## QUICK HITS

- Iowa made its ninth consecutive postseason appearance (8 NCAA, 1 WNIT), earning an at-large bid to the WNIT last season.
- The Hawkeyes have made a postseason tournament appearance in 15 of head coach Lisa Bluder's 16 seasons at the helm of the program, receiving 12 NCAA Tournament and three WNIT (2003, 2005, 2016) opportunities.
- Bluder is one of 14 Division I head coaches to win 675 or more in her career. She has been a head coach for 32 seasons, including 16 at Iowa.
- Iowa returns four of its five starters from last season in senior Ally Disterhoft, junior Chase Coley, and sophomores Tania Davis and Megan Gustafson.
- Iowa's freshmen class of Bre Cera (2016 Journal Sentinel Player of the Year), Kathleen Doyle (Illinois Miss Basketball), Makenzie Meyer (Iowa Miss Basketball), Amanda Ollinger, (Gazette Female Athlete of the Year) and Alexis Sevillian (Finalist for Michigan Miss Basketball) was ranked No. 7 nationally by Blue Star -- the highest ranked recruiting class for head coach Lisa Bluder and her staff.
- Senior Ally Disterhoft was named Preseason All-Big Ten by the coaches and media, the Big Ten Conference announced Oct. 24. She led the Hawkeyes in scoring last season, averaging 17.1 points per game. The guard/forward netted double figures in every game last season and became the highest scoring junior in program history with 565 points.
- Disterhoft ranks third on Iowa's all-time career scoring list with 1,843 career points. Former Hawkeye Cindy Haugejorde holds the scoring record with 2,059 points.
- Disterhoft earned Academic All-America of the Year and first team Academic All-America accolades last season. She owned the highest GPA (4.03) of any Academic All-American last season and was the only junior to be named to the first team.
- Bluder owns a 335-195 (.632) overall record and a 163-109 conference mark at Iowa. In her 32 seasons as a head coach, Bluder is 691-337 (.672).

### SCOUTING MINNESOTA

- Minnesota enters Saturday's contest with an 11-8 record and a 2-4 mark in Big Ten play.
- The Golden Gophers' two wins in conference action came in home bouts against Wisconsin (88-60) and Illinois (78-50).
- Junior guard Carlie Wagner leads the team, averaging 19.6 points per game. Redshirt sophomore guard Kenisha Bell (16.8) and freshman guard Gadiva Hubbard (13.4) are also averaging double figures in points.
- Junior center Bryanna Fernstrom (8.0) and senior forward Whitney Tinjum (7.3) lead the team in rebounds.
- As a team, Minnesota ranks fourth nationally in rebounds (876) and sixth in rebounds per game (46.11).
- Wagner ranks fifth nationally in field goal attempts (352), ninth in three point field goal attempts (1163), 12th in final points (372) and 13th in field goals made (135).
- Head coach Marlene Stollings is in her third year with the Golden Gophers.

### THE SERIES

- Iowa leads the all-time series, 48-25.
- Minnesota edged out the Hawkeyes, 78-76, in Minneapolis last season. Chase Coley (21), Ally Disterhoft (20), and Megan Gustafson (14) each scored in double figures for the Hawkeyes.
- The Hawkeyes have topped the Gophers in seven of the last 10 matchups in the series.
- In the Lisa Bluder era, Iowa owns a 15-12 edge of Minnesota.

### HOT HAWKEYES ROLL TO 1ST BIG ROAD WIN

- The Hawkeyes notched their first Big Ten road win of the season with a, 71-59, victory over Rutgers on Jan. 17.
- Iowa shot a season-high .625 (25-of-40) from the field in the contest.
- The Hawkeyes did not miss a field goal in the third quarter (7-for-7).
- Junior Megan Gustafson (7-for-7) and freshman Makenzie Meyer (4-for-4) were perfect from the field in the contest, while junior Chase Coley went 4-for-5 on the evening.
- Gustafson (19 points), sophomore Tania Davis (15 points), and Meyer (10 points) each scored in double figures for the Hawkeyes, while Coley and sophomore Hannah Stewart scored eight points apiece.

