PROGRAM QUICK HITS

- Iowa has made 12 consecutive postseason appearances (10 NCAA, 2 WNIT).
- The Hawkeyes have made a postseason tournament appearance in 18 of head coach Lisa Bluder's 19 seasons at the helm of the program, receiving 14 NCAA Tournament and four WNIT (2003, 2005, 2016, 2017) bids.
- Bluder is one of 10 active Division I head coaches to win 700 games or more in her career. She is in her 36th season as a head coach and 20th at Iowa in 2019-20.
- Iowa will face 10 2019 NCAA Tournament teams this season, including nonconference opponents Princeton, Towson, Clemson, Iowa State, and Drake, and conference opponents Indiana, Maryland, Michigan, Michigan State, and Rutgers.
- Senior Kathleen Doyle was named to the Preseason All-Big Ten team.
- The Hawkeyes finished the 2018-19 season ranked first nationally in field goal percentage (51.5), second in assists per game (21.5), third in total assists (775), fourth in assist/turnover ratio (1.55), 12th in free throw percentage (77.3), 13th in fewest fouls per game (13.6), and 14th in scoring offense (78.4).
- Bluder owns a 416-221 (.653) record and a 204-125 (.620) conference mark at Iowa. In her 35 seasons as a head coach, Bluder is 772-363 (.680).

- Lang is in her fourth year as Iowa's color commentator. She lettered at Iowa from 2002-05. Lang finished her Hawkeye career with 1,265 points and 506 rebounds. She was a two-time All-Big Ten selection.

- Iowa is ranked No. 17 in the AP Poll and 20th in the USA Today Coaches Poll.
- Towa is ranked No. 17 in the AP Poll and 20th in the OSA Today Coaches Poll.

 Iowa, No.19 Northwestern, and No. 20 Indiana.

 The Hawkeyes are one of four Big Ten teams ranked in the USA Today Coaches Poll. They include: No. 10 Maryland, No. 20 Iowa, No. 21 Northwestern, and No. 23 Indiana.

ON THE SEASON

- The Hawkeyes (20-4, 11-2) won nine straight Big Ten contests the most consecutive regular-season conference wins since 1995-96 (12) between Dec. 31 (Illinois) and Jan. 30 (Penn State). Senior Kathleen Doyle (18.7), sophomore Monika Czinano (15.3), and senior Makenzie Meyer (14.8) lead
- Senior Kathleen Doyle (18.7), sophomore Monika Czinano (15.3), and senior Makenzie Meyer (14.8) lead the Hawkeyes in points per game.

 Three Hawkeyes, including Meyer (22), Doyle (21), and Czinano (20), were the first to score 20 points (Wisconsin, Jan. 19) in the same game since Megan Gustafson (25), Allie Disterhoft (22), and Chase Coley (20) did against Michigan at the Big Ten Tournament (March 3, 2016). The trio did it again at Purdue with Doyle and Meyer each scoring 22 and Czinano putting up 20 points.

 Doyle recorded an Iowa single-game record of 15 assists against Nebraska (Feb.6).

 Doyle and fellow senior Amanda Ollinger recorded their third double-doubles this season vs. Nebraska.

 Doyle tallied 15 points and 15 assists, while Ollinger scored 11 points and pulled in 13 rebounds.

 Ollinger recorded her first career double-double, scoring 12 and rebounding 14 against Illinois (Dec. 31) and followed it up with her second against Northwestern (Jan. 5) with 11 points and 12 rebounds.

 Freshman McKenna Warnock scored 22 points against Michigan State (Jan. 26), recording the first 20-point game by a freshman since Doyle (21) did during the 2016-17 season.

 Ollinger tallied a career-high eight blocks in Iowa's 66-61 win over Maryland (Jan. 9).

 Doyle scored a career high 33 points in 26 minutes against Illinois (Dec. 31) and added a second 30-point game against Indiana, finishing the double-overtime game with 31 points.

 Czinano recorded her first career double-double at Nebraska (Dec. 28), putting up 16 points and pulling in a career-high 17 rebounds. Czinano is also leading the Hawkeyes in shooting percentage (70.5).

Maryland is 12-1 in Xfinity Center this season, losing to South Carolina, 63-54. Five Terps are averaging double-figure scoring, including senior guard Kaila Charles (14.9), freshman guard Ashley Owusu (11.5), sophomore forward Shakira Austin (11.3), sophomore guard Taylor Mikesell (10.8), and senior forward Stephanie Jones (10.1).

The Terps have held opponents to 54.9 points per game, while scoring 81.5 points to lead the Big Ten in scoring margin (24.3) and rank fifth in the country.

Charles and Austin lead the Terps in rebounds with 7.8 and 6.4 rebounds, respec-

As a team, Maryland is leading the Big Ten in 10 categories – steals (300), steals per game (12.5), scoring margin (24.3), turnovers forced (22.13), scoring offense (81.5), turnover margin (7.04), offensive rebounds per game (15.5), rebounds (993), rebound margin (7.9), and rebounds per game (41.38).

