the AP and ESPN/USA Today polls: North Carolina (10/10), Michigan State (12/16), Ohio State (13/12) and lowa State (20/21).

Northwestern is receiving votes.

2010-11 Team Captains

Iowa captains are senior Kelsey Cermak and junior Kamille Wahlin.

HIGHEST RANKING UNDER BLUDER

lowa's No. 14 ranking in the Associated Press poll is the highest ranking for a Hawkeye team under Head Coach Lisa Bluder and the highest since Nov. 17, 1997 (11th). Bluder led her to a No. 16 ranking in the AP poll in 2001.

The No. 13 ESPN/USA Today Coaches poll ranking is also the highest under Bluder (previous high was No. 17 in 2005). This is the highest lowa has been ranked in the coaches poll since a No. 12 preseason ranking in 1997.

HAWKEYES STUMBLE AT PENN STATE

lowa opened Big Ten play with a 68-59 loss at Penn State Dec. 30. The two teams were tied at 34 at halftime, but lowa gained a seven-point lead in the second half. Penn State closed the game with a 20-4 run in the final 6:33 to seal the win. During the run, lowa went 0-8 from the floor.

Jaime Printy led lowa with 17 points. Kelly Krei added 14 and Kamille Wahlin chipped in 11.

TOUGH AT HOME

The Hawkeyes have won 12-straight home games, dating back to last season. Iowa's last loss at Carver-Hawkeye Arena was Jan. 14, 2010 (68-62 to Penn State).

The Hawkeyes are a perfect 6-0 this season at home.

KASH CLOSE TO A GRAND

Kachine Alexander is close to becoming the 27th player in school history to score 1,000 career points.

Alexander needs just 16 more points to hit the 1,000 mark. She currently has 984 points.

BLUDER REACHES MILESTONE

With a 75-71 win at Drake Dec. 20, lowa Head Coach Lisa Bluder became only the second coach in school history to reach the 200-win milestone.

Bluder currently has 201 wins in her 11 years at lowa. C. Vivian Stringer is the only other Hawkeye head coach to reach the 200-win plateau at lowa, finishing her time in lowa City with 269 wins.

Ohio State Head Coach Jim Foster is the only other active Big Ten coach to have reached 200 wins at his/her current school.

HAWKEYES DOMINATING THE PAINT

lowa is racking up the points in the lane through 14 games.

The Hawkeyes have scored 20 or more paint points in all but one game (Bradley, 16) this season and have netted 30 or more points seven times. Iowa has outscored its opponents, 404-352 in the paint so far and the Hawkeyes are averaging 28.9 points in the paint per game.

lowa has recorded more paint points than its opponents in 10 games this season.

AT THE CHARITY STRIPE

lowa currently leads the Big Ten with a .779 free throw percentage. Jaime Printy ranks second in the league at .927 (38-41).

Head Coach Lisa Bluder

Lisa Bluder (pronounced BLUE-dir) is in her 11th season as head coach at the University of Iowa and her 27th season as a college head coach. She is a three-time Big Ten and two-time WBCA Regional Coach of the Year.

Bluder, 47, has a career record of 557-267 (.676), including a 201-125 (.617) record at lowa, a 187-106 (.638) record in 10 seasons (1990-2000) at Drake and a six-year mark (1984-90) of 169-36 (.824) at St. Ambrose.



Bluder is Iowa's second all-time winningest coach and trails only C. Vivian Stringer. She has guided the Hawkeyes to nine post-season tournaments (7 NCAA, 2 WNIT) and seven upper-division finishes in the Big Ten Conference, including winning a share of the league championship in 2008 and tying for second place in 2009.

