#### LEADING OFF

- The Hawkeyes' nine-game home winning streak and five-game overall winning streak was snapped in an 11-6 loss to Illinois State on April 3. It was lowa's only sixth loss in midweek games since the start of 2016.
- lowa has posted nine come-from-behind wins this season.
- The Hawkeyes are 11-4 in games decided by two runs or less.
- lowa has three series wins -- at No. 19 Oklahoma State, vs. Cal-State Northridge, and vs. No. 23 Illinois. The Hawkeyes split a four-game series at Hawaii and suffered series losses at Evansville and at Indiana.
- lowa's sweep of No. 23 Illinois was its first series sweep over a ranked team since 2015 when lowa took three from No. 19 Indiana.
- With five wins over top-25 teams this season, lowa was has 13 games over ranked opponents since the start of the 2018 season.
- Junior Austin Martin has the third-best batting average (.370) in the Big Ten, which is tops amongst league catchers. In Martin's last 15 games, he is hitting .404 (21-of-52) with seven multi-hit games. The Altoona, lowa, native is up to a team-leading 12 multi-hit games on the season.
- Junior Grant Judkins owns the fourth-best ERA (1.69) in the Big Ten, having allowed one run or fewer in five of seven starts.
- Redshirt junior Grant Leonard (2-1, 2.03 ERA) is a perfect 6-for-6 in save opportunities, which are the second most in the Big Ten conference.
- The Hawkeye pitching staff owns a 4.06, the sixth-best in the conference, along with 8.8 strikeouts per nine innings, which ranks fifth in the league.
- lowa is 9-2 at Banks this season, after going 20-6 at home last season. The Hawkeyes are 83-22 in lowa City since 2015.
- lowa has won 159 games since the start of the 2015 season, the best four-year stretch in school history. The Hawkeyes have won 182 games in the Rick Heller era (2014-present), which is the third-best five-year stretch all-time. The Hawkeyes won 178 games from 1981-85 and 175 from 1977-1981 under Duane Banks.

#### **ABOUT HEAD COACH RICK HELLER**

Rick Heller has turned the University of Iowa baseball program into a perennial Big Ten Conference and NCAA contender in his first five seasons as the Hawkeyes' head coach.

Heller has injected new life into the lowa program, leading the Hawkeyes to the best four-year stretch in program history, winning 173 games, advancing to two NCAA Regionals, and claiming the first Big Ten Tournament title in program history. It was lowa's first conference title since winning the regular season crown in 1990.

Under Heller's watch, lowa has advanced to the postseason in five consecutive years for the first time in program history, he has coached six All-Americans and at least one first-team All-Big Ten selection each season, and Iowa has had 20 Major League Baseball Draft picks in five seasons -- the most in a five-year stretch all-time.

Heller has also given the Hawkeyes an international flavor, taking the team to the Dominican Republic in 2016 and Taipei, Taiwan, as the United States representative at the 2017 World University Games. Heller led USA to a silver medal, as the team became the first American squad to medal in Universiade history.

The Eldon, lowa, native became the 20th head coach in program history in 2013 -- his fourth stop as a collegiate head coach. He has enjoyed stints at lowa (2014-present), Indiana State (2009-13), Northern lowa (1999-2009), and Upper Iowa (1987-99), leading all four schools to NCAA postseason play. He is one of nine coaches all-time and one of five active coaches to lead three different Division I programs to NCAA Regional play.

Heller guided lowa to an at-large berth into NCAA Regional play in 2015 -- a first for the program since 1990 -- and the team posted the school's first NCAA Tournament win since 1972. It wasn't a fluke; in the two seasons since, lowa was runner-up at the 2016

Big Ten Tournament before claiming the program's first tournament title in 2017 to lock up the school's second NCAA Regional appearance in three seasons.

Iowa made just three NCAA Tournament appearances in its history prior to Heller's arrival.

