**Personal** -- Born September 19, 1986... daughter of Janny and Ruud van Bunnik... interdepartmental studies major.

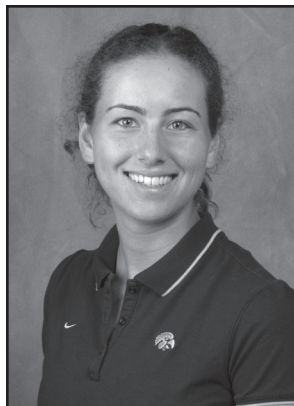
