BACK POINTS

- Iowa leads the all-time series against Ohio State, 38-3.
- Ohio State's only series win in Iowa City was a 17-13 victory in 1929, the first ever meeting in the series. Iowa has since won 14 in a row at home against the Buckeyes.
- For the third time in 13 days, junior Brandon Sorensen will face a top-five opponent. Sorensen is 2-2 this year against ranked opponents, 23-9 in his career against ranked opponents, and 10-8 all-time against top-five opponents.
- Senior Thomas Gilman, the nation's top-ranked 125-pounder, is 18-0 and has scored bonus points in 16 matches.

ON THE MAT

The University of Iowa wrestling team hosts No. 4 Ohio State on Friday at 7 p.m. (CT) on Media-com Mat at Carver-Hawkeye Arena. Tickets are available at the UI Athletics Ticket Office, over the phone at 1-800-IA-HAWKS, and online at hawkeyesports.com.

ON THE TUBE

Friday's dual against Penn State is televised by BTN. Tim Johnson and Jim Gibbons will call the action live from Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

THE SERIES -- OHIO STATE

Iowa leads the all-time series against Ohio State, 38-3. The schools split the first four meetings, 2-2, before Iowa rattled off 34 consecutive victories from 1967-2011. Ohio State ended the streak with a 21-9 win in 2012 at Columbus.

The Hawkeyes have since won the last two meetings, 22-9 at Carver-Hawkeye Arena in 2013 and 18-14 in 2015 at Ohio State. Iowa is 14-1 all-time against the Buckeyes in Iowa City. Ohio State's only win was a 17-13 victory in 1929, the first ever meeting in the series. Iowa has since won 14 in a row at home against the Buckeyes.

HAWKEYES AT HOME

The Hawkeyes are 236-24 all-time at Carver-Hawkeye Arena since moving from the UI Field House in 1983. The Hawkeyes have recorded 20 undefeated seasons in Carver-Hawkeye Arena, the most recent in 2012-13 (9-0).

Carver-Hawkeye Arena has hosted two United States Olympic Team Trials, three Big Ten Championships (1983, 1994, 2005), and four NCAA Championships (1986, 1991, 1995, 2001). The Hawkeyes have won five tournament titles on their home mat, including the 1983 and 1994 Big Ten Championships, and the 1986, 1991 and 1995 NCAA Championships.

NATIONALLY RANKED MATCHUPS

Friday's dual could potentially feature three top-10 matchups and six top-20 matchups. The Hawkeyes and Buckeyes have wrestlers ranked in the top 20 in at least one national poll at 125 (Gilman/Rodriguez), 133 (Clark/Tomasello), 141 (Carton/Pletcher), 149 (Sorensen/Jordan), 174 (Meyer, Jordan), and 184 (Brooks/Martin).

Iowa's Cory Clark, Brandon Sorensen, and Sammy Brooks are scheduled for top-five matchups. Clark, ranked No. 2 by WIN Magazine, faces top-ranked Nathan Tomasello at 133

pounds. Sorensen, ranked No. 3 at 149, faces fifth-ranked Micah Jordan. Brooks, ranked No. 5 at 184, is matched against 10th-ranked Miles Martin, the defending 174-pound NCAA Champion.

Two more Hawkeyes have top five opponents visiting Friday. No. 11 Alex Meyer wrestles top-ranked Bo Jordan at 174 pounds, and Cash Wilcke faces fourth-ranked Kollin Moore at 197.

NICE TO MEET YOU

All 10 matchups feature wrestlers meeting their opponents for the first time. Three Buckeyes have a history with the Hawkeyes, but not against their respective opponent. Thomas Gilman is 2-1 all-time against Nathan Tomasello at 125 pounds with a pin at the 2016 NCAA semifinals. Ohio State's Micah Jordan defeated former Hawkeye Brody Grothus, 5-3, in the opening round of the 2016 Big Ten Championships at 141 pounds, and former Hawkeye Edwin Cooper, Jr. defeated Jake Ryan, 2-1, at the 2016 Big Ten Championships.

UNDEFEATED HAWKEYE

Senior Thomas Gilman enters Friday's dual as the last unbeaten Hawkeye. Gilman has opened his senior season with 18 straight wins. In the history of Iowa wrestling, 15 wrestlers have finished the season with a perfect record (minimum 20 matches). Four of those wrestlers were able to perform the feat twice. They include Mark Ironside, Lincoln McIlravy, T.J. Williams and Jim Zalesky. Iowa coaches Tom Brands and Terry Brands are among the 15 wrestlers. Tom went 45-0 in 1990-91 and Terry went 35-0 in 1991-92.