Heller led Indiana State to its first outright Missouri Valley Conference title in 2012, and Northern Iowa to the MVC title and into the NCAA Tournament in 2001, the first and only regional appearance for the Panthers as a Division I program.

On the recruiting trail, Heller has turned the Hawkeyes into a major player on the national recruiting scene by keeping the best in-state players at home. Iowa had the top-rated class in the Big Ten -- and 18th-best nationally -- in 2015, and the 2016 class was ranked third in the league.

In 31 seasons as a head coach, Heller owns a career record of 879-685-4. He is one of two lowa head coaches to lead the program to the NCAA Tournament.

#### **QUICK HITTERS**

- Sophomore Izaya Fullard's nine-game hitting streak came to a halt against Illinois State, but he extended his reached-base streak to 10 games.
- lowa is 10-1 when leading after six innings and 13-2 when leading after eight innings.
- The Hawkeyes have walked a conference-leading 132 times this season, which has produced the fourth-best on-base percentage in the conference at .369.
- lowa's 34 stolen bases are the fourth-most in the Big Ten. The Hawkeyes only swiped 39 bags last season. Ben Norman and Tanner Wetrich lead lowa with seven stolen bases each.
- Junior Matthew Sosa hit his first career home run -- an inside-the-park variety -- in game one at Evansville. He is one of five Hawkeyes with home runs this season.
- Three Hawkeyes -- seniors Cole McDonald and Chris Whelan and sophomore Jack Dreyer -- were selected to the Big Ten Preseason Honors list.
- The Hawkeyes return four starters, their designated hitter, 2/3 of their starting rotation, and 19 total letterwinners in 2019.

- The Hawkeyes were picked to finish fifth in the Big Ten by Perfect Game, sixth by D1 Baseball, and sixth by Baseball America in 2019.
- lowa will play 12 games on the road against four 2018 NCAA Tournament teams this season (at Oklahoma State, at Indiana, at Purdue, and at Ohio State).

#### **SCOUTING RUTGERS**

- The Scarlet Knights have won two straight games and own an 8-17 overall record, including a 1-2 mark in the Big Ten.
- Rutgers' batting average (.227), ERA (5.03), and fielding percentage (.949) all rank in the bottom three of the Big Ten.
- On the offensive end, Rutgers is led by second baseman Tim Dezzi, who is hitting .322 (29-for-90) with a .419 on-base percentage. Dezzi is the only Scarlet Knight hitting above .300.
- The Rutgers pitching staff has allowed 254 hits (.281 BAA) and struck out 199 batters in 225 1/3 innings.
- LHP Harry Rutkowski (0-2, 2.51 ERA) will start Friday followed by RHP Tommy Genuario (1-1, 2.13 ERA) in game two, and LHP Tevin Murray (0-3, 5.08 ERA) in the series finale.
- Genuario's 2.13 ERA is eighth-best in the Big Ten and his .221 batting average against leads the team. It will be the right-hander's second start of the season.

#### **SERIES RESULTS**

- lowa is 6-6 all-time versus Rutgers.
- The Hawkeyes have dropped both series since the Scarlet Knights joined the Big Ten. Rutgers took two of three games in Piscataway in 2015 and two of three games in Iowa City in 2017.

#### **BACK IN THE BIG TEN RACE**

After getting swept to start the Big Ten season, lowa swept No. 23 Illinois to get back to .500 (3-3) in the conference to sit in seventh after two weekends.

- The Hawkeyes allowed only six runs in three games to one of the best offenses in the Big Ten.
- All three of lowa's starting pitchers went at least six innings, while Cam Baumann and Grant Judkins posted quality starts.
- Trenton Wallace got his first career save in game two by pitching the final three innings, while Grant Leonard earned the win in game one and a save in the series finale.
- Austin Martin had a team-high four RBIs in the three-game series, including the go-ahead RBIs in game three.

(34), total bases (16), and slugging percentage (.522). He ranks among the top-11 in the Big Ten in all five categories.