### **BENCH PRODUCTION**

- Junior Chase Coley and sophomore Hannah Stewart notched quality minutes off the bench in Iowa's win over Rutgers on Jan. 17.
- The duo combined to score 16 points on 8-of-12 shooting from the field in Iowa's first Big Ten road win of the season.
- Coley and Stewart combined for 16 of Iowa's 18 total bench points.

### **HAVE A DAY, TANIA**

- Tania Davis netted a career-high 25 points against No. 3 Maryland on Jan. 14.
- It marked the second time this season the sophomore has registered 20 or more points.
- Davis also matched her career high with seven field goals made.

### **MARGIN OF VICTORY**

- Iowa has won by 20 or more points seven times this season, including wins against Oral Roberts (96-76), Hampton (84-51), Massachusetts (71-30), Northern Iowa (88-39), Robert Morris (81-60), Kent State (83-48) and Illinois (78-58).
- The Hawkeyes are averaging 76.2 points per game and holding their opponents to 65.3 (+10.9).

### **UNSELFISH BASKETBALL**

- The Hawkeyes rank second in the Big Ten and 13th nationally in assists per game (18.1).
- Iowa also ranks second in the conference and 12th in the NCAA in total assists (343).
- Seven Hawkeyes have dished out 20 or more assists on the season. Sophomore Tania Davis leads the team with 76. She is joined by freshman Kathleen Doyle (74), senior Ally Disterhoft (50), freshmen Makenzie Meyer (30) and Bre Cera (25), junior Chase Coley (21) and senior Alexa Kastanek (21).
- Doyle registered a career-high seven assists against No. 3 Maryland on Jan. 14. She also led the team with five against Rutgers on Jan. 17.

### **I'LL TAKE THAT, PLEASE**

- Freshman Kathleen Doyle leads the team with 36 steals on the season.
- The LaGrange Park, Illinois, native ranks seventh in the Big Ten Conference, averaging 2.0 steals per game.
- In six conference games this season, Doyle is averaging 2.2 steals -- the ninth-highest total in the Big Ten.
- Doyle's 2.1 steals per game average is the highest among all Big Ten freshmen.

### **DYNAMIC DUO**

- Sophomore Megan Gustafson has scored in double figures in every game this season, while senior Ally Disterhoft has netted double digits in 17-of-19 games.
- Gustafson has netted 20 or more points nine times this year, while Disterhoft has accomplished the feat four times. Both Hawkeyes have scored 20 or more points in games against Oral Roberts, James Madison, and Drake.
- Together, the pair averages 33.4 points per game.

### **DOUBLE-DOUBLE MACHINE**

- Sophomore Megan Gustafson registered the 18th double-double of her career against Illinois on Jan. 12. It was her ninth double-double of the season.
- Gustafson is one of 27 NCAA student-athletes to record nine or more double-doubles this season.
- Gustafson has led Iowa in boards in 17-of-19 games this season.
- Gustafson has netted 20 or more points in six of the last seven games.
- The Port Wing, Wisconsin, native ranks sixth nationally in field goal percentage (.675), 11th in field goals made (139), 21st in double-doubles (9) and rebounds (184), 33rd in final points (333), and 41st in rebounds per game (9.7).

### **MOVIN' ON UP**

- Senior Ally Disterhoft now ranks third on Iowa's all-time career scoring list.
- Disterhoft has 1,843 career points and is 216 points from tying Iowa's all-time scoring record of 2,059 set by Cindy Haugejorde (1976-80).
- Disterhoft also ranks ninth all-time in 3-point field goals (141), 13th in career blocks (63), and 13th in rebounds (706).

### **FAST FACTS**

- The Hawkeyes are 12-1 when leading at the half.
- Iowa is 12-1 when scoring 70 points or more.
- Iowa is ranked ninth nationally in field goal percentage, shooting .477 on the season.

- The Hawkeyes rank 12th nationally in total attendance (52,659). Iowa's largest crowd of the season (7,043) came against No. 3 Maryland on Jan. 14.

## **Head Coach Lisa Bluder**

Lisa Bluder (pronounced BLUE-dir), the all-time winningest coach in program history, completed her 16th season as head coach at the University of Iowa and her 32nd season as a college head coach in 2015-16.