CHASING MILESTONES

Four Hawkeyes are within striking distance of career win No. 100. Senior Thomas Gilman leads all active Hawkeyes with 93 career wins, three more than senior Sammy Brooks. Senior Cory Clark has 88 career wins, and junior Brandon Sorensen has 86 career wins. Forty wrestlers in the program history have accumulated 100 career wins, including coaches Tom Brands (158), Terry Brands (137), and Ryan Morningstar (110).

A LITTLE EXTRA FROM GILMAN

Senior Thomas Gilman, the nation's top-ranked 125-pounder, is 18-0 and has scored bonus points in 16 matches. Gilman has matched his career high with six technical falls and leads the team with seven pins. He averages 5.0 points per win, and 4.9 points in eight dual wins (three pins, three technical falls, and two major decision). He has five wins over ranked opponents.

Gilman went 6-0 at the 2016 Midlands Championships to win the title for the third time. He is the 11th Hawkeye in program history to win at least three Midlands championships. He recorded one pin, one major decision, and three technical falls en route to the title and was named Champion of Champions by his fellow first-place winners, the Dan Gable Most Outstanding Wrestler of the Tournament, and Big Ten Conference Co-Wrestler of the Week.

CLARK EYES THE TOP SPOT

Senior Cory Clark, who was the nation's top-ranked 133-pounder until losing for the first time on Jan. 15, faces the new No. 1 Nathan Tomasello Friday. Clark is 1-1 this year against top-10 opponents, and 31-14 in his career against ranked opponents. Clark, a two-time NCAA finalist, is looking for his first career win over a No. 1 ranked wrestler. He twice lost to Minnesota's Chris Dardanes in 2015, and fell to Cornell's Nahshon Garrett, 7-6, in the 2016 NCAA Finals.

The last time Tomasello face a Hawkeye while being ranked No. 1, he was pinned by Thomas Gilman in sudden victory in the 125-pound semifinals of the 2016 NCAA Championships.

3 TOP 5'S IN 13 DAYS

For the third time in 13 days, junior Brandon Sorensen, will face a top five opponent when No. 5 Micah Jordan visits Carver-Hawkeye Arena on Friday. In his last two meetings against then-No. 3 Anthony Collica and No. 1 Zain Retherford, Sorensen was on the losing end of two 11-minute matches. On Jan. 15, he lost, 4-3, to Collica in Stillwater, Oklahoma, in the second tiebreak because he trailed by two seconds in riding time. Five days later he lost, 9-8, to Retherford in the second tiebreak.

Sorensen is 2-2 this year against ranked opponents, 23-9 in his career against ranked opponents, and 10-8 all-time against top-five opponents.

Sorensen is ranked No. 3 in the country at 149. He is 17-2 with a team- and career-high eight major decisions. He has scored bonus points in 14-of-17 wins and averages 4.4 points per win.

Sorensen went 5-0 at the 2016 Midlands Championships to win the 149-pound title for the second straight year. He became the 24th wrestler in the 54-year history of the Midlands Championships to join the prestigious 20-in-4 club, which requires a wrestler to record at least 20 wins in their first four years of competition.

MEYER GETS SHOT AT NO. 1

For the first time in his career, senior Alex Meyer will wrestle a top-ranked opponent. Meyer has one top-five win in his career, a 6-2 decision against North Carolina's Ethan Ramos at the 2016 NCAA Championships. He is 2-4 this season against ranked opponents, but that doesn't include a 7-5 decision over Penn State's Mark Hall on Jan. 20. Hall was unranked and making his season debut, but entered the polls at No. 7 even after the loss. Including Hall, five of Meyer's last seven matches have been against top 12 opponents.

BROOKS GET ANOTHER SHOT AT TOP 10

Senior 184-pounder Sammy Brooks had won seven straight prior to getting pinned by No. 2 Bo Nickal on Jan. 20. Brooks' seven-match win streak included two major decisions, two technical falls, and four wins over ranked opponents, including a 13-3 major decision against No. 5 Nolan Boyd of Oklahoma State.

Brooks faces No. 10 Myles Martin on Friday. He is 4-2 this year against ranked opponents, and 23-20 in his career against ranked foes. He is 16-2 overall this season with bonus points in 12 matches.

