#### SCOUTING VIRGINIA TECH

The Virginia Tech Hokies are 2-4, with wins over Old Dominion (77-65) and George Washington (55-48).

Virginia Tech has lost its last three contests, including games against Saint Mary's, CA (60-47) and Minnesota (65-64) at the SMC Concord Hilton Tournament in Moraga, Calif. Minnesota hit a buzzer-beater to defeat the Hokies.

Monet Tellier led the Hokies against Minnesota with 18 points, seven rebounds, five assists and three steals. Aerial Wilson had 13 points and Alyssa Fenyn had 11.

Tellier is leading the team with 19.3 points per game and is second in rebounding at 5.5 boards per contest. Wilson is next at 11.2 points and Fenyn is scoring 11 points and has a team-best 5.8 rebounds per game.

As a team, the Hokies are shooting .419 (137-327) from the field, including .391 (25-64) from three-point range.

Dennis Wolff is in his first season as head coach at Virginia Tech.

#### REMATCH FROM CANCUN LAST SEASON

lowa defeated Virginia Tech, 72-43, in the final game of the 2010 Caribbean Challenge in Cancun, Mexico.

lowa took a 30-15 lead into the locker room at halftime and never looked back. The Hawkeyes were led by Jaime Printy with 15 points and six assists. Kelly Krei added 11 points while Kamille Wahlin chipped in 10.

The Hawkeyes shot a season-high .414 (12-29) from three-point distance. Printy and Krei made three long distance shots, while Wahlin, Kalli Hansen and Hannah Draxten each had two.

The Hawkeyes out-rebounded Virginia Tech, 42-35, and collected 17 offensive rebounds. lowa also turned 23 Hokie turnovers into 24 points and received 26 points off the bench.

Aerial Wilson had 11 points to lead Virginia Tech, while Alyssa Fenyn had eight points.

#### **BIG TEN/ACC CHALLENGE NOTES**

- lowa is 0-4 in Big Ten/ACC Challenge games. The Hawkeyes lost to Georgia Tech (76-57) at home in 2007, at Duke (71-47) in 2008), at home to Boston College (72-67) in 2009 and at North Carolina (79-67) in 2010.
- The ACC has won all four Challenges. Last season was the closest margin, with the ACC edging the Big Ten, 6-5.

### **OPPONENTS IN THE RANKINGS**

Four lowa opponents are ranked in the AP and ESPN/USA Today polls: Texas A&M (5/4), Purdue (15/17), Penn State (17/16) and Ohio State (18/19).

In addition, Iowa State, Kansas State, Nebraska, UNLV, Michigan, Michigan State and St. John's are receiving votes.

#### HAWKEYES FALL TO DEFENDING NCAA CHAMPIONS

No. 4 ranked Texas A&M defeated lowa, 74-58, in the champion-ship game of the Junkanoo Jam Saturday.

The Hawkeyes kept things close in the first half against Texas A&M and trailed by nine at halftime. Texas A&M started the second half with a 19-7 run to stretch its lead to 55-34. lowa couldn't mount the late second half comeback against the defending NCAA champions.

Texas A&M capitalized on 25 lowa turnovers, but only out-rebounded the Hawkeyes, 39-38. lowa turned 13 Texas A&M turnovers into 22 points.

Samantha Logic and Jaime Printy each scored double figures. Logic netted 16 points and Printy added 14.

#### LOGIC AND PRINTY EARN JUNKANOO ACCOLADES

Freshman Samantha Logic and junior Jaime Printy were both named to the Junkanoo Jam all-tournament team.

Logic averaged 14.5 points and six rebounds while shooting .500 (12-24) from the field against two tough opponents.

Logic started the week with 13 points, three rebounds and three steals in lowa's win over St. John's. Logic was 5-9 from the field in 22 minutes of action.

Against the No. 4 ranked and defending NCAA champion Texas A&M Aggies, Logic was one rebound shy of a double-double. She scored 16 points, grabbed nine rebounds and added three assists.

