Quick Hits

- The Hawkeyes have won 8-of-9 overall. lowa is one of 14 teams nationally with 12 or more wins, and is tied for the second-highest win total in the country this season.
- Indiana (13-0) is off to its best start in program history, and is tied for the most wins of any team in the country.
- lowa's 12 wins prior to the start of conference play equal the most in a season under head coach Lisa Bluder. lowa finished 12-1 in its pre-conference slate during the 2010-11 campaign.
- lowa is averaging 82.6 points and 19.7 assists per contest, leading the Big Ten in both categories. In addition, the Hawkeyes are seventh nationally in assists per game.
- lowa has had three or more players score in double figures in each of the last 12 contests, including six in the win over North Dakota (Logic 21, Taylor 14, Dixon 13, Doolittle 12, Disterthoft 12, Kastanek 11).
- Five Hawkeyes are averaging double figures (Dixon, Logic, Doolittle, Disterhoft, Taylor).
- Junior guard Samantha Logic the Big Ten leader in assists is averaging 16.5 points, 12 rebounds and nine assists over the last two contests.
- After converting seven 3-pointers total during the first six games of the season (7-of-46), junior guard Melissa Dixon has made 36 over the last eight games (36-of-81).
- Lisa Bluder needs seven wins to surpass Hall of Famer C. Vivian Stringer (269 wins) as lowa's all-time winningest coach. Bluder is one of 13 active Division I coaches with 600 or more wins.

THE SETTING:

The 22nd-ranked University of Iowa women's basketball team (12-2) opens Big Ten play at Indiana (13-0) on Thursday. Tip is set for 6 p.m. (CT) at Assembly Hall in Bloomington, Ind.

The Hawkeyes have won 8-of-9 overall. lowa is one of 14 teams nationally with 12 or more wins, and is tied for the secondhighest win total in the country this season.

NONCONFERENCE RECAP:

lowa's 12 wins prior to the start of conference play equal the most in a season under head coach Lisa Bluder. lowa finished 12-1 in its pre-conference slate during the 2010-11 campaign. The Hawkeyes were 11-3 prior to the start of league play last season, and 11-0 in 2004-05.

AUDIO COVERAGE:

Brent Balbinot and Shelley Till will call the action for the Hawkeye Radio Network. Hawkeye fans can listen to the contest on AM-800 KXIC in Iowa City, AM-1360 KMJM in Cedar Rapids, AM-1040 WHO in Des Moines or on the Hawkeye All-Access page of hawkeyesports.com. Balbinot is in his 10th season as lowa's play-by-play voice, while Till is in her ninth providing analysis.

IOWA HISTORY:

lowa has played 1,146 games since beginning basketball in 1974. Iowa's overall record is 704-442 (.613). That includes a 348-178 (.662) mark in regular season Big Ten contests and a 343-97 (.776) mark in Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

IOWA-INDIANA NOTES:

- Thursday's contest marks the 61st meeting between lowa and Indiana.
- lowa leads the all-time series, 45-15.
- The Hawkeyes have won the last seven in the series, including the last three at Indiana.
- lowa and Indiana last met in Bloomington in 2011-12. The Hawkeyes won, 83-64.

THE LAST MEETING:

lowa defeated Indiana, 75-70, on Feb. 28, 2013 in its Big Ten home finale last year inside Carver-Hawkeye Arena. It marked the only meeting between the two league foes last season.

On a night when the UI program honored seniors Morgan Johnson, Trisha Nesbitt, and Jaime Printy, a sophomore sharpshooter came off the bench to score a team-high 22 points and help dig the Hawkeyes out of an 18-point hole. Melissa Dixon made 5-of-13 3-point field goals -- four coming in the first half -- as she all but cemented the Big Ten Conference Sixth Player of the Year Award. Iowa outscored the Hoosiers 22-0 in bench points, and all 22 came from Dixon.

Indiana scored 14 of the game's first 16 points and led by 18 with 6:16 left in the first half. The Hoosiers led 44-34 at halftime. lowa outscored Indiana in the second half, 41-26.

lowa captains are senior Theairra Taylor and junior Samantha Logic.

SCOUTING INDIANA:

- Indiana defeated Xavier on the road on Dec. 29, 62-55, to give IU its best start in program history at 13-0.
- The 13-game winning streak is the longest ever in school history.
- Indiana ended nonconference play without a loss for the fourth time ever.
- Indiana's 13 nonconference regular season victories are the most ever in program history.
- The Hoosiers at 7-0 at home this season.
- Indiana is coached by Curt Miller. In his first season at the helm of the Indiana program last year,
 Miller led the Hoosiers to their most wins in three years, nearly doubling the program's win total from the year prior to his arrival. The Hoosiers finished 11-19 overall, and 2-14 in league play.
- Freshman Larryn Brooks leads the Hoosiers in scoring at 18.7 points per game.

