#### **IOWA HISTORY**

lowa has played 1,085 games since beginning basketball in 1974. lowa's overall record is 662-422 (.610). That includes a 331-168 (.663) mark in regular season Big Ten contests and a 317-91 (.777) mark in Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

#### **SCOUTING WISCONSIN**

The Wisconsin Badgers are 5-12 overall and 1-4 in Big Ten play.

In their last game, the Badgers wre defeated in Madison by Nebraska, 75-69. Four Wisconsin players scored double figures, led by Taylor Wurtz's 20 points. Anya Covington and Morgan Paige added 14 points while Jade Davis had 11. Covington also grabbed 11 rebounds for a double-double. Nebraska won the game in the paint, outscoring Wisconsin, 40-22.

Wurtz is the only player averaging double figures at 15.6 points per game. She is also the team's leading rebounder at 7.6 boards per contest. Covington is next at 8.9 points and 6.6 rebounds.

As a team, Wisconsin is shooting .387 (351-906) from the field, including .323 (95-294) from three-point distance.

#### WISCONSIN VS. IOWA NOTES

- Iowa leads the all-time series, 38-20. The Hawkeyes have won eight-straight matchups against the Badgers, dating back to the 2006-07 season. The Hawkeyes are 23-8 vs. Wisconsin in games played in Iowa City.
- Wisconsin sophomore Morgan Paige is from the same hometown as lowa's Jaime Printy (Marion, Iowa). Paige attended Marion HS, while Printy prepped at Linn-Mar HS.
- Wisconsin freshman Lindsay Smith is from Dewitt, lowa and prepped at Central DeWitt HS.
- Iowa freshman Samantha Logic is from Racine, Wis., and attended Racine J.I. Case HS.
- Wisconsin Director of Operations Jill Jameson graduated from Northern Iowa in 1993 and was a three-year starter for the Panthers.
- Wisconsin Head Coach Bobbie Kelsey is the newest coach in the Big Ten and is in her first season in Madison.

#### HAWKEYES CAN'T HOLD ON FOR WIN AT PURDUE

No. 17 Purdue held on for a 57-55 win over lowa on Sunday in West Lafayette.

The Hawkeyes trailed 30-17 with 5:21 left in the first half, but an 11-2 run to close the half made it a four point game at 32-28 heading into the second period.

lowa opened the second half on a 9-0 run to take a 37-32 lead with 16:16 remaining, but a 16-2 surge by Purdue gave the Boilermakers a 48-39 lead with just over 11 minutes left.

The Hawkeyes clawed back and eventually took a one point lead after Kelly Krei made a pair of free throws with 37 seconds on the clock. Alex Guyton then made one of two free throws with 18 seconds left to tie the game, and Brittany Rayburn grabbed an offensive rebound as was fouled. She hit both free throws to take a two point lead, and lowa's final shot attempt was blocked.

Morgan Johnson led lowa with 16 points, followed by 15 from Jaime Printy. Krei added 10 and Samantha Logic chipped in eight rebounds and six assists.

#### JOHNSON CONTINUES SOLID PLAY VS. TOUGH OPPONENTS

Junior Morgan Johnson is averaging 19 points, 9.8 rebounds and 2.8 blocks in lowa's last four games (at No. 9 Ohio State, vs. Illinois vs. No. 19 Nebraska and at No. 17 Purdue).

Johnson is shooting .571 (32-56) from the field and .750 (12-16) from the charity stripe over the four-game stretch.

lowa's starting center also recorded back-to-back double-doubles for the first time in her career. She scored 14 points (5-10 FGs) and grabbed a career-high 16 rebounds against Illinois. Johnson followed with 21 points (9-14 FGs) and 12 rebounds against Nebraska. Johnson had a double-double at half against the Huskers (10 points and 11 rebounds).

#### WAHLIN AND PRINTY ARE BEST ACTIVE 3-POINT SHOOTERS

lowa senior Kamille Wahlin and junior Jaime Printy rank first and second among active Big Ten players in career three-pointers made.