Printy started the Junkanoo Jam with a team-best 17 points (8-8 FTs), five rebounds, three assists and three steals against St. John's.

Printy added 14 points, three rebounds and three steals against Texas A&M.

#### PRINTY STREAK SNAPPED

Junior Jaime Printy had converted 30-straight free throws, dating back to lowa's game vs. UNLV (Nov. 13), before a miss from the charity stripe against Texas A&M (Nov. 26).

Printy went 8-8 against UNLV (Nov. 13), 9-9 against Albany (Nov. 16), 4-4 vs. Northern lowa (Nov. 19) and 8-8 vs. St. John's (Nov. 25). She made her first attempt against Texas A&M, before missing the first of two free throws in the second half.

Printy's latest streak is the second time she has made at least 30-straight free throws. She made 32-straight free throws last year, one shy of lowa's record for consecutive free throws (33 by Lindsey Meder).

## **CHARITY STRIPE SUCCESS**

The Hawkeyes have cashed in from the free throw line so far this season.

lowa has only missed 20 free throws in 112 attempts and is shooting .821 from the line. The Hawkeyes rank seventh in the nation in free throw percentage.

Individually, Jaime Printy's .946 free throw percentage ranks 15th best in the nation.

#### **HITTING FROM OUTSIDE**

Kelly Krei has emerged as lowa's top three-point shooter. Krei is 13-25 from beyond the arc and leads the team with a .520 three-point percentage. Her three-point percentage ranks 20th in the NCAA.

# Head Coach Lisa Bluder

Lisa Bluder (pronounced BLUE-dir) is in her 12th season as head coach at the University of Iowa and her 28th season as a college head coach. She is a three-time Big Ten and two-time WBCA Regional Coach of the Year.

Bluder, 48, has a career record of 571-276 (.674), including a 215-134 (.616) record at lowa, a 187-106 (.638) record in 10 seasons (1990-2000) at Drake and a six-year mark (1984-90) of 169-36 (.824) at St. Ambrose.



Bluder is Iowa's second all-time winningest coach and trails only C. Vivian Stringer. She has guided the Hawkeyes to 10 post-season tournaments (8 NCAA, 2 WNIT) and eight upper-division finishes in the Big Ten Conference, including winning a share of the league championship in 2008 and tying for second place in 2009.

In her first season with the Hawkeyes, Bluder transformed a struggling program into a 21-game winner. Iowa finished second in the Big Ten, won the conference tournament and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament. Bluder became Iowa's third coach to be named Big Ten Coach of the Year. She was also honored as the College Coach of the Year by the *Women's Basketball News Service* and was named the WBCA District 6 Coach of the Year. Iowa's 2001-02 squad finished fourth in the Big Ten and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament for the second consecutive year. In 2003, Bluder guided the Hawkeyes to their first-ever WNIT appearance. Iowa, which had nine underclassmen on its roster, advanced to the quarterfinals before falling to Creighton. In 2004-05, Iowa finished 23-10, starting the year 13-0 and was the last Division I undefeated team standing. In 2005-06, Bluder mentored a team plagued by injuries to a fifth-place Big Ten finish and an NCAA Tournament berth.

In her 10 years at Drake, Bluder brought great success and tradition to the Bulldog program and established herself as one of the top coaches in the country. She led Drake to five 20-plus win seasons in her last six years, including five post-season appearances. She guided the Bulldogs to eight Missouri Valley Conference Tournament appearances, reaching the semifinals six times and winning the tournament four times. Bluder was also named the Conference Coach of the Year three times at Drake.

Bluder began her coaching career at St. Ambrose, where she coached six successful seasons, building the Bees into a NAIA powerhouse. During her tenure at St. Ambrose, Bluder guided the Bees to four straight national tournaments, including two consecutive Final Four appearances. The 1990 St. Ambrose team was ranked No. 1 and Bluder was named the NAIA Converse Coach of the Year.

