### GAME #4 STORYLINES

- Iowa has won 39 of its last 41 nonconference home games, dating back to 2012.
- Peter Jok, who enters Sunday's game with 942 career points, has scored double digits in all three games, including netting 27 or more points in two of the contests. Jok leads the team in scoring (23.3 ppg), rebounding (7.0 rpg), free throws (8-of-8), and 3-pointers made (8).
- Peter Jok joins Reggie Evans (twice) and Aaron Fuller as the only Hawkeyes to post 30+ points and 10+ rebounds in a single game the last 20 years.
- Peter Jok owns three of Iowa's top ten scoring performances in a single-game during the Fran McCaffery era (30 vs. Seton Hall, and 29 vs. Rutgers and Illinois).
- Nicholas Baer is stuffing the stat sheet, averaging 8.3 points and 3.7 rebounds, leads the team with five steals, and has 10 assists to only one turnover through three games.
- Iowa scored 116 points last Sunday against Savannah State -- the most in the Fran McCaffery era. The 116 points equal the seventh most points scored in a single game in program history.
- Iowa's 3-pointers made (18) and attempted (43) versus Savannah State last Sunday are new school records.
- Peter Jok was named to the preseason 10-player All-Big Ten first team, while also being named to the 2017 Jerry West Shooting Guard of the Year Award and 2017 Naismith Trophy and John Wooden Award watch lists.
- Iowa has competed in postseason play the last five years (NCAA 2014-16; NIT 2012-13).
- The Hawkeyes won 22 games, tied for third place in the Big Ten, and won an NCAA Tournament game each of the last two seasons.
- Iowa sold out 23 home games the last three seasons. The Hawkeyes ranked 19th in national attendance in 2015-16.
- Iowa has won 20 or more games in four consecutive seasons -- its longest streak in 15 years.
- Fran McCaffery has guided Iowa to upper division finishes in the Big Ten in each of the last four seasons. McCaffery, who is one of just 12 Division I head coaches to take four different programs to the NCAA Tournament, has accumulated 16 first division finishes in 20 years as a head coach. McCaffery has posted 10 seasons of 20 or more wins as a head coach.
- Iowa is 52-8 when scoring 80 points or more, the last six seasons. The Hawkeyes are 61-2 when holding opponents to fewer than 61 points, the last six years.

### THE SETTING

Iowa (2-1) concludes a four-game home stand on Sunday, welcoming UT Rio Grande Valley (0-3). Tipoff is set for 4:35 p.m. (CT) on Mediacom Court at Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

Tickets are only \$18 for adults and \$5 for youths and UI students. Fans with a men's ticket are welcome to attend the women's game that tips at 2 p.m. with their men's ticket and sit in sections DD – JJ & E – I (above row 24).

There will be a Junior Hawk Club pregame party in Feller Club Room and postgame facility tour.

### ON THE AIR

**Radio:** Iowa games are broadcast on the Hawkeye Radio Network. Gary Dolphin will handle the play-by-play, along with color commentator Bob Hansen. The network includes more than 40 stations that blanket the state of Iowa and include portions of Illinois, Nebraska, Minnesota, Missouri and Wisconsin. The Hawkeye Radio Network coverage includes a 60-minute pregame show.

**Stream:** Sunday's game will be streamed on mobile devices and computers via BTN Plus on BTN2GO. Zach Mackey, Mac McCausland, and Taylor Brooks will call the action. There is a monthly or annual subscription fee to watch the game.

### ALL-TIME SERIES RESULTS

Iowa is 4-0 all-time against UT Rio Grande Valley (formerly known as UT Pan American). The Hawkeyes last played the Vaqueros in 2012 in Iowa City (W, 86-55).

The Vaqueros are members of the Western Athletic Conference (WAC), which Iowa is a perfect 10-0 against current members.

### CARVER-HAWKEYE ARENA ENHANCEMENTS

The Iowa Athletic Department upgraded Carver-Hawkeye Arena's video boards, sound system, lighting, digital scoretable displays, and playing surface this past summer.

A new four-sided centerhung video system is the centerpiece of the installation. The two main centerhung displays measure approximately 14.5 feet high by 26 feet wide and the other two centerhung displays measure 9.5 feet high by 16.5 feet wide. The project also upgraded the auxiliary displays located near the ceiling at each side of the arena.

### FRESHMEN MAKING THEIR MARK

Iowa's freshmen are making contributions to the Hawkeye offense. Through three games, Hawkeye freshmen are accounting for 41 percent (120 of 290 points) of Iowa's offense, led by forward Tyler Cook (44 points, 14.7 average). The rookies are also responsible for 39 percent of the team's rebounding production (53 of 137 rebounds).

## HEAD COACH FRAN McCAFFERY

Fran McCaffery, who is signed through the 2020 season, is in his seventh season as the head basketball coach at the University of Iowa and his 20th year overall as a college head coach. McCaffery has reached the 20-win plateau eight of the last 10 seasons, including the last four years.

