Quick Hits

- Louisville defeated lowa in the only meeting between the two teams in last year's NCAA Tournament Second Round.
- lowa is 14-8 all-time against ACC opponents, including a 2-0 record last season (Boston College, Syracuse).
- Iowa is ranked No. 22 in the Associated Press Top-25 poll and No. 19 in the USA Today Preseason Coaches poll.
- Senior Samantha Logic, an honorable mention All-American last year, has been named Preseason All-America Second
 Team by ESPN, preseason All-Big Ten by league media and coaches, a "Wade Watch" list candidate, and to the John R.
 Wooden Award Women's Preseason Top 30 list.
- Logic is seventh in Big Ten history in career assists (668) and first in the NCAA in career assists among active players.
- lowa set the school record for scoring offense (78.2) last season, leading the league in scoring while notching the second-most points in a season in Big Ten history (2,814). The Hawkeyes rank second in the category this year (85.4).
- lowa returns 84 percent of its scoring from last season, including 10 letterwinners and four starters that averaged double figures: Bethany Doolittle (14.2), Samantha Logic (13.3), Ally Disterhoft (13.2), Melissa Dixon (13.1).
- Ally Disterhoft has scored in double figures in 22 of her first 24 career starts. lowa is 19-5 when Disterhoft starts.
- Iowa was picked to finish third behind Maryland and Michigan State in the Coaches Big Ten preseason rankings.
- lowa is the only Big Ten team, and one of only 14 teams in the country, to appear in the last seven NCAA Tournaments.

THE SETTING:

The 19th-ranked University of Iowa women's basketball team (6-1) travels to Louisville to face the seventh-ranked Cardinals (7-0) on Thursday at 6 p.m. (CT) at the KFC Yum! Center in the ACC/Big Ten Challenge.

WATCH THE ACTION:

Thursday's top-25 matchup can be seen on ESPN3.

AUDIO COVERAGE:

Brent Balbinot and Shelley Till will call the game for the Hawkeye Radio Network. Hawkeye fans can listen to the contest on AM-800 KXIC in Iowa City, AM-600 WMT in Cedar Rapids, AM-1040 WHO in Des Moines (and other Hawkeye Radio Network stations), or on the Hawkeye All-Access page of **hawkeyesports.com**. Balbinot is in his 11th season as Iowa's play-by-play voice, while Till is in her 10th providing analysis.

FOLLOW THE ACTION:

Hawkeye fans can also follow the game via live stats (Gametracker). The "GT" link can be accessed under the "Calendar" tab on the front page of **hawkeyesports.com** or on the women's basketball schedule page.

SCOUTING LOUISVILLE:

- Louisville begins a new era as a first-year member of the Atlantic Coast Conference.
- The Cardinals are 7-0 this season and 5-0 at home.
- Louisville is coached by Jeff Walz. Walz enters his eighth year at the helm of the program in 2014-15. In his first seven seasons, he has guided the Cardinals to two Final Four appearances, National Runner-up finishes in 2009 and 2013, and five Sweet 16 appearances. Louisville advanced to the Elite Eight last year before falling to Maryland.
- The Cardinals returned two starters and eight letterwinners from last year's team that finished 33-5 overall and 17-1 at home.

ALL-TIME SERIES / LAST MEETING:

• This will mark the second meeting between the Hawkeyes and Cardinals, and the second in as many years. Fourth-ranked Louisville defeated lowa in the Second Round of the NCAA Tournament on March 25 in Iowa City, 83-53.

IOWA VS. THE ACC:

- lowa is 2-5 in the ACC/Big Ten Challenge after defeating another first-year ACC member, Syracuse, last year. The Hawkeyes defeated the 22nd-ranked Orange, 97-91, inside Carver-Hawkeye Arena on Dec. 5.
- lowa is 14-8 all-time against ACC opponents, including a 2-0 record last season. The Hawkeyes defeated Boston College on Nov. 29, 2013, in the Cancun Challenge (78-68), before downing the Orange six days later in last year's Challenge.

Iowa captains are seniors Melissa Dixon, Samantha Logic, and Kathryn Reynolds.

HAWKEYES 22/19 IN RANKINGS:

lowa is No. 22 in this week's *Associated Press* Top-25 poll and No. 19 in the *USA Today* Preseason Coaches poll.