A graduate of Linn-Mar High School in Marion, IA, Bluder was a three-year starter at Northern Iowa. She graduated from UNI in 1983 with a bachelor's degree in marketing.

#### **CONSISTENT STARTS**

Three Hawkeyes have recorded consistent starts in certain statistical categories through six games this season.

- Junior Jaime Printy has scored at least 15 points in all but one game, including back-to-back 20 point performances to start the season.
- Freshman Samantha Logic has grabbed at least five rebounds and dished out at least four assists in half of lowa's games.
- Junior Morgan Johnson has recorded three blocks in four of lowa's first six contests.

#### LOGIC COLLECTS DOUBLE-DOUBLE

Freshman Samantha Logic scored 10 points and grabbed 11 rebounds at Northern Iowa (Nov. 19) for her first career double-double.

Logic's double-double was the first for an Iowa freshman since the 2009-10 season. Morgan Johnson had 16 points and 11 rebounds vs. Purdue (Jan. 31, 2010).

#### KREI HITTING THE GLASS

Kelly Krei recorded her third career double-double vs. Albany (Nov. 16) with 13 points and 10 rebounds.

Krei's first double-double came at home vs. Indiana as a sophomore (14 points and 13 rebounds). Her second was in the season opener vs. Southern in the Islander Tip-Off Classic, hosted by Texas A&M Corpus Christi, as a junior (20 points and 10 rebounds).

#### **MAJOR BENCH POINTS**

lowa's 26 points off the bench vs. Albany were the most for a Hawkeye team in 26 games. The Hawkeyes scored 26 bench points against Virginia Tech last year in Cancun. Before the Virginia Tech game a year ago, the last time an lowa team scored 26 or more bench points was against Texas State in 2008 (27 off the bench).

### **NESBITT SIDELINED WITH KNEE SURGERY**

Junior Trisha Nesbitt will be sidelined after having minor knee surgery Nov. 15. She is expected to miss 3-6 weeks of action.

#### PRINTY AND WAHLIN NAMED TO ALL-TOURNAMENT TEAM

Junior Jaime Printy and senior Kamille Wahlin were named to the Hawkeye Challenge all-tournament team Nov. 13.

Printy led lowa in scoring vs. both Harvard (24 points) and UNLV (25 points). She added six rebounds and four assists vs. Harvard, along with five rebounds and four assists vs. UNLV.

Printy was also named CollegeSportsMadness.com's Big Ten Player of the Week.

Wahlin netted nine points against Harvard and scored 15 vs. UNLV. She also had two rebounds and three assists against the Rebels.

### **MOVING UP CAREER CHARTS**

Four Hawkeyes are currently working their way up the career records lists at lowa.

- Kamille Wahlin ranks fourth in career three-pointers made (177), 10th in career assists (324) and 21st in career scoring (1,139). She needs nine more three-pointers to move past Kristi Smith into third place, 16 more assists to move past Kachine Alexander for ninth place and nine more points to past Cara Consuegra for 20th place.
- Morgan Johnson ranks second in career blocks (171) and needs 65 more to move past Tangela Smith for first place.
- Jaime Printy ranks fifth in career three-pointers made (163) and 23rd in career scoring (1,135). She needs 15 more three-pointers to move past Wahlin for fourth place and three more points to move into 22nd place.
- Kelly Krei ranks eighth in career three-pointers made (129) and needs 10 more to move past Kristi Faulkner into seventh place.

#### HAWKEYES PICKED TO FINISH THIRD

The lowa women's basketball team was picked to finish third by both the league coaches and media. Penn State was chosen as the favorite in both polls.

Junior Jaime Printy was a preseason all-Big Ten selection by both the league media and coaches.

#### **PRINTY NAMED TO WATCH LISTS**

Junior Jaime Printy has been named to both the "Wade Watch" and Wooden Award Watch Lists. The "Wade Watch" List is made up of the top 25 preseason women's basketball players while the Wooden Award includes 30 student-athletes.

