The fourth-ranked University of Iowa wrestling team hosts No. 7 Michigan on Saturday at 5 p.m. (CT) at Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

TICKETS

Tickets to Saturday's dual are \$15 for adults and \$10 for youth 18-years-old and younger. UI students and children five and under are free, but everyone must have a ticket. Tickets are available at hawkeyesports.com/tickets, over the phone at 1-800-IA-HAWKS, or at the UI Athletics Ticket Office inside Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

ABOUT MICHIGAN

Iowa has won nine straight against the Wolverines and owns a 32-25-1 lead in the all-time series. Iowa won the last meeting, 31-6, in Ann Arbor on Jan. 6, 2017.

Michigan's last win in the series was 19-15 in 2006. The Hawkeyes are 14-9-1 at home in the series, having won the last four meetings in Iowa City. The Wolverines last win in Iowa City was Feb. 13, 2005 (21-11).

Iowa head coach Tom Brands is 9-0 all-time against the Wolverines.

NATIONALLY RANKED MATCHUPS

Saturday's dual features 16 wrestlers ranked in the top 20, and eight wrestlers ranked in the top five.

The Hawkeyes are ranked at seven weights and have five wrestlers ranked in the top five -- Spencer Lee (125), Brandon Sorensen (149), Michael Kemerer (157), Cash Wilcke (197), and Sam Stoll (285).

Michigan is ranked at every weight but 141. The Wolverines are ranked in the top five at 133, 184, and 285 pounds.

Saturday's 285-pound match features No. 3 Sam Stoll and Michigan's No. 2 Adam Coon. It is the first career meeting between the two wrestlers.

There are also top 10 matchups at 125 pounds and 157 pounds. True freshman Spencer Lee, ranked No. 3, and true freshman Drew Mattin, ranked No. 9, meet at 125. Sophomore Michael Kemerer, ranked No. 2 at 157, meets No. 7 Alec Pantaleo for the first time in their careers.

UNDEFEATED WRESTLERS

Iowa has four wrestlers entering Saturday's dual with undefeated records. They Brandon Sorensen (15-0), Kemerer (16-0), Alex Marinelli (9-0), and Stoll (12-0).

In the history of Iowa wrestling, 15 wrestlers have finished the season with a perfect record (minimum 20 matches). Four of those wrestlers were able to perform the feat twice. They

include Mark Ironside, Lincoln McIlravy, T.J. Williams and Jim Zalesky. Iowa coaches Tom Brands and Terry Brands are among the 15 wrestlers. Tom went 45-0 in 1990-91 and Terry went 35-0 in 1991-92.

SOERSEN'S HOT START

Senior Brandon Sorensen, ranked No. 2 at 149 pounds, has opened the season with 15 straight wins, including three technical falls, three major decisions, and four falls.

This is the third straight year Sorensen opened the season with at least 15 consecutive wins. He started the 2015-16 season with 25 straight wins, a career-best winning streak, and opened last year with 17 straight wins.

Sorensen is 30-1 all-time in Big Ten duals. He has 56 career dual starts. Sam Stoll ranks second on the team with 28 career dual starts.

LEE AND MARINELLI IMPRESS IN DEBUTS

True freshman Spencer Lee and redshirt freshman Alex Marinelli have steadily climbed the national rankings since entering the Iowa lineup.

Lee made his Hawkeye debut Jan. 5 against Michigan State and opened the dual with a fall in 46 seconds against Kayvon Foley at 125 pounds. He is 9-1 with four falls, three technical falls, and four wins over ranked opponents. He debuted in the rankings Jan. 9 at No. 9. He has since moved up to No. 3 (Intermat).

Marinelli made his collegiate debut Dec. 8 at Rutgers. He has since gone 9-0 with two pins, four wins over ranked opponents, and winning the Midlands championship at 165 pounds. He entered the Intermat rankings Dec. 12 at No. 13. He has since climbed to No. 9. He is ranked No. 5 by WIN Magazine.

