Game #10 Quick Hits

- Tuesday will be the first-ever meeting between Iowa and Alcorn State. The Hawkeyes are 10-0 all-time against current schools from the Southwestern Athletic Conference.
- Iowa won its 399th game (399-123, .764) in Carver-Hawkeye Arena Saturday afternoon. The Hawkeyes will be seeking win No. 400 in the arena Tuesday against Alcorn State.
- Tuesday is "Aaron White Bobblehead Night" and a "Four Pack Night." The first 1,500 fans in attendance will receive a free bobblehead. Also, fans can purchase four tickets, four hot dogs, and four drinks for \$55 (must be purchased in advance).
- Iowa has won 30 straight nonconference home games, a streak that dates back to November 2011 (Clemson). The active streak ties Oregon for ninth in the country.
- Since the news of Gabriel Olaseni's father's death, the Hawkeye senior has averaged 10.5 points (making 62 percent of his field goals), 5.8 rebounds, and 3.3 blocks. Olaseni will be in uniform for Tuesday's game. He tentatively plans to leave for his father's services in London after the Iowa State game (Dec. 12).
- Iowa is 36-6 when scoring 80 points or more, the last five seasons. The Hawkeyes are 46-1 when holding opponents to fewer than 61 points, the last five years.

Riding a five-game win streak, lowa (7-2) remains home its second game of its threegame home stand Tuesday with a contest versus Alcorn State (1-5). Tipoff is scheduled for 8:05 p.m. (CT) on Mediacom Court at Carver-Hawkeye Arena (15,400).

ON THE AIR

Radio: lowa games are broadcast on the Hawkeye Radio Network. Gary Dolphin handles the play-by-play, along with color commentator Bob Hansen. The network includes more than 40 stations that blanket the state of lowa and include portions of Illinois, Nebraska, Minnesota, Missouri and Wisconsin. The Hawkeye Radio Network coverage includes a 60-minute pregame show.

TV: Tuesday's game will be televised nationally on ESPNEWS. Bob Picozzi and Sean Harrington will call the action.

HAWKEYES CRUISE PAST UM-BALTIMORE COUNTY

- Four Hawkeyes scored in double figures in a 77-47 win over Maryland-Baltimore County (UMBC) Saturday in Iowa City.
- Peter Jok and Gabriel Olaseni each netted 15 points off the bench to lead the home squad. Both point totals equaled career highs for Jok and Olaseni. Jok also posted personal bests in steals (three), and 3-pointers made (four) and attempted (six).
- lowa forced a season-high 26 turnovers, collecting a season-best 16 steals. The 16 thefts are the second most by a Hawkeye team during the Fran McCaffery era (19 vs. SIUE in 2010). Iowa converted the UMBC miscues into 34 points.
- lowa's top-two leading scorers, Aaron White (14) and Jarrod Uthoff (11), each reached double figures. White has scored in double digits in every game this season.
- The Hawkeyes were 12-of-15 (.800) from the foul line. Iowa has made 33 of its last 39 free-throw attempts (.846) the last two games combined.
- lowa assisted on 20 of its 29 field goals, with Mike Gesell dishing out a game-best seven helpers. The seven assists tie a season best for the junior guard.
- UMBC did not have a player reach double digits; Cody Joyce led the team with nine points.

DEFENDING THE GOAL

Iowa enters Tuesday's game ranked sixth in the country in field goal percentage defense (.338) and 22nd in scoring defense (56.1). The Hawkeyes have held their last four opponents (Northern Illinois, Longwood, North Carolina, and UMBC) to 33 percent shooting or lower and five opponents overall (North Dakota State). Last year, Iowa opponents shot 41.5 percent from the field.

Head Coach Fran McCaffery

Fran McCaffery, who is signed through the 2020 season, is in his fifth season as the head basketball coach at the University of Iowa and his 19th year overall as a college head coach. McCaffery spent five seasons (2005-10) as the head coach at Siena, six years at UNC-Greensboro (1999-2005) and three seasons at Lehigh (1985-88) before joining the Hawkeyes.

McCaffery has three decades of Division I coaching experience. He completed his 32nd season as a collegiate coach in 2014, which includes 18 years as a head coach and 14 as an



assistant. McCaffery became one of 12 coaches to lead four different Division I teams to the NCAA Tournament in 2014.

McCaffery, 55, holds a career mark of 332-245 (.575) and guided his teams to nine postseason appearances (six NCAA, three NIT). He is 81-65 (.555) at lowa.

Since taking over the lowa program in 2010, the Hawkeyes have increased their win total by 15 games. McCaffery coached lowa to 25 victories in 2013, equaling the second-most win total in program history. McCaffery has guided the Black and Gold to back-to-back NIT appearances, including a runner-up finish in 2013.

McCaffery has posted upper division finishes in each of the past two seasons at Iowa and 14-of-18 seasons as a head coach. He has posted 20 wins or more six of the last eight seasons, including the last two at lowa (2013 and 2014).

