SCOUTING WESTERN ILLINOIS

The Western Illinois Leathernecks are 3-5 overall, with wins over Hannibal-LaGrange, Valparaiso and North Dakota State.

In their last game, the Leathernecks dropped an 88-55 decision at Eastern Illinois Monday night. Valencia Kelly led Western Illinois with 14 points and four assists, while Michele Savatori had a team-best seven rebounds. Eastern Illinois outscored the Leathernecks, 44-20, in the paint and turned 18 offensive rebounds into 22 second chance points.

Sadie Webb leads the team with 14.9 points per game. Savatori is next at 11 points and leads the team with 8.5 rebounds. Kelly is scoring 10.4 points per contest.

As a team, Western Illinois is averaging 66.8 points per game and shooting .355 (182-512) from the field, including .314 (54-172) from three-point distance.

WESTERN ILLINOIS VS. IOWA NOTES

- Iowa leads the all-time series, 6-2. The last meeting came in Iowa City during the 2007-08 season (70-49 win for Iowa). Five of the eight meetings have been in Iowa City, with the Hawkeye winning all five of those games.

- Western Illinois assistant coach Kerry Juhlin is from Cedar Falls, Iowa. She played at Drake and also spent time as an assistant coach at Loras College.

- Western Illinois graduate manager Jessie Biggs is from Ottumwa, Iowa. She played at Northern Iowa and spent three seasons as an assistant coach at Coe College.

OPPONENTS IN THE RANKINGS

Four Iowa opponents are ranked in the AP and ESPN/USA Today polls: Texas A&M (8/7), Purdue (12/14), Ohio State (13/15) and Penn State (17/18).

In addition, Michigan and Northwestern are receiving votes.

HAWKEYES DROP GAME IN AMES

The Hawkeyes were defeated at Iowa State Wednesday night, 62-54. Iowa held the Cyclones without a point for 6:08 in the first half, using a 12-2 run to gain a 21-16 lead. The Hawkeyes gave up six points in the final five seconds of the half and took just a one point lead into the locker room at halftime.

Iowa State limited Iowa to just a .269 (7-26) field goal percentage in the second half to seal the win. The Cyclones forced 22 turnovers and converted them into 21 points and also outscored Iowa in the paint, 24-14.

Junior Morgan Johnson led Iowa with 16 points and added seven rebounds. Freshman Melissa Dixon chipped in 11 points and four rebounds off the bench. Senior Kalli Hansen had a game-high 10 rebounds.

BACK-TO-BACK CAREER NIGHTS FOR HANSEN

Senior Kalli Hansen has been a spark off the Iowa bench, recording career highs in points and rebounds in two-straight games.

Against Kansas State (Dec. 3), Hansen recorded career-highs in points (11), field goals made and attempted (4-6), three-pointers made and attempted (2-3) and assists (2).

She followed with a career-best 10 rebounds at Iowa State.

DIXON'S STRONG SHOWING AT IOWA STATE

Freshman Melissa Dixon turned in her best performance in a Hawkeye uniform at Iowa State (Dec. 7).

Dixon was Iowa's second-leading scorer with 11 points, and also added four rebounds. She was 4-7 from the field, including 2-5 from three-point range.

JOHNSON FROM THE FIELD

Junior Morgan Johnson has attempted at least 10 shots in five of Iowa's nine games this season. In four of those games, Johnson has shot .500 or better.

Johnson was 5-10 (.500) vs. Harvard, 9-13 (.692) at Northern Iowa, 6-11 (.545) at Kansas State and 5-10 (.500) at Iowa State.

The only game Johnson failed to shoot .500 with 10 or more shots was vs. Virginia Tech (8-21, .381).

CHARITY STRIPE SUCCESS

The Hawkeyes have cashed in from the free throw line so far this season.

Iowa is 142-177 from the charity stripe and their .802 free throw percentage ranks first in the Big Ten. The Hawkeyes entered the week with the fourth-best free throw percentage in the NCAA.

Individually, Jaime Printy's .889 free throw percentage is third-best in the Big Ten and she entered the week ranked 45th in the NCAA.

REACHING DOUBLE FIGURES

Iowa's game at Kansas State (Dec. 3) marked the fourth time this season that at least three players have scored 10 or more points.

The Hawkeyes had four players in double figures against Northern Iowa and Kansas State. Three players reached double digits against Harvard and Albany.

NO DOUBLE FIGURES. NO PROBLEM

Iowa had just one player (Morgan Johnson) score double figures in a win over Virginia Tech (Nov. 30).

The last time an Iowa team won a game with just one player in double figures was Dec. 2, 2007 vs. Detroit when Kristi Smith netted 10 points.

