The University of Iowa softball team finishes a four game home stretch with a mid-week matchup against Western Illinois on Tuesday at 7 p.m. (CT).

## DOOZY DOOCY

- Doocy strikeout tracker: 156 in 150.1 innings pitched.
- Doocy leads lowa with a 1.54 ERA and 156 strikeouts in 150.1 innings of action.
- The Ankeny, Iowa, native is fourth in the Big Ten with a 1.54 ERA and third with 156 strikeouts.
- She went 2-0 in the circle with a 1.50 ERA and two compete games, throwing 18 strikeouts in 14 innings, helping the Hawkeyes sweep their weekend series against Wisconsin (4/7-8).
- After pitching a shutout game against Wisconsin, throwing 18 strikeouts in a combined 14 innings, and aiding the Hawkeye in their sweep of the Badgers, Doocy was named Big Ten Pitcher of the Week (April 9). It was the second time she received the honor.
- Doocy was also selected as the College Sports Madness Big Ten Player of the Week on April 9.
- Doocy led lowa to a 4-3 win over 17th-ranked Michigan on March 23, ending the Wolverines 18game win streak.
- After a career-high 15 strikeouts and a 2-0 weekend, Doocy was named co-Big Ten Pitcher of the Week on March 12. This was the first Pitcher of the Week award for Doocy and the first time a Hawkeye has earned the honor since Kayla Massey on March 31, 2014.
- Doocy was also selected as the College Sports Madness Big Ten Player of the Week on March 12.

## BOGIED

- Freshman Aralee Bogar has 35 hits, 21 runs, 19 stolen bases, and a .276 batting average during her time in Black and Gold.
- Bogar leads lowa with 21 runs and 19 stolen bases.
- She is third in the Big Ten with 19 stolen bases.
   She is currently a perfect 19-for-19 in stolen base attempts. She is the only student-athlete in the top five with a perfect stolen base percentage.
- Bogar is also fourth in conference action with four triples this season.
- She helped the Hawkeyes in their series sweep over Wisconsin when she hit her first career home run in game three.

## **WOOD AT THE DISH**

- Senior Allie Wood leads the Hawkeyes with seven doubles, two triples, and 18 RBIs.
- Wood hit her fourth home run of the season in lowa's series finale against Wisconsin.
- She led the Hawkeyes at the plate against the 13th-ranked Sun Devils on March 14. Wood had two hits with a double for a .400 batting average.

## **HOW SWEEP IT IS**

- On April 7 and 8 the Hawkeyes swept Wisconsin for the first time since 2010.
- In game two, lowa trailed Wisconsin by three runs in the bottom of the seventh when the Hawkeyes came back and scored four runs for the victory.
- Three Hawkeyes hit home runs in the series finale, including senior Allie Wood, freshman Aralee Bogar, and senior Angela Schmiederer.
- The last time three Hawkeyes hit homers in a single game was April 6, 2016 when lowa defeated Purdue, 10-3.
- It was lowa's first Big Ten sweep of the season and its first since sweeping Nebraska last season (April 12).

## SLUGGIN' SCHNEIDER

- The Hawkeyes are 3-0 when Schneider hits a home run.
- The Southlake, Texas, native sent a two-run shot deep over the right-center field wall in Iowa's 3-1 win over No. 8 Baylor.
- Schneider hit her second home run of the season
   -- and the first grand slam of her career -- to lift
   lowa to a 4-3 victory over Creighton on March 17.
- Schneider hit a solo home run in game two of lowa's weekend series against Wisconsin. The homer was her third this season.
- Sophomore McKenzie Schneider hit her first career triple and registered her ninth RBI of the season to give lowa the advantage in its 4-3 win over No. 17 Michigan, ending the Wolverines 18-game win streak.

## KILIAN KILLIN' IT

- Junior Mallory Kilian leads lowa with a .505 slugging percentage and five home runs. She has a career-high five stolen bases and 20 runs scored.
- The Fort Dodge, lowa, native hit her team-leading fifth home run of the season against Maryland on March 31.
- She recorded lowa's first home run at Pearl Field for the 2018 season against South Dakota State on March 21. It was her fourth homer of the season and the ninth of her career.

## **WESTERN ILLINOIS**

- The Leathernecks are 13-22 on the season.
- Haily Duwa leads Western Illinois with a .369 batting average, 38 hits. and 24 RBI.
- In the circle, Emily Ira owns a 3.59 ERA with 115 strikeouts in 101.1 innings pitched.