KEMERER FALLS TO NO. 1, STAYS NO. 2

Redshirt freshman Michael Kemerer, ranked No. 2 at 157, lost a 9-4 decision to top-ranked Jason Nolf on Jan. 20. It was the first loss of Kemerer's season, but he stayed ranked No. 2 in the latest national polls. Kemerer is 19-1 with 11 wins by bonus points and four wins over ranked opponents, including three in the top 10. Four of his last five matches have been against top-10 opponents. He was the first Hawkeye redshirt freshman to win his first 19 matches since Matt McDonough,

won 32 in a row to start the 2009-10 season.

THE ATTENDANCE GAME

The Hawkeyes have averaged 12,179 fans in their first two home duals against Iowa State (Dec. 10) and Penn State (Jan. 20).

Iowa led the national in attendance for the 10th consecutive season in 2015-16, when it averaged an NCAA record 12,166 fans and set the single season dual attendance record when 42,287 fans watched No. 4 Iowa defeat top-ranked Oklahoma State, 18-16, at Kinnick Stadium. Throughout the season, Kinnick and Carver-Hawkeye Arena welcomed 97,325 wrestling fans for a dual meet.

Iowa has averaged more than 8,000 fans in eight straight seasons.

HAWKEYE WRESTLING HISTORY

Iowa's overall dual meet record is 981-228-31 (.799) in 107 seasons. The Hawkeyes have won 23 national titles and 35 Big Ten titles. Iowa's 53 NCAA Champions have won a total of 81 NCAA individual titles, crowning six three-time and 16 two-time champions. The Hawkeyes' 111 Big Ten champions have combined for 197 conference titles. There have been seven four-time, 18 three-time, and 29 two-time Big Ten champions from Iowa.

Iowa's 154 All-Americans have earned All-America status 319 times, including 18 four-time, 36 three-time and 40 two-time honorees.

LAST MEETING: #1 Iowa 18, #7 Ohio State 14 (Jan. 4, 2015 -- Columbus, Ohio)

COLUMBUS, Ohio -- The top-ranked University of Iowa wrestling team won four straight matches to erase a 14-6 deficit and defeat No. 7 Ohio State, 18-14, in front of 6,558 fans at St. John Arena.

The Hawkeyes were quiet through the first three and two-thirds matches. Thomas Gilman used an escape in the first tiebreak to defeat ninth-ranked Nathan Tomasello, 2-1, at 125, but Cory Clark ran out of time in a 7-5 loss at 133 and Josh Dziewa was blanked, 15-0, at 141.

Brandon Sorensen didn't fare much better through two periods at 149, but the redshirt freshman scored three takedowns in the final frame to erase a 5-2 deficit and defeat All-American Hunter Stieber, 9-7.

Michael Kelly forced the action throughout the match, at 157, but he lost a leg in the third period and gave up a takedown as time expired, falling 5-2 and giving Ohio State an 11-6 lead at intermission.

The Buckeyes then grabbed their largest lead of the afternoon when No. 9 Bo Jordan defeated No. 7 Nick Moore, 9-2.

Trailing 14-6, Iowa's final four went to work. Mike Evans chipped into the Ohio State lead in a match emblematic of the dual. He started slow, allowing a takedown in the opening period, but he scored the final five points, a takedown in the second and a reversal in the third to win, 5-2.

Sammy Brooks then cut the lead to 14-12, recording Iowa's only first-period takedown of the dual and holding on for a 3-2 win.

Iowa grabbed the lead for good when Nathan Burak shed his redshirt and defeated seventh-ranked Kyle Snyder, 2-1, at 197. The match was scoreless after one period, but Snyder needed injury time between periods allowing Burak to start on bottom. Snyder piled up over a minute of riding time in the second, but Burak escaped to grab a 1-0 lead. Snyder started neutral and awarded Burak an escape to start the third, but the wrestlers went another two minutes without scoring and Burak held on for the decision.

Iowa led 15-14 when third-ranked Bobby Telford sealed the comeback with a 4-0 decision against tenth-ranked Nick Tavenello at 285.

