ON THE MAT

The fourth-ranked University of Iowa wrestling team wrestles at No. 20 Illinois on Friday at 8 p.m. (CT) and at Northwestern on Sunday at 2 p.m. The Illini host the Hawkeyes at Huff Hall. The Wildcats host the Hawkeyes at Welsh-Ryan Arena.

WHERE TO WATCH

Friday's dual at Illinois is televised by BTN. Shane Sparks and Ken Chertow call the action.

IOWA VS. ILLINOIS

The Hawkeyes own a 51-26-1 series advantage over the Illini and have won eight straight in the series, including the last three in Champaign. Iowa is 22-17 all-time in Champaign.

The Hawkeyes haven't lost at Illinois since Jan. 28, 2005 (25-7). The Hawkeyes lost 21 of the first 22 meetings in the series that began in 1920, but have since won 50-of-56 with one tie (12-12 in 1952). Iowa's largest win in the series was 52-0 in 1984. Illinois' largest win of the series was 34-8 in 1922. Iowa head coach Tom Brands is 8-0 all-time against the Illini. Illinois head coach Jim Heffernan is a graduate of the University of Iowa. Heffernan was a four-time All-American from 1983-87 and won the 1986 NCAA title.

IOWA VS. NORTHWESTERN

Iowa leads the all-time series, 72-7-1. Iowa has won 12 straight against Northwestern and owns an all-time mark of 34-4-1 in Evanston. The Hawkeyes have won five straight road duals against the Wildcats. Northwestern's last win in the series was a 22-19 victory in Evanston on Jan. 29, 2005. The Hawkeyes are 11-0 against Northwestern under head coach Tom Brands.

SPENCER LEE, 125, SOPHOMORE

Sophomore Spencer Lee is ranked No. 2 in the country. He is 11-1 overall with nine bonus-point victories. He leads the Hawkeyes with six technical falls.

Lee is scheduled to face Travis Piotrowski on Friday and Sebastian Rivera on Sunday. He has never met Piotrowski. He is 2-1 all-time against Rivera. Lee is 3-1 this year against ranked opponents.

Lee is 8-0 this year against unranked opponents, and has scored bonus points in each of those matches (one major decision, five technical falls, and two pins).

AUSTIN DESANTO, 133, SOPHOMORE

Sophomore Austin DeSanto is ranked No. 4 in the country with an overall record of 12-1. He has scored bonus points in seven matches this season and is riding an eight-match winning streak.

DeSanto has won two straight against top six opponents (Ethan Lizak 6-1, Nick Suriano 6-4) and is 5-1 this year against ranked opponents. He was named Big Ten co-Wrestler of the Week (Jan. 22) following his win against Suriano.

DeSanto faces No. 17 Dylan Duncan on Friday. He defeated Duncan in the semifinals of the 2018 Midlands Championships.

MAX MURIN, 141, R-FRESHMAN

Redshirt freshman Max Murin was the Midlands runner-up at 141. He is 10-3 overall with two of those losses to top 10 opponents: No. 9 Josh Alber (UNI), 5-2, in the Midlands finals; No. 6 Mitch McKee (MINN), 5-3, Jan. 13 at Minnesota.

Murin is ranked No. 15 in the country and is scheduled to face No. 4 Mike Carr on Friday and Alex McKenna on Sunday. He has never faced McKenna. He is 1-0 all-time against Carr, with a 3-2 win at the 2017 Midlands Championships.

Murin is 8-1 this season against unranked wrestlers, with three pins and three major decisions.

PAT LUGO, 149, JUNIOR

Junior Pat Lugo enters the weekend ranked No. 13 with an 8-6 record. He is scheduled to face Christian Kanzler on Friday and Shane Oster on Sunday. Neither wrestler is ranked.

KALEB YOUNG, 157, SOPHOMORE

Sophomore Kaleb Young opened the season ranked 15th in the country by Intermat and has climbed to No. 5 entering Friday's dual.

