This weekend's home series marks the beginning of a season-long nine-game home stand.
lowa is 1-0 at Banks Field this season and 53-14 dating back to the start of the 2015 season.
Senior Tyler Cropley has been named to the Johnny Bench Award Watch List. The honor is presented to the top catcher in Division I baseball.

• The Hawkeyes have used the same starting weekend rotation in each of the first four weeks of the season.

• Redshirt junior Chris Whelan has been medically cleared to return to the active roster. Whelan has missed the first month of the season recovering from Tommy John surgery.

• lowa is fifth in the Big Ten with a 4.20 team ERA and seventh with a .968 team fielding percentage.

• Junior left-hander Nick Allgeyer ranks in the top 10 in the Big Ten in five different pitching categories. He is fourth in ERA (1.82) and innings (24.2), eighth in strikeouts looking (6), and ninth in strikeouts (24) and opposing batting average (.214).

• During its five-game losing streak, lowa is averaging 1.6 runs per game and has a .196 team batting average. Tyler Cropley has a team-best .313 batting average during the stretch.


• Junior outfielder Robert Neustrom was named the preseason Big Ten Player of the Year by both Perfect Game and Baseball America. Neustrom and junior Brady Schanuel were named to PG's preseason all-conference team.

• The Hawkeyes were picked to finish fourth in the Big Ten by Perfect Game, fifth by D1Baseball. com, and sixth in the Big Ten Preseason Coaches poll.

• lowa has won 140 games over the past four seasons under head coach Rick Heller -- the best four-year stretch in school history. The Hawkeyes have advanced to NCAA Regional play in two of the last three seasons.

ABOUT HEAD COACH RICK HELLER

Rick Heller has turned the University of Iowa baseball program into a perennial Big Ten Conference and NCAA contender in his first four seasons as the Hawkeyes' head coach.

Heller has injected new life into the lowa program, leading the Hawkeyes to the best four-year stretch in program history, winning 140 games, advancing to two NCAA Regionals, and claiming the first Big Ten Tournament title in program history. It was lowa's first conference title since winning the regular season crown in 1990.

Under Heller's watch, Iowa has advanced to the postseason in four consecutive years for the first time in program history, he has coached five All-Americans and at least one first-team All-Big Ten selection each season, and Iowa has had 15 Major League Baseball Draft picks in four seasons -- the most in a four-year stretch all-time.

Heller has also given the Hawkeyes an international flavor, taking the team to the Dominican Republic in 2016 and Taipei, Taiwan, as the United States representative at the 2017 World University Games. Heller led USA to a silver medal, as the team became the first American squad to medal in Universiade history.

The Eldon, Iowa, native became the 20th head coach in program history in 2013 -- his fourth stop as a collegiate head coach. He has enjoyed stints at Iowa (2014-present), Indiana State (2009-13), Northern Iowa (1999-2009), and Upper Iowa (1987-99), leading all four schools to NCAA postseason play. He is one of nine coaches all-time and one of five active coaches to lead three different Division I programs to NCAA Regional play.

Heller guided lowa to an at-large berth into NCAA Regional play in 2015 -- a first for the program since 1990 -- and the team posted the school's first NCAA Tournament win since 1972. It wasn't a fluke; in the two seasons since, lowa was runner-up at the 2016

Big Ten Tournament before claiming the program's first tournament title in 2017 to lock up the school's second NCAA Regional appearance in three seasons.

lowa made just three NCAA Tournament appearances in its history prior to Heller's arrival.

Heller led Indiana State to its first outright Missouri Valley Conference title in 2012, and Northern Iowa to the MVC title and into the NCAA Tournament in 2001, the first and only regional appearance for the Panthers as a Division I program.

On the recruiting trail, Heller has turned the Hawkeyes into a major player on the national recruiting scene by keeping the best in-state players at home. Iowa had the top-rated class in the Big Ten -- and 18th-best nationally -- in 2015, and the 2016 class was ranked third in the league.

In 30 seasons as a head coach, Heller owns a career record of 830-654-4. He is one of two lowa head coaches to lead the program to the NCAA Tournament.

The University of Iowa baseball team hosts its first three-game home series of the season, welcoming Evansville to Duane Banks Field from March 16-18. Friday's opener is set for a 4:05 p.m. (CT) start, Saturday will begin at 2:05 p.m., and Sunday's finale is set for 1:05 p.m.

With parking around Banks Field being monitored until 4:30 p.m. on Friday, fans can park in Ramp 3, the Newton Road ramp, or feed meters until 4:30 p.m. to avoid being ticketed.