In the AP Poll, Nebraska is the highest-ranked Big Ten team (No. 12), followed by Maryland (No. 15), Michigan State (No. 16), Rutgers (No. 18) and Iowa (No. 22). Northwestern and Minnesota are receiving votes.

lowa has been ranked in each of the first four weeks this year: preseason (19/19), week 2 (18/18), week 3 (17/16), and week 4 (22/19).

The Hawkeyes finished the 2013-14 season ranked 19th in the AP Top-25 poll, and 26th (receiving votes) in the *USA Today* Coaches poll. Iowa was ranked for eight weeks last season in the AP poll, and received votes in nine additional weeks.

ANOTHER TRIPLE-DOUBLE:

Senior Samantha Logic notched her fifth career triple-double on Nov. 22, tallying 12 points, 11 rebounds, and 10 assists to lead lowa over Dayton in the Hawkeye Challenge title game. She is tied for the fifth-most triple-doubles in NCAA history, and has the most of any player as a member of the Big Ten. Suzie McConnell of Penn State (1985-88) and Louella Tomlinson of St. Mary's (CA) (2008-11) hold the career record with seven. Stanford's Nicole Powell (2001-04) and Alyssa Thomas of Maryland (2011-14) both posted six in their careers. Logic, Joskeen Garner (Northwestern State, 1993-96), Shalee Lehning (Kansas State, 2006-09), and Brittney Griner (Baylor, 2010-13), all have five career triple-doubles.

LOGIC NAMED TO WOODEN AWARD / WADE WATCH LIST:

Samantha Logic, named Preseason All-Big Ten and preseason All-America by ESPN, has been named to the John R. Wooden Award Women's Preseason Top 30 list, comprised of the early front-runners for college basketball's most prestigious honor. The list is chosen by a preseason poll of national women's college basketball media members.

She has also been named a 2014-15 "Wade Watch" list candidate for the prestigious award (The Wade Trophy), the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) announced.

Logic, the NCAA's active career assists leader (659), ranks seventh in assists in Big Ten history. She leads the NCAA in the category this season (9.3), while also averaging 10.5 points and 8.5 rebounds per game.

1.000-POINT CLUB:

Four members of this year's team have reached, or have the potential to reach 1,000 career points this year.

- Senior Samantha Logic (1,172 points) ranks 22nd on lowa's all-time scoring list. Crystal Smith is 21st (1,193).
- Senior Melissa Dixon (1,072 points) is 29th. Shanda Berry is 28th (1,100).
- Senior Bethany Doolittle has 947 career points. She needs 53 points to become the 33rd career member of the 1,000-point club.
- Sophomore Allie Disterhoft has 586 career points. She tallied 474 in 36 games as a freshman last year (13.2 per game), and is averaging 16.0 points per game this season.

MOVING UP CAREER CHARTS:

- Samantha Logic (668 career assists) surpassed Cara Consuegra (1997-2001; 576) as Iowa's
 all-time assists leader during Iowa's win at Illinois on March 2, 2014, in the regular season
 finale last season. She ranks seventh in Big Ten history. Nebraska's Lindsey Moore is sixth with
 699 career assists.
- Melissa Dixon is third in 3-pointers on Iowa's all-time list (235). Jaime Printy is second with 252. Lindsey Meder holds the school record (261).
- Bethany Doolittle is third all-time with 196 career blocks. Tangela Smith is second with 235.

TOUGH SCHEDULE:

lowa's schedule this season features 29 regular season games (18 conference, 11 nonconference). Of those 29 contests, 20 will come against teams that played in a postseason tournament last season. Seventeen-of-24 teams the Hawkeyes play this season reached a postseason tournament a year ago.

During the 2014 postseason, Big Ten programs combined for 15 NCAA Tournament and WNIT victories, tied for the most postseason wins in conference history.

Head Coach Lisa Bluder

Lisa Bluder (pronounced BLUE-dir), the all-time winningest coach in program history, is in her 15th season as head coach at the University of Iowa and her 31st season as a college head coach.