McCaffery and the Hawkeyes have made Carver-Hawkeye Arena one of the most feared arenas to play nationally. Fans have embraced Mc-Caffery and his team's style of play with attendance increasing by 57 percent since 2010. The Hawkeyes won a school-record 18 home games a year ago.

McCaffery's five years at Siena were the best in its 70-year history. He led the Saints on an incredible run that ended with three straight Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference championships and NCAA Tournament appearances. In so doing, Siena became the only program in the country to win its regular season and postseason title 2008-10.

McCaffery's Saints owned a 112-51 (.687) record in his five years with the program. He guided the Saints to four consecutive 20-win seasons.

The 2009 MAAC Coach of the Year and 2010 District I Coach of the Year is the third winningest coach, by percentage, in league history (68-22, .756). He is the only coach to guide a MAAC program to two NCAA Tournament wins. McCaffery led his 2008 and 2009 teams to first round NCAA Tournament victories over Vanderbilt and Ohio State, respectively.

In his final two seasons at Siena, he coached the Saints to back-toback 27-win campaigns and boasted a combined 39-3 (.929) record against MAAC opponents, which included MAAC Tournament contests.

McCaffery began his coaching career as an assistant at Penn (1982-83) and Lehigh (1983-85). After three seasons as head coach at Lehigh, he spent 11 seasons as an assistant at Notre Dame (1988-99).

McCaffery played basketball at Wake Forest his freshman year (1977-78) and then concluded his collegiate playing career at Penn his final three seasons (1979-82).

He earned his B.S. degree in Economics from The Wharton School (Penn) in 1982. McCaffery also earned a Master of Education from Lehigh in 1985.

SCOUTING ALCORN STATE

- Alcorn State last played a week ago Tuesday, falling 72-51 at Troy.
- The Braves and Hawkeyes have played one common opponent: Texas. Alcorn State lost 85-53 at Texas, while Iowa fell 71-57 to the Longhorns in New York.
- Alcorn State has one victory, beating Dillard University (95-73) at home on Nov. 24.
- The Braves have four players average double figures in scoring: Leantwan Luckett (16.2), Reginald Johnson (12.0), Tyrel Hunt (11.5), and Marquis Vance (10.7). Vance also leads the squad in rebounding, pulling down 6.5 boards per contest.

WHITE HOT

Aaron White ranks first among active Big Ten players in rebounding (719) and is third in scoring (1,442).

White ranks first on the team in rebounding (7.3), steals (1.8), and scoring (15.7), and third in assists (2.3) this season. White is seeking to become the first Hawkeye to lead the team in scoring and rebounding since Greg Brunner in 2006 (14.1 points and 9.2 rebounds per game).

White was the only Big Ten player to average 13+ points and 7+ rebounds during league play in 2014. White became the first Hawkeye ever to register 1,300+ points, 650+ rebounds, 100+ steals, and 100+ assists by his junior season.

White was the only player in the country to shoot better than 55 percent from the field and 80 percent from the foul line in 2014. He shot 58 percent from the field and 81 percent from the charity stripe. White is already on pace to accomplish the feat a second consecutive season, shooting 55 percent from the field and 87 percent from the foul line after nine games.

White became the fifth player, since 1960, to lead the Hawkeyes in rebounding three consecutive seasons. White joins Don Nelson (1960-62); Kevin Kunnert (1971-73); Bruce King (1975-77); and Greg Brunner (2004-06). He is seeking to become the first player alltime to lead the Hawkeyes in rebounding all four seasons.

White became the 41st Hawkeye to surpass 1,000 career points with his 19th point scored with one second remaining at the free throw line versus Notre Dame (Dec. 3). He reached the 1,000-point milestone in his 82nd career game. White currently ranks 15th in lowa scoring.

STRONG START FOR WOODBURY

Center Adam Woodbury averaged 5.7 points and 3.9 rebounds last year as a sophomore. Through nine games as a junior, Woodbury is averaging 8.9 points and 6.1 rebounds. He is shooting 60 percent (34-of-57) from the field this year. Woodbury has already surpassed his double-digit scoring total (five) from a year ago (four). The native of Sioux City, Iowa, ranks sixth in the Big Ten in field goal percentage (.596).

UTHOFF PRODUCING ON THE WING

Jarrod Uthoff ranks second in team scoring (11.1 ppg) and is second in steals (1.6) through nine games. The redshirt junior averaged 14 points, six rebounds, and three steals in lowa's two games in New York. He drained a personal-best four triples in Iowa's victory over Hampton (Nov. 14). He has reached double figures in six of Iowa's first nine contests.

The native of Cedar Rapids, Iowa, tallied eight points and equaled career bests in rebounding (11) and blocked shots (five) in lowa's five-point victory at No. 12 North Carolina.

CLEMMONS RETURNS TO FORM

After a sluggish sophomore campaign, Anthony Clemmons has had a strong start to his junior season. Clemmons has started the first nine games, averaging 6.6 points. Reaching double figures just once a season ago, Clemmons has already netted double digits three times. He was 6-of-16 (.375) from 3-point territory last season and has already surpassed that total through nine games this year (10-of-25, .400).
