ON THE MAT

The second-ranked University of Iowa wrestling team hosts Tennessee-Chattanooga on Sunday at 2 p.m. in the 2019-20 season opener at Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

IOWA VS. CHATTANOOGA

Iowa and Chattanooga are meeting for the fourth time, and the first time at Carver-Hawkeye Arena. The Hawkeyes are 3-0 all-time against the Mocs. The Hawkeyes won the first meeting, 47-0, in 2011, and the most recent meeting, 44-3, in 2015.

HAWKEYE WRESTLING HISTORY

The Hawkeyes have won 23 national titles and 35 Big Ten titles. Iowa's 55 NCAA Champions have won a total of 84 NCAA individual titles, crowning six three-time and 17 two-time champions. The Hawkeyes' 113 Big Ten champions have combined for 200 conference titles. There have been seven four-time, 18 three-time, and 30 two-time Big Ten champions from Iowa.

Iowa's 157 All-Americans have earned All-America status 335 times, including 20 four-time, 36 three-time and 42 two-time honorees.

lowa earned its 1,000th dual win in program history Nov. 9, 2018, topping California State Bakersfield, 36-3, in Kent, Ohio. Iowa is one of four NCAA Division I schools with 1,000 program wins (Oklahoma State, Iowa State, Oregon State). The Hawkeyes' overall dual meet record is 1,013-232-31 (.799) in 109 seasons.

A LOOK BACK ON THE MAT

The Hawkeyes finished the 2018-19 season with one NCAA individual champion, six All-Americans, and a school-record 13 academic All-Big Ten honors. The Hawkeyes were 14-1 overall and 9-0 in the Big Ten, sharing the regular season conference title with Penn State.

HOME SWEET HOME

Spencer Lee, Alex Marinelli, and Jacob Warner are undefeated in their careers at Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

Marinelli is 12-0 all-time at Carver. Lee owns a record of 11-0. Warner is undefeated in four home matches.

In Lee's 11 home wins, he has four pins, four technical falls, and one major decision. Four of the wins are against top 10 opponents.

Among Marinelli's 12 wins, he has five pins, three technical falls, and one major decision. He was 7-0 this year at home with bonus points in each match.

BIG DEBUT

Redshirt freshman Tony Cassioppi is set to make his collegiate debut Sunday.

lowa's heavyweight steps into the roll previously occupied by Sam Stoll, a 2018 All-American that owned a 24-4 all-time record at Carver-Hawkeye

Arena from 2015-2019.

Stoll stepped into the heavyweight position behind three-time All-American Bobby Telford. Telford was 30-5 all-time at Carver-Hawkeye Arena from 2011-15.

Telford recorded a fall in 2:17 in his Carver debut in 2011. Stoll recorded a fall in 1:36 in his Carver debut in 2015.

Cassioppi's teammate, sophomore Aaron Costello, won his Carver debut, 6-0, in 2018.

IOWA ALL-AMERICANS

Iowa crowned six All-Americans in 2019. Sophomores Spencer Lee and Alex Marinelli returned to the podium for the second straight season. Junior Pat Lugo earned his first All-America honor, as did sophomores Austin DeSanto and Kaleb Young, and redshirt freshman Jacob Warner.

Warner became the ninth Hawkeye freshman since 2007 to earn All-America honors (Matt McDonough 2010; Derek St. John, 2011; Bobby Telford, 2012; Cory Clark, 2014; Brandon Sorensen, 2015; Michael Kemerer, 2017; Spencer Lee, 2018; Alex Marinelli, 2018; Jacob Warner, 2019). McDonough won the national title in 2010 at 125 pounds. Lee won the national title in 2018 at 125 pounds.

BIG TEN REGULAR SEASON CO-CHAMPS

lowa won a share of the 2019 Big Ten regular season title with a 35-2 win at Wisconsin on Feb. 17. The Hawkeyes were 9-0 in conference duals and shared the title with Penn State.

The Hawkeyes have won or shared the Big Ten dual championships 11 times since the conference started recognizing a dual meet champion in 1999. Iowa won the title outright in 2000, 2008, 2009, 2010, 2011, 2013, and 2015, and shared the title in 2003, 2014, 2016, and 2019.

The Hawkeyes have eight undefeated conference seasons since 2006-07, head coach Tom Brands' first year.