HAWKEYES DOWN NORTH DAKOTA FOR 12TH WIN:

A balanced scoring effort sent the No. 21/25 University of Iowa women's basketball team to its 12th victory of the season Dec. 28 on Mediacom Court inside Carver-Hawkeye Arena. The Hawkeyes used a 43-10 run spanning halves to cruise to an 88-62 victory over North Dakota in their nonconference finale.

Junior Samantha Logic led a group of six Hawkeyes in double digits, netting 21 points on 6-of-10 shooting and a 9-of-12 performance from the charity stripe. She also had eight assists and seven rebounds.

Senior Theairra Taylor scored 14 points and had six rebounds, junior Melissa Dixon had 13 points, junior Bethany Doolittle and freshman Ally Disterhoft netted 12 points apiece and freshman Alexa Kastanek added 11 points. Sophomore Kali Peschel had a game-high 10 rebounds.

IN THE RANKINGS:

lowa is ranked 22nd in The Associated Press Top 25 poll this week, and sits 23rd in the USA Today Coaches Poll.

Six Iowa opponents are also ranked in the Associated Press/USA Today polls: Colorado (12/14), Iowa State (14/10), Penn State (15/17), Purdue (17/19), Nebraska (18/15), and Syracuse (20/24), In addition, Dayton and Indiana are receiving votes.

HAWKEYES IN BIG TEN PLAY:

lowa head coach Lisa Bluder, the dean of Big Ten coaches, is a three-time Big Ten Coach of the Year (2001, 2008 and 2010). She has guided lowa to nine upper-division finishes in the Big Ten in 13 seasons. lowa won a share of the Big Ten regular season championship in 2008 and finished in a three-way tie for second in 2009.

BALANCED ATTACK:

Five Hawkeyes are averaging double figures: Melissa Dixon (15.2), Samantha Logic (14.2), Bethany Doolittle (13.4), Ally Disterhoft (11.9), and Theairra Taylor (10.4).

lowa has had three or more players score in double figures in each of the last 12 contests, including six in the win over North Dakota (Logic 21, Taylor 14, Dixon 13, Doolittle 12, Disterthoft 12, Kastanek 11). The six players in double figures matched a season high (Dayton).

CLIMBING TO THE TOP:

Lisa Bluder needs seven wins to surpass Hall of Famer C. Vivian Stringer (269) as lowa's all-time winningest coach. Bluder -- one of 13 active Division I coaches with 600 or more wins -- is 263-159 all-time as the Hawkeye head coach.

MOVING UP CAREER CHARTS:

- Samantha Logic is second in career assists (449). Cara Consuegra (1997-2001) is lowa's all-time assists leader (576).
- Melissa Dixon has 156 career 3-pointers, equaling Leah Magner for seventh on lowa's all-time list. Kelli Krei is sixth with 162.
- Bethany Doolittle is fifth all-time with 121 career blocks. Toni Foster is fourth with 145.

Head Coach Lisa Bluder

Lisa Bluder (pronounced BLUE-dir) is in her 14th season as head coach at the University of Iowa and her 30th season as a college head coach. She is a three-time Big Ten and two-time WBCA Regional Coach of the Year.

Bluder has a career record of 619-301 (.673), including a 263-159 (.623) record at lowa, a 187-106 (.638) record in 10 seasons (1990-2000) at Drake and a six-year mark (1984-90) of 169-36 (.824) at St. Ambrose.



Bluder is lowa's second all-time winningest coach and trails only C. Vivian Stringer (269 wins). She has guided the Hawkeyes to 12 postseason tournaments (10 NCAA, 2 WNIT) and nine upper-division finishes in the Big Ten Conference, including winning a share of the league championship in 2008 and taking home the conference tournament title in 2001.

In her first season with the Hawkeyes, Bluder transformed a struggling program into a 21-game winner. Iowa finished second in the Big Ten, won the conference tournament and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament. Bluder became lowa's third coach to be named Big Ten Coach of the Year. She was also honored as the College Coach of the Year by the Women's Basketball News Service and was named the WBCA District 6 Coach of the Year. Iowa's 2001-02 squad finished fourth in the Big Ten and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament for the second consecutive year. In 2003, Bluder guided the Hawkeyes to their first-ever WNIT appearance. Iowa, which had nine underclassmen on its roster, advanced to the quarterfinals before falling to Creighton. In 2004-05, Iowa finished 23-10, starting the year 13-0 and was the last Division I undefeated team standing. In 2005-06, Bluder mentored a team plagued by injuries to a fifth-place Big Ten finish and an NCAA Tournament berth.