UNDEFEATED FRESHMAN

Redshirt freshman Alex Marinelli and North Carolina State's Hayden Hidlay (redshirt freshman) are the only two freshman (redshirt and true) still undefeated in all weight classes.

Marinelli is 9-0 and ranked No. 9 at 165 by Intermat. Hidlay is 15-0 and ranked No. 3 at 157.

THEY ALL FALL DOWN

Sophomore Michael Kemerer is 16-0 this season with seven pins. Kemerer had four pins all of last season in 36 matches. He has twice this season been named Big Ten Wrestler of the Week.

Five of his seven falls have come in the first period. Kemerer earned the Most Pins/Fastest Time award at the 2017 Midlands Championships. He pinned four opponents in a total of 9:54.

Kemerer is 16-0 for the second straight season. He opened his redshirt freshman year with 19 consecutive wins.

BOWMAN CRACKS NATIONAL RANKINGS

Junior Mitch Bowman made his national rankings debut on Jan. 16, coming in at No. 20 at 184 pounds in the InterMat rankings. Bowman is 10-4 overall and has scored bonus points in five wins. He has three wins over ranked opponents.

Bowman is 7-3 in duals, including 2-3 in Big Ten action. He entered the season with a 1-2 career dual record, 0-2 in the Big Ten.

FINISH STRONG

The Hawkeye 197 and 285-pounders have a combined record of 25-2 with 14 wins by bonus points.

Cash Wilcke, the sophomore 197-pounder, is ranked No. 5 and has two major decisions, one technical fall, and two falls. Wilcke won 197-pound title at the Midlands Championships.

Stoll, a junior ranked No. 3 at 285, has won a career-best 12 straight matches to open the season. Stoll won the 285-pound title at the Midlands Championships, and has six falls among his 12 wins.

Both wrestlers are 2-0 in overtime

NEW YEAR'S RESOLUTION... WELCOME ALL CHALLENGERS

The Hawkeyes ring in the New Year with a January schedule that includes top-ranked Penn State, No. 2 Ohio State, No. 5 Oklahoma State, No. 8 Michigan, No. 13 Minnesota, and No. 20 Northwestern.

The Hawkeyes defeated then No. 3 Oklahoma State on Jan. 14, and fell at No. 2 Ohio State, 22-12, on Jan. 21. They host Michigan, Minnesota, and Northwestern at home over the next eight days, in that particular order. All three home duals, and Iowa's dual at Penn State, are televised by BTN. Iowa's dual at Penn State will start at 8 p.m. (ET).

Carver-Hawkeye Arena single dual tickets are \$15/\$10 (adult/youth) for duals against Michigan, (Jan. 27), and Minnesota (Feb. 4). Northwestern tickets are \$12/\$8.

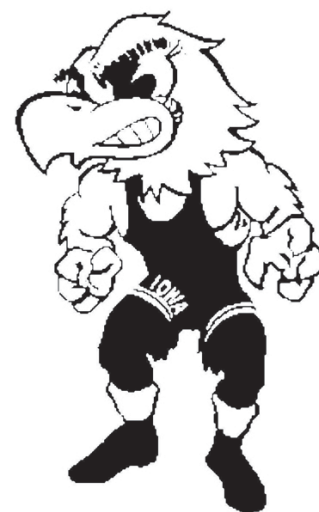

Tom Brands

Head Coach

University of Iowa, 1992

Three-time Big Ten Coach of the Year Tom Brands enters his 12th season as head wrestling coach at the University of Iowa. A 1996 Olympic gold medalist and member of wrestling's Hall of Fame, Brands is only the eighth wrestling coach at the University of Iowa. The former Hawkeye wrestler was a four-time All-American and three-time national champion (1989-92) at Iowa. He has a 201-20-1 (.908) overall and 88-8 (.917) Big Ten coaching record at Iowa, and a 218-40-1 (.847) career mark.