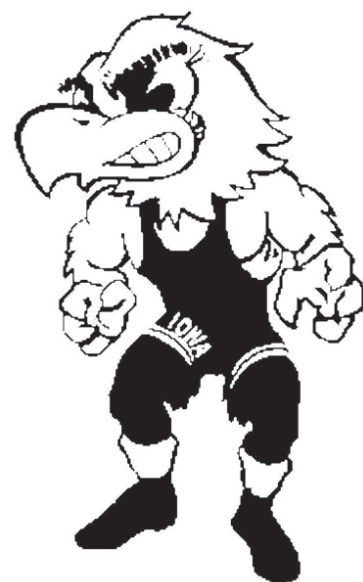

Tom Brands Head Coach University of Iowa, 1992

Three-time Big Ten Coach of the Year Tom Brands is in his 11th season as head wrestling coach at the University of Iowa. A 1996 Olympic gold medalist and member of wrestling's Hall of Fame, Brands is only the eighth wrestling coach at the University of Iowa. The former Hawkeye wrestler was a four-time All-American

and three-time national champion (1989-92) at Iowa. He has a 186-19-1 (.913) overall and 79-7 (.928) Big Ten coaching record at Iowa, and a 203-39-1 (.842) career mark.

In 10 full seasons as Iowa's head coach, Brands has led the Hawkeyes to three NCAA and four Big Ten team titles, crowning nine NCAA champions, 13 Big Ten champions and 56 All-Americans. Iowa has had 80 academic all-Big Ten recipients, including a school-record 12 in 2011-12. The Hawkeyes have qualified 91 wrestlers for the NCAA Championships in the last 10 years, sending the entire 10-man lineup in 2009, 2010, 2014, and 2015. Iowa has also won or shared eight of the last nine Big Ten regular season titles.

Iowa also made another entry in the record books, setting the national collegiate dual meet attendance record of 42,287 when Iowa defeated top-ranked Oklahoma State, 18-16, on Nov. 14, 2016 at the Grapple on the Gridiron at Kinnick Stadium. Iowa has led the nation in attendance in each of Brands' 10 seasons, setting an NCAA all-time attendance average of 12,166 in 2015-16.

Brands was named 2008 NWCA Coach of the Year after leading the Hawkeyes to their first NCAA team title since 2000 and their first Big Ten team title since 2004. He was named Big Ten Coach of the Year in 2008, 2009 and 2010, becoming the first coach in conference history to earn the honor in three consecutive seasons.

Brands served as head coach at Virginia Tech University for two seasons (2005-06), recording a 17-20 dual mark. In his first season with the Hokies, Brands led the team to the 2005 regular season Atlantic Coast Conference title, set a school record for dual meet wins (16) and had a school-record five wrestlers qualify for the NCAA Championships. During his tenure, Virginia Tech crowned five ACC champions and had two All-Americans. Senior heavy-weight Mike Faust was named 2006 ACC Wrestler of the Year.

Prior to taking the helm at Virginia Tech, Brands was an assistant coach at Iowa for 12 seasons (1993-2004). He helped the Hawkeyes to a 177-27 dual record, seven NCAA and eight Big Ten team titles, while crowning 23 NCAA champions, 73 All-Americans and 36 Big Ten champions. He was named the National Wrestling Coaches Association Assistant Coach of the Year in 2000.

In 2004, he was one of three coaches for the U.S. Olympic freestyle wrestling team, participating in Athens, and in 2016 he was named a volunteer coach of the United States Olympic team in Rio. Brands also served as assistant coach for the U.S. Freestyle World Teams in 2001, 2002, 2003, 2013, 2014, and 2015. He was named Freestyle Coach of the Year by USA Wrestling in 2002 and 2003. He has coached a number of other U.S. teams in international competition.

As a competitor, Brands won the 1996 Olympic freestyle gold medal at 136.5 pounds in Atlanta, Georgia. He also won a gold medal at the 1993 World Freestyle Championships in Toronto, two World Cup gold medals (1994, 1995) and was the 1995 Pan American Games champion. He won four U.S. National titles (1993-96) and made four straight U.S. World or Olympic teams (1993-96). Along with his twin brother, Terry, Tom was named 1993 USA Wrestling Athlete of the Year, the 1993 John Smith Outstanding Freestyle Wrestler, and 1993 Amateur Wrestling News Man of the Year. He was inducted into wrestling's Hall of Fame in 2001, and entered the Midlands Hall of Fame with Terry in 2016.

Brands was a four-time All-American at Iowa (1989-92). During his Hawkeye career, he won three NCAA titles and was named Outstanding Wrestler of the 1992 NCAA Championships. Also a three-time Big Ten champion, Brands won 95 percent of his matches at Iowa. His career mark of 158-7-2 includes an undefeated season in 1991 (45-0).

The Sheldon, Iowa, native was born April 9, 1968. He earned his B.S. degree in physical education from Iowa in 1992. He and his wife, Jeni, have three children, Madigan, Kinsee and Tommy.
