

HAWKEYE HITS

THIS WEEK

The University of Iowa softball team travels to the Creighton Invitational on Saturday-Sunday. The Hawkeyes face Wichita State on Saturday and Sunday, with both games slated for a noon (CT) start. Iowa also play Creighton on Saturday at 2:30 p.m.

KILLIN' IT KILIAN

- Junior Mallory Kilian blasted a solo home run on the first pitch at the Grand Canyon Invitational. The Hawkeyes went on to defeat Georgetown, 5-0.
- Kilian also recorded a personal-best two stolen bases against the Hoyas. These were the first two stolen bases of her career.
- Kilian leads Iowa with a .313 batting average, a .583 slugging percentage, and a .435 on-base percentage. She has a career-high four stolen bases and a team-high three home runs.

BOGIED

- Freshman Aralee Bogar has 17 hits, 14 runs, 10 stolen bases, and a .279 batting average during her time in black and gold.
- She also has a .377 slugging percentage and a .348 on-base percentage.
- Bogar is tied for second in the Big Ten with 10 stolen bases. She is currently a perfect 10-for-10 in stolen bases.

WOOD AT THE DISH

- Senior Allie Wood led the Hawkeyes at the plate against the 13th-ranked Sun Devils. She had two hits with a double for a .400 batting average.
- She also led Iowa with a .600 slugging percentage and tied a team-high .400 on-base percentage.
- Wood hit a double and scored one run in Iowa's 3-1 victory over No. 13 Arizona State.

DOOZY DOOCY

- After a career-high 15 strikeouts and a 2-0 weekend, sophomore pitcher Allison Doocy was named co-Big Ten Pitcher of the Week.
- The final 10 outs of the game against Georgetown on March 11 came from her hand.
- This was the first pitcher of the week award for Doocy and the first time a Hawkeye has earned the honor since Kayla Massey on March 31, 2014.
- Doocy was also selected as the College Sports Madness Big Ten Player of the Week.
- Doocy then led the Hawkeyes to victory against No. 13 Arizona State on Wednesday.
- The sophomore had eight strikeouts and allowed six hits and just one walk in 7.0

innings against the Sun Devils.

- Doocy leads Iowa with a 1.17 ERA and 71 strikeouts in 60.0 innings pitched.

WICHITA STATE

- The Shockers are 14-8 overall after a 7-6 victory over Western Illinois on March 11 at the Wichita State University Tournament.
- Paige Luellen leads WSU with a .390 batting average. She has 16 hits with two doubles and four home runs for a .732 slugging percentage.
- Iowa leads the series, 4-1. The Hawkeyes and Shockers last faced on Feb. 18, 2012, when Iowa registered an 11-0, five-inning victory.

CREIGHTON

- Creighton is 10-7 overall after a 7-5 win over Southeast Missouri on March 10.
- Hope Moreno leads CU with a .404 batting average. She has 19 hits with three doubles for a .532 slugging percentage.
- Creighton leads the series, 21-8. The Bluejays and Hawkeyes last faced on March 19, 2017, when Creighton secured a 4-2, eight-inning win. Iowa last defeated CU on May 17, 2008 (2-1, eight innings).
- The last four contests between the two teams have gone extra innings.

COMPLETE GAMES

- Three Hawkeyes have thrown complete games: freshman Lauren Shaw, sophomore Allison Doocy, and junior Erin Riding.
- Doocy leads the team with seven complete games, including a 3-1 victory over No. 13 Arizona State on March 14.
- Riding threw a five-inning run rule performance on Feb. 17 against Butler at the Texas A&M Invitational. She gave up two hits and no walks in the 8-0 win.
- Shaw pitched a 5-0 victory over Georgetown on March 10 at the Grand Canyon Invitational. She had a career-high six strikeouts and allowed just four hits in 7.0 innings pitched. This was also Shaw's first career shutout.

IN THE RANKINGS

Five Hawkeye opponents are ranked in the USA Today/NFCA Coaches Poll released on March 13: Texas A&M (7), Baylor (11), Arizona State (13), Michigan (19), and Louisiana-Lafayette (20). Wichita State, Minnesota, and Nebraska received votes.

Ohio State and No. 19 Michigan. Minnesota and Nebraska received votes.

SCHNEIDER GOES YARD

- Sophomore McKenzie Schneider hit her first home run of the season at the Judi Garman Classic on March 4.
- The Southlake, Texas, native sent a two-run shot deep over the right-center field wall in Iowa's 3-1 win over then-No. 8 Baylor.
- The homer was the second of her career.