In her first season with the Hawkeyes, Bluder transformed a struggling program into a 21-game winner. Iowa finished second in the Big Ten, won the conference tournament and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament. Bluder became Iowa's third coach to be named Big Ten Coach of the Year. She was also honored as the College Coach of the Year by the *Women's Basketball News Service* and was named the WBCA District 6 Coach of the Year. Iowa's 2001-02 squad finished fourth in the Big Ten and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament for the second consecutive year. In 2003, Bluder guided the Hawkeyes to their first-ever WNIT appearance. Iowa, which had nine underclassmen on its roster, advanced to the quarterfinals before falling to Creighton. In 2004-05, Iowa finished 23-10, starting the year 13-0 and was the last Division I undefeated team standing. In 2005-06, Bluder mentored a team plagued by injuries to a fifth-place Big Ten finish and an NCAA Tournament berth.

In her 10 years at Drake, Bluder brought great success and tradition to the Bulldog program and established herself as one of the top coaches in the country. She led Drake to five 20-plus win seasons in her last six years, including five post-season appearances. She guided the Bulldogs to eight Missouri Valley Conference Tournament appearances, reaching the semifinals six times and winning the tournament four times. Bluder was also named the Conference Coach of the Year three times at Drake.

Bluder began her coaching career at St. Ambrose, where she coached six successful seasons, building the Bees into a NAIA powerhouse. During her tenure at St. Ambrose, Bluder guided the Bees to four straight national tournaments, including two consecutive Final Four appearances. The 1990 St. Ambrose team was ranked No. 1 and Bluder was named the NAIA Converse Coach of the Year.

A graduate of Linn-Mar High School in Marion, IA, Bluder was a three-year starter at Northern Iowa. She graduated from UNI in 1983 with a bachelor's degree in marketing.

BALANCED SCORING ATTACK

lowa is the only team in the Big Ten to have five players ranked among the top 30 scorers in the league.

Northwestern, Penn State and Ohio State each have four players ranked. Wisconsin has three and the remaining six schools have either two or one.

The Hawkeyes have had at least three players reach double figures in scoring in all 14 games this year. Five players scored 10 or more points against Bradley. Four players hit double digits against Northeastern, Central Michigan and Kansas State.

HAWKEYES HITTING THE BOARDS

lowa's rebounding numbers through its first 14 games are impressive. The Hawkeyes lead the Big Ten in total rebounding (43.2 per game), rank second in defensive rebounding (29 per game) and rebounding margin (+6.8 per game) and third in offensive rebounding (14.2).

Morgan Johnson ranks second in offensive rebounding (3.3 per game) and Kachine Alexander ranks fourth (31 per game). Alexander's 18 rebounds against Central Michigan, Nov. 21, are tied for the most by any Big Ten player this season.

TOP FIVE IN THE BIG TEN

Four of lowa's starters rank in the top five in the Big Ten in different statistical categories.

- Morgan Johnson ranks second in offensive rebounding (3.3 per game) and blocks (2.4 per game).
- Kachine Alexander ranks fourth in total rebounding (8.8 per game) and offensive rebounding (3.1 per game).
- Jaime Printy ranks second in free throw percentage (.927) and third in three-pointers made (2.2 per game).
- Kamille Wahlin ranks fifth in assist/turnover ratio (1.4).

MOVING UP CAREER CHARTS

Four Hawkeyes are currently working their way up the career records lists at lowa.

- Kachine Alexander ranks second in career double-doubles (27), ninth in career rebounding (738), 13th in career assists (268) and 27th in career scoring (984). She needs eight more rebounds to move past Randi Peterson for eighth place on the rebounding list and 12 assists to move past Laurie Aaron and Necole Tunsil into 12th on the assists list. She needs nine more double-doubles to take over first place (Lisa Long, 35).
- Morgan Johnson ranks fifth in career blocks (113) and needs two more to move past Jennie Lillis into fourth place.
- Kamille Wahlin ranks sixth in career three-pointers made (135) and needs two more to move past Kristi Faulkner into fifth place.
- Jaime Printy ranks 10th in career three-pointers made (113) and needs four more to move past Crystal Smith for ninth place.

JOHNSON FILLING UP THE STAT SHEET

Morgan Johnson scored double figures over a tough four game-stretch, including double-doubles in two of those four contests.