In 11 full seasons as Iowa's head coach, Brands has led the Hawkeyes to three NCAA and four Big Ten team titles, crowning 10 NCAA champions, 15 Big Ten champions and 61 All-Americans. Iowa has had 89 Academic All-Big Ten recipients, including a school-record 12 in 2011-12. The Hawkeyes have qualified 100 wrestlers for the NCAA Championships in the last 11 years, sending the entire 10-man lineup in 2009, 2010, 2014, and 2015. Iowa has also won or shared eight of the last 10 Big Ten regular season titles.

Iowa also made another entry in the record books, setting the national collegiate dual meet attendance record of 42,287 when Iowa defeated top-ranked Oklahoma State, 18-16, on Nov. 14, 2015 at the Grapple on the Gridiron at Kinnick Stadium. Iowa has led the nation in attendance in each of Brands' 11 seasons, setting an NCAA all-time attendance average of 12,166 in 2015-16.

Iowa also made another entry in the record books, setting the national collegiate dual meet attendance record of 42,287 when Iowa defeated top-ranked Oklahoma State, 18-16, on Nov. 14, 2015 at the Grapple on the Gridiron at Kinnick Stadium. Iowa has led the nation in attendance in each of Brands' 11 seasons, setting an NCAA all-time attendance average of 12,166 in 2015-16.

Brands was named 2008 NWCA Coach of the Year after leading the Hawkeyes to their first NCAA team title since 2000 and their first Big Ten team title since 2004. He was named Big Ten Coach of the Year in 2008, 2009 and 2010, becoming the first coach in conference history to earn the honor in three consecutive seasons.

Brands served as head coach at Virginia Tech University for two seasons (2005-06), recording a 17-20 dual mark. In his first season with the Hokies, Brands led the team to the 2005 regular season Atlantic Coast Conference title, set a school record for dual meet wins (16) and had a school-record five wrestlers qualify for the NCAA Championships. During his tenure, Virginia Tech crowned five ACC champions and had two All-Americans. Senior heavy-weight Mike Faust was named 2006 ACC Wrestler of the Year.

Prior to taking the helm at Virginia Tech, Brands was an assistant coach at Iowa for 12 seasons (1993-2004). He helped the Hawkeyes to a 177-27 dual record, seven NCAA and eight Big Ten team titles, while crowning 23 NCAA champions, 73 All-Americans and 36 Big Ten champions. He was named the National Wrestling Coaches Association Assistant Coach of the Year in 2000.

In 2004, he was one of three coaches for the U.S. Olympic freestyle wrestling team, participating in Athens, and in 2016 he was named a volunteer coach of the United States Olympic team in Rio. Brands also served as assistant coach for the U.S. Freestyle World Teams in 2001, 2002, 2003, 2013, 2014, and 2015. He was named Freestyle Coach of the Year by USA Wrestling in 2002 and 2003. He has coached a number of other U.S. teams in international competition.

As a competitor, Brands won the 1996 Olympic freestyle gold medal at 136.5 pounds in Atlanta, Georgia. He also won a gold medal at the 1993 World Freestyle Championships in Toronto, two World Cup gold medals (1994, 1995) and was the 1995 Pan American Games champion. He won four U.S. National titles (1993-96) and made four straight U.S. World or Olympic teams (1993-96). Along with his twin brother, Terry, Tom was named 1993 USA Wrestling Athlete of the Year, the 1993 John Smith Outstanding Freestyle Wrestler, and 1993 Amateur Wrestling News Man of the Year. He was inducted into wrestling's Hall of Fame in 2001.

Brands was a four-time All-American at Iowa (1989-92). During his Hawkeye career, he won three NCAA titles and was named Outstanding Wrestler of the 1992 NCAA Championships. Also a three-time Big Ten champion, Brands won 95 percent of his matches at Iowa. His career mark of 158-7-2 includes an undefeated season in 1991 (45-0).

The Sheldon, Iowa, native was born April 9, 1968. He earned his B.S. degree in physical education from Iowa in 1992. He and his wife, Jeni, have three children, Madigan, Kinsee and Tommy.