Under her direction, the Hawkeyes have advanced to 15 postseason appearances (12 NCAA and three WNIT) in 16 seasons, including NCAA Tournament berths in eight of the last nine seasons.

Bluder, the 2015 Carol Eckman Award winner, has posted a 335-195 (.632) record at Iowa and her career record stands at 691-337 (.672). Bluder surpassed Hall of Famer C. Vivian Stringer (269 wins) as the all-time winningest coach in program history on Feb. 10, 2014, as the Hawkeyes defeated Northwestern, 90-84.

Bluder, 1-of-14 active Division I coaches with 675 or more wins, is a three-time Big Ten Coach of the Year (2001, 2008 and 2010) and two-time WBCA Regional Coach of the Year (2001 and 2008). She has guided Iowa to a winning record in 15 of her 16 years at Iowa, including 11 upper-division finishes in the challenging Big Ten Conference. Bluder, who ranks third among Big Ten coaches all-time in league victories (162), has led Iowa to nine 20-win seasons in her 16 years, including seven of the last nine years.

Bluder has coached numerous players to different awards in her 16 years in Iowa City. She has mentored 19 players to 47 All-Big Ten honors, including 12 first team picks, 16 second, 11 third and eight honorable mention selections. She has also had two Big Ten Freshman of the Year award winners, two Big Ten Sixth Player of the Year recipients, eight members of the Big Ten All-Freshman team and three players named to the Big Ten All-Defensive team, with Kachine Alexander earning the honor twice.

Five players during Bluder's tenure have earned a total of seven Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) all-region team accolades and six players have earned a total of 11 honorable mention All-America honors. Bluder coached her first consensus All-American in Samantha Logic, who earned the honor after being named a WBCA Division I Coaches All-American, USBWA All-American, ESPN Second Team All-American, and Third Team Associated Press All-American.

With Bluder on the Iowa sidelines, student-athletes have been named Academic All-Big Ten 75 times, including a program-best eight honorees in 2011 and 2012. The 75 honorees is the highest total mentored by any of the Big Ten coaches. Bluder has also mentored three Academic All-Americans in Ally Disterhoft (2015, 2016), Logic (2015), and Lindsey Meder (2001, 2002). Disterhoft was also named Academic All-America of the Year in 2015.

In her 10 years at Drake, Bluder brought great success and tradition to the Bulldog program and established herself as one of the top coaches in the country. She led Drake to five 20-plus win seasons in her last six years, including five postseason appearances. She guided the Bulldogs to eight Missouri Valley Conference Tournament appearances, reaching the semifinals six times and winning the tournament four times. Bluder was also named the Conference Coach of the Year three times at Drake.

Bluder began her coaching career at St. Ambrose, where she coached six successful seasons, building the Bees into a NAIA powerhouse. During her tenure at St. Ambrose, Bluder guided the Bees to four straight national tournaments, including two consecutive Final Four appearances. The 1990 St. Ambrose team was ranked No. 1 and Bluder was named the NAIA Converse Coach of the Year.

A graduate of Linn-Mar High School in Marion, Iowa, Bluder was a three-year starter at Northern Iowa. She graduated from UNI in 1983 with a bachelor's degree in marketing.

## CALL ON ME

- Senior Ally Disterhoft has netted double figures in 95 of her 103 career starts, including 50 of her last 52 games.
- The Iowa City, Iowa, native has started 103 consecutive games and appeared in every game of her Hawkeye career (121).
- Disterhoft has 1,843 career points and is 216 points from tying Iowa's all-time scoring record of 2,059 set by Cindy Haugejorde (1976-80).
- Disterhoft has registered 20 or more points in four games this season.
- Last season, Disterhoft became the program's highest scoring junior, netting 565 points to break Michelle Edwards' record of 564 points in 1986-87.

