GAME #5 STORYLINES

- Friday will be the third meeting between Iowa and Virginia and first since a 75-64 Hawkeye win in Charlottesville on March 27, 2013 in the quarterfinals of the NIT.
- Iowa will be making its second straight trip to the state of Florida for a Thanksgiving holiday tournament. The Hawkeyes played in the Advocare Invitational in Orlando a year ago.
- Senior Dale Jones suffered a fracture in his right wrist and will miss the next 8-9 weeks.
- Peter Jok, who enters Friday's game with 969 career points, has scored double digits in all four games, including netting 27 or more points in three of the contests. Jok leads the Big Ten in scoring (24.3 ppg), scoring nearly a point per minute played (97 points in 104 minutes).
- Peter Jok joined Reggie Evans (twice) and Aaron Fuller as the only Hawkeyes to post 30+ points and 10+ rebounds in a single game the last 20 years. Jok totaled 30 points and 11 rebounds against Seton Hall. His efforts last week earned the team captain Big Ten Player of the Week honors.
- Iowa's Nicholas Baer and Virginia's London Perrantes have 13 assists to only two turnovers. Baer has played 92 minutes, while Perrantes has played 81 minutes.
- Iowa will play another member of the Atlantic Coast Conference next week, traveling to Notre Dame in the annual ACC/Big Ten Challenge.
- Peter Jok (97 points) and Tyler Cook (59 points) account for 40 percent of Iowa's offense.
- Peter Jok was named to the preseason 10-player All-Big Ten first team, while also being named to the 2017 Jerry West Shooting Guard of the Year Award and 2017 Naismith Trophy and John Wooden Award watch lists.
- lowa has competed in postseason play the last five years (NCAA 2014-16; NIT 2012-13).
- The Hawkeyes won 22 games, tied for third place in the Big Ten, and won an NCAA Tournament game each of the last two seasons.
- lowa has won 20 or more games in four consecutive seasons -- its longest streak in 15 years.
- Fran McCaffery has guided lowa to upper division finishes in the Big Ten in each of the last four seasons. McCaffery, who is one of just 12 Division I head coaches to take four different programs to the NCAA Tournament, has accumulated 16 first division finishes in 20 years as a head coach. McCaffery has posted 10 seasons of 20 or more wins as a head coach.
- lowa is 53-8 when scoring 80 points or more, the last six seasons. The Hawkeyes are 61-2 when holding opponents to fewer than 61 points, the last six years.

<u>ON THE AIR</u>

Radio: lowa games are broadcast on the Hawkeye Radio Network. Jim Albracht will handle the play-by-play, along with color commentator Bob Hansen. The network includes more than 40 stations that blanket the state of lowa and include portions of Illinois, Nebraska, Minnesota, Missouri and Wisconsin. The Hawkeye Radio Network coverage includes a 60-minute pregame show.

TV: Friday's game will be televised nationally on CBS Sports Network. Bradley Johansen and Doug Gottlieb will call the action.

ALL-TIME SERIES RESULTS

lowa is 2-0 all-time against Virginia. The Hawkeyes beat the Cavaliers in the first round of the NCAA Tournament, 73-60, in Salt Lake City on March 13, 1997. Iowa defeated Virginia, 75-64, in March 27, 2013 in Charlottesville in the NIT Quarterfinals. The Hawkeyes made all 15 free throw attempts in the road win against Virginia in 2013.

lowa is 2-0 all-time against Memphis and 0-1 against Providence. Both previous contests against Memphis were played on neutral floors: lowa topped Memphis 73-66 in Los Angeles in 1983 and 75-71 in Kansas City in 2001. Providence edged lowa, 71-70, in lowa City in 1965.



PETER JOK NAMED BIG TEN PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Peter Jok was named Big Ten Player of the Week on Monday. Jok, who collects his second Big Ten weekly honor of his career and first of the season, was a stat sheet stuffer in two games last week for the Hawkeyes. The guard averaged 28.5 points, six rebounds, two steals, and two assists in two games. Jok made all 10 free throw attempts and shot 59 percent (20-of-34) from the field, including 44 percent (7-of-16) from 3-point range.

The 6-foot-6, 205-pound guard registered his first career double-double in Iowa's loss to Seton Hall, posting career highs in scoring (30) and rebounding (11).

Jok helped led lowa to a 95-67 win over UT Rio Grande Valley last Sunday. The team captain totaled 27 points, two steals and one rebound in only 19 minutes of action. Jok shot a blistering 69 percent (9-of-13) from the field, including 62 percent (5-of-8) from long distance. The five 3-pointers equaled a personal best.

HEAD COACH FRAN McCAFFERY

Fran McCaffery, who is signed through the 2020 season, is in his seventh season as the head basketball coach at the University of Iowa and his 20th year overall as a college head coach. McCaffery has reached the 20-win plateau eight of the last 10 seasons, including the last four years.

McCaffery spent five seasons (2005-10) as the head coach at Siena, six years at UNC-Greensboro (1999-2005) and three seasons at Lehigh (1985-88) before joining the Hawkeyes.