HAWKEYES AND CARVER-HAWKEYE ARENA

The Hawkeyes are 255-25 all-time at Carver-Hawkeye Arena since moving from the UI Field House in 1983. Iowa was 7-0 at home last season, completing its 21st undefeated season in Carver-Hawkeye Arena. The Hawkeyes have recorded 21 undefeated seasons in Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

Carver-Hawkeye Arena has hosted two United States Olympic Team Trials, four Big Ten Championships (1983, 1994, 2005, 2016), and four NCAA Championships (1986, 1991, 1995, 2001). The Hawkeyes have won five tournament titles on their home mat, including the 1983 and 1994 Big Ten Championships, and the 1986, 1991 and 1995 NCAA Championships

In 2018, the University of Iowa hosted the UWW World Cup, an international dual tournament featuring eight of the top countries in the world.

Tom BrandsHead Coach University of Iowa, 1992

Three-time Big Ten Coach of the Year Tom Brands is in his 13th season as head wrestling coach at the University of Iowa in 2019. A 1996 Olympic gold medalist and member of wrestling's Hall of Fame, Brands is only the eighth wrestling coach at the University of Iowa. The former Hawkeye wrestler was a four-time All-American and three-time na-

tional champion (1989-92) at lowa. He has a 218-23-1 (.903) overall and 99-10 (.908) Big Ten coaching record at lowa. He has a 235-43-1 (.844) career mark.

In 13 seasons as lowa's head coach, Brands has led the Hawkeyes to three NCAA and four Big Ten team titles, crowning 12 NCAA champions, 16 Big Ten champions and 72 All-Americans. Iowa has had 112 Academic All-Big Ten recipients, including a school-record 13 in 2018-19. The Hawkeyes have qualified 118 wrestlers for the NCAA Championships in the last 13 years, sending the entire 10-man lineup in 2009, 2010, 2014, and 2015. Iowa has also won or shared nine of the last 12 Big Ten regular season titles.

lowa set the national collegiate dual meet attendance record of 42,287 when lowa defeated top-ranked Oklahoma State, 18-16, on Nov. 14, 2015 at the Grapple on the Gridiron at Kinnick Stadium. Iowa has led the nation in attendance in each of Brands' 13 seasons, setting an NCAA all-time attendance average of 12,166 in 2015-16.

Brands was named 2008 NWCA Coach of the Year after leading the Hawkeyes to their first NCAA team title since 2000 and their first Big Ten team title since 2004. He was named Big Ten Coach of the Year in 2008, 2009 and 2010, becoming the first coach in conference history to earn the honor in three consecutive seasons.

Brands served as head coach at Virginia Tech University for two seasons (2005-06), recording a 17-20 dual mark. In his first season with the Hokies, Brands led the team to the 2005 regular season Atlantic Coast Conference title, set a school record for dual meet wins (16) and had a school-record five wrestlers qualify for the NCAA Championships. During his tenure, Virginia Tech crowned five ACC champions and had two All-Americans. Senior heavy-weight Mike Faust was named 2006 ACC Wrestler of the Year.

Prior to taking the helm at Virginia Tech, Brands was an assistant coach at lowa for 12 seasons (1993-2004). He helped the Hawkeyes to a 177-27 dual record, seven NCAA and eight Big Ten team titles, while crowning 23 NCAA champions, 73 All-Americans and 36 Big Ten champions. He was named the National Wrestling Coaches Association Assistant Coach of the Year in 2000.

In 2004, he was one of three coaches for the U.S. Olympic freestyle wrestling team, participating in Athens, and in 2016 he was named a volunteer coach of the United States Olympic team in Rio. Brands also served as assistant coach for the U.S. Freestyle World Teams in 2001, 2002, 2003, 2013, 2014, and 2015. He was named Freestyle Coach of the Year by USA Wrestling in 2002 and 2003. He has coached a number of other U.S. teams in international competition.

As a competitor, Brands won the 1996 Olympic freestyle gold medal at 136.5 pounds in Atlanta, Georgia. He also won a gold medal at the 1993 World Freestyle Championships in Toronto, two World Cup gold medals (1994, 1995) and was the 1995 Pan American Games champion. He won four U.S. National titles (1993-96) and made four straight U.S. World or Olympic teams (1993-96). Along with his twin brother, Terry, Tom was named 1993 USA Wrestling Athlete of the Year, the 1993 John Smith Outstanding Freestyle Wrestler, and 1993 Amateur Wrestling News Man of the Year. He was inducted into wrestling's Hall of Fame in 2001.

Brands was a four-time All-American at Iowa (1989-92). During his Hawkeye career, he won three NCAA titles and was named Outstanding Wrestler of the 1992 NCAA Championships. Also a three-time Big Ten champion, Brands won 95 percent of his matches at Iowa. His career mark of 158-7-2 includes an undefeated season in 1991 (45-0).

The Sheldon, Iowa, native was born April 9, 1968. He earned his B.S. degree in physical education from Iowa in 1992. He and his wife, Jeni, have three adult children, Madigan, Kinsee and Tommy.