Since the game vs. Detroit in 2007, Iowa teams have only had one player score 10 or more points just seven times. The Hawkeyes lost all seven of those contests.

HITTING FROM OUTSIDE

Kelly Krei has emerged as Iowa's top three-point shooter.

Krei is 16-34 from beyond the arc and leads the team with a .471 three-point percentage. Her three-point percentage ranks second in the Big Ten.

Head Coach Lisa Bluder

Lisa Bluder (pronounced BLUE-dir) is in her 12th season as head coach at the University of Iowa and her 28th season as a college head coach. She is a three-time Big Ten and two-time WBCA Regional Coach of the Year.

Bluder, 48, has a career record of 572-278 (.673), including a 216-136 (.614) record at Iowa, a 187-106 (.638) record in 10 seasons (1990-2000) at Drake and a six-year mark (1984-90) of 169-36 (.824) at St. Ambrose.

Bluder is Iowa's second all-time winningest coach and trails only C. Vivian Stringer. She has guided the Hawkeyes to 10 post-season tournaments (8 NCAA, 2 WNIT) and eight upper-division finishes in the Big Ten Conference, including winning a share of the league championship in 2008 and tying for second place in 2009.

In her first season with the Hawkeyes, Bluder transformed a struggling program into a 21-game winner. Iowa finished second in the Big Ten, won the conference tournament and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament. Bluder became Iowa's third coach to be named Big Ten Coach of the Year. She was also honored as the College Coach of the Year by the *Women's Basketball News Service* and was named the WBCA District 6 Coach of the Year. Iowa's 2001-02 squad finished fourth in the Big Ten and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament for the second consecutive year. In 2003, Bluder guided the Hawkeyes to their first-ever WNIT appearance. Iowa, which had nine underclassmen on its roster, advanced to the quarterfinals before falling to Creighton. In 2004-05, Iowa finished 23-10, starting the year 13-0 and was the last Division I undefeated team standing. In 2005-06, Bluder mentored a team plagued by injuries to a fifth-place Big Ten finish and an NCAA Tournament berth.

In her 10 years at Drake, Bluder brought great success and tradition to the Bulldog program and established herself as one of the top coaches in the country. She led Drake to five 20-plus win seasons in her last six years, including five post-season appearances. She guided the Bulldogs to eight Missouri Valley Conference Tournament appearances, reaching the semifinals six times and winning the tournament four times. Bluder was also named the Conference Coach of the Year three times at Drake.

Bluder began her coaching career at St. Ambrose, where she coached six successful seasons, building the Bees into a NAIA powerhouse. During her tenure at St. Ambrose, Bluder guided the Bees to four straight national tournaments, including two consecutive Final Four appearances. The 1990 St. Ambrose team was ranked No. 1 and Bluder was named the NAIA Converse Coach of the Year.

A graduate of Linn-Mar High School in Marion, IA, Bluder was a three-year starter at Northern Iowa. She graduated from UNI in 1983 with a bachelor's degree in marketing.

CONSISTENT STARTS

Three Hawkeyes have recorded consistent starts in certain statistical categories through seven games this season.

- Junior Jaime Printy has scored at least 15 points in all but three games, including three 20 point performances.
- Freshman Samantha Logic has grabbed at least five rebounds and dished out at least four assists in five of Iowa's nine games.
- Junior Morgan Johnson has recorded three blocks in four of Iowa's first nine contests.

PRINTY STREAK SNAPPED

Junior Jaime Printy had converted 30-straight free throws, dating back to Iowa's game vs. UNLV (Nov. 13), before a miss from the charity stripe against Texas A&M (Nov. 26).

Printy went 8-8 against UNLV (Nov. 13), 9-9 against Albany (Nov. 16), 4-4 vs. Northern Iowa (Nov. 19) and 8-8 vs. St. John's (Nov. 25). She made her first attempt against Texas A&M, before missing the first of two free throws in the second half.

Printy's latest streak is the second time she has made at least 30-straight free throws. She made 32-straight free throws last year, one shy of Iowa's record for consecutive free throws (33 by Lindsey Meder).

LOGIC COLLECTS DOUBLE-DOUBLE

Freshman Samantha Logic scored 10 points and grabbed 11 rebounds at Northern Iowa (Nov. 19) for her first career double-double.

Logic's double-double was the first for an Iowa freshman since the 2009-10 season. Morgan Johnson had 16 points and 11 rebounds vs. Purdue (Jan. 31, 2010).

KREI HITTING THE GLASS

Kelly Krei recorded her third career double-double vs. Albany (Nov. 16) with 13 points and 10 rebounds.

