### IOWA HISTORY

Iowa has played 1,049 games, since beginning basketball in 1974. Iowa's overall record is 641-409 (.611). That includes a 318-160 (.665) mark in regular season Big Ten contests and a 303-88 (.775) mark in Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

### WIN NO. 300 AT HOME

The UI women's basketball program picked up victory No. 300 inside Carver-Hawkeye Arena with a 90-79 win over Central Michigan Nov. 21. The Hawkeyes have compiled a 303-88 (.775) record inside their home venue since it opened in 1983.

### SCOUTING MINNESOTA

The Minnesota Golden Gophers are 8-7 overall and 0-2 in Big Ten play.

In their last game, the Golden Gophers were defeated at home by Indiana, 80-79, in overtime. Four players scored double figures, led by a team-high 21 points by China Antoine. Katie Loberg had 15 points, Brianna Mastey had 13 points and seven rebounds and Jackie Voigt had 12 points and eight rebounds. Antoine added four assists and six steals.

Leah Cotton leads Minnesota with 15.1 points per game, followed by Kiara Buford at 14.9 points. Voigt is the team's best rebounder, averaging seven boards per contest.

As a team, Minnesota is shooting .443 (357-806) from the field, including .337 (65-193) from three-point distance.

### IOWA VS. MINNESOTA NOTES

- Iowa leads the all-time series, 42-22. The Hawkeyes have won five of the previous seven matchups against the Golden Gophers. Iowa won 20-straight games over Minnesota between 1983-94. The Hawkeyes are 16-13 in games played at Minnesota.
- Iowa's Theairra Taylor and Minnesota's Kiara Buford are from the same hometown (St. Paul, MN) and attended the same high school (St. Paul Central).
- Iowa's Trisha Nesbitt and Minnesota's Kionna Kellogg are both from Ames, IA and were high school teammates at Ames High School.
- Iowa has four players from Minnesota on its roster, including Kachine Alexander (Minneapolis), Kamille Wahlin (Crookston), Hannah Draxten (Fergus Falls) and Theairra Taylor (St. Paul). The Golden Gophers have seven players from Minnesota on their roster.
- Iowa and Minnesota both played Virginia Tech and Southern this season. Minnesota defeated Virginia Tech, 63-58 at home in the ACC/Big Ten Challenge and also defeated Southern at home, 63-48. The Hawkeyes opened the season with a 76-52 win over Southern at the Islander Tip-Off Tournament in Corpus Christi, TX. Iowa knocked off Virginia Tech, 72-43, at the Caribbean Challenge in Cancun.

### LAST MEETING

Iowa defeated Minnesota, 75-54, Feb. 18 last season in Iowa City.

Iowa sprinted out to a 26-10 lead in the first 9:06, and took a 50-28 lead into halftime. The Hawkeyes maintained their advantage during a Minnesota run in the second half to walk away with the 21-point victory.

The Hawkeyes outscored Minnesota, 27-20, in the paint, and converted eight Minnesota turnovers into 14 points.

Four starters scored double figures, led by 15 points by Kamille Wahlin. Kachine Alexander turned in a double-double with 14 points and 17 rebounds. Jaime Printy added 15 points and Morgan Johnson chipped in 12.

## **2010-11 Team Captains**

Iowa captains are senior Kelsey Cermak and junior Kamille Wahlin.

### **IOWA IN THE RANKINGS**

The Hawkeyes are ranked No. 21 in the AP poll. The most recent ESPN/USA Today poll had not been released at press time.

Four Iowa opponents are also ranked in the AP poll: North Carolina (8th), Michigan State (11th), Iowa State (17th) and Ohio State (20th).

Michigan and Northwestern are receiving votes.

### **MICHIGAN KNOCKS OFF IOWA**

The Hawkeyes dropped their second-straight Big Ten game to open the conference season, losing 60-53 to Michigan in Iowa City.

Iowa couldn't overcome a tough shooting night. The Hawkeyes finished 20-51 (.392) from the field, including just .222 (4-18) from three-point range.

Jaime Printy led Iowa with 18 points and Morgan Johnson added 13. Kachine Alexander was just one point shy of a double-double, recording nine points and 15 rebounds.

### **PRINTY SETS SCHOOL RECORD VS. MICHIGAN**

Jaime Printy's 15 three-point attempts vs. Michigan Jan. 2 set a Carver-Hawkeye Arena record for three-pointers attempted in a single game. The previous record was 13, held by Alabama's Arnedo Yarbrough (March 20, 1994).

Printy also tied the Iowa single-game record for three-pointers attempted. Kamille Wahlin set that record last season with 15 three-point attempts at Penn State (Dec. 28, 2009).

### **KASH CLOSE TO A GRAND**

Kachine Alexander is close to becoming the 27th player in school history to score 1,000 career points.

Alexander needs just seven more points to hit the 1,000 mark. She currently has 993 points.

### **MORE ON KASH**

Kachine Alexander would be the eighth player in school history to collect 1,000 career points and 700 career rebounds. She would be just the third player in Iowa history to amass 1,000 career points, 700 career rebounds and 200 career assists.