McCaffery has three decades of Division I coaching experience. He completed his 34th season as a

collegiate coach in 2016, which includes 20 years as a head coach and 14 as an assistant. McCaffery is one of 12 coaches to lead four different Division I teams to the NCAA Tournament.

McCaffery, 57, holds a career mark of 372-264 (.585) and guided his teams to 10 postseason appearances (seven NCAA and three NIT). He is 121-87 (.582) at Iowa. McCaffery has led Iowa to NCAA Tournament victories in each of the past two seasons, the first time Hawkeye teams have won tournament games in consecutive seasons since 1996-97

Since taking over the lowa program in 2010, the Hawkeyes have earned five postseason tournament berths (3 NCAA, 2 NIT). McCaffery coached lowa to 25 victories in 2013, equaling the second-most win total in program history. McCaffery has guided five different Hawkeyes to all-conference honors, including three straight first team honorees. The last time lowa had three consecutive first-team all-league honorees was 1946-48.

McCaffery has posted upper division finishes in each of the past four seasons at Iowa and 16 of 20 seasons as a head coach. He has posted 20 wins or more eight of the last 10 seasons, including the last four at Iowa (2013, 2014, 2015, and 2016).

McCaffery and the Hawkeyes have made Carver-Hawkeye Arena one of the most feared arenas to play nationally. Fans have embraced McCaffery and his team's style of play with attendance increasing by more than 50 percent since 2010. The Hawkeyes boast a 58-12 home record the last four seasons, which includes a school-record 18 wins in 2014.

McCaffery's five years at Siena were the best in its 70-year history. He led the Saints on an incredible run that ended with three straight Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference championships and NCAA Tournament appearances. In so doing, Siena became the only program in the country to win its regular season and postseason title 2008-10.

McCaffery's Saints owned a 112-51 (.687) record in his five years with the program. He guided the Saints to four consecutive 20-win seasons.

The 2009 MAAC Coach of the Year and 2010 District I Coach of the Year is the third winningest coach, by percentage, in league history (68-22, .756). He is the only coach to guide a MAAC program to two NCAA Tournament wins. McCaffery led his 2008 and 2009 teams to first round NCAA Tournament victories over Vanderbilt and Ohio State, respectively.

In his final two seasons at Siena, he coached the Saints to back-to-back 27-win campaigns and boasted a combined 39-3 (.929) record against MAAC opponents, which included MAAC Tournament contests.

McCaffery began his coaching career as an assistant at Penn (1982-83) and Lehigh (1983-85). After three seasons as head coach at Lehigh, he spent 11 seasons as an assistant at Notre Dame (1988-99).

McCaffery played basketball at Wake Forest his freshman year (1977-78) and then concluded his collegiate playing career at Penn his final three seasons (1979-82).

He earned his B.S. degree in Economics from The Wharton School (Penn) in 1982. McCaffery also earned a Master of Education from Lehigh in 1985.

HAWKEYES OVERWHELM UT RIO GRANDE VALLEY

Four Hawkeyes scored in double figures in 195-67 win over UT Rio Grande Valley (UTRGV) Sunday afternoon in Iowa City.

- Leading the way offensively for the Hawkeyes were Peter Jok with 27 points, followed by Tyler Cook (15), Isaiah Moss (14), and Brady Ellingson (11).
- lowa scored 41 points after forcing 26 Vaquero turnovers. The Hawkeyes also outscored UTRGV 10-0 in transition.
- The Hawkeyes drained 11 triples, led by Peter Jok's five, which tied a career high. Moss and Ellingson made two apiece, while Dom Uhl and Jordan Bohannon each made one.
- Freshmen Ryan Kriener recorded a game-high three blocks, while Nicholas Baer continued to fill the stat sheet (8 points, 7 rebounds, 3 assists, and a game-best 3 steals).
- lowa improved to 11-0 against current members of the Western Athletic Conference.

SCOUTING VIRGINIA

- Virginia won its first three games of the season, winning at UNC Greensboro (76-51) and beating St. Francis Brooklyn (72-32) and Yale (62-38) at home.
- Virginia won its first three games by an average of 29.7 points. The Cavaliers average 70 points per game, while allowing only 40.3 points per contest.
- The Cavaliers have one active player who averages double digits in scoring, Marial Shayok (12.7). Memphis transfer Austin Nichol scored 11 points against St. Francis on Nov. 15, before being dismissed from the squad last week.
- In their last outing against Yale on Sunday, Virginia grabbed 13 more rebounds than the Bulldogs. The Cavaliers controlled 16 offensive rebounds and scored 15 points on second chance opportunities. Virginia forced 14 turnovers and scored 18 points off the Yale miscues.
- Preseason All-ACC first team honoree London Perrantes averages 8.7 points, 2.3 rebounds, and a team-best 4.3 assists. The senior guard has committed only two turnovers.
- Tony Bennett is in his eighth season (168-72) at Virginia and 11th year (237-105) overall as a head coach. The Wisconsin native has guided the Cavaliers to five straight postseason tournaments, including four NCAA Tournaments. Virginia advanced to the Elite Eight last March, beating Hampton, Butler, and Iowa State before falling to Syracuse.

