ON THE MAT

The fourth-ranked University of Iowa wrestling team hosts No. 16 Lehigh at Carver-Hawkeye Arena on Saturday at 7:30 p.m. (CT). Admission is \$12 for adults and \$8 for youth. Children five-years-old and younger and UI students are admitted free.

IOWA VS. LEHIGH

Iowa is 25-0 all-time against Lehigh. That includes a 14-0 mark in Iowa City. The teams last met on Feb. 14, 2014. Iowa won the dual 31-6 in Bethlehem.

Iowa won the first meeting in the series, 33-3, in 1972. The largest margin of victory was a 47-0 Hawkeye win in January, 1986. The most narrow margin of victory was just one 11 months later, an 18-17 win December, 1986.

MOVING UP THE RANKINGS

Sophomore Kaleb Young and redshirt freshman Jacob Warner both jumped up the rankings this week.

Young moved up seven spots in the Track-Wrestling rankings, from No. 12 to No. 5. It is the highest ranking of his career. Young is 5-0 with two pins and a major decision. He has one win over a ranked wrestler, pinning No. 14 Griffin Parriott in 3:37. He was named Big Ten Wrestler of the Week following that victory. Young was ranked No. 17 in TrackWrestling's preseason rankings.

Warner moved up five spots this week, ascending from the No. 11 to No. 6 in the Inter-mat rankings. Warner debuted last week with a 5-4 win over No. 5 Willie Miklus. He is 1-0.

NEXT MAN IN

Fourteen Hawkeyes have at least one dual win this season. Iowa has opened the season with three projected starters on the bench, including redshirt freshman Jacob Warner (197), and All-Americans Michael Kemerer (174) and Sam Stoll (285).

Starters Spencer Lee (125) and Pat Lugo (149) have missed one dual this season.

In their absence, Carter Happel, Myles Wilson, Connor Corbin, Mitch Bowman, and Aaron Costello have picked up wins for Iowa.

Happel and Bowman have each bumped up a weight class this year. Happel shutout Parker Filius of Purdue, 2-0, at 149. Bowman has two wins at 197. First a 6-2 decision in the season opener, and later a 7-5 win over No. 11 Christian Brunner of Purdue.

Aaron Costello has posted a 3-1 mark at heavyweight. He has outscored his opponents 16-2 in his three wins. His lone loss was a 3-1 decision in sudden victory.

Reshirt freshmen Connor Corbin and Myles Wilson also have dual wins. Corbin is 1-1 at 197, and Wilson is 2-3 at 174.

This week's probable lineup includes four weight classes with a two-deep. Bowman and Costello are listed at 184 and 285, respectively. Paul Glynn and Jeremiah Moody are listed at 133 and 165, respectively. Neither Glynn or Moody have appeared in a dual this season. Glynn was 3-6 in duals last year at 133. Moody has one career dual start, recording a fall in 0:25 against Iowa Central. He wrestled that dual at 184 pounds.

A LITTLE EXTRA ON TOP

Sophomore Spencer Lee has a team-high 11-match winning streak. It is a career-long for Lee. He had a nine-match winning streak in 2017-18. The 11-match streak includes 10 bonus point victories (two major decision, six technical falls, two pins), eight wins over ranked opponents, and a decision in the 2018 NCAA finals.

HAWKEYE WRESTLING HISTORY

Iowa earned its 1,000th dual win in program history Nov. 9, topping California State Bakersfield, 36-3, in Kent, Ohio. Iowa is one of four NCAA Division I schools with 1,000 program wins (Oklahoma State, Iowa State, Oregon State). The Hawkeyes' overall dual meet record is 1,004-230-31 (.799) in 109 seasons.

The Hawkeyes have won 23 national titles and 35 Big Ten titles. Iowa's 55 NCAA Champions have won a total of 83 NCAA individual titles, crowning six three-time and 16 two-time champions. The Hawkeyes' 112 Big Ten champions have combined for 199 conference titles. There have been seven four-time, 18 three-time, and 30 two-time Big Ten champions from Iowa.

Iowa's 157 All-Americans have earned All-America status 329 times, including 20 four-time, 36 three-time and 40 two-time honorees.

