ON THE MAT

The University of Iowa wrestling team hosts No. 7 Nebraska on Saturday at 8:03 p.m. (CT) at Carver-Hawkeyes Arena. Tickets are \$12 for adults and \$8 for youth 18-years old and younger. Children five-years old and under and UI Students are admitted free to all matches.

THE SERIES -- NEBRASKA

Iowa leads the all-time series 32-10-1 and has won the last 10 meetings overall. The Hawkeyes are 14-3 all-time against the Huskers in Iowa City and won the most recent meeting in Iowa City, 27-9, in 2017.

Nebraska's last win in the series was a 24-13 victory at the National Duals on Nov. 19, 2005. The Huskers' last win in Iowa City was in 1937, 15.5-14.5.

#SORENSENSTRONG

The wrestling program will distribute #SorensenStrong bandanas to the first 3,000 fans through the doors of Carver-Hawkeye Arena on Jan. 18. The #SorensenStrong bandanas are a symbol of support for former All-American Brandon Sorensen, who is battling acute lymphoblastic leukemia. LUGO CLIMBS TO NO. 1

Senior Pat Lugo climbed to the top spot of the 149-pound rankings Jan. 7 following the Midlands Championships on Dec. 29-30.

Lugo won the 149-pound title, going 6-0 and using one pin, one technical fall, and two major decisions to reach the semifinals. He defeated No. 7 Max Thomsen, 3-2, in the semis, and defeated top-ranked Austin O'Conner, 8-4, in the finals.

Lugo is 12-0 this season with five wins over ranked opponents, including three in the top seven. He is 17-9 all-time against ranked opponents.

The No. 1 billing is the first of Lugo's career. He has spent all season in the top 5 after finishing the 2019 season with an eighth-place All-America finish. Prior to the 2019 national tournament, Lugo had not been ranked higher than 10th.

FORCEFUL-LEE

Junior Spencer Lee enters Saturday's dual ranked No. 1 at 125 with a 8-0 record. Lee has scored bonus points in each match, winning

once by major decision, twice by fall, and five times by technical fall.

Only four times this season has Lee wrestled into the second period. His two pins are both in under a minute, 0:54 and 0:52. He has two first-period technical falls, and the other three were in 3:13, 3:32, and 3:16.

ANOTHER TOP 10 AT 184

Freshman Abe Assad is ranked ninth in the nation in the Jan. 14 Track Wrestling rankings. Assad is the third Hawkeye this year to crack the top 10 at 184 pounds.

Senior Cash Wilcke opened the season ranked ninth, and was ranked 10th in the Jan. 7 poll. Redshirt freshman Nelson Brands was ranked ninth in the Dec. 3 poll, and 10th in the Dec. 17 poll.

The Hawkeyes 184-pounders have a combined record of 32-8. Assad is 17-3 overall, recording a runner-up finish at the 2019 Midlands Championships. He made his Hawkeye debut with a 6-2 win at Indiana on Jan. 10.

Wilcke is 11-2 overall and placed third at Midlands. Brands is 4-3 overall with one win over a top 10 opponent, No. 7 Sam Colbray of Iowa State (4-2 SV1).

BIG TEN & 0

Junior Spencer Lee (16-0), junior Austin DeSanto (10-0), junior Alex Marinelli (20-0), freshman Abe Assad (2-0), and redshirt freshman Tony Cassioppi (3-0) are all undefeated in their careers in Big Ten duals.

Among Lee's 16 Big Ten dual wins are seven falls, five in the first period, five technical falls, and one major decision.

Junior Michael Kemerer has a career mark of 19-1 in Big Ten duals, and senior Pat Lugo is 10-1 in his career in Big Ten duals.

HOME SWEET HOME

Spencer Lee, Alex Marinelli, and Jacob Warner are undefeated in their careers at Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

Marinelli is 14-0 all-time at Carver. Lee owns a record of 13-0. Warner is undefeated in six home matches.

