Game #3 Quick Hits

- Thursday is the first of two Cancun Challenge preliminary games.
- lowa has started the year 2-0 for the second straight season.
- lowa has won seven of its last eight home games, dating back to Feb. 1.
- lowa blocked 10 shots vs. UT-Pan American on Friday, the most by an lowa team since Nov. 14, 2005 (Md.-Eastern Shore).
- Aaron White leads the team in scoring (15.0), rebounding (7.0), steals (2.5), and free throws made (11) and attempted (15).
- On Nov. 9, 2011, Iowa's No. 25 ranked recruiting class signed with Iowa. One year later the class helped the Hawkeyes post their first victory of the 2012-13 season.
- This marks the second time in three years under Fran McCaffery that the Hawkeye head coach has started two freshmen in the season opener (Basabe and McCabe in 2010).
- lowa is 10-2 when scoring 80 points or more, the last three seasons. The Hawkeyes are 15-0 when holding opponents to fewer than 60 points, the last two years.
- lowa's average starting lineup height is 6-foot-6. The Hawkeye starting lineup consists of two freshmen, one sophomore, and two juniors.

Head Coach Fran McCaffery

Fran McCaffery is in his third season as the head basketball coach at the University of lowa and his 17th year overall as a college head coach. McCaffery spent five seasons (2005-10) as the head coach at Siena, six years at UNC-Greensboro (1999-2005) and three seasons at Lehigh (1985-88) before joining the Hawkeyes.



McCaffery has three decades of Division I coaching experience. He completed his

30th season as a collegiate coach in 2012, which includes 16 years as a head coach and 14 as an assistant.

McCaffery, 53, holds a career mark of 282-214 (.568) and guided his teams to seven postseason appearances (five NCAA, two NIT). He is 31-37 (.456) at lowa.

McCaffery's five years at Siena were the best in its 70-year history. He led the Saints on an incredible run that ended with three straight Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference championships and NCAA Tournament appearances. In so doing, Siena became the only program in the country to win its regular season and postseason title the last three years.

McCaffery's Saints owned a 112-51 (.687) record in his five years with the program. He guided the Saints to four consecutive 20-win seasons, something that has never been accomplished before at the Siena.

The 2009 MAAC Coach of the Year and 2010 District | Coach of the Year is the third winningest coach, by percentage, in league history (68-22, .756). He is the only coach to guide a MAAC program to two NCAA Tournament wins. McCaffery led his 2008 and 2009 teams to first round NCAA Tournament victories over Vanderbilt and Ohio State, respectively.

In his final two seasons at Siena, he coached the Saints to back-to-back 27-win campaigns and boasted a combined 39-3 (.929) record against MAAC opponents, which included MAAC Tournament contests.

McCaffery began his coaching career as an assistant at Penn (1982-83) and Lehigh (1983-85). Then at age 26, he became the nation's youngest Division I head coach when hired by Lehigh in 1985. After three seasons as head coach at Lehigh, he spent 11 seasons as an assistant at Notre Dame (1988-99).

McCaffery played basketball at Wake Forest his freshman year (1977-78) and then concluded his collegiate playing career at Penn his final three seasons (1979-82).

He earned his B.S. degree in Economics from The Wharton School (Penn) in 1982. McCaffery also earned a Master of Education from Lehigh in 1985.

- Howard travels to Wichita State next for a game against the Shockers on Saturday.

HOME COOKIN'

lowa posted 14 home wins last season (14-6), the most since collecting 14 home victories in 2007. Five of the Hawkeyes' 14 home victories came in league play.

MARKED IMPROVEMENT IN YEAR TWO

Fran McCaffery guided Iowa to 18 wins (18-17) in his second season as head coach of the Hawkeyes, with four of the 18 victories coming against top 20 opponents. McCaffery was one of only four Big Ten coaches to record four or more wins over ranked opponents, and the only coach to do so with an unranked team.

McCaffery's seven-win improvement in his second season, ties Pops Harrison (1943-44) for the fourth best improvement following his second year as Iowa head coach. Steve Alford (2000-01) and Lute Olsen (1975-76) rank first (+9), while George Raveling (1984-85) is third (+8). Furthermore, the seven-win improvement ranked third-best in the Big Ten in 2012 behind Indiana (+12) and Michigan State (+10).

lowa improved by four wins in conference play from 2011 (four) to 2012 (eight), its best improvement since 1994-95. Tom Davis' 1994 team won five, while his 1995 squad collected nine victories.

WHITE. WOODBURY RECEIVE PRESEASON RECOGNITION

Sophomore Aaron White has been named preseason third team All-Big Ten by the website College Sports Madness, while Adam Woodbury was named by CBSSports.com as a top 30 freshman to make an impact.

White, who was named to the 2012 Kyle Macy Freshman All-America team, averaged 11.1 points and a team-best 5.7 rebounds a year ago.

White's 389 points rank as the fifth-most by a Hawkeye freshman, while his 199 rebounds rank fourth and 23 blocks rank eighth.

Woodbury, is a three-time All-State honoree, and was tabbed MVP of the NBA Top 100 Camp in 2011. The 7-foot-1 center topped 1,000 career points and rebounds in his prep career for Sioux City East High School.