## **TOP 25 VICTORIES**

- The Hawkeyes picked up their third win over a ranked opponent on March 23 when they defeated No. 17 Michigan, 4-3, ending the Wolverines 18-game win streak.
- After defeating No. 8 Baylor, 3-1, in their final game at the Judi Garman Classic on March 4, the Hawkeyes topped No. 13 Arizona State in Tempe, Arizona, on March 14.
- Sophomore pitcher Allison Doocy earned all three wins for the Hawkeyes.
- This is the first time lowa has defeated three ranked opponents in a season since 2015 when lowa topped No. 17 UCF (3-2), No. 4 Michigan (6-4) and No. 12 Minnesota (2-0) at the Big Ten Tournament.

## **COMPLETE GAMES**

- Four Hawkeyes have thrown complete games this season: freshman Lauren Shaw, sophomore Allison Doocy, junior Erin Riding, and senior Kenzie Ihle.
- Doocy leads the team with 16 complete games, including four conference victories.
- Riding threw a five-inning run rule performance on Feb. 17 against Butler at the Texas A&M Invitational. She gave up two hits and no walks in the 8-0 win.
- Shaw pitched a 5-0 victory over Georgetown on March 10 at the Grand Canyon Invitational. She had a career-high six strikeouts and allowed just four hits in 7.0 innings pitched. It was Shaw's first career shutout.
- Senior pitcher Kenzie Ihle threw her first complete game in Iowa's run-rule win over UW Green Bay on March 27. Ihle threw a career-high eight strikeouts in the six inning, 9-1 victory



## **HEAD COACH MARLA LOOPER**

Marla Looper is in her seventh season at the helm of the University of lowa softball program in 2017. Looper owns a 170-236-1 overall record and a 67-105 mark in Big Ten play since the 2011 season.



The Hawkeyes also earned the Community Service Award at the Golden Herkys, the annual award ceremony for the University of Iowa athletics department. The softball team completed approximately 750 hours of community service, more than any other Iowa team.

lowa excelled in the classroom during the 2016-17 academic year, with seven Hawkeyes earning Academic All-Big Ten honors in the spring. Kurtz was also named a Big Ten Distinguished Scholar.

Under Looper's guidance in 2016, Kaitlyn Mullarkey collected a team-high nine home runs, which tied for eighth in singleseason home runs in program history. Mullarkey currently ranks tied for 15th in program history with 15 career home runs.

In 2015, Looper led the Hawkeyes to their deepest Big Ten Tournament run since 2008. After earning the No. 10 seed with an 8-15 conference record (19-40 overall), the Hawkeyes overcame a three-run deficit against seventh-seeded Rutgers to win the opening round of the tournament on May 7. The Hawkeyes then upset the nationally ranked Gophers with a 2-0 victory to secure lowa's third win over a ranked opponent on the season (No. 17 UCF, No. 4 Michigan). After falling behind early in its semifinal game against third-seeded Nebraska, lowa rallied to come within three runs, but fell short of a comeback as the Huskers notched the 9-6 victory.

Looper collected her 100th career victory in the 2014 season finale. On the season, lowa posted 16 wins -- nine in conference action and three over ranked opponents (16-30-1).

In 2013, Looper's third year with the Hawkeyes, the squad amassed 30 wins (30-24), which was the most wins for the program since a 42-16 record in 2009. lowa posted six wins over ranked opponents.

During her second season with the Hawkeyes in 2012, Looper led the team to a runner-up finish in the Big Ten — the program's highest finish since winning the league title in 2003. Iowa dropped two of its first three conference series before winning five straight to close out the season. It was the first time the team had won five straight series since the 2004 season.

lowa entered the final weekend with a conference title within reach, but it could not close the gap with Michigan despite taking 2-of-3 games at Minnesota. The Hawkeyes finished with a 27-26 overall record and a 16-8 mark in conference play in 2012. The Hawkeyes finished second in the Big Ten in pitching (2.31 ERA) and third in fielding (.967). The squad turned 26 double plays during the course of the season to rank sixth nationally in double plays per game (.49).

Looper guided the Hawkeyes to a 27-24 overall and a 9-11 Big Ten record in her first season in Iowa City in 2011. The first-year head coach led the UI to a pair of six game winning streaks in her opening campaign and a tournament title at the Stetson Classic.

lowa opened Big Ten Conference play strong with an 8-3 record. Among the victories was a 4-2 triumph at No. 1 Michigan. The win, which pushed the overall mark to 26-16, was lowa's first over a No. 1 ranked opponent since the 2005 season and the first over a ranked foe since 2008.

Looper's Hawkeyes were on the verge of completing a series sweep in Ann Arbor before the Wolverines rallied from a 2-0 deficit in the bottom of the seventh inning to claim the victory.

A pair of Hawkeyes earned All-Big Ten recognition at the conclusion of the season. Liz Watkins was tabbed as a second team selection, while Katie Keim earned third team accolades.

Looper took over the reigns of the Iowa program after serving as an assistant coach at the University of Texas for 11 seasons (1999-2010). Looper helped lead the Longhorns to three College World Series appearances (2003, 2005 and 2006) and nine NCAA Tournament berths.