## AROUND THE NATION

- Iowa is ranked ninth nationally in field goal percentage, shooting .477 on the season.
- The Hawkeyes rank 10th nationally with 343 assists on the year.
- Iowa's 18.1 assists per game rank 13th nationally.
- The Hawkeyes also rank 22nd in defensive rebounds per game (29), 28th in rebounds (774), and 29th in scoring offense (76.2).
- Sophomore Megan Gustafson ranks sixth nationally in field goal percentage (.675), 11th in field goals made (139), 21st in double-doubles (9) and rebounds (184), 31st in free throw percentage (.866), 33rd in final points (333), and 41st in rebounds per game (9.7).
- Sophomore Tania Davis is 31st nationally in free throw percentage (.866).

## AROUND THE LEAGUE

- Iowa leads the Big Ten Conference in 3-point field goal percentage defense (.282) and ranks third in field goal percentage defense (.370).
- The Hawkeyes also rank second in assists (18.1) and third in field goal percentage (.477).
- Two Hawkeyes rank within the top-10 in field goal percentage. They include: Megan Gustafson (.675; 2nd) and Ally Disterhoft (.522; 10th).
- Gustafson ranks second in the league in field goal percentage (.675), third in double-doubles (9), fourth in defensive rebounds (6.4), fifth in rebounding (9.7) and offensive rebounds (3.3), eighth in blocked shots (1.4), and 10th in scoring (17.5).
- Sophomore Tania Davis is shooting .866 from the free throw line -- the fourth-highest total in the conference. She also ranks 13th in assists, averaging 4.0 per game.
- Freshman Kathleen Doyle is seventh in the conference in steals (2.0) and ranks 15th in assists (3.9).
- Disterhoft ranks 10th in field goal percentage (.522) and 13th in scoring (15.8).

## RUNNIN' RUNNIN'

- After trailing by 14 in the first quarter, the Hawkeyes went on a 25-9 run over a span of 8:09 in the second quarter to head into halftime with a 47-43 advantage over No. 3 Maryland.
- The Hawkeyes scored a season-high 31 points in the second quarter against the nationally-ranked Terrapins.
- Down 11-2 in the first quarter to Kent State, the Hawkeyes used a 40-5 run over a 12-minute span to ultimately defeat Kent State, 83-48, on Dec. 20.
- Iowa made 12-of-18 field goals in the second quarter and held Kent State to 3-of-16 shooting. Iowa also dominated the boards in the second frame, 18-3.
- Megan Gustafson (20 points), Ally Disterhoft (18 points), and Makenzie Meyer (12 points) all scored in double figures for the Hawkeyes.
- Junior Christina Buttenham registered her first career start in the contest. She netted five points and pulled-down a career-high six boards in 18 minutes of action.

## GUSTAFSON EARNS 2ND STRAIGHT BIG TEN HONOR ROLL PLAUDIT

- For the second straight week, sophomore Megan Gustafson was named to the Big Ten Women's Basketball Player of the Week Honor Roll, the conference office announced Jan. 2. It marked the fourth weekly honor of Gustafson's career and her third of the season.
- Gustafson averaged 21.5 points and 11.0 rebounds in a pair of Big Ten Conference games against Illinois and Nebraska last week.
- She led all scorers with 21 points, shooting 7-of-12 (.583) from the field at Illinois. Gustafson pulled down 13 boards (6 offensive) to register her eighth double-double of the season. She also dished out three assists and went 7-for-8 from the free throw line against the Illini.
- The Port Wing, Wisconsin, native recorded a team-high 22 points and a team-leading nine rebounds to lead Iowa to its first Big Ten victory of the season. She shot an impressive .750 from the field (9-for-12) and added two blocks and a pair of steals.
- Gustafson was also named Big Ten Player of the Week on Nov. 14. The Port Wing, Wisconsin, native posted back-to-back double-doubles to lead Iowa to wins overall Oral Roberts and Hampton on Nov. 11 and 13. The sophomore tied a career high in points (25) and recorded 12 rebounds, an assist and a block in 26 minutes of action against Oral Roberts on Nov. 11. Two days later, Gustafson netted 14 points and pulled down 11 boards to lead the Hawkeyes past Hampton. She also went a combined 7-for-8 from the free throw line.