 Martin became the second Hawkeye to record four hits in a game this season in lowa's loss to Illinois State on April 3. The catcher went 4-for-5 with a double and three singles. Redshirt Tanner Padgett racked up four hits in lowa's series finale against Hawaii on February 24.

#### **B NORM BALLIN' OUT**

Junior outfielder Ben Norman has reached base safely in 15 straight games -- a new career high. He surprassed his previous high of 14 games set during his freshman year.

- During his 15-game on-base streak, Norman is hitting .317 (19-of-60) with a .397 on-base percentage.
- Norman has turned his season around after hitting .200 (9-of-45) in his first 12 games.
- The Des Moines, Iowa, native is the only Hawkeye to start all 27 games this season. Norman has seen starts at all three outfield spots with 13 in right field, 10 in center field, and four in left field.

#### JUNIOR GRANT JUDKKINS...

- ranks fourth in the Big Ten with a 1.69 ERA.
- has posted a team-leading four quality starts (vs. Marshall, vs. CSUN, at Indiana, vs. Illinois) in seven chances
- has allowed one or fewer runs in the five of seven starts.
- pitched five or more innings in all seven starts.
- ranks fifth in the Big Ten, allowing 5.91 hits per nine innings

#### **BACK AT THE TOP**

Senior Chris Whelan had seen his name appear in five different spots in the Hawkeyes' batting order before returning to the top of the lineup April 2 against Clarke. Whelan was lowa's primary leadoff hitter in 2018.

• In the two games since, Whelan is 3-for-6 with a

double, home run, four RBIs, three runs scored, and two walks.

• Whelan leads the team in walks (20), hit-by-pitches (7), and on-base percentage (.448).

#### **DUNCAN DAVITT DEALS**

In his second straight midweeks start, freshman Duncan Davitt threw a career-high five innings and struck out a career-high six batters. The right-hander from Indianola, lowa, received a no decision, but allowed didn't allow a run while giving up just one hit and two walks. Davitt has also been a key piece in the Hawkeye bullpen.

#### LEONARD LOCKS DOWN THE NINTH

Closer questions lingered to start the 2019 season, but redshirt junior Grant Leonard has secured the closer role

- The junior right-hander has a team-leading six saves, which are the second-most in the Big Ten.
- Leonard has been lowa's high leverage guy, making two appearances in one day during lowa's doubleheader sweep of Cal-State Northridge to earn a win and a save.
- Leonard owns a 2.03 ERA in 12 appearances this season.

#### **OFFENSIVELY SPEAKING**

- lowa's offensive approach has produced the most walks (132) in the Big Ten for the fourth-best on-base percentage in the conference (.364).
- lowa has 12 home runs this season. Ben Norman leads the Hawkeyes with four home runs, followed by Tanner Wetrich and Austin Martin who each have two home runs. Chris Whelan became the latest Hawkeye to hit a home run on April 3.
- Junior Zeb Adreon tied a school record, roping three doubles in the game one victory at Evansville. Chris Whelan and Adreon both have three-double games this season, which are tied for the most by a Big Ten player this season.

• The Hawkeye have eclipsed 10 hits nine times this season, registering a season-high 19 hits in game one against Evansville. Iowa has scored 10 runs in four games this season.

#### ON THE BUMP

- lowa ranks fifth in the Big Ten with 8.8 strikeouts per nine innings, but lowa's 5.09 walks per nine innings rank 10th in the Big Ten. The Hawkeyes 1.73 strikeoutto-walk ratio is the fourth-worst in the conference.
- The Hawkeye staff is allowing 7.86 hits per nine innings, which ranks fifth-best in the Big Ten.

#### **BACK END OF THE BULLPEN**

The Hawkeye bullpen has held opposing hitters to a .236 average over 105 2/3 innings with 101 strikeouts.