Wahlin's 196 career three-pointers ranks first, while Printy's 187 rank second. Purdue's Brittany Rayburn and Michigan's Carmen Reynolds are tied for third with 179, Ohio State's Samantha Prahalis is fifth with 162 and Penn State's Maggie Lucas is sixth with 159.

#### **HAWKEYE 3-POINT SHOOTERS IN ELITE COMPANY**

lowa is the only Big Ten school, and just one of three in the nation, to` boast three players inside the top 10 in career three-point shooting in school history.

Kamille Wahlin (3rd), Jaime Printy (4th) and Kelly Krei (7th) all rank inside the top 10 in career three-pointers made at Iowa. Only Oral Roberts and Miami (FL) have three players inside its respective top 10.

#### PRINTY HITS 1.300

Junior Jaime Printy became just the 13th player in school history to score 1,300 career points in lowa's game vs. Nebraska (Jan. 8).

Printy needs just five more points to move into the top 10 on lowa's all-time scoring list.

## Head Coach Lisa Bluder

Lisa Bluder (pronounced BLUE-dir) is in her 12th season as head coach at the University of Iowa and her 28th season as a college head coach. She is a three-time Big Ten and two-time WBCA Regional Coach of the Year.

Bluder, 48, has a career record of 577-282 (.672), including a 221-140 (.612) record at lowa, a 187-106 (.638) record in 10 seasons (1990-2000) at Drake and a six-year mark (1984-90) of 169-36 (.824) at St. Ambrose.



Bluder is Iowa's second all-time winningest coach and trails only C. Vivian Stringer. She has guided the Hawkeyes to 10 post-season tournaments (8 NCAA, 2 WNIT) and eight upper-division finishes in the Big Ten Conference, including winning a share of the league championship in 2008 and tying for second place in 2009.

In her first season with the Hawkeyes, Bluder transformed a struggling program into a 21-game winner. Iowa finished second in the Big Ten, won the conference tournament and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament. Bluder became Iowa's third coach to be named Big Ten Coach of the Year. She was also honored as the College Coach of the Year by the *Women's Basketball News Service* and was named the WBCA District 6 Coach of the Year. Iowa's 2001-02 squad finished fourth in the Big Ten and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament for the second consecutive year. In 2003, Bluder guided the Hawkeyes to their first-ever WNIT appearance. Iowa, which had nine underclassmen on its roster, advanced to the quarterfinals before falling to Creighton. In 2004-05, Iowa finished 23-10, starting the year 13-0 and was the last Division I undefeated team standing. In 2005-06, Bluder mentored a team plagued by injuries to a fifth-place Big Ten finish and an NCAA Tournament berth.

In her 10 years at Drake, Bluder brought great success and tradition to the Bulldog program and established herself as one of the top coaches in the country. She led Drake to five 20-plus win seasons in her last six years, including five post-season appearances. She guided the Bulldogs to eight Missouri Valley Conference Tournament appearances, reaching the semifinals six times and winning the tournament four times. Bluder was also named the Conference Coach of the Year three times at Drake.

Bluder began her coaching career at St. Ambrose, where she coached six successful seasons, building the Bees into a NAIA powerhouse. During her tenure at St. Ambrose, Bluder guided the Bees to four straight national tournaments, including two consecutive Final Four appearances. The 1990 St. Ambrose team was ranked No. 1 and Bluder was named the NAIA Converse Coach of the Year.

A graduate of Linn-Mar High School in Marion, IA, Bluder was a three-year starter at Northern Iowa. She graduated from UNI in 1983 with a bachelor's degree in marketing.

#### WAHLIN DELIVERS IN THE CLUTCH

lowa's game against Illinois (Jan. 5) marked the seventh time in Kamille Wahlin's four-year career that she hit a shot in the final 1:05 of a game or overtime to either tie the game or give the Hawkeyes a lead.

#### KREI HITTING THE GLASS

Senior Kelly Krei recorded her fourth career double-digit rebound performance against Illinois (Jan. 5).

Krei grabbed 11 rebounds against the Fighting Illini, two shy of her career-high. Krei had 13 rebounds against Indiana as a sophomore, 10 against Southern as a junior and 10 against Albany this season.