Under her direction, the Hawkeyes have advanced to 13 postseason appearances (11 NCAA and two WNIT) in 14 seasons, including NCAA Tournament berths in each of the last seven seasons. Iowa is the only team in the Big Ten, and one of 14 in NCAA Division I women's basketball, to qualify



for the NCAA Tournament in each of the last seven years. There are 343 Division I teams.

The longest-tenured Big Ten coach, Bluder has posted a 284-167 (.629) record at lowa and her career record stands at 640-309 (.674). Bluder surpassed Hall of Famer C. Vivian Stringer (269 wins) as the all-time winningest coach in program history on Feb. 10, 2014, as the Hawkeyes defeated Northwestern, 90-84.

Bluder, 1-of-10 active major college coaches with 600 or more wins, is a three-time Big Ten Coach of the Year (2001, 2008 and 2010) and two-time WBCA Regional Coach of the Year (2001 and 2008). She has guided lowa to a winning record in 13 of her 14 years at lowa, including 10 upper-division finishes in the challenging Big Ten Conference. Bluder, who ranks fourth among Big Ten coaches all-time in league victories (138), has led lowa to eight 20-win seasons in her 14 years, including six of the last seven years.

Bluder has coached numerous players to different awards in her 14 years in lowa City. She has mentored 19 players to 40 All-Big Ten honors, including 11 first team picks, 11 second, 11 third and seven honorable mention selections. She has also had two Big Ten Freshman of the Year award winners, two Big Ten Sixth Player of the Year recipients, six members of the Big Ten All-Freshman team and three players named to the Big Ten All-Defensive team, with Kachine Alexander earning the honor twice.

Five players during Bluder's tenure have earned a total of six Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) all-region team accolades and six players have earned a total of 11 honorable mention All-America honors.

With Bluder on the lowa sidelines, student-athletes have been named Academic All-Big Ten 67 times, including a program-best eight honorees in 2011 and 2012. The 67 honorees equal the third-highest total in the Big Ten during the last 14 years.

In her 10 years at Drake, Bluder brought great success and tradition to the Bulldog program and established herself as one of the top coaches in the country. She led Drake to five 20-plus win seasons in her last six years, including five post-season appearances. She guided the Bulldogs to eight Missouri Valley Conference Tournament appearances, reaching the semifinals six times and winning the tournament four times. Bluder was also named the Conference Coach of the Year three times at Drake.

Bluder began her coaching career at St. Ambrose, where she coached six successful seasons, building the Bees into a NAIA powerhouse. During her tenure at St. Ambrose, Bluder guided the Bees to four straight national tournaments, including two consecutive Final Four appearances. The 1990 St. Ambrose team was ranked No. 1 and Bluder was named the NAIA Converse Coach of the Year.

A graduate of Linn-Mar High School in Marion, Iowa, Bluder was a three-year starter at Northern Iowa. She graduated from UNI in 1983 with a bachelor's degree in marketing.

WATCH THE HAWKEYES:

Twenty-six of lowa's 29 regular season contests can be seen on BTN, BTN Plus, ESPN2, ESPN3, or MC22 (Mediacom Connections). Seventeen games will appear on BTN or digitally on BTN Plus, and two additional regular season contests will be televised by ESPN2. All 18 of lowa's league games can be seen on one of the BTN or ESPN platforms, and the Hawkeyes' home nonconference contest against lowa State on Dec. 11 will be televised by BTN at 7 p.m. (CT).

LOGIC NAMED TO B1G HONOR ROLL:

Samantha Logic was named to the Big Ten Player of the Week Honor Roll on Nov. 24 after recording her fifth-career triple-double with 12 points, 11 rebounds and 10 assists in the Hawkeyes' comeback win over Dayton. Logic was named the Hawkeye Challenge MVP after guiding lowa to victories over Pepperdine and Dayton, averaging 12.0 points, 8.5 rebounds, 9.5 assists and 2.5 steals per game.

DIXON REACHES 1.000. NAMED TO B1G HONOR ROLL:

Iowa senior Melissa Dixon was named to the Big Ten Player of the Week Honor Roll on Nov. 17 after recording her 1,000th-career point and averaging 18.5 points per game in a pair of wins over USC Upstate (107-65) and Robert Morris (85-67). She is Iowa's 32nd career 1,000-point scorer.

