DOOZY DOOCY

- Doocy strikeout tracker: 186 in 183.2 innings pitched.
- Doocy leads Iowa with a 1.83 ERA and 186 strikeouts in 183.2 innings of action.
- The Ankeny, Iowa, native is fourth in the Big Ten with a 1.83 ERA and 186 strikeouts.
- She went 2-0 in the circle with a 1.50 ERA and two complete games, helping the Hawkeyes sweep their weekend series against Wisconsin (April 7-8).
- After pitching a shutout game against Wisconsin, throwing 18 strikeouts in a combined 14 innings, and aiding the Hawkeyes in their sweep of the Badgers, Doocy was named Big Ten Pitcher of the Week (April 9). It was the second time she received the honor this season.
- Doocy was also selected as the College Sports Madness Big Ten Player of the Week on April 9.
- Doocy led Iowa to a 4-3 win over 17th-ranked Michigan on March 23, ending the Wolverines 18-game win streak.
- After a career-high 15 strikeouts and a 2-0 weekend, Doocy was named co-Big Ten Pitcher of the Week on March 12. This was the first Pitcher of the Week award for Doocy and the first time a Hawkeye has earned the honor since Kayla Massey on March 31, 2014.
- Doocy was also selected as the College Sports Madness Big Ten Player of the Week on March 12.

BOGIED

- Freshman Aralee Bogar has 44 hits, 26 runs, 23 stolen bases, and a .273 batting average during her first season in the Black and Gold.
- Bogar leads Iowa with 44 hits, 26 runs, four triples, and 23 stolen bases.
- She is fourth in the Big Ten with 23 stolen bases. Bogar is currently a perfect 23-for-23 in stolen base attempts. She is the only student-athlete in the top five with a perfect stolen base percentage.

2018 BIG TOURNEY

- Wisconsin hosts the 2018 Big Ten Softball tournament on May 10-13 at the Goodman Softball Complex in Madison, Wisconsin.
- The 2018 tournament will be single-elimination.
- During Iowa's last appearance in 2017, the Hawkeyes were defeated, 3-0, in the first round by the Badgers

BIG TOURNEY HISTORY

This is the 21st Big Ten Tournament appearance for the Hawkeyes, tying Michigan for the conference lead. The Hawkeyes have 23 Big Ten Tournament wins, which is the third most in the Big Ten Tournament history (Michigan has 39, Northwestern has 24).

Iowa has won two Big Ten Tournament championships in program history:

2001 – The Hawkeyes won their first Big Ten Tournament championship in 2001 in Ann Arbor, Michigan. Iowa opened the tournament with an 8-0, six-inning victory over Wisconsin. After dropping a 6-1 decision to Michigan, Iowa clinched the title with a 7-1 win over Illinois and a 2-1 win over Michigan.

2003 – Two years later Iowa hosted the tournament. The Hawkeyes defeated Illinois (3-2) and then topped Northwestern twice (2-1, 2-0) to earn their second conference title in three years.

WOOD AT THE DISH

- Senior Allie Wood leads the Hawkeyes with a .306 batting average, eight doubles, two triples, five home runs, and 21 RBIs.
- Wood hit her fifth home run of the season in Iowa's series finale against Northwestern on April 29.
- She led the Hawkeyes at the plate against the 13th-ranked Sun Devils on March 14. Wood had two hits with a double for a .400 batting average.

OHIO STATE

- The Buckeyes are 34-13 this season and 14-8 in conference action.
- Lilli Piper leads Ohio State with a .409 batting average, 48 runs on 61 hits, 14 doubles, one triple, 19 homers, and 56 RBI.
- In the circle, Morgan Ray owns a 2.30 ERA with 139 strikeouts in 149.1 innings pitched.

TOP 25 VICTORIES

- The Hawkeyes picked up their third win over a ranked opponent on March 23 when they defeated No. 17 Michigan, 4-3, ending the Wolverines 18-game win streak.
- After defeating No. 8 Baylor, 3-1, in their final game at the Judi Garman Classic on March 4, the Hawkeyes topped No. 13 Arizona State in Tempe, Arizona, on March 14.
- Sophomore pitcher Allison Doocy earned all three wins for the Hawkeyes.
- This is the first time Iowa has defeated three ranked opponents in a season since 2015 when Iowa topped No. 17 UCF (3-2), No. 4 Michigan (6-4) and No. 12 Minnesota (2-0) at the Big Ten Tournament.