### **JOHNSON AT .500 OR BETTER**

If Morgan Johnson takes eight or more shots in a game, chances are she will make at least half of them.

Johnson has attempted eight or more shots in 11 of Iowa's 15 games this year. In those 11 games, Johnson has shot .500 or better eight times.

Johnson has attempted 10 or more shots five times, shooting .500 or better in each game. Johnson was 8-13 (.615) against Northeastern, 10-16 (.625) against Central Michigan, 8-11 (.727) vs. Iowa State, 9-12 (.750) vs. South Dakota State and 5-10 (.500) vs. Michigan.

### **BLUDER REACHES MILESTONE**

With a 75-71 win at Drake Dec. 20, Iowa Head Coach Lisa Bluder became only the second coach in school history to reach the 200-win milestone.

Bluder currently has 201 wins in her 11 years at Iowa. C. Vivian Stringer is the only other Hawkeye head coach to reach the 200-win plateau at Iowa, finishing her time in Iowa City with 269 wins.

Ohio State Head Coach Jim Foster is the only other active Big Ten coach to have reached 200 wins at his/her current school.

## **Head Coach Lisa Bluder**

Lisa Bluder (pronounced BLUE-dir) is in her 11th season as head coach at the University of Iowa and her 27th season as a college head coach. She is a three-time Big Ten and two-time WBCA Regional Coach of the Year.

Bluder, 47, has a career record of 557-268 (.675), including a 201-126 (.615) record at Iowa, a 187-106 (.638) record in 10 seasons (1990-2000) at Drake and a six-year mark (1984-90) of 169-36 (.824) at St. Ambrose.

Bluder is Iowa's second all-time winningest coach and trails only C. Vivian Stringer. She has guided the Hawkeyes to nine post-season tournaments (7 NCAA, 2 WNIT) and seven upper-division finishes in the Big Ten Conference, including winning a share of the league championship in 2008 and tying for second place in 2009.

In her first season with the Hawkeyes, Bluder transformed a struggling program into a 21-game winner. Iowa finished second in the Big Ten, won the conference tournament and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament. Bluder became Iowa's third coach to be named Big Ten Coach of the Year. She was also honored as the College Coach of the Year by the *Women's Basketball News Service* and was named the WBCA District 6 Coach of the Year. Iowa's 2001-02 squad finished fourth in the Big Ten and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament for the second consecutive year. In 2003, Bluder guided the Hawkeyes to their first-ever WNIT appearance. Iowa, which had nine underclassmen on its roster, advanced to the quarterfinals before falling to Creighton. In 2004-05, Iowa finished 23-10, starting the year 13-0 and was the last Division I undefeated team standing. In 2005-06, Bluder mentored a team plagued by injuries to a fifth-place Big Ten finish and an NCAA Tournament berth.

In her 10 years at Drake, Bluder brought great success and tradition to the Bulldog program and established herself as one of the top coaches in the country. She led Drake to five 20-plus win seasons in her last six years, including five post-season appearances. She guided the Bulldogs to eight Missouri Valley Conference Tournament appearances, reaching the semifinals six times and winning the tournament four times. Bluder was also named the Conference Coach of the Year three times at Drake.

Bluder began her coaching career at St. Ambrose, where she coached six successful seasons, building the Bees into a NAIA powerhouse. During her tenure at St. Ambrose, Bluder guided the Bees to four straight national tournaments, including two consecutive Final Four appearances. The 1990 St. Ambrose team was ranked No. 1 and Bluder was named the NAIA Converse Coach of the Year.

A graduate of Linn-Mar High School in Marion, IA, Bluder was a three-year starter at Northern Iowa. She graduated from UNI in 1983 with a bachelor's degree in marketing.

### HAWKEYES DOMINATING THE PAINT

Iowa is racking up the points in the lane through 15 games. The Hawkeyes have scored 20 or more paint points in all but one game (Bradley, 16) this season and have netted 30 or more points seven times. Iowa has outscored its opponents, 426-380 in the paint so far and the Hawkeyes are averaging 28.4 points in the paint per game. Iowa has recorded more paint points than its opponents in 10 games this season.

### AT THE CHARITY STRIPE

Iowa currently leads the Big Ten with a .767 free throw percentage. Jaime Printy ranks third in the league at .889 (40-45).

### BALANCED SCORING ATTACK

Iowa is one of only three teams in the Big Ten to have four players ranked among the top 30 scorers in the conference. Iowa, Ohio State and Northwestern each have four players ranked. Wisconsin has three, while the remaining six schools have either one or two players ranked. The Hawkeyes have had at least three players reach double figures in scoring in 14 of the 15 games this year. Five players scored 10 or more points against Bradley. Four players hit double digits against Northeastern, Central Michigan and Kansas State.