IOWA WINS HAWKEYE CHALLENGE:

The Hawkeyes defeated Dayton, 90-83, in the Hawkeye Challenge title game on Nov. 22. Iowa defeated Pepperdine, 97-68, in its opening game on Nov. 21. Samantha Logic was named tournament MVP, while Ally Disterhoft and Bethany Doolittle were named to the all-tournament team.

HAWKEYES SET SCHOOL RECORD IN OPENER:

The Hawkeyes defeated USC Upstate in the season-opener on Nov. 14, 107-56, setting a new school record for points in a game. The previous record was 106 against North Carolina in 1990 and Northern Iowa in 1978.

lowa is leading the Big Ten in scoring offense (94.8).

NCAA STREAK BEST IN BIG TEN:

lowa is the only Big Ten team, and one of only 14 teams in the country, to appear in the last seven NCAA Tournaments. There are 343 Division I teams.

lowa is 1-of-21 teams to advance to the Second Round of the NCAA Tournament in each of the last two seasons. The Hawkeyes, a No. 6 seed in the 2014 NCAA Tournament, defeated 11th-seeded Marist in the First Round, 87-65, marking the fourth-largest margin of victory in an NCAA Tournament game in program history.

IOWA PICKED 3RD: LOGIC NAMED ALL-BIG TEN:

lowa has been picked to finish third behind Maryland and Michigan State in the 2014-15 Coaches Big Ten preseason rankings, while senior Samantha Logic has been named preseason All-Big Ten by league media and coaches.

Logic earned honorable mention All-America honors from the *Associated Press* and the WBCA as a junior last year. The Racine, Wisconsin, native was a unanimous first team All-Big Ten selection by the coaches, and a first team selection by the media to become the 18th lowa player to garner first team All-Big Ten honors — the most of any Big Ten program.

LOGIC NAMED PRESEASON ALL-AMERICAN:

Samantha Logic, a 2014 honorable mention All-American, has been named to ESPN's Preseason All-America Second Team. Logic was joined on the second team by Rachel Banham of Minnesota, Moriah Jefferson of UConn, Isabelle Harrison of Tennessee and Aleighsa Welch of South Carolina. The first team included Jewell Loyd of Notre Dame, Tiffany Mitchell of South Carolina, Kaleena Mosqueda-Lewis of UConn, Nina Davis of Baylor and Breanna Stewart of UConn.

RETURNING SCORING POWER:

Last season, lowa set the school record for scoring offense (78.2), leading the league in scoring while notching the second-most points in a season in Big Ten history (2,814). lowa returns 84 percent of its scoring from last season, including 10 letterwinners and four starters that averaged double-figures: All-Big Ten honoree Bethany Doolittle (14.2 points per game), All-American Samantha Logic (13.3), All-Big Ten honoree Ally Disterhoft (13.2), and Melissa Dixon (13.1).

ROSTER CHANGES FOR 2014-15:

Theairra Taylor averaged 12.4 points per game last season as a senior. lowa returns all other 10 letterwinners from a year ago, and adds a promising freshmen class that includes 6-foot forward Christina Buttenham (Canadian Junior Women's National Team member), 6-foot-3 forward Chase Coley (Gatorade Minnesota Girls Basketball Player of the Year), 5-foot-5 guard Whitney Jennings (Indiana Miss Basketball), and 6-foot-1 forward Carly Mohns (first-team all-state).

SEASON IN REVIEW

The University of lowa women's basketball team finished the 2013-14 campaign with a 27-9 overall record, including an 11-5 mark in Big Ten play. lowa finished tied for fourth in the league with Purdue.

The Hawkeyes were an at-large selection for the NCAA Tournament, earning a No. 6 seed and hosting the First and Second rounds. lowa defeated No. 11 seed Marist, 87-65, in the First Round, marking the fourth-largest margin of victory in an NCAA Tournament game in program history. The Hawkeyes fell to No. 3 seed and fourth-ranked Louisville, 83-53, in the Second Round.



MOST WINS SINCE 1995-96:

lowa's 27 wins last year marked the highest total under UI head coach Lisa Bluder, and the highest since lowa finished 27-4 in 1995-96. Seven of lowa's nine losses came against ranked opponents.

