INDIVIDUAL NOTES

FS Jack Koerner had a game and career-high 13 tackles, the most by a Hawkeyes since LB Josey Jewell had 13 against Purdue in 2017. Four more Hawkeyes set career highs in tackles: DL Cedrick Lattimore (7), DL Brady Reiff (6), LB Dillon Doyle (5), and DL Austin Schulte (4). DE Chauncey Golston tied his career high with eight tackles.

QB Nate Stanley set season highs in completions (25), attempts (43), and passing yards (286).

Three Hawkeyes set career highs in receptions and receiving yards: Brandon Smith (7-86), Nico Ragaini (7-55), and Nate Wieting (4-54). WR Ihmir Smith-Marette set a career high in receptions (5).

QB Nate Stanley threw one touchdown pass, raising his career total to 61 and tying Drew Tate for second all-time in program history. He trails Chuck Long (74) on the all-time list.

QB Nate Stanley passed for 286 yards, raising his career total to 6,862. He passed Matt Rodgers (6,725) for fifth in school history. Stanley totaled 281 yards of offense tonight, raising his career total to 6,720 yards of total offense, fifth all-time. He passed Chuck Hartlieb tonight on Iowa's all-time list.

RB Tyler Goodson's 29-yard rush in the second quarter was a career long.

RG Mark Kallenberger made his first career start.

MISCELLANEOUS

The last three games in the series have been decided by one possession.

Iowa scored three points in the first quarter. It is the first time this season Penn State allowed points in the first quarter.

Penn State won the toss and deferred. The Hawkeyes have played 259 games under head coach Kirk Ferentz. Iowa has opened the game on offense 194 times (120-74). The Hawkeyes have opened the game on defense 65 times (36-29).