Young faces No. 12 Eric Barone on Friday and No. 3 Ryan Deakin on Sunday. No. 14 John Van Brill on Friday. It is his fourth and fifth straight match against a ranked opponent. He has won two straight against ranked opponents and is 5-1 this season against ranked opponents. His only loss is to Deakin (6-2) in the Midlands finals.

Young has wins over No. 14 Griffin Parriott (Pin 3:37), No. 15 Josh Humphreys (4-1), No. 16 Luke Weiland (15-0), No. 9 Steve Bleise (7-1), and No. 14 John Van Brill. He was named Big Ten Wrestler of the Week following his win over Parriott. Young is 13-1 with three pins, three technical falls, and a major decision.

ALEX MARINELLI, 165, SOPHOMORE

Sophomore Alex Marinelli is 11-0 in his career in Big Ten duals. Marinelli will face former teammate Joey Gunther on Friday. It is the first career meeting between the two. Gunther transferred to Illinois after three years at Iowa. Marinelli faces Tyler Morland on Sunday. It is the first meeting between the two. Neither wrestler is ranked. Marinelli is 10-0 against with 10 bonus point victories against unranked wrestlers this season.

Marinelli has climbed to No. 2 in the national rankings following his Midlands Championship on Dec. 30. Marinelli defeated Evan Wick, 4-3, in the 165-pound Midlands finals. It was his second straight Midlands title. He was 5-0 in the tournament with wins over Wick, No. 5 Joshua Shields (4-1), and No. 19 Jonathan Viruet (8-6 SV1). The No. 2 ranking matches his career best. He was ranked No. 2 the final two weeks of the 2018 regular season.

174, SENIOR MITCH BOWMAN // JUNIOR JEREMIAH MOODY

Senior Mitch Bowman, a national qualifier at 184 last season, has wrestled at 197 (2-0) and 174 (2-3) this season. Moody has made one dual appearance at 174, a 12-3 loss to Lehigh's sixth-ranked Jordan Kutler. Moody is 6-3 this season at 157, 2-2 at 165, and 0-1 at 174. The competition this weekend includes Illinois' Carver James and Northwestern's Johnny Sebastian. There is no history between any of the four wrestlers.

CASH WILCKE, 184, JUNIOR

Junior Cash Wilcke is 12-2 this season and ranked No. 13 in the country. He is scheduled to face No. 2 Emery Parker of Illinois on Friday, and Northwestern's Brendan Devine on Sunday. He has never faced either competitor. His teammate, Mitch Bowman, lost a 5-3 decision to Parker in the dual last season. Wilcke is 0-1 this year against ranked opponents. He fell to No. 7 Drew Foster, 3-2, in the 184-pound finals of the Midlands Championships.

JACOB WARNER, 197, R-FRESHMAN

Redshirt freshman Jacob Warner is a three-time Illinois high school state champion for Washington HS. He is 2-0 in his brief Big Ten dual career. He is scheduled to face Andre Lee on Friday and Zach Chakonis on Sunday. He has never faced either wrestler. His teammate, Cash Wilcke, had two overtime wins against Lee last season.

Warner has climbed to No. 5 in the country following an 8-2 start to the season. He opened the year ranked No. 13 by Intermat.

285, SENIOR SAM STOLL // R-FRESHMAN AARON COSTELLO

Senior Sam Stoll is 4-0 in limited action this season. He could potential face Illinois' Deuce Rachal on Friday, and No. 15 Canan Jennings on Sunday. Stoll pinned Rachal in their only meeting. The fall gave Iowa a walk-off 18-17 win in the dual meet last season. Stoll is 4-0 all-time, with two pins, against Jennings. Redshirt freshman Aaron Costello is 6-4 overall. He has not wrestled in a dual since Dec. 8 against Lehigh. He has no history with either opponent



Tom Brands Head Coach University of Iowa, 1992

Three-time Big Ten Coach of the Year Tom Brands is in his 13th season as head wrestling coach at the University of Iowa in 2018. A 1996 Olympic gold medalist and member of wrestling's Hall of Fame, Brands is only the eighth wrestling coach at the University of Iowa. The former Hawkeye wrestler was a four-time All-American and three-time

national champion (1989-92) at Iowa. He has a 212-22-1 (.901) overall and 93-10 (.903) Big Ten coaching record at Iowa, and a 228-42-1 (.839) career mark.

