ON THE MAT

The third-ranked University of Iowa wrestling team travels to West Lafayette, Indiana, to open its Big Ten season against Purdue. The Hawkeyes and Boilermakers meet Sunday at 12 p.m. (CT) at Holloway Gymnasium.

BIG TEN OPENERS

Sunday's dual against Purdue is the Big Ten opener for both schools. The Hawkeyes have won 18 straight conference openers since falling to Penn State, 25-17, at home in 1998.

The Hawkeyes have won or shared eighth of the last nine Big Ten dual championships, and have won or shared the regular season title nine times since the conference started recognizing a dual meet champion in 1999. Iowa won the title outright in 2000, 2008, 2009, 2010, 2011, 2013, and 2015, and shared the title in 2003, 2014 and 2016.

THE SERIES

Iowa leads the all-time series 39-4-3. The Hawkeyes are 19-3-1 all-time at Purdue and have won 28 straight overall in the series.

The teams battled to a 14-14 tie in 1966, the last time Iowa walked away without a win. The Boilermakers' last win in the series was in 1961, a 23-9 win in Iowa City. The Hawkeyes have not lost at Purdue since 1954 (16-10).

IOWA COACHING TREE

Purdue head coach Tony Ersland is a 1997 graduate of the University of Iowa. He is one of six Big Ten coaches to graduate from Iowa (Tom Brands, Iowa; Barry Davis, Wisconsin; Tony Ersland, Purdue; Duane Goldman, Indiana; Jim Heffernan, Illinois; Tom Ryan, Ohio State). Ersland was part of three NCAA championship teams from 1995-97.

STREAKING THROUGH THE B1G

Iowa has won 17 straight conference road duals. The Hawkeyes' last road loss was Jan. 22, 2012 at Penn State (22-12).

lowa has won 21 consecutive Big Ten duals, the longest conference winning streak since winning 39 straight from 2007-12. lowa has not lost a Big Ten dual since falling at home to Minnesota, 19-15, on Jan. 25, 2014.

The 21-dual conference winning streak ties for the third longest in program history. The Hawkeyes won 21 straight Big Ten duals from 1989-92, 39 in a row from 2007-12, and 98 consecutive duals from 1974-89.

B1G VETERANS, B1G ROOKIES

Seniors Thomas Gilman, Cory Clark, Topher Carton, Alex Meyer and Sammy Brooks have a combined 73-11 record in Big Ten duals. Gilman is 22-1 overall and has won 19 straight conference duals. Meyer is undefeated in 13 conference duals, and Brooks is 19-3 in Big Ten duals. Clark was undefeated as a freshman (8-0) wrestling 125, went 4-4 as a sophomore at 133, and 8-1 at 133 last season. Carton is 4-2 in his career.

In addition to Meyer, Brandon Sorensen and Sam Stoll also enter the season unbeaten in Big Ten duals. Stoll was 9-0 in Big Ten duals as a redshirt freshman in 2016. Sorensen was 8-0 as a redshirt freshman and 9-0 last year as a sophomore at 149.

Four Hawkeyes in the probable lineup are in line to make their Big Ten dual debuts. They include redshirt freshmen Michael Kemerer (157), Joey Gunther (165), Cash Wilcke (197), and Steven Holloway (285).

PIN PARTY

Senior Thomas Gilman is halfway towards matching his career high in single-season falls. Gilman recorded 10 falls in 2016, sharing the team lead with Sam Stoll. Through five matches this year Gilman has five pins, including three first-period falls.

BIG SHOES TO FILL

Sophomore Sam Stoll is out of the Iowa lineup while rehabbing an injury. Stoll was 20-2 and ranked No. 7 in the country prior to his injury Feb. 22, 2016, at the National Duals Championship Series.

He is listed in the probable lineup for the first time this season. In his absence, sophomore Mitch Bowman and redshirt freshman Steven Holloway have filled the 285-pound spot in the lineup. Bowman, who was 10-5 at 174 pounds last season, has bumped up to 197 this season. Against lowa Central on Nov. 12, he moved up to 285 and recorded a fall in 1:32.

Holloway, who was 16-6 competing unattached at 197 last season, is 4-1 at 285 this year. He placed second at the Luther Open and won by decision, 3-2, in Iowa's dual against Cornell College.

HOT START TO 141

Topher Carton has taken ownership of the 141-pound spot in the lowa lineup, rattling off a career-best seven match winning streak to open the season. Carton has scored bonus points in six of seven matches, including one major decision, two pins, and three technical falls.

HOW WILCKE WON 197

Redshirt freshman Cashe Wilcke is filling the lineup spot vacated by three-time All-American Nathan Burak at 197 pounds. Wilcke is 6-0 this season with one pin, one technical fall, and two major decision. He defeated teammate Mitch Bowman, 3-2, in the 197-pound finals of the Luther Open.