McCaffery spent five seasons (2005-10) as the head coach at Siena, six years at UNC-Greensboro (1999-2005) and three seasons at Lehigh (1985-88) before joining the Hawkeyes.

McCaffery has three decades of Division I coaching experience. He completed his 34th season as a collegiate coach in 2016, which includes 20 years as a head coach and 14 as an assistant. McCaffery is one of 12 coaches to lead four different Division I teams to the NCAA Tournament.

McCaffery, 57, holds a career mark of 371-264 (.584) and guided his teams to 10 postseason appearances (seven NCAA and three NIT). He is 120-87 (.580) at Iowa. McCaffery has led Iowa to NCAA Tournament victories in each of the past two seasons, the first time Hawkeye teams have won tournament games in consecutive seasons since 1996-97.

Since taking over the Iowa program in 2010, the Hawkeyes have earned five postseason tournament berths (3 NCAA, 2 NIT). McCaffery coached Iowa to 25 victories in 2013, equaling the second-most win total in program history. McCaffery has guided five different Hawkeyes to all-conference honors, including three straight first team honorees. The last time Iowa had three consecutive first-team all-league honorees was 1946-48.

McCaffery has posted upper division finishes in each of the past four seasons at Iowa and 16 of 20 seasons as a head coach. He has posted 20 wins or more eight of the last 10 seasons, including the last four at Iowa (2013, 2014, 2015, and 2016).

McCaffery and the Hawkeyes have made Carver-Hawkeye Arena one of the most feared arenas to play nationally. Fans have embraced McCaffery and his team's style of play with attendance increasing by more than 50 percent since 2010. The Hawkeyes boast a 58-12 home record the last four seasons, which includes a school-record 18 wins in 2014.

McCaffery's five years at Siena were the best in its 70-year history. He led the Saints on an incredible run that ended with three straight Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference championships and NCAA Tournament appearances. In so doing, Siena became the only program in the country to win its regular season and postseason title 2008-10.

McCaffery's Saints owned a 112-51 (.687) record in his five years with the program. He guided the Saints to four consecutive 20-win seasons.

The 2009 MAAC Coach of the Year and 2010 District I Coach of the Year is the third winningest coach, by percentage, in league history (.687). He is the only coach to guide a MAAC program to two NCAA Tournament wins. McCaffery led his 2008 and 2009 teams to first round NCAA Tournament victories over Vanderbilt and Ohio State, respectively.

In his final two seasons at Siena, he coached the Saints to back-to-back 27-win campaigns and boasted a combined 39-3 (.929) record against MAAC opponents, which included MAAC Tournament contests.

McCaffery began his coaching career as an assistant at Penn (1982-83) and Lehigh (1983-85). After three seasons as head coach at Lehigh, he spent 11 seasons as an assistant at Notre Dame (1988-99).

McCaffery played basketball at Wake Forest his freshman year (1977-78) and then concluded his collegiate playing career at Penn his final three seasons (1979-82).

He earned his B.S. degree in Economics from The Wharton School (Penn) in 1982. McCaffery also earned a Master of Education from Lehigh in 1985.

### SETON HALL BEATS HAWKEYES IN GAVITT GAMES

Seton Hall shot 65.5 percent (19-of-29) from the field in the second half en route to a 91-83 win over Iowa on Mediacom Court at Carver-Hawkeye Arena Thursday night.

- Two Hawkeyes scored in double figures: Peter Jok (30) and Tyler Cook (24).
- Iowa did a solid job on the glass, outrebounding the Pirates by eight (46-38). Jok led the team with a career-high 11 rebounds to post his first career double-double, while Dom Uhl matched a personal best with 10 boards.
- Peter Jok joins Reggie Evans (twice) and Aaron Fuller as the only Hawkeyes to post 30+ points and 10+ rebounds in a single-game the last 20 years.
- Both teams made eight 3-pointers in the contest, with six different Hawkeyes making at least one triple.
- Twenty-five of Seton Hall's 33 baskets were scored in the paint.

### SCOUTING UT RIO GRANDE VALLEY

- UT Rio Grande Valley (UTRGV) lost its first three games, falling on the road to UT Martin (88-80) and Memphis (94-75), and at home to Texas A&M-Corpus Christi (94-72).
- Junior Nick Nixon, an Illinois native, leads the team in scoring (19 ppg), steals (2.6 spg), and rebounding (7 rpg). Sophomore Antonio Green is the team's top 3-point threat, making 13-of-29 (.448) attempts from long distance.
- UTRGV posted an 8-22 overall record a year ago, which includes a 4-10 mark in Western Athletic Conference action. The Vaqueros welcome 10 newcomers this season.
- In their last outing against Texas A&M-Corpus Christi, the Vaqueros committed 26 turnovers and shot 62 percent (23-of-37) from the foul line. Antonio Green netted a team-best 26 points for UTRGV.
- Lew Hill is in his first season as a head coach (0-3). Hill spent the previous five years (2011-16) as an assistant coach at Oklahoma, helping guide the Sooners to four straight NCAA tournaments, including advancing to the 2016 Final Four. Prior to his coaching stint at Oklahoma, Hill served as an assistant coach under Lon Kruger at UNLV for seven seasons (2004-11).
- Following Sunday's game, UTRGV will travel to Cape Girardeau, Missouri, to face South-east Missouri State on Tuesday.