The Hawkeyes' 27 victories equal the second-highest total in program history. lowa also won 27 games in 1995-96 (27-4), 1992-93 (27-4), and 1988-89 (27-5). The program record for single-season victories is 29, as the Hawkeyes went 29-2 during the 1987-88 season.

lowa defeated Illinois inside Carver-Hawkeye Arena on Feb. 13 (69-55), earning its 20th win of the season and becoming the first Big Ten team to reach the mark.

The Hawkeyes have won 20 games or more in a season eight times under Lisa Bluder, including six of the last seven seasons (lowa finished 19-12 in 2011-12). Dating back to the 1984-85 season, lowa has reached the 20-win mark 18 times.

lowa won its 20th game last season in its 26th contest, marking the fastest year to 20 wins under Bluder, and fastest since the 1995-96 season. That year, the Hawkeyes won their 20th in their 21st game under head coach Angie Lee. Iowa started 20-1 and finished 27-4 while advancing to the NCAA Sweet Sixteen.

HAWKEYES AT CARVER-HAWKEYE ARENA:

The Hawkeyes are 354-101 (.778) all-time inside Carver-Hawkeye Arena, and 11-6 in NCAA Tournament games. Iowa went 14-4 at home last season, and is 94-23 in its last 117 games inside Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

lowa's 14 home wins a year ago equaled the second-highest single-season total in program history. The 14 wins were the most in lowa City since the Hawkeyes finished 14-0 in the 1995-96 season. Iowa also won 14 home games in 1988-89 (14-0), 1987-88 (14-0), 1986-87 (14-1), 1985-86 (14-1). The program record for home wins is 15, as the Hawkeyes finished 15-0 in 1992-93. Iowa advanced to the NCAA Final Four that season.

ANOTHER TOP ATTENDANCE YEAR:

lowa ranked 22nd in the country in attendance last season, averaging 4,395 fans per contest. Last year marks the fourth-straight season that lowa has ranked inside the top 25 in attendance. The Hawkeyes were 19th in attendance in each of the previous two years, and were 13th in 2010.

MOST B1G VICTORIES:

Head coach Lisa Bluder has 138 career Big Ten victories (138-92), surpassing former Ohio State head coach Jim Foster (136) for the fourth-most in league history. Rene Portland of Penn State has the most in conference history (176). Former Hawkeye head coach C. Vivian Stringer is second with 169 wins, and Karen Langeland of Michigan State has the third most (156).

IOWA HISTORY:

lowa has played 1,175 games since beginning basketball in 1974. lowa's overall record is 725-450 (.617). That includes a 359-183 (.660) mark in regular season Big Ten contests and a 354-101 (.778) mark in Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

2015 Recruiting Class

Tania Davis (Grand Blanc, Michigan), Megan Gustafson (Port Wing, Wisconsin), Tagyn Larson (Sioux Falls, South Dakota) and Hannah Stewart (Minot, North Dakota) have signed National Letters of Intent to attend the University of Iowa next fall. Iowa's class is ranked 18th nationally by ESPN HoopGurlz.

Davis, a 5-foot-4 guard from Goodrich High School in Grand Blanc, Michigan, is an ESPN HoopGurlz Top 100 recruit, ranking as the 37th-best prospect nationally and the 12th-best point guard. She is ranked as the top prospect in the 2015 class in the state of Michigan by Lady Baller Insider.

The two-time team captain has led Goodrich to three-straight conference titles, a district champion-ship, and two state titles. Davis earned honorable mention all-conference honors as a freshman, leading Goodrich to a 28-0 record and a state title, playing in 28 contests while making six starts. She averaged 8.1 points, 2.1 rebounds, 2.3 assists, and 1.7 steals. As a sophomore, Davis started all 28 games while averaging 17.6 points, 2.7 rebounds, 4.0 assists, 3.2 steals, leading Goodrich to a 25-3 record and a second-consecutive state title. She earned first team all-conference, Basketball Coaches Association Class B All-State, Associated Press Class B Special Mention All-State, Detroit Free Press First Team All-State Class B, and Detroit News First Team All-State Class B honors.

Last year as a junior, Davis led Goodrich to a district title and a 22-3 record, averaging 19.1 points, 3.0 rebounds, 4.1 assists, and 3.2 steals, while starting all 25 games. She earned MLive (Flint) Player of the Year, Associated Press Class B Player of the Year, Basketball Coaches Association Best of the Best (top 11 players in state), Detroit Free Press First Team All-State Class B, Detroit News First Team All-State, and first team all-conference honors. Davis notched five 25-point games, including a 41-point performance. A National Honor Society member, she has been a member of the honor roll every semester since her freshman year.