In Lee's 14 home wins, he has four pins, six technical falls, and two major decisions. Four of the wins are against top 10 opponents.

Among Marinelli's 14 wins, he has five pins, three technical falls, and one major decision.

STRENGTH OF SCHEDULE

Saturday's dual begins a stretch of three duals in 14 days against three of the top seven teams in the country. Nebraska is ranked No. 7 in the NWCA Coaches Poll. No. 4 Ohio State visits Carver-Hawkeye Arena on Jan. 24, and No. 2 Penn State is in Iowa City on Jan. 31. Those three teams have a combined record of 15-3. All three duals are televised on BTN.

The Hawkeyes close the regular season hosting No. 11 Minnesota on Feb. 15, and No. 9 Oklahoma State on Feb. 23. Those duals are also televised on BTN.

MARINELLI EARNS B1G WEEKLY HONOR

Junior Alex Marinelli was named Big Ten Co-Wrestler of the Week on Jan. 3.

Marinelli won the 165-pound Midlands championship on Dec. 30. He ran through the bracket, recording four falls and three wins over ranked opponents. He was named the Midlands Champion of Champions, and earned tournament awards for most falls (4) and highest point scorer (29). He shared the weekly conference honor with Wisconsin's Seth Gross.

The Big Ten honor was the fourth of Marinelli's career, and the second for Iowa this season. Austin DeSanto earned the award Dec. 3.

DESANTO EARNS B1G WEEKLY HONOR

Junior Austin DeSanto was named Big Ten Conference Wrestler of the Week on Jan. 3.

In a matchup of one versus two, DeSanto defeated Wisconsin's Seth Gross, 6-2, in Iowa's Big Ten opener on Dec. 1.

DeSanto scored one takedown in the first period and two more in the second to hand Gross his first loss at 133 pounds since the 2017 NCAA finals.

The Big Ten Conference honor was the second of DeSanto's career. He was named co-Wrestler of the week on January 22, 2019.

BRANDS GET B1G #100

Iowa's 32-3 win against No. 6 Wisconsin on Dec. 1, 2019, was head coach Tom Brands' 100th Big Ten victory. He has a 101-10 Big Ten record in 14 seasons. Brands has had eight undefeated Big Ten seasons, and Iowa has won or shared the Big Ten regular season title 10 times under Brands' watch.

HAWKEYES AND CARVER-HAWKEYE ARENA

The Hawkeyes are 257-25 all-time at Carver-Hawkeye Arena since moving from the UI Field House in 1983. Iowa was 7-0 at home in 2018-19 completing its 21st undefeated season in Carver-Hawkeye Arena. The Hawkeyes have recorded 21 undefeated seasons in Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

Carver-Hawkeye Arena has hosted two United States Olympic Team Trials, four Big Ten Championships (1983, 1994, 2005, 2016), and four NCAA Championships (1986, 1991, 1995, 2001). The Hawkeyes have won five tournament titles on their home mat, including the 1983 and 1994 Big Ten Championships, and the 1986, 1991 and 1995 NCAA Championships.

In 2018, the University of Iowa hosted the UWW World Cup, an international dual tournament featuring eight of the top countries in the world.

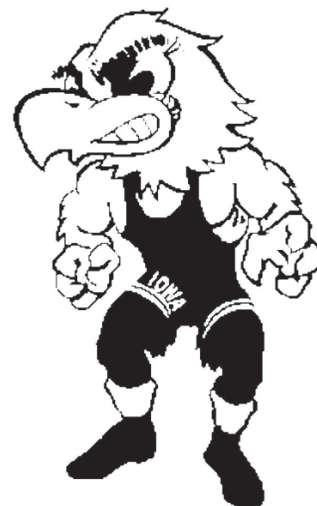

Head Coach

University of Iowa, 1992

Three-time Big Ten Coach of the Year Tom Brands is in his 14th season as head wrestling coach at the University of Iowa in 2019-20. A 1996 Olympic gold medalist and member of wrestling's Hall of Fame, Brands is only the eighth wrestling coach at the University of Iowa. The former Hawkeye wrestler was a four-time All-American and

three-time national champion (1989-92) at Iowa. He has a 224-23-1 (.905) overall and 102-10 (.910) Big Ten coaching record at Iowa. He has a 241-43-1 (.847) career mark.