In her 10 years at Drake, Bluder brought great success and tradition to the Bulldog program and established herself as one of the top coaches in the country. She led Drake to five 20-plus win seasons in her last six years, including five post-season appearances. She guided the Bulldogs to eight Missouri Valley Conference Tournament appearances, reaching the semifinals six times and winning the tournament four times. Bluder was also named the Conference Coach of the Year three times at Drake.

Bluder began her coaching career at St. Ambrose, where she coached six successful seasons, building the Bees into a NAIA powerhouse. During her tenure at St. Ambrose, Bluder guided the Bees to four straight national tournaments, including two consecutive Final Four appearances. The 1990 St. Ambrose team was ranked No. 1 and Bluder was named the NAIA Converse Coach of the Year.

A graduate of Linn-Mar High School in Marion, lowa, Bluder was a three-year starter at Northern Iowa. She graduated from UNI in 1983 with a bachelor's degree in marketing.

B1G HONOR ROLL:

- Two Hawkeyes -- Samantha Logic and Melissa Dixon -- have been named to the Big Ten Player of the Week Honor Roll in the last six weeks. Iowa has had a player named to the Honor Roll or be named Player of the Week in five of the last six weeks.
- Logic was named to the Honor Roll on Nov. 25 after averaging 21.5 points, 7.5 rebounds, 4.0 assists and 2.0 steals as lowa split
 a pair of road contests at No. 16 Colorado and UNI.
- Dixon was honored Dec. 2 after being named MVP of the Cancun Challenge Mayan Division, where she averaged 22.3 points per
 game, including a career-high 32 against UNC-Wilmington.
- Dixon was honored again on Dec. 9, after helping lowa to wins over No. 22 Syracuse and Idaho State last week, averaging 25.5
 points per game, while converting 13-of-21 three-point attempts.
- Logic was to the Honor Roll on Dec. 31. She finished with 21 points, eight assists, seven rebounds and two steals while shooting 60 percent from the floor in a win over North Dakota
- Logic was named Big Ten Player of Week on Nov. 12 for her efforts in Iowa's wins against UC Riverside and No. 14 Dayton, and on Dec. 23 following her triple-double against Drake.

DIXON CATCHING FIRE:

- Junior guard Melissa Dixon finished with six 3-point field goals in lowa's win over Idaho State on Dec. 7 one shy of her personal
 record and the school record (seven accomplished five times, twice by Dixon).
- After converting seven 3-pointers total during the first six games of the season (7-of-46), Dixon has made 36 over the last eight games (36-of-81).
- Prior to the Cancun Challenge, Dixon was averaging 9.7 points per game. She is now lowa's leading scorer, averaging 15.2 points per outing.

LOGIC NAMED B1G PLAYER OF THE WEEK:

lowa junior guard Samantha Logic was named Big Ten Player of Week on Monday following her second career triple-double in lowa's 73-51 win over Drake on Dec. 21.

Logic (5-foot-9) -- the Big Ten leader in assists -- tallied 12 points, 10 assists and 17 rebounds, while shooting 85.7 percent from the field on 6-of-7 shooting and added two steals. She last accomplished the feat on Feb. 26, 2012, against Michigan (13 points, 11 rebounds, 11 assists).

Logic, the only current Big Ten player with two career triple-doubles, has two of the five triple-doubles in program history -- Cara Consuegra, Kachine Alexander (twice).

The Racine, Wis., native, who has 15 career double-doubles, is second in career assists (441). She surpassed Michelle Edwards (431) during lowa's win over the Bulldogs. Logic, 1-of-2 conference juniors named preseason All-Big Ten, has nine career games with double-digit assists, equaling Cara Consuegra for the most in program history.

The award marks Logic's fourth career Player of the Week honor, and second this season (Nov. 12).

IOWA SETS NEW SINGLE-GAME 3-POINT RECORD:

The Hawkeyes won their sixth game in a row, thanks to a school-record 17 made 3-point field goals, 95-47, on Dec. 7 against Idaho State inside Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

lowa shot 56.4-percent from the field for the game and held the Bengals to 21.5-percent (11.8-percent in the second half). While the Hawkeyes made 75-percent of their two-point field goals (14-of-21), the real story was their success from long range.

Junior Melissa Dixon converted six 3-pointers, giving her 20 in the last three games. She had a school-record seven against UNC-Wilmington and Syracuse. Senior Theairra Taylor made four 3-pointers against Idaho State, freshman Ally Disterhoft had three, sophomore Kathryn Reynolds added two, and junior Samantha Logic and freshman Alexa Kastanek made one apiece.

The previous record was 14, last accomplished on Dec. 22, 2011, against Mississippi Valley State.