Gustafson, a 6-foot-3 forward from South Shore High School in Port Wing, Wisconsin, is an ESPN HoopGurlz Top 100 recruit (No. 92). The two-time team captain is a three-time first team all-conference honoree and a two-time first team all-state selection. As a freshman, she averaged 19.9 points, 13.7 rebounds, and 5.3 blocks. Gustafson led South Shore to a conference, regional, and sectional championship as a sophomore, averaging 30.9 points, 12.6 rebounds, and 5.6 blocks in 28 starts as team finished 27-1. Last year as a junior, she started all 27 games, leading team to a 26-1 record and conference and regional titles. Gustafson averaged 29.8 points, 18.9 rebounds, and 5.9 blocks.

Gustafson is also a four-time all-conference selection in volleyball, and competes in the shot put, discus, triple jump, 300-meter hurdles, and 100-meter hurdles in track. She finished seventh in the shot put and 11th in the discus in last year's state track meet. Gustafson, a National Honor Society member, has been an honor roll student throughout high school. She has served as class president all four years of high school, and served as a student council member as a junior.

Larson, a 6-foot-2 forward from Roosevelt High School in Sioux Falls, South Dakota, is a three-time all-state and all-city honoree. She is a two-time all-tournament and all-conference selection, and has been named to the Argus Leader First Five. Larson averaged 12 points and eight rebounds and registered 90 blocks as a sophomore, leading Roosevelt to a conference title. As a junior she averaged 16 points and eight rebounds, tallying 69 blocks. She shot 51 percent from the field and 80 percent from the foul line. Larson holds the school record for career blocks and blocks in a game, and needs 71 rebounds to become the school's career leader.

Larson is a standout outside hitter for the Roosevelt volleyball team, earning all-state, all-conference, and all-city honors. Named a Hometown Hero for her high school, she is also involved in Spanish Club, Cancer Awareness Club, and Fellowship of Christian Athletes.

Stewart, a 6-foot-2 forward from Bishop Ryan High School in Minot, North Dakota, is an ESPN Hoop-Gurlz Top 100 recruit (No. 95). She has played varsity basketball since she was in eighth grade, when she averaged 7.8 points, 6.4 rebounds, 1.7 assists, 1.9 steals, and 1.7 blocks, as team finished third in Region 6. As a freshman, Stewart averaged 18.7 points, 10.2 rebounds, 1.8 assists, 3.6 steals, and 2.2 blocks, leading team to a 26-2 record, a conference title, and a fifth-place finish at the state tournament. She was named all-state, all-region, all-district, and to the state all-tournament team.

Stewart has led Bishop Ryan to a state record 57-game winning streak entering her senior year, winning conference and state championships in each of the last two years. As a sophomore, she averaged 21.9 points, 10.5 rebounds, 2.1 assists, 4.7 steals, and 3.2 blocks, while posting 23.0 points, 11.3 rebounds, 2.4 assists, 4.3 steaks, and 2.9 blocks per contest as a junior. A two-time team captain, she has garnered all-state, all-region, all-district, state all-tournament team, and state tournament MVP honors in each of the last two years. Stewart was a Gatorade Player of the Year nominee in 2014, an all-area athlete in 2013 and 2014, and athlete of the year for the state of North Dakota in 2014. She holds school records for career points (1,955), rebounds (1,047), blocks (274), and steals (397), and rebounds in a single game (16).

Stewart is also a standout volleyball player, earning all-district and all-region honors. She plays pitcher and shortstop in softball, and owns the school records for home runs, career hits, and pitching wins. Stewart tossed a no-hitter in the 2013 state tournament. She has guided Bishop Ryan to three-straight conference titles and three-consecutive state runner-up finishes, while being named all-state and state all-tournament four times and a nominee for the Gatorade Player of the Year twice.

A 4.0 student, Stewart serves as National Honor Society president, and is a member of the speech team, Rotary Club, and S.A.D.D. She is also a Special Olympics volunteer and plays violin in the orchestra.
