The University of Iowa women's tennis team returns home this weekend hosting Purdue on Friday and Indiana on Sunday at the Hawkeye Tennis and Recreation Complex. The Hawkeyes host Purdue, Friday, at 5 p.m. (CT) and Indiana, Sunday, at 11 a.m. (CT). Admission is free.

TAKING ON THE BOILERMAKERS

Friday's match is the 51st meeting all-time between the Hawkeyes and the Boilermakers. The all-time series is tied, 25-25. The previous match between the two teams was last season, where the Hawkeyes were defeated (6-1).

TAKING ON THE HOOSIERS

Sunday's match is the 47th meeting all-time between Iowa and Indiana. Indiana leads the all-time series, 35-11. The last match between the two was last season, where they Hawkeyes fell (4-3). The Hawkeyes defeated the Hoosiers in 2017, Schmid's first season as head coach, 6-1.

HAWKEYE HOME STRETCH

Iowa finds themselves at home for their next five Big Ten matches. The Hawkeyes completed a seven-game road trip, going 1-6, and faced three nationally ranked opponents (Kansas State, Michigan, & Ohio State). Iowa, 12th in the Big Ten, is looking to bounce back and pick up a pair of key conference wins heading into the season's final stretch.