- Grant Leonard has converted all six of his saves, which leads the team and are the second-most in the Big Ten.
   Jason Foster and Trenton Wallace each have one save this season.
- Trace Hoffman (3-1) has been one of lowa's go-to guys out of the bullpen, leading the team with 14 appearances, which are the second-most in the Big Ten. Hoffman owns a .214 batting average against and has 15 strikeouts in 15 innings to only three walks.
- Freshman Duncan Davitt, who started lowa's midweek game against Clarke, has been a steady arm out of the bullpen, striking out 14 batters in 13 innings of relief.

#### **MCCAFFERY'S DOUBLE DUTY**

Redshirt freshman multi-sport athlete Connor McCaffery made his lowa debut against Cal-State Northridge on March 16 as a pinch hitter. McCaffery made his first career start in game three of the series, finishing 3-for-4 with two doubles.

- McCaffery was a reserve guard for the lowa men's basketball team that nearly completed a 25-point comeback win over second-seeded Tennessee on March 24, but fell in overtime in the Round of 32 of the NCAA Tournament. McCaffery finished the season averaging 4.4 points and 3.0 assists in 34 games.
- McCaffery is believed to be the first Hawkeye since the

late 1980s to play both basketball and baseball at lowa since Randy Norton (79-82), Todd Berkenpas (82-85) Tom Norman (1979), and Kurt Stange (1983-86).

• Basketball-baseball combinations are rare. A select few who have done it recently are Notre Dame's Pat Connaughton and Washington State's Mark Hendrickson as pitchers. Other notables are Chris Young (Princeton), Kenny Lofton (Arizona), and Tony Gwynn (San Diego State).

#### MASTERS OF THE MIDWEEK

• lowa's 11-6 loss to Illinois State on Wednesday was lowa's sixth midweek loss in the last four years. lowa is 29-6 in midweek contests since the start of 2016.

#### DON'T COUNT 'EM OUT

The Hawkeyes have posted nine come-from-behind victories this season, including two in walk-off fashion.

- In two of three games against No. 23 Illinois, lowa overcame one-run defecits to complete the sweep.
- lowa scored four runs in the bottom of the eighth against Bradley after trailing 2-0 for the first seven inning to win 4-2.
- Junior Grant Judkins had a pinch-hit, RBI double, giving the Hawkeyes a 5-4 walk-off win over Cal-State Northridge on March 17. lowa trailed 4-3 heading into the ninth.
- lowa posted its second walk-off win of the season against Chicago State. Trailing 4-3 entering the ninth, Austin Martin's RBI double tied the score at four and Ben Norman's fly ball to centerfield was misplayed, giving the Hawkeyes their 11th win.
- The Hawkeyes have overcome deficits to win 42 games since the start of the 2017 season and posted 11 walkoffs. Twenty-four of those victories have come with lowa trailing or being tied entering or through seven innings. Sixteen have come in the final at-bat.

#### **BANKS MAGIC**

- The Hawkeyes are 83-22 at home since the start of the 2015 season.
- lowa won 20 games last season, the second-most in a single-season in school history, trailing only the 22

• lowa has 15 walk-off victories at Duane Banks Field since the start of 2015.

#### ON THE MEND

- Sophomore Ben Probst will miss the remainder of the season with a partial tear to his UCL. He suffered the injury at Hawaii on Feb. 23.
- Junior Hunter Lee made just two appearances before going down because of injury. He had season-ending surgery in March.
- Sophomore Jack Dreyer is out with a shoulder injury. He left his start at Hawaii after three innings.
- Sophomore Tanner Padgett re-injured his hamstring on March 20. He initially suffered the injury in the series finale at Oklahoma State.

#### **COACHING STAFF CHANGES**

lowa welcomed Robin Lund and Tom Gorzelanny to the Hawkeye coaching staff after Desi Druschel and Joe Migliaccio accepted positions within the New York Yankees organization. Lund, who served as the volunteer hitting coach for the Northern lowa softball program in 2018 and UNI's volunteer strength and conditioning coach under Heller in 2005-06, replaces Migliaccio as the team's hitting coach. Gorzelanny, who pitched for six MLB teams over a 12-year span, replaces Druschel as the team's volunteer pitching coach.