Krei's rebounding numbers have steadily improved since her sophomore season. She averaged 4.7 rebounds in 34 games as a sophomore and 5.1 boards in 31 games as junior. The lowa City native is already averaging 5.7 rebounds in 18 games this season.

#### **CHARITY STRIPE SUCCESS**

The Hawkeyes have cashed in from the free throw line so far this season.

lowa is 290-353 from the charity stripe and their .822 free throw percentage ranks first in the Big Ten and is ranked third-best in latest NCAA statistics.

Individually, Jaime Printy is first in the Big Ten with a .888 percentage and is ranked 15th-nationally in the latest NCAA statistics.

The Hawkeyes haven't missed more than seven free throws in any game this year and have attempted at least 10 in every contest, including eight games with 20 or more attempts.

#### JOHNSON AMONG THE BEST AT HER POSITION

Junior Morgan Johnson's .795 (66-83) free throw percentage is the second-best percentage in the country for players listed as true centers.

According to the latest NCAA statistics, only Stephen F. Austin's Porsha Roberts (.816) tops Johnson's .795 free throw percentage.

#### IOWA GUARDS LIKE TO SHARE

lowa is the only team to have three players ranked inside the top 15 in assists in the latest Big Ten statistics.

Jaime Printy (sixth - 4.2), Kamille Wahlin (10th - 3.7) and Samantha Logic (11th - 3.6) are all ranked. Northwestern has two players ranked.

The trio has combined for 119 of lowa's 166 assists over the last eight games. Printy has tallied 44 assists, Wahlin has 40 and Logic has 35.

In the latest NCAA statistics, Iowa ranks 23rd in assists per game (16.6).

#### JOHNSON FROM THE FIELD

Junior Morgan Johnson leads the Big Ten and is 27th in the nation with a .539 (104-193) field goal percentage.

Johnson has atttempted at least 10 shots in 10 of Iowa's 18 games this season. In eight of those games, Johnson has shot .500 or better.

Johnson was 5-10 (.500) vs. Harvard, 9-13 (.692) at Northern Iowa, 6-11 (.545) at Kansas State, 5-10 (.500) at Iowa State, 13-20 (.650) at Bradley, 11-16 (.688) at Ohio State, 5-10 (.500) vs. Illinois and 9-14 (.643) vs. Nebraska.

The only games Johnson failed to shoot .500 with 10 or more shots was vs. Virginia Tech (8-21, .381) and at Purdue (7-16, .438).

#### **REACHING DOUBLE FIGURES**

lowa's game at Purdue (Jan. 15) marked the 11th time this season that at least three players have scored 10 or more points.

The Hawkeyes had all five starters score double figures against Mississippi Valley State. Four players hit double figures against Northern Iowa, Kansas State, Western Illinois and Northwestern. Three players reached double digits against Harvard, Albany, Ohio State, Illinois, Nebraksa and at Purdue.

#### **MOVING UP CAREER CHARTS**

Four Hawkeyes are currently working their way up the career records lists at lowa.

- Kamille Wahlin ranks third in career three-pointers made (196), sixth in career assists (374) and 15th in career scoring (1,274). She needs 26 more three-pointers to move past Wendy Ausdemore into second place, 14 more assists to move past Franthea Price for fifth place and 10 more points to past Necole Tunsil for 14th place.
- Morgan Johnson ranks second in career blocks (196) and 17th in career rebounds (534). She needs 40 more blocks to move past Tangela Smith for first place and 30 more rebounds to move past Necole Tunsil for 16th place.

#### JOHNSON NAMED BIG TEN PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Junior Morgan Johnson was named Big Ten Player of the Week after a career night at Bradley (Dec. 17).

Johnson notched new career highs in points (37), field goals made (13), free throws made (11) and free throws attempted (12). Her 37 points were also a Renaissance Coliseum record and are the second-most scored by any player in the Big Ten, so far, this season.

Johnson's 37 points were the most for an lowa center since Megan Skouby netted 33 at Kansas in 2008. Skouby finished the game 10-17 from the field and 13-14 from the free throw line

The award was Johnson's first Big Ten Player of the Week honor. She was named Big Ten Freshman of the Week once during her first season at lowa.