In 13 complete seasons as Iowa's head coach, Brands has led the Hawkeyes to three NCAA and four Big Ten team titles, crowning 12 NCAA champions, 16 Big Ten champions and 72 All-Americans. Iowa has had 112 Academic All-Big Ten recipients, including a school-record 13 in 2018-19. The Hawkeyes have qualified 118 wrestlers for the NCAA Championships in the last 13 years, sending the entire 10-man lineup in 2009, 2010, 2014, and 2015. Iowa has also won or shared nine of the last 12 Big Ten regular season titles.

Iowa set the national collegiate dual meet attendance record of 42,287 when Iowa defeated top-ranked Oklahoma State, 18-16, on Nov. 14, 2015 at the Grapple on the Gridiron at Kinnick Stadium. Iowa has led the nation in attendance in each of Brands' 13 seasons, setting an NCAA all-time attendance average of 12,166 in 2015-16.

Brands was named 2008 NWCA Coach of the Year after leading the Hawkeyes to their first NCAA team title since 2000 and their first Big Ten team title since 2004. He was named Big Ten Coach of the Year in 2008, 2009 and 2010, becoming the first coach in conference history to earn the honor in three consecutive seasons.

Brands served as head coach at Virginia Tech University for two seasons (2005-06), recording a 17-20 dual mark. In his first season with the Hokies,

Brands led the team to the 2005 regular season Atlantic Coast Conference title, set a school record for dual meet wins (16) and had a school-record five wrestlers qualify for the NCAA Championships. During his tenure, Virginia Tech crowned five ACC champions and had two All-Americans. Senior heavy-weight Mike Faust was named 2006 ACC Wrestler of the Year.

Prior to taking the helm at Virginia Tech, Brands was an assistant coach at Iowa for 12 seasons (1993-2004). He helped the Hawkeyes to a 177-27 dual record, seven NCAA and eight Big Ten team titles, while crowning 23 NCAA champions, 73 All-Americans and 36 Big Ten champions. He was named the National Wrestling Coaches Association Assistant Coach of the Year in 2000.

In 2004, he was one of three coaches for the U.S. Olympic freestyle wrestling team, participating in Athens, and in 2016 he was named a volunteer coach of the United States Olympic team in Rio. Brands also served as assistant coach for the U.S. Freestyle World Teams in 2001, 2002, 2003, 2013, 2014, and 2015. He was named Freestyle Coach of the Year by USA Wrestling in 2002 and 2003. He has coached a number of other U.S. teams in international competition.

As a competitor, Brands won the 1996 Olympic freestyle gold medal at 136.5 pounds in Atlanta, Georgia. He also won a gold medal at the 1993 World Freestyle Championships in Toronto, two World Cup gold medals (1994, 1995) and was the 1995 Pan American Games champion. He won four U.S. National titles (1993-96) and made four straight U.S. World or Olympic teams (1993-96). Along with his twin brother, Terry, Tom was named 1993 USA Wrestling Athlete of the Year, the 1993 John Smith Outstanding Freestyle Wrestler, and 1993 Amateur Wrestling News Man of the Year. He was inducted into wrestling's Hall of Fame in 2001.

Brands was a four-time All-American at Iowa (1989-92). During his Hawkeye career, he won three NCAA titles and was named Outstanding Wrestler of the 1992 NCAA Championships. Also a three-time Big Ten champion, Brands won 95 percent of his matches at Iowa. His career mark of 158-7-2 includes an undefeated season in 1991 (45-0).

The Sheldon, Iowa, native was born April 9, 1968. He earned his B.S. degree in physical education from Iowa in 1992. He and his wife, Jeni, have three adult children, Madigan, Kinsee and Tommy.