The Wade Trophy and Wooden Award are considered the two most prestigious awards in NCAA women's college basketball.

#### **PRINTY NOTES FROM LAST SEASON**

- Became the youngest player in school history to earn All-America honors, taking home Associated Press honorable mention accolades as a sophomore. She is the only returning All-American in the Big Ten this season.
- Became the first player in school history to reach the 1,000 career point milestone as a sophomore.
- Earned second team All-Big Ten honors by the coaches and was a third team pick by the media.
- One of eight Hawkeyes named Academic All-Big Ten.
- Named Big Ten Player of the Week once.
- Started all 31 games and led the Hawkeyes with 16.8 points per game.
- Tied school record for free throw percentage in a single game (10-10, 1.000 vs. Indiana), three-pointers attempted in a single game (15 vs. Michigan) and three-pointers made in an NCAA Tournament game (5 vs. Gonzaga).

## **AWARD WINNERS RETURNING**

- Jaime Printy was named honorable mention All-America by the Associated Press. She was also a second team All-Big Ten selection by the coaches and a third team pick by the media. She was also named Big Ten Player of the Week once.
- Kamille Wahlin was an honorable mention All-Big Ten selection by the league coaches and media. Wahlin was named a National Strength and Conditioning Association All-American. She also earned all-tournament honors at the Islander Tip-Off Tournament and the Caribbean Challenge.

#### SUCCESS UNDER BLUDER

Last season marked the eighth time in 11 seasons under head coach Lisa Bluder that lowa has been selected for the NCAA Tournament, including each of the last four seasons. The Hawkeyes have participated in postseason play in all but one season under Bluder (two WNIT appearances).

In addition, Iowa finished with a winning record for the 10th time in 11 seasons under Bluder. Iowa's tie for third place in the Big Ten is also the eighth time, under Bluder, the Hawkeyes recorded an upper-division finish in the conference.

lowa also tallied its sixth 20-win season under Bluder, including each of the last four seasons.

#### JUMP IN ATTENDANCE LAST SEASON

The University of Iowa had the second-largest increase in attendance from the previous season among Division I women's basketball programs, according to data released by the NCAA. Lisa Bluder's squad also finished the 2010-11 season ranked 13th nationally in average attendance, the highest ranking since the 1997-98 season when the UI ranked ninth.

lowa jumped from an average of 3,488 fans during the 2009-10 season to 5,823 fans for the 2010-11 season, a boost of 2,335 fans. Louisville was the only other school to see a larger increase, adding 4,462 fans.

lowa's total attendance figure of 81,528 is the third-highest in school history, while the average of 5,823 is the fourth best in school history.

lowa's top crowd of the season came on Jan. 8 vs. Ohio State, when 9,865 fans saw the Hawkeyes knock off the 20th-ranked Buckeyes. That crowd was the 11th-largest single-game crowd in women's basketball history.

### **NEW HAWKEYES RANK HIGH**

lowa's freshmen class was tabbed as the 11th best recruiting class of 2011 by ESPNHoop-Gurlz.com. The class includes five players, one at each position.

Included in the class is guard Samantha Logic, who is the third McDonald's High School All-American to commit to the University of Iowa under Head Coach Lisa Bluder.

#### **TOUGH SCHEDULE IN 11-12**

The Hawkeyes are scheduled to face 14 teams who advanced to postseason play a year ago, including 10 NCAA Tournament teams.

Iowa will play six non-conference games on the road, with two of those matchups coming in the Bahamas at the Junkanoo Jam. Iowa faced St. John's in the first round and played the defending NCAA national champions in Texas A&M in the championship.

### TWO PLAYERS OUT FOR THE SEASON

Senior Megan Considine and sophomore Jade Rogers will both miss the entire 2011-12 season.

Considine suffered a torn Achillies tendon during preseason workouts. Rogers had surgery to repair an injured knee.
