PRACTICE ATTENDANCE/INTERVIEWS

Practice is open to the media each Tuesday, and interviews may be conducted 15 minutes prior to practice at 2:15 p.m. (CT). Media must inform <u>Jack Rossi</u> of their intention to attend practice <u>at least 24 hours in advance</u>. The Hawkeyes practice at Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

HAWKEYES SWEEP NO. 22 WASHINGTON STATE

- Iowa defeated No. 22 Washington State on Aug. 31 for the team's first win over a ranked team this season and second win overall.
- The victory is lowa's first win over a ranked opponent on the road since Oct. 12, 2012, when lowa downed the Boilermakers in West Lafayette.
- lowa held the edge in kills (46-28), blocks (6-5), assists (37-26), and digs (49-43).
- Senior Meghan Buzzerio and junior Griere Hughes led Iowa with 12 kills each.
- Junior Brie Orr added a match-high 32 assists.
- Junior Halle Johnston tallied 21 digs.

THREE AND OH MY

- After the first weekend of competition, lowa shares the Big Ten lead with four other teams.
- After going 3-0 at the JMU Invitational, interim head coach Vicki Brown is the first head coach in school history to win her first three matches.
- lowa is one of three conference teams to go 2-0 at a neutral site and is one of two teams to remain undefeated without having played a home match.

BREAKOUT WEEKEND FOR HUGHES

- Junior Griere Hughes has been lowa's most effective outside hitter through the first weekend.
- After playing in only three sets in 2018, Hughes played in all 10 of lowa's sets, tallying a team-high .404 hitting percentage, which ranks 10th in the Big Ten.
- Hughes set a career high with 14 kills in the season opening sweep over Stony Brook.
- Hughes' efforts translate to the defensive side where she is tied for second on the team with seven total blocks and leads all outside hitters.

SISTER ACT

- Senior Meghan Buzzerio and sophomore Courtney Buzzerio have provided lowa a potent spark on offense.
- The Buzzerio sisters have combined for 43% (60-137) of lowa's kills and 66.7% (10-15) of lowa's service aces and through three matches.
- In her first season as a right-side hitter, Courtney Buzzerio has added 20 kills through three matches to rank fourth on the team.
- Meghan Buzzerio leads the Hawkeyes with 40 kills and four kills per set. She ranks 14th in the conference with a .374 hitting percentage.

HIT IT!

- lowa is among the Big Ten's best in hitting percentage and opponent hitting percentage through the first weekend.
- The Hawkeyes rank third in the Big Ten with a .331 team attack percentage, earning 137 kills in 308 attempts with 35 errors.
- Defensively, the Hawkeyes have held opponents to a .105 hitting percentage to place fourth among Big Ten foes.

24TH-RANKED RECRUITING CLASS

- The Hawkeyes' 2019 recruiting class was ranked 24th in the nation by FloVolleyball last spring.
- Iowa is bringing in eight new faces, including Joslyn Boyer, Emma Lowes, Kyndra Hansen, Blythe Rients, Emma Grunkemeyer, Grace Tubbs, Edina Schmidt, and Jaedynn Evans.
- Of Iowa's eight newcomers, two are from Iowa (Evans, Tubbs), while Hansen and Rients are from Minnesota, Boyer is from Illinois, Grunkemeyer is from Nebraska, Lowes is from Texas, and Schmidt is from Germany.

NEW HEAD HAWKEYE

- Vicki Brown was named interim head coach on May 20, 2019, after serving as associate head coach for two seasons, when she was in charge of lowa's defense and recruiting efforts.
- Under Brown's guidance, lowa brought in the 24th-ranked recruiting class in the nation in 2019.

FACING THE BEST

- lowa faces seven teams currently ranked in the American Volleyball Coaches Association (AVCA) Week one poll - Nebraska (2), Wisconsin (4), Illinois (5), Penn State (6), Minnesota (8), Michigan (14), and Purdue (17).
- In each of the last three years, the Big Ten has been represented by two teams in the NCAA Final Four.
- 14 of lowa's 31 matches are against ranked teams, 12 against teams inside the Big Ten.
- Seven of lowa's final 10 matches this season are against teams ranked inside the top-25.