COMPLETE GAMES

- Four Hawkeyes have thrown complete games this season: freshman Lauren Shaw, sophomore Allison Doocy, junior Erin Riding, and senior Kenzie Ihle.
- Doocy leads the team with 18 complete games, including five conference victories.
- Riding threw a five-inning run rule performance on Feb. 17 against Butler at the Texas A&M Invitational. She gave up two hits and no walks in the 8-0 win.
- Shaw pitched a 5-0 victory over Georgetown on March 10 at the Grand Canyon Invitational. She had a career-high six strikeouts and allowed just four hits in 7.0 innings pitched. It was Shaw's first career shutout.
- Senior pitcher Kenzie Ihle threw her first complete game in Iowa's run-rule win over UW Green Bay on March 27. Ihle threw a career-high eight strikeouts in the six inning, 9-1 victory.

HEAD COACH MARLA LOOPER

Marla Looper is in her eighth season at the helm of the University of Iowa softball program in 2017. Looper owns a 171-246-1 overall record and a 68-113 mark in Big Ten play since the 2011 season.

In 2017, earned a berth in the conference tournament, marking the program's 20th Big Ten Tournament appearance and tying Michigan for the conference lead in appearances.

The Hawkeyes also earned the Community Service Award at the Golden Herkys, the annual award ceremony for the University of Iowa athletics department. The softball team completed approximately 750 hours of community service, more than any other Iowa team.

Iowa excelled in the classroom during the 2016-17 academic year, with seven Hawkeyes earning Academic All-Big Ten honors in the spring. Kurtz was also named a Big Ten Distinguished Scholar.

Under Looper's guidance in 2016, Kaitlyn Mullarkey collected a team-high nine home runs, which tied for eighth in single-season home runs in program history. Mullarkey currently ranks tied for 15th in program history with 15 career home runs.



In 2015, Looper led the Hawkeyes to their deepest Big Ten Tournament run since 2008. After earning the No. 10 seed with an 8-15 conference record (19-40 overall), the Hawkeyes overcame a three-run deficit against seventh-seeded Rutgers to win the opening round of the tournament on May 7. The Hawkeyes then upset the nationally ranked Gophers with a 2-0 victory to secure Iowa's third win over a ranked opponent on the season (No. 17 UCF, No. 4 Michigan). After falling behind early in its semifinal game against third-seeded Nebraska, Iowa rallied to come within three runs, but fell short of a comeback as the Huskers notched the 9-6 victory.

Looper collected her 100th career victory in the 2014 season finale. On the season, Iowa posted 16 wins -- nine in conference action and three over ranked opponents (16-30-1).

In 2013, Looper's third year with the Hawkeyes, the squad amassed 30 wins (30-24), which was the most wins for the program since a 42-16 record in 2009. Iowa posted six wins over ranked opponents.

During her second season with the Hawkeyes in 2012, Looper led the team to a runner-up finish in the Big Ten -- the program's highest finish since winning the league title in 2003. Iowa dropped two of its first three conference series before winning five straight to close out the season. It was the first time the team had won five straight series since the 2004 season.

Iowa entered the final weekend with a conference title within reach, but it could not close the gap with Michigan despite taking 2-of-3 games at Minnesota. The Hawkeyes finished with a 27-26 overall record and a 16-8 mark in conference play in 2012. The Hawkeyes finished second in the Big Ten in pitching (2.31 ERA) and third in fielding (.967). The squad turned 26 double plays during the course of the season to rank sixth nationally in double plays per game (.49).

Looper guided the Hawkeyes to a 27-24 overall and a 9-11 Big Ten record in her first season in Iowa City in 2011. The first-year head coach led the UI to a pair of six game winning streaks in her opening campaign and a tournament title at the Stetson Classic.

Iowa opened Big Ten Conference play strong with an 8-3 record. Among the victories was a 4-2 triumph at No. 1 Michigan. The win, which pushed the overall mark to 26-16, was Iowa's first over a No. 1 ranked opponent since the 2005 season and the first over a ranked foe since 2008.

Looper's Hawkeyes were on the verge of completing a series sweep in Ann Arbor before the Wolverines rallied from a 2-0 deficit in the bottom of the seventh inning to claim the victory.

A pair of Hawkeyes earned All-Big Ten recognition at the conclusion of the season. Liz Watkins was tabbed as a second team selection, while Katie Keim earned third team accolades.

Looper took over the reigns of the Iowa program after serving as an assistant coach at the University of Texas for 11 seasons (1999-2010). Looper helped lead the Longhorns to three College World Series appearances (2003, 2005 and 2006) and nine NCAA Tournament berths.

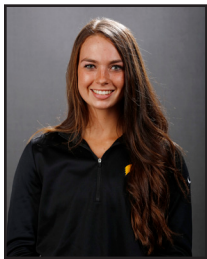