SERIES PROMOTIONS

 Friday is "Baseball Bingo" at Duane Banks Field. Saturday is "Have a Catch" Day -- parents and children can play catch on the field following the game. Sunday is "Sunday Runday" -- kids can run the bases after the game.

OUICK HITTERS

 lowa's current five-game losing streak is the first for the program since the 2012 season. • Senior Matt Hoeg hit his first home run of the season -- sixth of his career -- to leadoff the midweek game against Missouri State (3/14). Four Hawkeyes have homered in 2018. Redshirt freshman Kace Massner became the sixth different Hawkeye to start in left field. He has started the last two games at the position. • The Hawkeyes were crowned the team champions at the All-State Sugar Bowl Baseball Classic on Feb. 25 in New Orleans. Iowa and New Orleans both posted 2-1 records, but the Hawkeyes won the head-to-head meeting. lowa is 13-of-16 in stolen base attempts in 2018. Sophomore Lorenzo Elion has a team-best three steals in four chances.

 Senior Tyler Cropley and juniors Robert Neustrom and Zach Daniels were named to the Big Ten Preseason Honors List.

 The Hawkeyes return two All-Big Ten selections -- Neustrom and Tyler Cropley -- and Collegiate Baseball Freshman All-Americans Kyle Shimp

and Ben Norman.

 Iowa was ranked 44th in the College Sports Madness preseason rankings. The Hawkeyes were also receiving votes in the USBWA preseason rankings.

ABOUT EVANSVILE

• The Purple Aces bring a 5-8 record into the weekend after being swept in their three-game series last weekend at Florida Gulf Coast.

• Evansville was picked to finish seventh out of eight teams in the Missouri Valley Conference preseason poll.

• Evansville is hitting .247 as a team and is averaging 4.7 runs per game. The Purple Aces have two players hitting over .300 in Troy Beilsmith (.348) and Kenton Crews (.300). Beilsmith has a team-high 12 runs and seven doubles and has a team-best .630 slugging percentage. Crews and Andrew Tanous are tied for the team lead with 10 RBIs.

• The Aces' pitching staff has a 4.71 team ERA, allowing 114 hits and 73 runs (61 earned) in 116 2/3 innings. Evansville has 108 strikeouts in 13 games.

• Evansville will start RHP Jace Burke (0-0, 2.57 ERA), RHP Adam Lukas (1-1, 1.64 ERA), and RHP Austin Allinger (1-1, 5.50 ERA).

SERIES RESULTS

• The Hawkeyes are 1-2 all-time against Evansville with the last meeting coming in 2006 -- a 6-4 lowa win in Lafayette, Louisiana.

 The Aces won the first-ever meeting in 2000 by the score of 5-4, and the 2001 match-up, 8-3, in Evansville.

CROPLEY NAMED TO JOHNNY BENCH AWARD WATCH LIST

Senior Tyler Cropley has been named to the Johnny Bench Award Watch List. The honor is given to the top catcher in Division I baseball. The South Dakota native is hitting .300 with a team-best 13 RBIs. He has four multi-hit games and four multi-RBI games.

 Cropley his hitting a team-best .625 (10-of-16) wtih runners in scoring position this season. • He is one of six catchers from the Big Ten Conference to be included on the watch list.

WHELAN CLEARED FOR HAWKEYES

Junior Chris Whelan, who is recovering from fall Tommy John surgery, has been medically cleared to return for the three-game series against Evansville. Whelan, who was lowa's leadoff hitter and the Big Ten Tournament Most Outstanding Player, hit .309 with 11 doubles and 25 RBIs last season.

lowa posted its fourth straight 30-win season in 2017. The program hasn't enjoyed a better stretch since posting seven consecutive 30 win campaigns from 1979-85. • lowa won 39 games last season -- the fifth-most in a single season in program history. The Hawkeyes won 41 games in 2015, the second-most wins in program history.

STATISTICAL BREAKDOWN

It's tough to envision the lowa lineup without All-America first baseman Jake Adams (.335, 29 HR, 55 R, 14 2B, 72 RBIs) and All-Big Ten shortstop Mason McCoy (.328, 83 H, 18 2B, 5 HR, 55 R, 34 RBIs), but offensively, the Hawkeyes have a lot returning in 2018.

• lowa has six starters, including its designated hitter, back from an offense that ranked in the top three in the Big Ten in nine categories.

• The Hawkeyes have 70.9 percent (421 of 594) of their hits, 69.9 percent (79 of 113) of their doubles, 67.6 (234 of 346) of their RBIs, 66.4 percent (250 of 376) of their runs, and 50.1 percent (36 of 71) of their home runs back in 2018. Iowa also has 80 percent of its stolen bases back (52 of 65).