Krei's first double-double came at home vs. Indiana as a sophomore (14 points and 13 rebounds). Her second was in the season opener vs. Southern in the Islander Tip-Off Classic, hosted by Texas A&M Corpus Christi, as a junior (20 points and 10 rebounds).

MAJOR BENCH POINTS

Iowa's 26 points off the bench vs. Albany were the most for a Hawkeye team in 26 games.

The Hawkeyes scored 26 bench points against Virginia Tech last year in Cancun. Before the Virginia Tech game a year ago, the last time an Iowa team scored 26 or more bench points was against Texas State in 2008 (27 off the bench).

MOVING UP CAREER CHARTS

Four Hawkeyes are currently working their way up the career records lists at Iowa.

- Kamille Wahlin ranks fourth in career three-pointers made (180), 10th in career assists (334) and 21st in career scoring (1,157). She needs six more three-pointers to move past Kristi Smith into third place, six more assists to move past Kachine Alexander for ninth place and four more points to past Tia Jackson for 20th place.
- Morgan Johnson ranks second in career blocks (176) and needs 60 more to move past Tangela Smith for first place.
- Jaime Printy ranks fifth in career three-pointers made (167) and 19th in career scoring (1,174). She needs 14 more three-pointers to move past Wahlin for fourth place and 20 more points to move past Crystal Smith for 18th place.
- Kelly Krei ranks eighth in career three-pointers made (132) and needs seven more to move past Kristi Faulkner into seventh place.

NESBITT SIDELINED WITH KNEE SURGERY

Junior Trisha Nesbitt will be sidelined after having minor knee surgery Nov. 15. She is expected to miss 3-6 weeks of action.

HAWKEYES ON ALL-TOURNAMENT TEAMS

Junior Jaime Printy was named to both the Hawkeye Challenge and Junkanoo Jam all-tournament teams. Senior Kamille Wahlin was chosen for the Hawkeye Challenge all-tournament team and freshman Samantha Logic was picked for the Junkanoo Jam all-tournament team.

Printy led Iowa in scoring vs. both Harvard (24 points) and UNLV (25 points) in the Hawkeye Challenge. She added six rebounds and four assists vs. Harvard, along with five rebounds and four assists vs. UNLV.

Printy was also named CollegeSportsMadness.com's Big Ten Player of the Week.

Wahlin netted nine points against Harvard and scored 15 vs. UNLV. She also had two rebounds and three assists against the Rebels.

Logic averaged 14.5 points and six rebounds while shooting .500 (12-24) from the field against two tough opponents in the Junkanoo Jam.

Logic started the week with 13 points, three rebounds and three steals in Iowa's win over St. John's. Logic was 5-9 from the field in 22 minutes of action.

Against the No. 4 ranked and defending NCAA champion Texas A&M Aggies, Logic was one rebound shy of a double-double. She scored 16 points, grabbed nine rebounds and added three assists.

Printy started the Junkanoo Jam with a team-best 17 points (8-8 FTs), five rebounds, three assists and three steals against St. John's.

Printy added 14 points, three rebounds and three steals against Texas A&M.

HAWKEYES PICKED TO FINISH THIRD

The Iowa women's basketball team was picked to finish third by both the league coaches and media. Penn State was chosen as the favorite in both polls.

Junior Jaime Printy was a preseason all-Big Ten selection by both the league media and coaches.

PRINTY NAMED TO WATCH LISTS

Junior Jaime Printy has been named to the "Wade Watch," Wooden Award and Naismith Trophy Watch Lists. The "Wade Watch" List is made up of the top 25 preseason women's basketball players, the Wooden Award includes 30 student-athletes and the Naismith Trophy list has 51 players.

The three awards are considered the most prestigious awards in NCAA women's college basketball.

In addition, Iowa finished with a winning record for the 10th time in 11 seasons under Bluder. Iowa's tie for third place in the Big Ten is also the eighth time, under Bluder, the Hawkeyes recorded an upper-division finish in the conference.

Iowa also tallied its sixth 20-win season under Bluder, including each of the last four seasons.

NEW HAWKEYES RANK HIGH

Iowa's freshmen class was tabbed as the 11th best recruiting class of 2011 by ESPNHoop-Guriz.com. The class includes five players, one at each position.

Included in the class is guard Samantha Logic, who is the third McDonald's High School All-American to commit to the University of Iowa under Head Coach Lisa Bluder.

TWO PLAYERS OUT FOR THE SEASON

Senior Megan Considine and sophomore Jade Rogers will both miss the entire 2011-12 season.

Considine suffered a torn Achilles tendon during preseason workouts. Rogers had surgery to repair an injured knee.