MORE FROM ORR

- Junior Brie Orr enters her junior year as team captain.
- Orr has amassed 2,541 assists in her career to rank seventh in program history. She trails Barb Zvonek for sixth all-time.
- Orr's 1,242 assists in 2018 are the second most in program history since the 25-point scoring format was implemented in 2008.
- Orr has played in every match in her career, averaging 10.35 assists per set.

WE'RE THE CAPTAINS NOW

Heading into the 2019 season, lowa has three team captains: seniors Emily Bushman and Meghan Buzzerio, and junior Brie Orr.

HOW'S THE WEATHER UP THERE?

- With the addition of eight freshman, the Hawkeyes got taller in the offseason.
- Of lowa's eight newcomers, four are 6-2 or taller, including Grace Tubbs (6-4), Emma Grunkemeyer (6-3), Blythe Rients (6-2), and Kyndra Hansen (6-2).

THE PREMIER CONFERENCE

- The Big Ten Conference has had an NCAA champion in nine of the last 15 years.
- Seven teams Penn State, Michigan, Nebraska, Illinois, Wisconsin, Minnesota, and Purdue, – appeared in the 2018 NCAA Tournament.

UI HEAD COACH VICKI BROWN



Vicki Brown 3rd Season (1st as HC) Alma Mater: Illinois, 2008

Vicki Brown -- a University of Illinois graduate and Toledo, Ohio, native -- took over the lowa volleyball program in 2019 after two seasons as associate head coach.

At Iowa

- Vicki Brown was named interim head coach of the lowa volleyball team on May 20, 2019.
- Brown was named Associate Head Coach in April 2017 to help lead the Hawkeye recruiting efforts and run the defense.
- With Brown on staff, the Hawkeyes have secured two consecutive seasons with 15 or more wins the program's longest streak since they accomplished the feat from 1986-90.
- lowa opened the 2017 season 12-3, its best start since 1994. The Hawkeyes swept Rutgers, 3-0, in their conference opener on Sept. 22, 2017, marking the first time lowa won its conference opener since 2009.
- lowa finished the 2017 season 18-15 overall the highest win total since
- In 2018, Brown helped lowa to another 15-win season, including the program's highest ranked win in its history with a five-set victory over sixthranked Wisconsin on Oct. 6, 2018.
- Senior Taylor Louis was named second-team All-Big Ten to become the program's first first- or second-team honoree since 2001.
- Brown helped lowa garner its highest ranked recruiting class in program history, bringing in the 24th-ranked recruiting class in the nation in the summer of 2019.

Prior to UI

- Brown came to lowa after one year as the head coach of both the indoor and beach volleyball teams at the University of San Francisco.
- Prior to that, Brown spent the 2014-15 season at UC Davis where she worked as the team's recruiting coordinator as well as organizing team travel throughout the year.
- For two seasons, Brown coached under Melissa Myers at Illinois State, helping the Redbirds to a combined 37-25 record. She primarily worked on
- defensive strategy, scouting, and recruiting. In 2013 under Brown's guidance, Emily Schneider and LeaghAnn Hranka ranked among the top three MVC leaders in blocks, and the Illinois State defense led the confernce with a .153 opposing attack average.
- Brown spent time as a volunteer assistant at Toledo, where she worked with opposites, liberos and defensive specialists. She also served as the head coach for the Toledo Volleyball Club 14s and 15s squad, becoming the leading expert in implementing training ideas for all age-group coaches. Following her collegiate career, Brown enjoyed a professional career with
- stops in Austria, Puerto Rico, and Spain.
- Brown played collegiately at Illinois from 2004-07. She was named All-Big Ten her junior and senior seasons, amassing over 1,000 career kills and breaking the century mark in blocks for three straight years.
- Brown graduated from Illinois in 2008 with a degree in communications.

- Brown earned a bachelor of communications degree in 2008.
 - She is a native of Toledo, Ohio.