### HAWKEYES HITTING THE BOARDS

Iowa's rebounding numbers through its first 15 games are impressive. The Hawkeyes lead the Big Ten in total rebounding (43.4 per game) and rebounding margin (+6.9) and rank second in offensive rebounding (14.5 per game), defensive rebounding (28.9). Kachine Alexander ranks first in the league in offensive rebounding (3.4 per game), while Morgan Johnson ranks second (3.3 per game). Alexander's 18 rebounds against Central Michigan, Nov. 21, are tied for the most by any Big Ten player this season.

### TOP FIVE IN THE BIG TEN

Four of Iowa's starters rank in the top five in the Big Ten in different statistical categories.

- Kachine Alexander ranks first in offensive rebounding (3.4 per game) and third in total rebounding (9.2 per game).
- Morgan Johnson ranks second in offensive rebounding (3.3 per game) and third in blocks (2.4 per game).
- Jaime Printy ranks second in three-pointers made (2.3 per game) and third in free throw percentage (.889).
- Kamille Wahlin is tied for fifth in assist/turnover ratio (1.3).

### MOVING UP CAREER CHARTS

Four Hawkeyes are currently working their way up the career records lists at Iowa.

- Kachine Alexander ranks second in career double-doubles (27), eighth in career rebounding (753), 13th in career assists (270) and 27th in career scoring (993). She needs 37 more rebounds to move past Amy Herrig for seventh place on the rebounding list and nine assists to tie Laurie Aaron and Necole Tunsil for 12th on the assists list. She needs nine more double-doubles to take over first place (Lisa Long, 35).
- Morgan Johnson ranks fourth in career blocks (115) and needs 31 more to move past Toni Foster into third place.
- Kamille Wahlin ranks sixth in career three-pointers made (135) and needs two more to move past Kristi Faulkner into fifth place.
- Jaime Printy ranks eighth in career three-pointers made (117) and needs two more to move past Nadine Domond for seventh place.

### **JOHNSON FILLING UP THE STAT SHEET**

Morgan Johnson scored double figures over a tough four game-stretch, including double-doubles in two of those four contests.

Johnson tallied a double-double with 16 points and 13 rebounds at No. 14 North Carolina Dec. 2. She followed with 13 points and six rebounds against Kansas State and recorded another double-double with 16 points and 10 rebounds against No. 15 Iowa State. Johnson had a career-high 26 points at South Dakota State, including the first 11 points of the contest.

Over the four-game stretch, Johnson averaged 17 points, nine rebounds, shot .707 (29-41) from the field and blocked 13 shots.

### **PRINTY'S STREAK SNAPPED**

Jaime Printy came within one made free throw of tying a school record for consecutive free throws made.

After missing her first free throw attempt of the season in Iowa's season-opener, Printy made 32-straight free throws. She finished 1-2 from the charity stripe at Drake and missed tying Lindsey Meder's record of 33 consecutive free throws made by one shot.

### **PRINTY LENDS A HELPING HAND**

Jaime Printy recorded a career-high nine assists in Iowa's 22-point victory over Iowa State Dec. 9.

Printy leads the team with 52 assists and has led the team in helpers in six of Iowa's 11 games.

### **KREI DRAINING FROM DISTANCE**

Kelly Krei tied a career-high for three-pointers made against Iowa State Dec. 9, draining five long distance shots. The Iowa City native finished with 15 points (5-8 3Pt FGs).

Krei made five three-pointers against Penn State in the quarterfinals of the Big Ten Tournament last season.

### **SILENCING THE CYCLONES**

Iowa's defense was stout against No. 15 Iowa State Dec. 9, holding the Cyclones to just 40 points.

The scoring output by Iowa State was the lowest for an Iowa opponent since the 2007-08 season. Iowa held Michigan to 37 points in the Big Ten Tournament (March 7, 2008).

### **BOMBS AWAY FOR A SCHOOL RECORD**

The Hawkeyes set a school record with 37 three-point attempts against North Carolina Dec. 2. Iowa was just one three-pointer away from tying the school record for long distance shots made (12).

Kamille Wahlin attempted 11 treys while Jaime Printy had nine.

### **HAWKEYES TIE SCHOOL RECORD AGAINST VIRGINIA TECH**

Iowa tied a school record with 12 made three-pointers against Virginia Tech Nov. 26. Iowa went 12-29 from distance. The Hawkeyes made 12 three-pointers against Gonzaga (11/21/02) and Columbia (11/28/09).

Kachine Alexander was named co-Big Ten Player of the Week, Nov. 22, for her efforts against Bradley, Northeastern and Central Michigan. Alexander shared the weekly honor with Northwestern's Amy Jaeschke.

Alexander collected double-doubles in each of Iowa's three games and earned MVP honors at the KCRG-TV9 Hawkeye Challenge.

Alexander's first double-double of the season came against Bradley, recording 14 points and 10 rebounds. Alexander was 8-10 from the free throw line and also had five assists and three steals.

Alexander started the KCRG-TV9 Hawkeye Challenge with 21 points and 12 rebounds in a win over Northeastern, adding six assists, two steals and a block.

She wrapped up the tournament MVP award with 20 points and 18 rebounds against Central Michigan in the championship.

Iowa also tallied its fifth 20-win season under Bluder, including each of the last three seasons.
