FIRST ROUND MATCHUP

The No. 3 seed Hawkeyes will face No. 14 Nebraska in the first round on Friday at the Ocean Course.

TOURNAMENT FORMAT

Teams can have an eight-player tournament roster with six players competing in each match. Matches will be scored in a win, loss, or tie fashion. An individual match win is worth one point, and a halved match is worth 1/2 point for each team. Matches ending in a 3-3 tie have a tie breaking criteria. After the three round robin matches, teams will be ranked one through 7 in their Big Ten division, and face the team from the opposing division with the same ranking in Saturday's final round.

THE FIELD

No. 47 Iowa is joined by a field of 13 other teams that include: No. 27 Illinois, No. 36 Northwestern, Michigan, Minnesota, Indiana, Michigan State, Penn State, Wisconsin, Ohio State, Rutgers, Maryland, Purdue, and Nebraska (Golfweek Rankings).

THE LINEUP

The lineup for Big Ten Match Play includes two seniors (Matthew Walker and Aaron DeNucci), two juniors (Alex Schaake and Benton Weinberg), one sophomore (Jake Rowe), and one freshman (Gonzalo Leal Montero).

THE COURSE

Big Ten Match Play will be played at Hammock Beach Golf Resort. Play will take place at both of the resorts courses, Ocean Course (par 72; 7,113 yards) and Conservatory Course (par 72; 7,777 yards).

LAST TIME OUT

The Hawkeyes concluded fall play at the Royal Oaks Intercollegiate, finishing eighth with a 54-hole score of 884 (+44). Junior Benton Weinberg earned his first top-10 finish of the season, tying for 10th with a three-round total of 215 (+5). Junior Alex Schaake fired a 54-hole score of 216 (+6) to earn his team-leading fourth top-20 finish of the season, tying for 12th.

HISTORICALLY AT BIG TEN MATCH PLAY

This will be lowa's eighth time competing in this tournament. The Hawkeyes have finished in top-10 all previous seven times, including five top-five finishes. lowa's best finish came in 2012, when they finished first based on criteria following a 3-3 tie. Last season, lowa posted a 2-2 record to earn a ninth place finish.

FALL RECAP

The Hawkeyes recorded top-10 finishes in four of their five fall tournaments, including three finishes in the top-five. lowa's best finish of the fall came at the Golfweek Conference Challenge where they finished second with a two-round score of 565 (-11). Junior Alex Schaake recorded the best finish for the Hawkeyes, tying for second with a 36-hole score of 139 (-5).

RECORD PERFORMANCE

The Hawkeyes etched their name into the program record books for their performance at the Notre Dame Fighting Irish Classic. lowa carded a 277 (-7) in the final round to tie for the sixth lowest 18-hole score in program history. Schaake's 54-hole score of 203 (-10) set a new school record, while his 67 (-4) in the final round tied for the fifth lowest 18-hole score. Weinberg's 54-hole score of 205 (-8) set a new career best and tied Raymond Knoll for the second lowest 54-hole score.

SCHAAKE LEADING THE WAY

Schaake leads the Hawkeyes, posting nine of his 14 rounds this season at or below par. The Omaha, Nebraska, native has registered the top individual finish for lowa in two of their five tournaments, finishing tied for second at the Golfweek Conference Challenge and tied for seventh at the Notre Dame Fighting Irish Classic. Schaake fired all three rounds below par at the Notre Dame Fighting Irish Classic, including two four-below (67). He leads lowa with four top-20 finishes, three top-10 finishes, a stroke average of 70.7, and is tied for the team lead low 18-hole score of 67.

STAYING HOT IN THE WINTER

Junior Alex Schaake and senior Matthew Walker competed in the 2018 South Beach International Amateur, Dec. 19-22, at the Miami Beach Golf Club. Schaake finished eighth with a four-round score of 279 (-5). Walker posted a four-round score of 285 (+7), tying for 23rd.

HAWKEYE NEWCOMER

Sophomore Joe Kim joined the Iowa men's golf program in January after transferring from Indian Hills Community College. The Castle Hill, NSW Australia, native led Indian Hills to the 2018 NJCAA National Championship. He recorded a fifth-place individual finish at the NJCAA Championship. Kim will be eligible to compete beginning with the Colleton River Collegiate (March 4-5).

STAYING BELOW PAR

Junior Benton Weinberg carded three-straight rounds below par at the Notre Dame Fighting Irish Classic. He tied a career-low 18-hole score with a 67 (-4) in the second round. Weinberg has four rounds at or below par this season and a stroke average of 71.6.

LOOKING AHEAD

lowa will travel to Rio Grande, Puerto Rico, for the Puerto Rico Classic, Feb. 17-19.