PETER JOK IN HIS FINAL SEASON AS A HAWKEYE

After averaging seven points per game as a sophomore, Peter Jok surged 9.1 points last year as a junior averaging 16.1 points per contest. The 9.1 improvement was tops among Big Ten players. Jok's 16.1 scoring average ranks second among Big Ten players returning this season behind Illinois' Malcolm Hill (18.1 ppg).

Jok was named to the preseason All-Big Ten first team, while also being named to the 2017 Jerry West Shooting Guard of the Year Award and 2017 Naismith Trophy and John Wooden Award watch lists. Jok is averaging a team-best 24.3 points per game through four contests this season. The 24.3 scoring average is an 8.2 improvement from last year.

Jok ranked second on the team in scoring (16.1 ppg) and first in free throw accuracy (.852, 92-of-108). Jok made 28 straight free throws before missing in the win over Temple. He has made 12 straight free throws to start this season. Jok scored 20 points or more 10 times in 2015-16, while he has eclipsed 20 points three times already this year.

Jok became the first Hawkeye non-senior to average 16 points or more since Chris Kingsbury averaged 16.8 points as a sophomore in 1995.

DALE JONES TO MISS 8-9 WEEKS DUE TO INJURY

Senior Dale Jones suffered a fracture in his right wrist in Iowa's game against Seton Hall (Nov. 17) and is expected to miss approximately 8-9 weeks. After missing the first two games this season, Jones sustained the injury minutes after making his season debut against Seton Hall.

Jones, who transferred to lowa in 2015 after three years at Tyler Junior College in Texas, has played limited minutes in only seven games during his Hawkeye career. Jones suffered a season-ending knee injury in practice on Dec. 1, 2015, after competing in lowa's first six games. The native of Waterloo, lowa, suffered his first knee injury in 2014.

NICHOLAS BAER PLAYED OVERSEAS IN AUGUST

Nicholas Baer averaged 8.5 points, 8.3 rebounds, and two steals in four games (3-1) overseas on the USA East Coast All-Star Team.

This marked the sixth consecutive year that a Hawkeye traveled overseas with the USA East Coast basketball team. In 2011, Matt Gatens and Bryce Cartwright traveled overseas; Zach McCabe went in 2012; Jarrod Uthoff was on the roster in 2013; Mike Gesell and Adam Woodbury competed in 2014; while Dom Uhl traveled with the team in 2015.

IOWA HISTORY

lowa has played 2,710 games since beginning basketball in 1902. lowa's overall record is 1,596-1,114 (.589). That includes a 1,018-356 (.741) record in home games, a 574-755 (.432) record in contests away from lowa City, a 752-757 (.498) mark in Big Ten games and a 423-130 (.765) record in Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

IOWA SIGNS 2 PREP STANDOUTS

Luka Garza and Jack Nunge have signed a National Letter of Intent to attend the University of Iowa in 2017.

Garza is a 6-foot-11, 240-pound forward from Maret School in Washington, D.C. Garaza is a two-time first team All-DC, all-conference and second team Washington Post All-Met honoree. He scored more than 1,000 points and grabbed over 600 rebounds his first three years. Garza averaged 25.5 points, 12.6 rebounds, and 2.6 blocks as a junior, and 19.8 points and 9.8 rebounds his sophomore campaign. He helped Maret earn back-to-back conference championships (22-8 in 2014 and 22-5 in 2015). He was recognized as the 2014-15 Washington Post All-Met Most Improved Player. Garza averaged 11.3 points (54% FG, 36% 3-pt FG) and 6.5 rebounds last year in the EYBL.

Nunge is also 6-foot-11 and weighs 220 pounds. He hails from Newburgh, Indiana and attends Castle High School. Nunge earned first-team All-SIAC, IBCA Supreme 15 Underclassmen, and Indiana All Star-Core 6 honors following his junior campaign. He posted a team-best 18 double-doubles, and averaged 19.3 points (FG%: 57%, 3-pt FG%: 43%, FT%: 81%), 11.4 rebounds, and 3.7 blocks per game his junior season. He was named team Most Valuable Player in 2016. A two-time team captain, he tallied 35 points and 25 rebounds against Bosse High School, and 35 points and 22 rebounds versus Harrison High School his junior season. Nunge also excels in the classroom, boasting a 3.97 grade point average, ranks 20th in his class, and earned the Scholastic "C" Award. He is a member of the National Honor Society and Student Council. He played with the Pocket City AAU basketball team.

CARVER-HAWKEYE ARENA ENHANCEMENTS

The lowa Athletic Department upgraded Carver-Hawkeye Arena's video boards, sound system, lighting, digital scorestable displays, and playing surface this past summer.

A new four-sided centerhung video system is the centerpiece of the installation. The two main centerhung displays measure approximately 14.5 feet high by 26 feet wide and the other two centerhung displays measure 9.5 feet high by 16.5 feet wide. The project also upgraded the auxiliary displays located near the ceiling at each side of the arena.