### PETER JOK ENTERS FINAL SEASON AS A HAWKEYE

After averaging seven points per game as a sophomore, Peter Jok surged 9.1 points last year as a junior averaging 16.1 points per contest. The +9.1 improvement was tops among Big Ten players. Jok's 16.1 scoring average ranks second among Big Ten players returning this season behind Illinois' Malcolm Hill (18.1 ppg).

Jok was named to the preseason 10-player All-Big Ten first team, while also being named to the 2017 Jerry West Shooting Guard of the Year Award and 2017 Naismith Trophy and John Wooden Award watch lists. Jok is averaging a team-best 23.3 points and 7.0 rebounds per game through three contests this season.

Jok ranked second on the team in scoring (16.1 ppg) and first in free throw accuracy (.852, 92-of-108). Jok made 28 straight free throws before missing in the win over Temple (3-of-5). He scored 20 or more points 10 times in 2015-16, including a career-best 29 points at Rutgers (Jan. 21) and versus Illinois (March 10). The 29-point outbursts tie for seventh-most by a Hawkeye during the Fran McCaffery era.

Jok became the first Hawkeye non-senior to average 16 points or more since Chris Kingsbury averaged 16.8 points as a sophomore in 1995.

## **HAWKEYE FASTBREAKS**

- Iowa surpassed the century mark for the 97th time in program history with a 116-84 win over Savannah State on Nov. 13. The 116 points equal the seventh most points scored in a game in program history.
- Iowa posted school records in 3-pointers made (18) and attempted (43) in its victory over Savannah State on Nov. 13.
- Peter Jok scored 27 points in Iowa's opening win over Kennesaw State. The 27 points are the most by a Hawkeye in a season opener since Adam Haluska poured in 29 against The Citadel in 2006.
- Freshman Tyler Cook (10) joined Aaron White as the only two players to grab 10 or more rebounds in their first game as a Hawkeye in the past 20 years.

## **NICHOLAS BAER PLAYED OVERSEAS IN AUGUST**

Nicholas Baer averaged 8.5 points, 8.3 rebounds, and two steals in four games (3-1) overseas on the USA East Coast All-Star Team.

This marked the sixth consecutive year that a Hawkeye traveled overseas with the USA East Coast basketball team. In 2011, Matt Gatens and Bryce Cartwright traveled overseas; Zach McCabe went in 2012; Jarrod Uthoff was on the roster in 2013; Mike Gesell and Adam Woodbury competed in 2014; while Dom Uhl traveled with the team in 2015.

## **IOWA SIGNS 2 PREP STANDOUTS**

Luka Garza and Jack Nunge have signed a National Letter of Intent to attend the University of Iowa in 2017.

Garza is a 6-foot-11, 240-pound forward from Maret School in Washington, D.C. Garza is a two-time first team All-DC, all-conference and second team Washington Post All-Met honoree. He scored more than 1,000 points and grabbed over 600 rebounds his first three years. Garza averaged 25.5 points, 12.6 rebounds, and 2.6 blocks as a junior, and 19.8 points and 9.8 rebounds his sophomore campaign. He helped Maret earn back-to-back conference championships (22-8 in 2014 and 22-5 in 2015). He was recognized as the 2014-15 Washington Post All-Met Most Improved Player. Garza averaged 11.3 points (54% FG, 36% 3-pt FG) and 6.5 rebounds last year in the EYBL.

Nunge is also 6-foot-11 and weighs 220 pounds. He hails from Newburgh, Indiana and attends Castle High School. Nunge earned first-team All-SIAC, IBCA Supreme 15 Underclassmen, and Indiana All Star-Core 6 honors following his junior campaign. He posted a team-best 18 double-doubles, and averaged 19.3 points (FG%: 57%, 3-pt FG%: 43%, FT%: 81%), 11.4 rebounds, and 3.7 blocks per game his junior season. He was named team Most Valuable Player in 2016. A two-time team captain, he tallied 35 points and 25 rebounds against Bosse High School, and 35 points and 22 rebounds versus Harrison High School his junior season. Nunge also excels in the classroom, boasting a 3.97 grade point average, ranks 20th in his class, and earned the Scholastic "C" Award. He is a member of the National Honor Society and Student Council. He played with the Pocket City AAU basketball team.