• On the mound, Iowa has seven pitchers returning, but it will be a new-look staff under first-year pitching coach Desi Druschel. The Hawkeyes bring back 43.6 percent (17 of 39) of their wins, 40 percent (6 of 15) of their saves, 39.8 percent (187 of 470) of their strikeouts, and 36.8 percent (200 of 543 2/3) of their innings pitched.

ROSTER BREAKDOWN

• Of Iowa's 32-man roster, nine are freshman, eight are sophomores, 11 are juniors, and four are seniors.

• lowa has 19 lowa natives on the roster -- the most of any state. Eight Hawkeyes hail from Illinois, two from Missouri, and one from Indiana, South Dakota, and Canada.

• The Hawkeyes have two sets of junior college teammates on the 2018 roster. Tyler Cropley and Matt Hoeg were teammates for two seasons at Iowa Western Community College, while Chris Whelan and Brady Schanuel were teammates in 2016 at Parkland Community College.

 Iowa has one set of high school teammates; Zach Daniels and Matt Berst (Cedar Rapids Kennedy High School).

TEAM CAPTAINS

lowa's team captains for the 2018 season are senior Tyler Cropley, redshirt junior Nick Allgeyer, junior Robert Neustrom, and redshirt sophomore Kyle Shimp.

SILVER MEDALISTS IN TAIWAN

lowa made history when it represented the United States at the 2017 World University Games in Taiwan. Competing as the USA Team, lowa claimed the silver medal, becoming the first American team to medal in Universiade history. lowa went 5-2 during the two-week stretch before falling to Japan in the gold medal game.

DEFENDING B1G TOURNEY CHAMPS

• lowa went 4-1 during a four-day stretch to claim the program's first Big Ten Tournament title in school history in 2017. It was the second straight year the team advanced to the title game.

• The Hawkeyes won three games over higher seeded teams -- fourth-seeded Maryland, top-seeded Nebraska, and third-seeded Minnesota -- to reach the

BANKS MAGIC

• lowa finished 19-4 at home during the 2017 season, running its record to 53-14 at Banks Field since the start of the 2015 season. The 19 wins were the most by the team since winning 1989 (19-2).

• Iowa has 10 walk-off victories at Duane Banks Field since the start of 2015.

IOWA'S BACKBONE

The Hawkeyes have been built on pitching and defense under UI head coach Rick Heller.

 lowa has ranked in the top 24 nationally in the nation in team fielding percentage in each of the past three seasons. The Hawkeyes have been in the top four in the Big Ten throughout Heller's tenure.

• Iowa has posted team ERA records in 2015 and 2016 (2.95 in 2015, 3.56 in 2016), ranking in the top four in the conference in both seasons. The Hawkeyes set school strikeout records in 2016 and 2017.

COACHING STAFF CHANGES

• Marty Sutherland was promoted to associate head coach in the offseason. He also serves as recruiting coordinator.

• Desi Drushchel was promoted to an assistant coach after serving as the director of baseball operations for three seasons.

• Nic Ungs joins the coaching staff as the director of baseball operations. Ungs played for Rick Heller at Northern Iowa and played professional baseball for 11 seasons.

#HELLERBALL

• UI head coach Rick Heller is one of nine coaches all-time to lead three different NCAA Division I teams to regional play.

• Heller recorded his 800th career win against Lehigh on March 12 at the Snowbird Classic in Florida.

• The Hawkeyes have won 30 or more games in each of Heller's four seasons as the helm of the program. It's a first for the team since winning 30 or more in seven straight seasons from 1979-85.

Heller has led the Hawkeyes to two NCAA Regional appearances in three seasons; the program had three regional appearances in its history prior to his arrival.
Heller is fourth in school history in career wins with 140 in his four seasons at lowa, including the second (41) and fifth-most (39) in school history.

 Heller led lowa to its first Big Ten Tournament title in 2017 -- the first conference title since 1990 -- and he guided the Hawkeyes to the Big Ten Tournament title game in consecutive seasons. Iowa has advanced to the league tournament in four straight years for the first time in program history.

• Heller has coached at least one first-team All-Big Ten selection each season, and has 15 Major League



 Iowa had a school-record six All-Big Ten selections in 2015 and five in 2017. The Hawkeyes have had 18 All-

Baseball Draft picks in four seasons -- the most in a

four-year stretch in school history.

Big Ten honorees in four seasons under Heller. • lowa has posted winning streaks of nine games (in 2015) and eight games (in 2017) -- the longest streaks for the program since 2012.


SEASON TICKETS ON SALE