Wilcke was 13-3 last year competing unattached at 184 pounds. He competed in four open tournaments and won the Grand View Open and Duhawk Open.

lowa's overall dual meet record is 976-226-31 (.799) in 107 seasons. The Hawkeyes have won 23 national titles and 35 Big Ten titles. Iowa's 53 NCAA Champions have won a total of 81 NCAA individual titles, crowning six three-time and 16 two-time champions. The Hawkeyes' 111 Big Ten champions have combined for 197 conference titles. There have been seven four-time, 18 three-time, and 29 two-time Big Ten champions from lowa.

lowa's 154 All-Americans have earned All-America status 319 times, including 18 four-time, 36 three-time and 40 two-time honorees.

Three-time Big Ten Coach of the Year Tom Brands enters his 11th season as head wrestling coach at the University of Iowa. A 1996 Olympic gold medalist and member of wrestling's Hall of Fame, Brands is only the eighth wrestling coach at the University of Iowa. The former Hawkeye wrestler was a four-time All-American

and three-time national champion (1989-92) at lowa. He has a 181-17-1 (.911) overall and 76-6 (.927) Big Ten coaching record at lowa, and a 198-37-1 (.840) career mark.

In 10 seasons as lowa's head coach, Brands has led the Hawkeyes to three NCAA and four Big Ten team titles, crowning nine NCAA champions, 13 Big Ten champions and 56 All-Americans. Iowa has had 80 academic all-Big Ten recipients, including a school-record 12 in 2011-12. The Hawkeyes have qualified 91 wrestlers for the NCAA Championships in the last 10 years, sending the entire 10-man lineup in 2009, 2010, 2014, and 2015. Iowa has also won or shared eight of the last nine Big Ten regular season titles.

lowa also made another entry in the record books, setting the national collegiate dual meet attendance record of 42,287 when lowa defeated topranked Oklahoma State, 18-16, on Nov. 14, 2016 at the Grapple on the Gridiron at Kinnick Stadium. Iowa has led the nation in attendance in each of Brands' 10 seasons, setting an NCAA all-time attendance average of 12,166 in 2015-16.

Brands was named 2008 NWCA Coach of the Year after leading the Hawkeyes to their first NCAA team title since 2000 and their first Big Ten team title since 2004. He was named Big Ten Coach of the Year in 2008, 2009 and 2010, becoming the first coach in conference history to earn the honor in three consecutive seasons.

Brands served as head coach at Virginia Tech University for two seasons (2005-06), recording a 17-20 dual mark. In his first season with the Hokies, Brands led the team to the 2005 regular season Atlantic Coast Conference title, set a school record for dual meet wins (16) and had a school-record five wrestlers qualify for the NCAA Championships. During his tenure, Virginia Tech crowned five ACC champions and had two All-Americans. Senior heavy-weight Mike Faust was named 2006 ACC Wrestler of the Year.

Prior to taking the helm at Virginia Tech, Brands was an assistant coach at Iowa for 12 seasons (1993-2004). He helped the Hawkeyes to a 177-27 dual record, seven NCAA and eight Big Ten team titles, while crowning 23 NCAA champions, 73 All-Americans and 36 Big Ten champions. He was named the National Wrestling Coaches Association Assistant Coach of the Year in 2000.

In 2004, he was one of three coaches for the U.S. Olympic freestyle wrestling team, participating in Athens, and in 2016 he was named a volunteer coach of the United States Olympic team in Rio. Brands also served as assistant coach for the U.S. Freestyle World Teams in 2001, 2002, 2003, 2013, 2014, and 2015. He was named Freestyle Coach of the Year by USA Wrestling in 2002 and 2003. He has coached a number of other U.S. teams in international competition.

As a competitor, Brands won the 1996 Olympic freestyle gold medal at 136.5 pounds in Atlanta, Georgia. He also won a gold medal at the 1993 World Freestyle Championships in Toronto, two World Cup gold medals (1994, 1995) and was the 1995 Pan American Games champion. He won four U.S. National titles (1993-96) and made four straight U.S. World or Olympic teams (1993-96). Along with his twin brother, Terry, Tom was named 1993 USA Wrestling Athlete of the Year, the 1993 John Smith Outstanding Freestyle Wrestler, and 1993 Amateur Wrestling News Man of the Year. He was inducted into wrestling's Hall of Fame in 2001.

Brands was a four-time All-American at Iowa (1989-92). During his Hawkeye career, he won three NCAA titles and was named Outstanding Wrestler of the 1992 NCAA Championships. Also a three-time Big Ten champion, Brands won 95 percent of his matches at Iowa. His career mark of 158-7-2 includes an undefeated season in 1991 (45-0).

The Sheldon, Iowa, native was born April 9, 1968. He earned his B.S. degree in physical education from Iowa in 1992. He and his wife, Jeni, have three children, Madigan, Kinsee and Tommy.