Nationally, the Terps rank in the top 15 in seven categories, including third in steals (195) and steals per game (13.9), fifth in scoring margin (28.6), sixth in turnovers forced (24.21), eighth in scoring offense (83.4), ninth in turnover margin (9.07), and 14th in offensive rebounds per game (15.5).

Maryland leads the all-time series, 6-4.

In the teams' first meeting this season (Jan. 9), the Hawkeyes won, 66-61, at

Seniors Kathleen Doyle and Makenzie Meyer led the Hawkeyes with 21 and 20 points respectively. Junior Alexis Sevillian followed with 15 points. Senior Amanda Ollinger and freshman McKenna Warnock each pulled in nine rebounds.

Iowa saw Maryland twice during the 2018-19 season, sweeping the Terps for the first time in a season, including an 86-73 win on Feb. 17 and in the Big Ten Tournament title game (March 10), 90-76.

Senior Kathleen Doyle averaged 12.5 points and 4.5 assists per game last season against the Terps.

NATIONALLY SPEAKING

Iowa leads the nation in field goals assisted (71.2 percent) with 484 assists on 680 haskets.

The Hawkeyes rank fourth in assists per game (20.2), fifth in total assists (484) and field goal percentage (48.5), and 10th in free throws made (353). Iowa is also ranked in the top 25 in five additional categories, including 13th in scoring offense (79.1) and assist turnover ratio (1.32), and 14th in 3-point percentage (37.2), 21st in won-lost percentage (82.6), and 22nd in free throw attempts (480).

THE NATION'S TOP 50

Sophomore Monika Czinano is leading the country in field goal percentage (69.2), shooting 155-for-224. Czinano's 155 made field goals ranks 32nd in the country despite missing the game at Penn State (Jan. 30).

Senior Kathleen Doyle is third in the nation in total assists (157), fourth in assists per game (6.5), 9th in free throws made (121), 13th in free throw attempts (153), 16th in total points (448), 29th in points per game (18.7), and 46th in field goals made (148).

Senior Makenzie Meyer ranks 38th in free throw percentage (85.0) and 40th in

3-pointers made (58).

Senior Amanda Ollinger is ranked 27th in the country with 47 blocked shots, and 39th in blocked shots per game (1.96), and 47th in total rebounds (214).

The Hawkeyes are leading the Big Ten in seven categories, including assists per game (20.2), total assists (484), field-goal percentage (48.5), free throws made (353), 3-point percentage (37.2), 3-pointers made (185), and 3-pointers per game

Lowaranks second in assist turnover ratio (1.32), scoring offense (79.1 ppg), free throw attempts (480), and free-throw percentage (73.5). The Hawkeyes are third in fouls per game (14.8), 3-point attempts (497), and fewest fouls (356).

BIG INDIVIDUALS

Three Hawkeyes rank in the Big Ten top 10 points per game, including senior Kathleen Doyle (18.7), who ranks fourth, sophomore Monika Czinano (15.3), who ranks seventh, and senior Makenzie Meyer (14.8), who ranks 10th. The Hawkeyes are the only team with multiple athletes on the Big Ten top-10 scoring list. Czinano is leading the conference in field goal percentage (69.2) and ranks fourth field goals made, sinking 155-of-224 shots taken. Doyle leads the league in total assists (157) and assists per game (6.5), and freethrows made (121).

Senior Makenzie Meyer leads the Big Ten in free-throw percentage (83.3), ranks third in 3-pointers made, knocking down 60 on the season, and 3-pointers attempted (148), and 3-point percentage (40.5), and ties for third in 3-pointers per

Senior Amanda Ollinger averages 6.4 defensive rebounds per game, tying for first. Ollinger ranks third in total blocks (47) and blocks per game (2.0), and ties

for second in rebounds per game (8.9).

Senior Makenzie Meyer is ranked third in the Big Ten for 3-point percentage (40.5), 3-pointers made (60), 3-pointers per game (2.5), and 3-pointers attempted (148). Iowa is leading the Big Ten in 3-point percentage (37.2), 3-pointers made (185), and 3-pointers per game (7.7) -- numbers that rank 14th, 32nd, and 47th in the NCAA, respectively.

HIGH-POWERED OFFENSE

HEAD COACH LISA BLUDER

Lisa Bluder, the all-time winningest coach in program history, is in her 20th year as head women's basketball coach at the University of Iowa and her 36th year overall. Under her direction, the Hawkeyes have advanced to 18 postseason appearances (14 NCAA and four WNIT) in 19 seasons, including NCAA Tournament berths in 10 of the last 12 seasons. Iowa has advanced to the postseason in 12 consecutive seasons (10 NCAA and two WNIT).