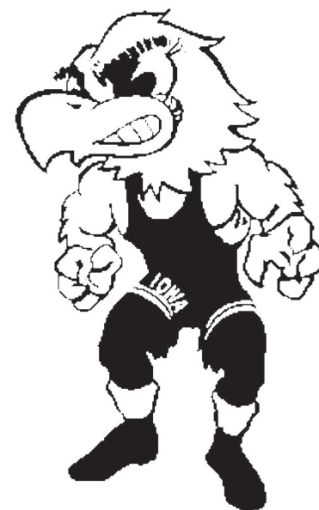

Tom Brands Head Coach University of Iowa, 1992

Three-time Big Ten Coach of the Year Tom Brands is in his 13th season as head wrestling coach at the University of Iowa in 2018. A 1996 Olympic gold medalist and member of wrestling's Hall of Fame, Brands is only the eighth wrestling coach at the University of Iowa. The former Hawkeye wrestler was a four-time All-American and three-time

national champion (1989-92) at Iowa. He has a 209-22-1 (.901) overall and 91-10 (.900) Big Ten coaching record at Iowa, and a 226-42-1 (.839) career mark.

In 12 full seasons as Iowa's head coach, Brands has led the Hawkeyes to three NCAA and four Big Ten team titles, crowning 11 NCAA champions, 15 Big Ten champions and 66 All-Americans. Iowa has had 99 Academic All-Big Ten recipients, including a school-record 12 in 2011-12. The Hawkeyes have qualified 109 wrestlers for the NCAA Championships in the last 12 years, sending the entire 10-man lineup in 2009, 2010, 2014, and 2015. Iowa has also won or shared eight of the last 11 Big Ten regular season titles.

Iowa also made another entry in the record books, setting the national collegiate dual meet attendance record of 42,287 when Iowa defeated top-ranked Oklahoma State, 18-16, on Nov. 14, 2015 at the Grapple on the Gridiron at Kinnick Stadium. Iowa has led the nation in attendance in each of Brands' 11 seasons, setting an NCAA all-time attendance average of 12,166 in 2015-16.

Brands was named 2008 NWCA Coach of the Year after leading the Hawkeyes to their first NCAA team title since 2000 and their first Big Ten team title since 2004. He was named Big Ten Coach of the Year in 2008, 2009 and 2010, becoming the first coach in conference history to earn the honor in three consecutive seasons.

Brands served as head coach at Virginia Tech University for two seasons (2005-06), recording a 17-20 dual mark. In his first season with the Hokies, Brands led the team to the 2005 regular season Atlantic Coast Conference title, set a school record for dual meet wins (16) and had a school-record five wrestlers qualify for the NCAA Championships. During his tenure, Virginia Tech crowned five ACC champions and had two All-Americans. Senior heavy-weight Mike Faust was named 2006 ACC Wrestler of the Year.

Prior to taking the helm at Virginia Tech, Brands was an assistant coach at Iowa for 12 seasons (1993-2004). He helped the Hawkeyes to a 177-27 dual record, seven NCAA and eight Big Ten team titles, while crowning 23 NCAA champions, 73 All-Americans and 36 Big Ten champions. He was named the National Wrestling Coaches Association Assistant Coach of the Year in 2000.

In 2004, he was one of three coaches for the U.S. Olympic freestyle wrestling team, participating in Athens, and in 2016 he was named a volunteer coach of the United States Olympic team in Rio. Brands also served as assistant coach for the U.S. Freestyle World Teams in 2001, 2002, 2003, 2013, 2014, and 2015. He was named Freestyle Coach of the Year by USA Wrestling in 2002 and 2003. He has coached a number of other U.S. teams in international competition.

As a competitor, Brands won the 1996 Olympic freestyle gold medal at 136.5 pounds in Atlanta, Georgia. He also won a gold medal at the 1993 World Freestyle Championships in Toronto, two World Cup gold medals (1994, 1995) and was the 1995 Pan American Games champion. He won four U.S. National titles (1993-96) and made four straight U.S. World or Olympic teams (1993-96). Along with his twin brother, Terry, Tom was named 1993 USA Wrestling Athlete of the Year, the 1993 John Smith Outstanding Freestyle Wrestler, and 1993 Amateur Wrestling News Man of the Year. He was inducted into wrestling's Hall of Fame in 2001.

Brands was a four-time All-American at Iowa (1989-92). During his Hawkeye career, he won three NCAA titles and was named Outstanding Wrestler of the 1992 NCAA Championships. Also a three-time Big Ten champion, Brands won 95 percent of his matches at Iowa. His career mark of 158-7-2 includes an undefeated season in 1991 (45-0).

The Sheldon, Iowa, native was born April 9, 1968. He earned his B.S. degree in physical education from Iowa in 1992. He and his wife, Jeni, have three children, Madigan, Kinsee and Tommy.

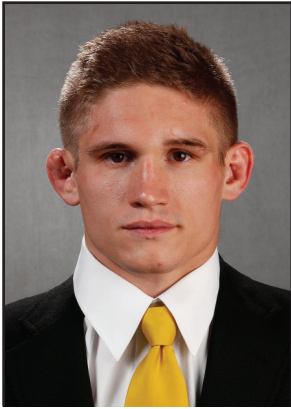