### **HISTORICALLY GOOD DEFENSE**

- The Hawkeyes held Massachusetts to just 30 points in the first game of the Hawkeye Challenge on Nov. 19, tying a Carver-Hawkeye Arena record for fewest points allowed. It also marked the second-fewest points allowed in the Big Ten this season (27, Purdue vs. North Carolina Central).
- Iowa held the Minutewomen to just 10 first half points, breaking a program record for fewest points allowed in a first half.
- The Hawkeyes allowed just 39 points against UNI on Dec. 4. It marked the second time this season Iowa has held an opponent to under 40 points.

### **DAVIS NAMED MADNESS B1G PLAYER OF THE WEEK**

- Sophomore Tania Davis was named the Madness Big Ten Women's Basketball Player of the Week, College Sports Madness announced Dec. 12.
- Davis averaged a team-high 18.5 points, shot .526 from the field (10-of-19), .600 from 3-point range (6-for-10) and a perfect 1.000 (11-for-11) from the free throw line to lead Iowa to a pair of wins over Iowa State and Robert Morris.
- The Flint, Michigan, native registered career highs in points (23), 3-pointers made (5) and field goals made (7) to guide the Hawkeyes past in-state rival Iowa State (88-76) on Wednesday.
- Two days later, Davis netted 14 points and was a perfect 7-for-7 from the charity stripe to help the Hawkeyes to an 81-60 win over Robert Morris.

### **HAWKEYES CONTINUE POSTSEASON STREAK**

- Iowa made its ninth straight postseason appearance (8 NCAA, 1 WNIT) with an at-large bid to the WNIT in 2016.
- Iowa was one of six Big Ten Conference teams (Minnesota, Michigan, Nebraska, Northwestern, Rutgers) and one of three teams from Iowa (Drake, UNI) to be included in the WNIT field of 64.

### **RETURNING EXPERIENCE**

- Iowa returns four of its five starters from last season in senior Ally Disterhoft, junior Chase Coley, and sophomores Tania Davis, and Megan Gustafson.
- Senior Ally Disterhoft garnered second team All-Big Ten accolades by coaches and media for the second consecutive season and received Iowa's Sportsmanship Award. The preseason All-Big Ten pick by coaches and media scored in double figures in every game last season and in 78 of her 84 consecutive starts.
- Tania Davis and Megan Gustafson were named to the 2016 Big Ten All-Freshman Team.
- Davis was one of two Big Ten freshmen to lead her team in assists per game (3.4) and average at least one steal per game (1.2) last season. She has dished out 111 assists in 33 games played, the second-highest total recorded by a freshman at Iowa (Samantha Logic; 136).
- Gustafson was the only freshman and one of three players in the conference overall to lead her team in field goal percentage (.554), rebounds (225), and blocks (58) last season.
- Chase Coley averaged 11.1 points per game last season -- the second highest mark on the team. The junior compiled 365 points, 194 rebounds, 53 assists, 37 blocks, and 24 steals in her sophomore campaign to receive Iowa's Most Improved Award.

### **QUALITY YOUTH**

- Iowa's freshman class was ranked No. 7 nationally by Blue Star -- the highest ranked recruiting class for head coach Lisa Bluder and her staff.
- Iowa's freshmen class consists of Bre Cera (2016 Journal Sentinel Player of the Year), Kathleen Doyle (Illinois Miss Basketball), Makenzie Meyer (Iowa Miss Basketball), Amanda Ollinger (2016 Gazette Female Athlete of the Year), and Alexis Sevellian (finalist for Michigan Miss Basketball).

### **THE BLUDER FILE**

- Head coach Lisa Bluder begins her 17th season at the helm of the Iowa women's basketball program this season. She owns a 335-195 (.632) overall record and a 163-109 Big Ten record at Iowa. In her 32 seasons as a head coach, Bluder is 691-337 (.673).
- Bluder is one of 14 active Division I coaches to collect 675 or more career wins.
- The head Hawkeye is second in career Big Ten wins (163) and in total wins among Big Ten coaches. She trails only C. Vivian Stringer who has compiled 189 Big Ten wins and 971 career wins.
- Bluder ranks third all-time among all Big Ten coaches with 163 conference victories.