HAWKEYES CONTINUE TREND AGAINST RANKED FOES:

- lowa is 2-2 this season against ranked opponents (the two top-25 wins are the most of any Big Ten team):
- W vs. No. 14 Dayton (97-93 in overtime) Nov. 10
- L at No. 16 Colorado (90-87) Nov. 20
- W vs. No. 22 Syracuse (97-91) Dec. 5
- L at No. 11 Iowa State (83-70) Dec. 12
- The Hawkeyes have defeated nine top-25 opponents since the start of last season (9-6 record).
- lowa is averaging 87.8 points per game during its three contests against ranked teams this season.
- The Hawkeyes have recorded at least one win against a top-25 team in all but two seasons under Bluder. In nine of those seasons, lowa has knocked off at least one top-15 opponent.
- This year marks the seventh time in school history that lowa has played at least three ranked teams prior to conference action. lowa faced five ranked opponents in 1990 (2-3 record) and three in 2012 (last year) (3-0), 1999 (0-3), 1995 (2-1), 1993 (3-0), and 1989 (1-2).
- Last season marked just the second time in school history that lowa defeated three ranked teams prior to Big Ten play (No. 12 West Virginia, No. 22 Iowa State, No. 20 Texas). The only other time Iowa defeated three ranked opponents was in 1993 (No. 4 Louisiana Tech, No. 20 Missouri State, No. 9 Southern California).
- lowa tied the school record for number of wins over ranked teams in a season last year with seven. The Hawkeyes have accomplished the feat three other times (1995-96, 1993-94, 1992-93). lowa faced 11 ranked teams last season, which tied for the most games against ranked opponents in a season. The only other time lowa played 11 ranked teams in a season was in 1992-93 (7-4 record).

BLUDER GETS WIN NO. 600:

Head coach Lisa Bluder became the 42nd coach in NCAA women's basketball history (all divisions) and only the 25th Division I head coach (minimum 10 years at a DI school) to collect 600 wins Jan. 20 vs. Purdue. Bluder is one of 13 active Division I coaches with 600 or more wins.

HAWKEYES LIKE TO SHARE:

- The Hawkeyes lead the Big Ten in assists, averaging 19.7 per contest. lowa also leads the league in assist/turnover ratio (1.4).
- Samantha Logic leads the league in assists, averaging 6.9 a game.
- lowa tallied 28 assists on 31 made field goals on Dec. 7 in its win over Idaho State. The Hawkeyes have tallied 28 or more assists
 in three of their last five games (30, 28, 28), and 28 or more four times this season. The school record for assists in a game is 31.
- lowa broke the school record for single-season assists last year in the win over Miami (March 24). The previous record of 514
 was set in 2011-12. lowa finished with 531 assists. lowa finished second in the Big Ten and 26th in the NCAA with 15.7 assists
 per game. lowa recorded at least 17 assists in 15 games, including five games with 20 or more.

NCAA STREAK LEADS THE BIG TEN:

lowa is the only Big Ten team, and one of only 13 teams in the country, to have appeared in the last six NCAA Tournaments.

LOGIC BREAKS ASSIST RECORD:

- Last season, Logic led the Big Ten and ranked 15th in the NCAA with 6.4 assists per game. She leads the Big Ten in the category
 this season, and is 11th nationally.
- Logic's nine games with double digit assists equal Cara Consuegra for the most games with 10 or more assists. The next closest Hawkeyes on the list are Kachine Alexander, Jolette Law and Michelle Edwards, with two career games.
- Logic recorded seven or more assists in 15 games, including four games with 10 or more. She had at least five assists in 24 games.
- Samantha Logic recorded her 13th career double-double (16 points, 14 assists) on Nov. 10, leading the Hawkeyes to a 97-93 overtime victory against No. 14 Dayton. Logic hit the game-tying 3-pointer with nine seconds remaining in regulation to send the game into overtime. The 14 assists equaled a personal best and lowa school record, and are the most in Carver-Hawkeye Arena history. The previous high was 12 (three times).
- Logic -- who now has 15 career double-doubles -- became lowa's single-season assist record holder a year ago, breaking the mark in lowa's win at Northwestern (March 3). Logic entered the game tied with Cara Consuegra (2000-01) at 191 assists. Logic collected seven assists at Northwestern and finished with 217.

Tickets for the 2014 NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Championship First and Second Rounds, hosted by the University of lowa, are now on sale for UI women's basketball season ticket holders and the general public.

lowa's First and Second Round Games will be played Sunday, March 23 (4:30 and 7 p.m.) and Tuesday, March 25 (8:30 p.m.). The UI was one of 16 sites chosen to host First and Second Round Games, and 1-of-8 chosen to host in back-to-back years.