#### **TEAM CAPTAINS**

Three seniors -- Mitchell Boe, Cole McDonald, and Chris Whelan -- and redshirt junior Kyle Shimp were voted team captains in January. Shimp is a team captain for a second straight season.

#### **IOWA BY THE NUMBERS**

- Offensively, lowa returns 41.9 percent (133-317) of its runs, 46.1 percent (218-472) of its hits, 38.9 percent (37-95) of its doubles, 21.9 percent (9-41) of its home runs, 40.3 percent (113-280) of its RBIs, and 58.9 percent (23-39) of its stolen bases.
- On the mound, lowa has three starters -- RHP Cole McDonald, LHP Jack Dreyer, and RHP Grant Judkins -- and 10 pitchers returning. The Hawkeyes have 45.4 percent (15-33) of their wins, 45.4 percent (214 of 471 1/3) of their innings, 46.2 percent (231-499) of their strikeouts, and 18.1 percent (2-11) of their saves back in 2019.

#### **CHAMPIONSHIP HAWKEYES**

- Chris Whelan and Lorenzo Elion won a Prospect League championship with the Terre Haute Rex in 2018. The Rex defeated Kokomo, 11-3, to claim their second title in four seasons.
- Mitchell Boe led the Fond du Lac Dock Spiders to their first Northwoods League title with a 4-3 victory over Duluth.

#### ROSTER BREAKDOWN

- lowa's 35-man roster features six freshmen, eight sophomores, 14 juniors, and seven seniors. Fifteen newcomers (five freshman and 10 transfers) joined lowa's roster this season.
- The Hawkeyes come from seven different states: 22 from Iowa, eight from Illinois, and one from Missouri, Indiana, Ohio, Kansas, and California.
- lowa has two sets of junior college teammates. Zeb Adreon, Austin Martin, and Trace Hoffman were teammates at Southeastern CC, while Izaya Fullard, Hunter Lee, Adam Ketelsen, and Jake McLaughlin were teammates at Kirkwood CC. Junior Lorenzo Elion also played with Lee, Ketelsen, and McLaughlin at Kirkwood in 2017.
- The Hawkeyes also have two sets of teammates who played together in high school. Freshmen Brendan Sher and Duncan Davitt were teammates at Indianola, while Izaya Fullard and Connor McCaffery were teammates at Iowa City West.

#### **#HELLERBALL**

- UI head coach Rick Heller is one of nine coaches all-time to lead three different NCAA Division I teams to regional play.
- Heller recorded his 800th career win against Lehigh
   on

March 12 at the Snowbird Classic in Florida.

- The Hawkeyes have won 30 or more games in each of Heller's five seasons as the helm of the program. It's a first for the team since winning 30 or more in seven straight seasons from 1979-85.
- Heller has led the Hawkeyes to two NCAA Regional appearances in three seasons; the program had three regional appearances in its history prior to his arrival.
- Heller is fourth in school history in career wins with

in his four seasons at lowa, including the second (41) and fifth-most (39) in school history.

- Heller led lowa to its first Big Ten Tournament title in 2017 -- the first conference title since 1990 -- and he guided the Hawkeyes to the Big Ten Tournament title game in consecutive seasons. lowa has advanced to the league tournament in five straight years for the first time in program history.
- Heller has coached at least one first-team All-Big Ten selection each season, and has 20 Major League Baseball

Draft picks in four seasons -- the most in a five-year stretch in school history.

- lowa had a school-record six All-Big Ten selections in 2015 and five in 2017. The Hawkeyes have had 22 All-Big Ten honorees in five seasons under Heller.
- lowa has posted winning streaks of nine games (in 2015)

and eight games (in 2017) -- the longest streaks for the program since 2012.