In 12 full seasons as Iowa's head coach, Brands has led the Hawkeyes to three NCAA and four Big Ten team titles, crowning 11 NCAA champions, 15 Big Ten champions and 66 All-Americans. Iowa has had 99 Academic All-Big Ten recipients, including a school-record 12 in 2011-12. The Hawkeyes have qualified 109 wrestlers for the NCAA Championships in the last 12 years, sending the entire 10-man lineup in 2009, 2010, 2014, and 2015. Iowa has also won or shared eight of the last 11 Big Ten regular season titles.

Iowa also made another entry in the record books, setting the national collegiate dual meet attendance record of 42,287 when Iowa defeated top-ranked Oklahoma State, 18-16, on Nov. 14, 2015 at the Grapple on the Gridiron at Kinnick Stadium. Iowa has led the nation in attendance in each of Brands' 11 seasons, setting an NCAA all-time attendance average of 12,166 in 2015-16.

Brands was named 2008 NWCA Coach of the Year after leading the Hawkeyes to their first NCAA team title since 2000 and their first Big Ten team title since 2004. He was named Big Ten Coach of the Year in 2008, 2009 and 2010, becoming the first coach in conference history to earn the honor in three consecutive seasons.

Brands served as head coach at Virginia Tech University for two seasons (2005-06), recording a 17-20 dual mark. In his first season with the Hokies, Brands led the team to the 2005 regular season Atlantic Coast Conference title, set a school record for dual meet wins (16) and had a school-record five wrestlers qualify for the NCAA Championships. During his tenure, Virginia Tech crowned five ACC champions and had two All-Americans. Senior heavy-weight Mike Faust was named 2006 ACC Wrestler of the Year.

Prior to taking the helm at Virginia Tech, Brands was an assistant coach at Iowa for 12 seasons (1993-2004). He helped the Hawkeyes to a 177-27 dual record, seven NCAA and eight Big Ten team titles, while crowning 23 NCAA champions, 73 All-Americans and 36 Big Ten champions. He was named the National Wrestling Coaches Association Assistant Coach of the Year in 2000.

In 2004, he was one of three coaches for the U.S. Olympic freestyle wrestling team, participating in Athens, and in 2016 he was named a volunteer coach of the United States Olympic team in Rio. Brands also served as assistant coach for the U.S. Freestyle World Teams in 2001, 2002, 2003, 2013, 2014, and 2015. He was named Freestyle Coach of the Year by USA Wrestling in 2002 and 2003. He has coached a number of other U.S. teams in international competition.

As a competitor, Brands won the 1996 Olympic freestyle gold medal at 136.5 pounds in Atlanta, Georgia. He also won a gold medal at the 1993 World Freestyle Championships in Toronto, two World Cup gold medals (1994, 1995) and was the 1995 Pan American Games champion. He won four U.S. National titles (1993-96) and made four straight U.S. World or Olympic teams (1993-96). Along with his twin brother, Terry, Tom was named 1993 USA Wrestling Athlete of the Year, the 1993 John Smith Outstanding Freestyle Wrestler, and 1993 Amateur Wrestling News Man of the Year. He was inducted into wrestling's Hall of Fame in 2001.

Brands was a four-time All-American at Iowa (1989-92). During his Hawkeye career, he won three NCAA titles and was named Outstanding Wrestler of the 1992 NCAA Championships. Also a three-time Big Ten champion, Brands won 95 percent of his matches at Iowa. His career mark of 158-7-2 includes an undefeated season in 1991 (45-0).

The Sheldon, Iowa, native was born April 9, 1968. He earned his B.S. degree in physical education from Iowa in 1992. He and his wife, Jeni, have three children, Madigan, Kinsee and Tommy.