Johnson tallied a double-double with 16 points and 13 rebounds at No. 14 North Carolina Dec. 2. She followed with 13 points and six rebounds against Kansas State and recorded another double-double with 16 points and 10 rebounds against No. 15 lowa State. Johnson had a career-high 26 points at South Dakota State, including the first 11 points of the contest.

Over the four-game stretch, Johnson averaged 17 points, nine rebounds, shot .707 (29-41) from the field and blocked 13 shots.

PRINTY'S STREAK SNAPPED

Jaime Printy came within one made free throw of tying a school record for consecutive free throws made.

After missing her first free throw attempt of the season in lowa's season-opener, Printy made 32-straight free throws. She finished 1-2 from the charity stripe at Drake and missed tying Lindsey Meder's record of 33 consecutive free throws made by one shot.

PRINTY LENDS A HELPING HAND

Jaime Printy recorded a career-high nine assists in Iowa's 22-point victory over Iowa State Dec. 9.

Printy leads the team with 52 assists and has led the team in helpers in six of lowa's 11 games.

KREI DRAINING FROM DISTANCE

Kelly Krei tied a career-high for three-pointers made against lowa State Dec. 9, draining five long distance shots. The lowa City native finished with 15 points (5-8 3Pt FGs).

Krei made five three-pointers against Penn State in the quarterfinals of the Big Ten Tournament last season.

SILENCING THE CYCLONES

lowa's defense was stout against No. 15 lowa State Dec. 9, holding the Cyclones to just 40 points.

The scoring output by Iowa State was the lowest for an Iowa opponent since the 2007-08 season. Iowa held Michigan to 37 points in the Big Ten Tournament (March 7, 2008).

BOMBS AWAY FOR A SCHOOL RECORD

The Hawkeyes set a school record with 37 three-point attempts against North Carolina Dec. 2. Iowa was just one three-pointer away from tying the school record for long distance shots made (12).

Kamille Wahlin attempted 11 treys while Jaime Printy had nine.

HAWKEYES TIE SCHOOL RECORD AGAINST VIRGINIA TECH

lowa tied a school record with 12 made three-pointers against Virginia Tech Nov. 26. lowa went 12-29 from distance. The Hawkeyes made 12 three-pointers against Gonzaga (11/21/02) and Columbia (11/28/09).

STEALING AWAY AGAINST BRADLEY

lowa collected 17 steals against Bradley Nov. 16, which was the highest steal total for a Hawkeye team since the 2005-06 season. Iowa recorded 17 steals against UW-Milwaukee in the season opener on Nov. 20, 2005.

RACKING UP THE POINTS

lowa's 91 points against Bradley Nov. 16 were the most for a regular season, non-overtime game since Feb. 25, 2007, when the Hawkeyes defeated Wisconsin, 103-93. Iowa scored 97 points in a triple-overtime win against Penn State Feb. 1, 2009.

ALEXANDER CRACKS TOP 10 IN CAREER REBOUNDING

Kachine Alexander's 10 rebounds against North Carolina Dec. 2 increased her career total to 695, moving her into 10th place on Iowa's career rebounding list. Alexander moved past Lisa Becker, who collected 691 rebounds from 1893-87.

Alexander currently has 738 rebounds.

Alexander collected double-doubles in each of lowa's three games and earned MVP honors at the KCRG-TV9 Hawkeye Challenge.

Alexander's first double-double of the season came against Bradley, recording 14 points and 10 rebounds. Alexander was 8-10 from the free throw line and also had five assists and three steals.

Alexander started the KCRG-TV9 Hawkeye Challenge with 21 points and 12 rebounds in a win over Northeastern, adding six assists, two steals and a block.

She wrapped up the tournament MVP award with 20 points and 18 rebounds against Central Michigan in the championship.

Alexander has now been named Big Ten Player of the Week five times in her career. She was a two-time award winner as both a sophomore and junior.