RANKED VICTORIES

- After defeating then-No. 8 Baylor, 3-1, in their final game at the Judi Garman Classic on March 4, the Hawkeyes topped No. 13 Arizona State in Tempe, Arizona, on March 14.
- Sophomore pitcher Allison Doocy earned both wins for the Hawkeyes.
- Doocy recorded eight strikeouts in each game.
- Two of Doocy's eight strikeouts were against Baylor's Carlee Wallace, who had only struck out twice in 30 at-bats before Sunday's matchup.
- This is the first time Iowa has defeated two ranked opponents in a season since 2015 when Iowa topped No. 17 UCF (3-2), No. 4 Michigan (6-4), and No. 12 Minnesota (2-0).

HEAD COACH MARLA LOOPER

Marla Looper is in her seventh season at the helm of the University of Iowa softball program in 2017. Looper owns a 161-224-1 overall record and a 62-97 mark in Big Ten play since the 2011 season.

In 2017, earned a berth in the conference tournament, marking the program's 20th Big Ten Tournament appearance and tying Michigan for the conference lead in appearances.

The Hawkeyes also earned the Community Service Award at the Golden Herkys, the annual award ceremony for the University of Iowa athletics department. The softball team completed approximately 750 hours of community service, more than any other Iowa team.

Iowa excelled in the classroom during the 2016-17 academic year, with seven Hawkeyes earning Academic All-Big Ten honors in the spring. Kurtz was also named a Big Ten Distinguished Scholar.

Under Looper's guidance in 2016, Kaitlyn Mullarkey collected a team-high nine home runs, which tied for eighth in single-season home runs in program history. Mullarkey currently ranks tied for 15th in program history with 15 career home runs.



In 2015, Looper led the Hawkeyes to their deepest Big Ten Tournament run since 2008. After earning the No. 10 seed with an 8-15 conference record (19-40 overall), the Hawkeyes overcame a three-run deficit against seventh-seeded Rutgers to win the opening round of the tournament on May 7. The Hawkeyes then upset the nationally ranked Gophers with a 2-0 victory to secure Iowa's third win over a ranked opponent on the season (No. 17 UC, No. 4 Michigan). After falling behind early in its semifinal game against third-seeded Nebraska, Iowa rallied to come within three runs, but fell short of a comeback as the Huskers notched the 9-6 victory.

Looper collected her 100th career victory in the 2014 season finale. On the season, Iowa posted 16 wins -- nine in conference action and three over ranked opponents (16-30-1).

In 2013, Looper's third year with the Hawkeyes, the squad amassed 30 wins (30-24), which was the most wins for the program since a 42-16 record in 2009. Iowa posted six wins over ranked opponents.

During her second season with the Hawkeyes in 2012, Looper led the team to a runner-up finish in the Big Ten -- the program's highest finish since winning the league title in 2003. Iowa dropped two of its first three conference series before winning five straight to close out the season. It was the first time the team had won five straight series since the 2004 season.

Iowa entered the final weekend with a conference title within reach, but it could not close the gap with Michigan despite taking 2-of-3 games at Minnesota. The Hawkeyes finished with a 27-26 overall record and a 16-8 mark in conference play in 2012. The Hawkeyes finished second in the Big Ten in pitching (2.31 ERA) and third in fielding (.967). The squad turned 26 double plays during the course of the season to rank sixth nationally in double plays per game (.49).

Looper guided the Hawkeyes to a 27-24 overall and a 9-11 Big Ten record in her first season in Iowa City in 2011. The first-year head coach led the UI to a pair of six game winning streaks in her opening campaign and a tournament title at the Stetson Classic.

Iowa opened Big Ten Conference play strong with an 8-3 record. Among the victories was a 4-2 triumph at No. 1 Michigan. The win, which pushed the overall mark to 26-16, was Iowa's first over a No. 1 ranked opponent since the 2005 season and the first over a ranked foe since 2008.

Looper's Hawkeyes were on the verge of completing a series sweep in Ann Arbor before the Wolverines rallied from a 2-0 deficit in the bottom of the seventh inning to claim the victory.

A pair of Hawkeyes earned All-Big Ten recognition at the conclusion of the season. Liz Watkins was tabbed as a second team selection, while Katie Keim earned third team accolades.

Looper took over the reigns of the Iowa program after serving as an assistant coach at the University of Texas for 11 seasons (1999-2010). Looper helped lead the Longhorns to three College World Series appearances (2003, 2005 and 2006) and nine NCAA Tournament berths.
